LSC BASKETBALL

The Tarleton State men's team is the lone unbeaten Lone Star Conference squad at 10-0 heading into the Winter Break. On the women's side, West Texas A&M and TSU each have one loss to top the standings.

After the break from December 23-29, teams return to the court with a mix of LSC and non-conference games.

The LSC men have a 59-27 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 19-8 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 1-3 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 51-34 overall. The women's squads are currently 12-10 combined against the Heartland, and 7-6 versus RMAC teams, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Chuck Guy, Tarleton State University, SR, Guard, Fort Worth, Texas, Eastern Hills

Guy averaged 15.0 points per game while guiding the Texans to a 3-0 week, which included downing No. 5-ranked Western Washington in Las Vegas, Nev., on Sunday. Guy was 29-for-31 from the charity stripe on the week after making 6-of-6 free throws in the final minutes and securing wins against both McMurry and Central Washington. He was a perfect 13-for-13 at the stripe against WWU, averaged 5.0 assists per game and tallied eight steals on the week as well.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Davene Carter, Tarleton State University, JR, Forward, Duncanville, Texas, Duncanville

Carter averaged 4.0 rebounds and had three blocks in three wins for the Texans this week. Carter was influential in the Texans downing No. 5-ranked Western Washington on Sunday, pouring in 20 points, pulling down seven boards and blocking two shots. The Duncanville native went on to be named to the South Point Holiday Hoops Classic All-Tournament Team following his two-day performance in Las Vegas, Nev.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Devin Griffin, West Texas A&M University, SR, Forward, Lubbock, Texas, Coronado HS

Led the team in scoring at 19.0 points in a pair of huge wins against Simon Fraser and at No. 9 Seattle Pacific to help the Lady Buffs improve to a league-best 9-1 record. She went 14 of 26 from the field for a .538 clip and 9 of 12 from the line (.750) and 1 of 2 from beyond the arc. Had 13 rebounds in the two games (6.5 avg.) to tie for the team lead. She had eight assists to just four turnovers along with four steals and one block. Griffin had 20 points for her third 20-plus point game of the season against Simon Fraser and followed with 18 against SPU in both come-from-behind wins.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Khalisha Lee, Angelo State University, JR, Forward, Houston, Texas, Russelville High

Lee was a key part of the Belle defense that set a school record for fewest points allowed in a game with 30 against Schreiner. Overall, Lee and the Belles limited teams to 40.5 points per game and held teams to 23.4-percent shooting with an exhibition win over Incarnate Word. The Houston native averaged 5.5 rebounds and 6.0 points per game in the two wins including eight points and seven rebounds in the win over Schreiner. She had three blocks and five steals on the defensive side for the week.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Rashad Basey, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led the Javelinas in scoring on Wednesday for the ninth time in 12 games with 23 points and sits second in the LSC with 19.1 points a contest. It was the sixth, 20-point game for Basey, who has scored at least 11 points each game this season.

Rodney Blackmon, Eastern New Mexico University, recorded his 12th straight game of scoring 10+ points with a team-high 19-point performance at Azusa Pacific. He went 7-for-17 (41.2%) from the field including 4-of-12 (33.3%) on shots from beyond the arc. Inside the three-point line, Blackmon went 3-for-5 (60.0%). He grabbed three rebounds and dished out a team-best three assists while also recording a steal. Blackmon is averaging a LSC-best 20.9 ppg while recording 4.1 apg.

Kenny Williams, Angelo State University, continued his strong start to the season by averaging 18 points and 6.7 rebounds in a three-game week. Williams scored 23 points against Oklahoma Wesleyan last Tuesday before scoring 17 last Saturday against Arkansas-Monticello in 23 minutes of play. Williams is averaging 17.8 points per game this season and has recorded five double-doubles.

Ronald Scott, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, finished with eight points, eight assists, and four steals versus Texas Lutheran. Scott and Jordan Jahr combined for seven of Kingsville's nine steals.

Daniel Skinner, Angelo State University, has proved to be a versatile player for the Rams this season and continued producing last week. Skinner had four steals last Saturday against Arkansas-Monticello and finished the three-game week with six steals, four blocks and 17 rebounds. He also added 11 assists and averaged 11.7 points per game. He has 12 blocks and 16 steals through the first 12 games of the ASU season.

Cornelius Cammock, Eastern New Mexico University, grabbed a game-high six rebounds and set a new career-best with three steals which was also the most by a player in the game at Azusa Pacific. His rebounds were evenly split with three being offensive and three defensive. Cammock scored 16 points on 4-of-7 (57.1%)

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Hillari Adam, Angelo State University, was the Belles leading scorer in both victories last week. The Wall native averaged 18.5 points and 7.5 rebounds. The junior hit 60.0-percent of her shots from the field and 85.7-percent from the charity stripe. It is her ninth game of the season to score in double figures and her third and fourth of scoring at least 18 points.

Kirsti Degelia, Midwestern State University, was an offensive leader for the Mustangs as Midwestern extended its winning streak to five straight with wins at Texas-Permian Basin and at home against Cedarville (Ohio). Degelia averaged 16.5 points with 3.5 assists to go with 4.0 rebounds for the week. The 5-8 senior guard from Denton, Texas/Krum shot 54.5 percent from the floor (12-of-22), including 67.7 percent (4-of-6) from the 3-point arc. She also had a block and two steals. Degelia led the Mustangs with 18 points and six assists in the 68-57 win over Cedarville, and had 15 points with five rebounds at UTPB.

Breanna Harris, Texas A&M University - Commerce, continued her solid play to help the Lions go 1-1 last week and help the Lions pick up their first win of the season over OBU ... The senior has scored in double-figures in all eight games this season with her 17 and 10-point efforts this past week ... Harris is second in the LSC in ppg (17.5) and rpg (10.8) so far this season ... The Mansfield native is also having a career year from the free throw line so far by hitting .706 of attempts.

Jade Herl, Cameron University, managed to make eight three pointers and average 13 points in Cameron's two games this last week in Alaska. Herl shot 57.1% from the arc over the weekend and was perfect from the line. Her performance was good enough to be placed on the All-Tournament team. Herl has hit double digit scoring in her last five games while shooting 41% from the field this season.

Ruby Robertson, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led the Javelina offense from off the bench over the last week with a team-best 12.0 a game. She hit 10-of-16 shots on the week. She had 12 points in each of two games. Robertson matched her season-high of rebounds with seven in the final game before the break with. She played just 15 minutes against the Blossoms and 10 minutes against Southern Arkansas for 24 points in 25 minutes

DJ Vallier, Cameron University, came up big on the defensive end for the Aggies with five blocks and three steals. Vallier had four blocks and three steals against UA-Anchorage who was 9-1. She added one more block on the next night against Brevard. In two games in Alaska Vallier helped the Aggies hold teams to 38.4% shooting from the field.

Danielle Dixon, Texas A&M University - Commerce, tied a career high with five steals in the Lions win over OBU last week ... The senior also helped the Lions play their best defense of the season last week in terms of ppg (71.5) and FG% (39.2), leading to a 1-1 record ... Against OBU Dixon also set a season high four defensive rebounds.

Chontiquah White, West Texas A&M University, had two big games this week as she was 10 of 23 from the field and 6 of 7 from the line in two huge wins for the Lady Buffs against Simon Fraser and at No. 9 Seattle Pacific. White tied for the team-lead in rebounding at 6.5 per game and tallied six offensive rebounds. She tallied eight assists and two steals for the week. White and WT held the opposition to .416 from the field, including holding Seattle Pacific to just .329 from the field in the 74-65 win Saturday. WT forced 29 miscues and had 18 steals for the week.

Andrea Carter, Midwestern State University, led Midwestern State on both ends of the floor as the Mustangs extended their winning streak to five straight heading into the holiday break with a 77-67 win at Texas-Permian Basin and a 68-57 triumph at home over Cedarville (Ohio). Carter averaged 17.0 points and 10.0 rebounds with 1.5 blocked shots and 1.0 steals for the week. The 5-10 junior forward from Angleton, Texas shot 77.8 percent from the floor (14-of-18) and hit her only 3-point attempt, while going 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) from the free throw line. She tallied 15 points with nine rebounds at UTPB, then followed that with her fourth double-double of the season against Cedarville with 16 points and 11 boards to go with two blocked shots.

Lindsey Mahone, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, continued to establish herself as a 2-way threat for the Hoggies. The team's leading scorer at over 13 a game, Mahone had 15 rebounds on the week for 7.5 a game and now is averaging 6.4. Of those 15 rebounds, 12 came on the defensive end.
