LSC BASKETBALL

The Lone Star Conference Basketball Championship is rapidly approaching, with only three weeks of regular season play remaining. Midwestern State remains atop the standings on both the men's side and women's side.

The MSU men have won five-straight to improve to 12-2 in conference play ahead of Incarnate Word (8-4). On the women's side, the Mustangs stretched their winning streak to 11 games and lead the league with a 13-2 mark, which is just in front of Abilene Christian (12-3), Tarleton State (11-3), and UIW (10-4).

The LSC champion will be the regular season winner determined by conference games, while the postseason tournament winner is designated as LSC Tournament Champion and earns the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. The top eight teams in the final conference standings qualify for the postseason tournament set for March 6-9 in Allen, Texas.

The LSC men have a 116-94 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 18-18 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 3-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 113-117 overall. The women's squads are currently 17-12 combined versus Heartland teams, and 5-1 against the RMAC, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

LSC BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP: TICKETS ON SALE NOW

Lone Star Conference officials revealed a new team spirit pass option as advance tickets are on sale now for the 2013 LSC Basketball Championship, set for March 6-9 at the Allen Event Center in Allen, Texas.

The pass, featuring modest pricing of \$30 for adults and \$20 for students, will cater to those fans whose primary interest is simply to follow their favorite team instead of attending all of the tournament's seven sessions. Available only for purchase at member schools through Feb. 21, team spirit passes entitle the bearer to admission to all games (up to three) played by a men's or women's team from the school of choice.

Those wanting access to all seven sessions can purchase all-session tickets at a reduced rate of \$45 through Feb. 27 at member schools. After the advance purchase deadline, the adult price moves to \$60 for all-session tickets or \$15 per session. Student prices will be \$32 for all-session tickets or \$10 by session.

Tickets are also available at the Allen Event Center Box Office or through Ticketmaster (www.ticketmaster.com). Another option available to fans is to enjoy the view from one of the Allen Event Center's luxury suites. This marks the second straight year for the LSC Basketball Championship to be played in Allen, with the tournament again featuring eight men's and eight women's teams. The format is set to change slightly this year, with all games being played in doubleheader sessions throughout the event. Every doubleheader session will consist of a women's game followed by a men's game, including Saturday night's final session that features both the men's and women's championship games.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Rodney Blackmon, Eastern New Mexico University, JR, Guard, Los Angeles, Calif., David Starr Jordan HS/West LA College
Blackmon averaged 23.0 points, 5.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocks per game in contests against Cameron and Midwestern State. Blackmon scored 22 points including 16 of the Greyhounds' final 18 points against the Aggies. He made the game-winning jumper in the paint with 2.9 seconds left as Eastern won 74-72. He dished out five assists, grabbed four rebounds and blocked a career-high two shots against CU as well. On the road at Midwestern State, Blackmon was 6-for-18 from the field and 9-of-12 at the free throw line as he netted 24 points in Eastern's setback. He handed out a game-high six assists, pulled down three boards and his three steals tied his career-best in 39 minutes of action. With his two 20-plus point scoring efforts, Blackmon has scored 20 points or more in six of ENMU's last eight games.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Eddie D'Haiti, Midwestern State University, JR, Forward, Orlando, Fla., Oak Ridge HS/Youngstown State
D'Haiti played a central role in one of the Midwestern State's most dominating defensive efforts of the season Wednesday night at First United Bank Center. He had two blocked shots and severely altered five more shots while playing a key role in forcing NCAA Division II field goal percentage leader and LSC Preseason Player of the Year Donald Sims into a 4-for-14 shooting night. D'Haiti's efforts helped the Mustangs limit WT to 3-of-23 shooting (13 percent) officially in the opening half as the Buffs managed their second lowest scoring output since moving to NCAA Division II in 1986-87 in the 55-42 victory. D'Haiti blocked three more shots against

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Mackenzie Lankford, Abilene Christian University, JR, Guard, Weatherford, Texas, Weatherford HS

Lankford, who was hurt earlier in the week at Commerce, finished with 31 points Saturday in an 86-70 win over Tarleton State. The victory pushed the Wildcats ahead of the TexAnns for second place in the Lone Star Conference. Lankford's effort vs. Tarleton marked the second-best scoring game of her career behind a 38-point effort against Texas A&M-Kingsville on Feb. 19, 2012. Against the TexAnns, Lankford poured in 25 first-half points on 7 of 9 shooting, including 5 of 7 from 3-point range. She was also 6 of 7 from the free throw line, pulled down four rebounds and had one assist in 16 minutes of play. With Tarleton's defense concentrating even more on Lankford in the second half, she had just six points in 14 minutes, but that allowed Whitney West (eight points), Kelsey Smith (nine points) and Sadie Dickinson (five points) to take over the scoring load for the Wildcats, who beat Tarleton State for the first time since 2009.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Andrea Carter, Midwestern State University, SO, Forward, Angleton, Texas, Angleton HS

Led Midwestern State in a pair of victories including the Mustangs first win in Canyon in a decade to place the Mustangs alone at the top of the Lone Star Conference standings. The 5-10 sophomore forward from Angleton had 12 points with seven rebounds and a blocked shot in the Mustangs 58-55 win at West Texas A&M, the first for MSU at the First United Bank Center since 2003. She followed that with her 11th double-double of the year, collecting a career-high 21 points with 10 rebounds in a 67-52 win over Eastern New Mexico where she added three steals. For the week, Carter shot 73.7 percent from the floor and 62.5 percent from the foul line while averaging 16.5 points and 8.5 rebounds. She helped MSU hold its opponents to 53.5 points and shooting 38.5 percent from the floor as the Mustangs extended their conference-best winning streak to 11 games, the second-best winning streak this season in the South Central Region.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Craig Foster, Cameron University, led the Aggies in points in both of their games last week putting up 19 points at Eastern New Mexico on Feb. 6 and 29 against West Texas A&M on Feb. 9. Foster put up 10 assists this week to keep his season average at 5.6 which is a tied for a program best historically and top 20 in the nation. The 29 points against the Buffs on Feb. 9 was the highest point total a player done against WT all season who was second in the nation in scoring defense. With the pair of high scoring games, Foster pushed his season point's average to 16.1 per game. He averaged 24.0 points per game last week, with 5.0 assists, 18-21 from the line (85.7 percent), and had a pair of steals for CU.

Preston Whitley, Texas A&M University - Commerce, helped lead the Lions to a 1-1 mark over the week, averaging 17.5 points and 5.5 rebounds while shooting 47.8% from the floor and 60.0% from three-point range ... Against Angelo State, Whitley finished with 24 points, including going 5-of-6 from three-point range and 5-of-6 from the free throw line ... Whitley hit threes on five-straight possessions in the first half, helping the Lions overcome a 7-point deficit to build an 11-point lead ... Had 11 points and seven rebounds against Abilene Christian three days earlier ... Ranks sixth in the LSC rankings averaging 14.8 ppg.

Kevin Grayer, Midwestern State University, netted a career-high 24 points to go along with four rebounds and four assists to lead LSC-leading Midwestern State to an 83-72 win over Eastern New Mexico Saturday night at D.L. Ligon Coliseum. The senior guard from Tallahassee, Fla. connected on 9-of-12 shots from the field and connected on a 3-pointer to help the Mustangs to their season-best sixth straight win. The 6-3, 204-pound guard notched 10 points in leading MSU to its first win at the First United Bank Center in seven years in a 55-42 victory over West Texas A&M. Grayer averaged 17.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists a game while shooting 12-of-19 from the field (63.2) and 9-of-10 from the charity stripe in the victories.

Jovan Austin, Angelo State University, led the Rams by averaging 12. 5 points per game in last week's games against Tarleton State and Texas A&M-Commerce. The freshman scored 13 at Tarleton State before contributing 12 on Saturday against A&M-Commerce. He also added six assists and two steals.

Chuck Guy, Tarleton State University, came within two points of tying his career-high in Tarleton's win over Angelo State Wednesday, scoring 23 points in Tarleton's 13-point win. He then turned in a 19-point effort against Abilene Christian in the Texan's come-from-behind overtime victory on the road. Guy went 3-for-7 from beyond the arc against the Wildcats, and his three-pointer from about eight feet back of the line sealed Tarleton's second road victory of the season. Guy averaged 21.0 points on the week and dished out eight assists as well. He averaged 38.0 minutes per game and had just two turnovers running the point guard position.

Rafael Love, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 22.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.0 blocks per game in two contests, at home against Cameron and on the road at Midwestern State. He recorded his fourth double-double of the year with 19 points and 11 rebounds against the Aggies while playing 39 minutes. He was 6-of-11 shooting including 2-for-4 from three-point range and 5-of-8 at the free throw line. Seven of Love's rebounds were on the defensive end while four were offensive. He also had an assist and steal against CU. Love led Eastern with 26 points as he played the entire game. He made a career-high 11 field goals on a career-high 22 shot attempts and was also 4-for-6 on three-pointers. He grabbed six rebounds, three apiece on each end, dished out one assist, blocked a shot and was credited with a steal.

Angelo State

The Rams dropped a pair of games last week to Tarleton State and Texas A&M-Commerce. ASU opened the week with a 67-44 loss at Tarleton State before falling 96-90 last Saturday to A&M-Commerce at the Junell Center. The Rams shot 39 percent from the floor during the week and saw their two opponents shoot 50 percent. The Rams remain strong at the free-throw line after shooting 75 percent last week on 54 attempts.

Cameron

The Cameron men's team split their games this week. First on Wednesday, the Aggies fell short against ENMU in Portales, 74-72. The Aggies couldn't get things going early in the first half, shooting 28.6%, but were able to end the half trailing only by three. Then they came out in the second half and took the lead early. After that, both teams fought back and forth. Despite shooting almost 54% in the second half, Cameron would miss a free throw at the end and the Greyhounds would net a last second shot to win. Craig Foster had a big game with 19 points and 7 assists. Aaron Thompson also played well, getting 15 points, 6 rebounds, and 3 blocks off the bench. Then on Saturday the Aggies came home to take on West Texas A&M. Time Johnson got things going early for Cameron with a quick basket. The Aggies would then lead for most of the first half, but went into halftime trailing by three. The second half had both teams trading baskets until Cameron went on a 10-3 run with under 10 minutes left in the game. Cameron would keep a 10 point lead for most of the rest of the game, and would get the win, 72-63. Craig Foster led the Aggies with 29 points. He also had 5 rebounds, 3 assists, and a steal. Tim Johnson also came up big for Cameron, scoring 16 points, grabbing 5 rebounds, and getting 2 assists.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 1-1 on the week with a win at home over Cameron (74-72) and fell on the road to Midwestern State (83-72). Junior guard Rodney Blackmon scored a game-high 22 points, including the 16 of the Greyhounds' final 18 points, against the Aggies. Blackmon made the game-winning jumper with 2.9 remaining on the clock. Junior guard Rafael Love recorded his fourth double-double of the year with 19 points and 11 rebounds in the contest as well. In Wichita Falls, Texas, Blackmon and Love combined to score 50 points with 26 coming from Love and 24 from Blackmon. In the past eight games, Blackmon has scored at least 20 points in six of them and the Greyhounds have gone 5-3. ENMU has a 12-day break in between games and will not play this week. Their next game is Thursday, February 21 at home versus Texas A&M-Kingsville.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals were off last week. They are back in action this week with a home game against Texas A&M-Commerce on Wednesday and a road game at Tarleton State on Saturday.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State claimed a pair of Lone Star Conference victories over West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico last week to improve to 16-5 overall and to 12-2 in league play... The Mustangs own a two-game lead (in the loss column) over Incarnate Word with four games to play... MSU can clinch the No. 1 seed with two more wins by virtue of its season sweep of the Cardinals... The Mustangs could clinch their seventh Lone Star Conference title

outright with two wins and an Incarnate Word loss... Midwestern claimed its first win at the First United Bank Center since beating the Buffs 61-55 on Feb. 24, 2007... MSU's 13-point margin of victory (55-42) was the largest in Canyon since taking an 86-66 victory on Dec. 3, 1960... The Mustangs improved to 2-9 at the First United Bank Center and to 7-24 all time in Canyon... MSU continued its mastery over the Greyhounds by winning for the 12th time in the last 13 tries by an 83-72 count Saturday at D.L. Ligon Coliseum... The Mustangs extended their season long winning streak to six games with all the victories coming by at least 11 points... MSU is now 66-3 on its home floor since the start of the 2008-09 and 15-0 against LSC foes since Nelson Haggerty took over the reins of the program to start the 2011-12 season... The Mustangs have held the opposition to 30 points or less in the first half over the last seven games... MSU held West Texas A&M to their second lowest output since entering NCAA Division II in 1986-87 in a 55-42 win on Feb. 6 at the First United Bank Center... Senior guard Kevin Grayer poured in a career-high 24 points to go along with four rebounds and four assists Saturday against Eastern New Mexico... Junior forward Derek Kaster knocked down a season-high two 3-pointers to score 13 points Saturday against Eastern New Mexico. He has scored in double figures in four of his last six games... Junior guard Cam Adderley had a string of nine consecutive games with 10-or-more points snapped when he tallied six points and eight rebounds Saturday against Eastern New Mexico... Sophomore guard Derrell Gibbs has connected for a 3-pointer in six consecutive games while shooting 9-of-15 (60.0 percent) during the stretch...

Tarleton State

The Texans went 2-0 for the week, picking up a 13-point win over Angelo State to avenge its loss to the Rams earlier this season... Tarleton then turned around to pick up just its second road win of the season, coming back from being down as many as 10 points late in the second half... The Texans outscored the Wildcats 52-39 in the second half and overtime period combined for the five point win... Chuck Guy led the Texans on the week, averaging 21.0 points... He had just two turnovers while averaging 38.0 points... The Texans shot 48.6 percent as a team from the arc this week, and went 47-for-100 from the field overall... The Texans remain in fourth-place in the league, but still face all three teams ahead of them down the stretch... Tarleton will take on Texas A&M-Kingsville in Kingsville this Wednesday before returning home to take on Incarnate Word.

The Buffs went 0-2 this past week as they fell to league leading Midwestern State at home on Wednesday night before dropping an LSC road contest at Cameron on Saturday in Lawton. The Buffs enter the week with an overall record of 14-8 with a 6-8 mark in the LSC to sit sixth place in the league. The Buffs are currently on a 12 day break between games as they return to action on Feb. 21st as they host Incarnate Word at the First United Bank Center in Canyon.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Devin Griffin, West Texas A&M University, tallied a pair of 19-point games at WT split two games this past week...She went a team-high 12 of 32 from the field and 14 of 18 from the line...Griffin knocked down some key free throws late at Cameron in the Lady Buffs' 55-53 win...She averaged 5.5 rebounds along with four assists, three blocks and four steals... She played in 79 of the 80 minutes.

Peyton Adamson, Tarleton State University, led the TexAnns in offense last week with 19.0 points per game, including a 21-point effort against Abilene Christian Saturday. The junior guard shot .440 from the floor and .545 from beyond the arc. She was also 10-12 from the charity stripe.

Andrea Carter, Midwestern State University, led Midwestern State to standing alone at the top of the Lone Star Conference standings as the Mustangs won a pair of games to stretch their conference-best winning streak to 11 games. The 5-10 sophomore forward from Angleton had 12 points with seven rebounds and a blocked shot in the Mustangs 58-55 win at West Texas A&M, the first for MSU at the First United Bank Center since 2003. She also dished out three assists.

Karli Kellermeier, Angelo State University, had a career night against Texas A&M-Commerce. The sophomore set career highs in points, rebounds and assists. She recorded her first double-double of her career with 11 points and 13 rebounds. Kellermeier was only four assists from a triple-double. Nine of her 14 rebounds came on the offensive end. For the week she averaged eight points and nine rebounds.

Nelsha Peterson, Eastern New Mexico University, matched a career-high, with 16 points, in a winning effort against Cameron, last week. She also finished the game with eight rebounds and shot .412 from the floor.

Breanna Gonzalez, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led a team that tied a season-high by forcing 30 turnovers with five steals which is a season high.

Kelsey Smith, Abilene Christian University, helped the Wildcats move into second place in the Lone Star Conference standings and clinch a playoff berth this week following a pair of wins over Texas A&M-Commerce (75-61) and Tarleton State (86-70). Smith had eight points, six boards and a block vs. the Lions, and against the TexAnns, nine points, eight rebounds, two steals and two blocks. Smith ranks 45th in NCAA D-II with 1.71 blocks per game.

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, was a beast on the boards last week, averaging 19.5 rebounds per game against Angelo State and Abilene Christian.

She also recorded her third 20-rebound game of the season Saturday with a career-high 23 boards against the Wildcats. Prior to this season, only two players in Tarleton's NCAA history had recorded a 20-rebound game. Wright, this season, has three.

Jaylyn Cooper, Eastern New Mexico University, turned in a strong defensive effort last week, which helped limit the opposition to 57.5 points per game and a .290 shooting percentage from three-point range. At Midwestern State, she registered three steals, a blocked shot seven points and a .750 shooting percentage. Cooper also shot .500 from the floor and scored eight points in the win over Cameron.

Abilene Christian

The ACU Wildcats punched their ticket to the Lone Star Conference Tournament this week after beating both Texas A&M-Commerce, 75-61, at the Lion Fieldhouse, and Tarleton State at home, 86-70. The Wildcats' win over the TexAnns snapped an eight-game series losing streak to Tarleton and pushed them into second place in the Lone Star Conference standings - 1.0 game behind Midwestern State. Against Tarleton State, junior Mackenzie Lankford finished with 31 points, the second-best scoring game of her career behind a 38-point effort against Texas A&M-Kingsville on Feb. 19, 2012. Before Saturday night's win, the last time the Wildcats had beaten the TexAnns was Jan. 28, 2009, with a 77-71 decision at Moody Coliseum. Marquez finished with 19 points, four rebounds, four assists and two steals against the Lions, while Whitney West poured in a career-high 19 points on 6 of 8 shooting from the floor, including 5 of 7 from 3-point range. West also had five rebounds and two assists in 34 minutes. ACU will return to action Wednesday at 5:30 p.m. with a huge game at first-place Midwestern State, which beat Eastern New Mexico, 67-52, Saturday night to improve to 18-3 overall and 13-2 in league play.

Angelo State

The Belles moved to 9-12 and 6-9 in the Lone Star Conference after going 1-1 last week. ASU lost to Tarleton State 75-48 before defeating Texas A&M-Commerce 64-50. Angelo State is the top team in the LSC in rebounding margin (+5.1), blocked shots (3.9) and defensive rebound percentage (.718). Haylee Oliver is ranked in the top 10 of six statistical categories including being No. 2 in defensive rebounds. Lauren Holt is also ranked in the top 10 in six statistical categories as well as being the No. 1 shot blocked in the LSC. The Belles will host Cameron at 5:30 on Wednesday before traveling to face Midwestern State.

Cameron

The Cameron women's basketball team dropped both games this week. Starting in Portales against ENMU on Wednesday, the Aggies lost 53-48. Cameron started early, getting a three pointer from Chelsea Stamp, but it would be mostly Zias for the rest of the game. With 8:00 minutes left, the Aggies 13-4 run to pull to within 2, but they could never get ahead. Stamp led the way for Cameron with 15 points, followed by Lacy Reinke with 10 points, and Hannah Pollart, who had 7 points and 10 rebounds. The Aggies lost the next game at home to WT, 55-53. Cameron and the Lady Buffs went at it evenly throughout the game. After going in to the locker room trailing 33-30, the Aggies were able to tie it up at 39. They continued to go back and forth for the rest of the half. With a little more than a second on the clock and down by two, Chelsea Stamp got the inbound pass and put up a shot, but

missed the target. Stamp led Cameron with 15 points. After her was Ellie Carter, who had 9 points 3 assists and 2 steals.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University women's basketball team split a pair of Lone Star Conference games, last week, and remain half a game out of position to capture a berth in the upcoming LSC Tournament. Last Wednesday, the Zias turned in a dominant performance and limited Cameron to just 22.7 percent from the field in the opening half, on the way to a 53-48 win. Strong defense and rebounding allowed the Aggies just four trips to the free throw line, while ENMU held a decisive 41-32 advantage on the boards, with a 14-5 edge on the offensive glass. Nelsha Peterson led the way, with a career-best 16 points and eight boards. The Zias were unable to complete the season sweep of Midwestern State and dropped a tough road decision, in Wichita Falls, Texas. This weekend, Eastern will have a critical LSC contest at Texas Woman's.

Incarinate Word

Ashlyn Green led the Cardinals to a 58-40 victory over Texas Woman's to run the team's record to 10-4 in conference play. She posted her second double-double of the season with 13 points and 12 rebounds from her guard position. She went 4-of-8 from the field and was a perfect 4-for-4 at the foul line. She also dished out three assists. Green was one of three Cardinals to score in double figures in the game. Rose Whitehead and Ify Mora scored 15 and 14 points, respectively. UIW remains in fourth place in the conference with six regular season games remaining. One more win would secure a berth in the conference tournament.

Midwestern State

The Mustangs are 18-3 overall , 13-2 in Lone Star Conference play to lead the LSC by a full game ... MSU extended its winning streak to 11 games, the second longest streak in school history ... The 11-game streak is also the second-longest in the new South Central Region this year behind the 14-game streak of Colorado Mesa ... The Mustangs have an 11-game D.L. Ligon Coliseum winning streak as well, the second-longest official win streak under the Dome ... Midwestern is off to the best official start in program history, bettering the 15-3 start of the 1989-90 team. The 1990-91 team went 23-3 on the floor, but used an ineligible reserve and was forced to forfeit the first 15 games ... During MSU's 11-game winning streak, the Mustangs have won by double figures in all but two games: the 78-71 overtime win against Tarleton State and the 58-55 win at West Texas A&M. Tarleton (71 points) and Abilene Christian (62) are the only teams to score more than 60 against the Mustangs in that time ... With the two wins this past week, Midwestern State coach Noel Johnson raised her record to 64-62, winning 50.2 percent of her games. Johnson has led MSU to a 37-11 mark so far over the last two seasons ... Midwestern has held opponents to shooting below 40 percent in nine of the last 11 games, with the teams combining for just 33.8 percent from the floor and scoring an average of 53.6 points a game ... Kirsti Degelia is currently second in scoring in the Lone Star Conference, averaging 15.7 points a game, ranking 85th in NCAA Division II ... The 5-8 junior from Denton, Texas/Krum is third LSC in assists (3.5 per game), is fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.2), seventh in steals (1.7 per game), eighth in free throw percentage (.786, 114-of-145), 14th in blocked shots (0.5) and leads the league in minutes played (34.0) ... Sophomore Andrea Carter of Angleton, Texas is second in the LSC in rebounds (10.2

per game), which is 20th in Division II and is second in steals (2.5 per game), which is 80th nationally ... Carter ranks ninth in the LSC in scoring (12.4 ppg), third in field goal percentage (.508, 95-of-187), and fifth in blocked shots (0.9 bpg). She's second in the LSC and 11th in Division II with 11 double-doubles this season ... Sophomore Dianna Jones returned to the floor for MSU after missing five games due to injury. She picked up 10 points against Eastern New Mexico with two assists and grabbed two steals at West Texas A&M ... MSU received a vote this week in the WBCA/USA Today Sports Division II poll for the first time in five reporting periods. After losing twice while being ranked 25th on Dec. 16, MSU did not get one mention in the poll again until gathering enough points this week to sit five spots away from returning to the poll.

Tarleton State

Tarleton split a pair of games last week, knocking off Angelo State at home before falling to Abilene Christian on the road. In Saturday's loss, Peyton Adamson scored 21 points and Kiara Wright grabbed a career-high 23 rebounds in the loss.
