MEN'S

Derek Oland, Midwestern State University, JR, McKinney, Texas, Boyd HS

Oland set a new Midwestern State 36-hole record in winning The Classic at The Tribute with a 13-under-131, taking the individual title by five strokes. The 6-2 junior from McKinney, Texas/Boyd toured the par 72, 6,535-yard course at The Tribute at The Colony with a 7-under 65 in the first round and then followed it with a 6-under 66 in the final round. His 131 bettered the programs previous 36-hole record of 135 by four strokes and the 13-under-par mark shattered the previous mark of 8-under through 36 by five strokes. Oland has a fall stroke average of 70.80, with seven of his 10 rounds of par or better and four in the 60s.

WOMEN'S

Isabel Jimenez-Perea, Tarleton State University, SO, Cobena, Spain

Jimenez-Perea carded back-to-back 3-under 68's this week, on the way to capturing the individual title at the Rock Barn Invitational in Conover, N.C. Jimenez-Perea has now won individual titles in consecutive tournaments, shooting par in three of her last four rounds. Her two-day total of 6-under-par was inspirational in the TexAnns claiming second place overall as a team and finishing just eight strokes behind the nation's No. 1 ranked team, Lynn.

Cameron

The Cameron University men's golf team finished off the fall with a 12 stroke win at The Classic at The Tribute in Commerce, Texas. The Aggies shot a 277 in round one and then followed that up the next day by carding a 279 to give them a score of 556 for the tournament. Dylan McClure and Michael Kelly matched each other in both rounds and led Cameron with a pair of 68s on day one and then two 70s to finish up with a pair of 138s, which tied them for fourth individually. Bradley Ferrell tied for 10th by improving from his first round 75 to card a 66 for the final round and give him a score of 141 for the tournament. Felipe Anzarut and Corey Bounds rounded out the Aggie five with scores of 144 and 145 respectively. The Cameron JV team also competed in the event, and placed eighth overall with a score of 580. They were led by Zeb Littlefield, who tied for fourth with fellow Aggies McClure and Kelly. Littlefield shot one over par on day one, but bounced and tied for the lowest round of the tournament by carding a 65 to give him a score of 138 over the two day tournament. This was Cameron's final event of the fall, and they will take the next couple of months to prepare themselves for the upcoming spring season.

The TexAnns closed out the fall schedule with a second-place finish at the Rock Barn Invitational in Conover, N.C., this week... The No. 7-ranked TexAnns carded scores of 1-over 285 and 4-over 288 (+5, 573), finishing just eight strokes behind the nation's No. 1-ranked team, Lynn (-3, 565)... Tarleton has now posted team scores below 300 in five straight rounds and in six of the eight rounds it has played in this fall... The TexAnns had one team championship (Oklahoma Intercollegiate), a pair of second place finishes and one third place finish this fall... Isabel Jimenez-Perea, a sophomore for the TexAnns, won her second straight individual title after carding back-to-back 3-under-par 68's this week... Here two-day score of 6-under was two strokes better than her next competitor and five strokes better than those players that tied for third place... She has played under-par in four of her eight rounds this fall, averaging 71.25 strokes per round... Junior Jessica Pickwick had her best tournament of the season, finishing in a tie for third place after carding a 71 on Monday and a season-low 70 on Tuesday... She will head into the spring season averaging 75.25 strokes per round... Freshman Beatriz Prados is averaging 75.12 in her eight rounds this fall... Senior Sharon Lau is averaging 77.0 strokes per round, while junior Maraea Durie is averaging 78.75 strokes per round.
