LSC BASKETBALL

Five women's teams and five men's squads have clinched a berth in the Lone Star Conference Basketball Championship.

Midwestern State, Cameron, Tarleton State, Incarnate Word and Eastern New Mexico are in on the men's side. The Mustangs have clinched a share of the LSC title.

Abilene Christian, Tarleton, MSU, UIW and West Texas A&M have earned a spot in the women's bracket. The championship crown is still up for grabs with teams having either three or four league games remaining. This week featured three 30-point scoring performances as ACU's Mackenzie Lankford (33), Texas A&M-Kingsville's Sheana Jones (31) and Tarleton's Peyton Adamson (30) had stellar games.

The LSC champion will be the regular season winner determined by conference games, while the postseason tournament winner is designated as LSC Tournament Champion and earns the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. The top eight teams in the final conference standings qualify for the postseason tournament set for March 6-9 in Allen, Texas.

The LSC men have a 124-102 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 18-18 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 3-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 123-127 overall. The women's squads are currently 17-12 combined versus Heartland teams, and 5-1 against the RMAC, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

LSC BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP: TICKETS ON SALE NOW

Lone Star Conference officials revealed a new team spirit pass option as advance tickets are on sale now for the 2013 LSC Basketball Championship, set for March 6-9 at the Allen Event Center in Allen, Texas.

The pass, featuring modest pricing of \$30 for adults and \$20 for students, will cater to those fans whose primary interest is simply to follow their favorite team instead of attending all of the tournament's seven sessions. Available only for purchase at member schools through Feb. 21, team spirit passes entitle the bearer to admission to all games (up to three) played by a men's or women's team from the school of choice.

Those wanting access to all seven sessions can purchase all-session tickets at a reduced rate of \$45 through Feb. 27 at member schools. After the advance purchase deadline, the adult price moves to \$60 for all-session tickets or \$15 per session. Student prices will be \$32 for all-session tickets or \$10 by session.

Tickets are also available at the Allen Event Center Box Office or through Ticketmaster (www.ticketmaster.com). Another option available to fans is to enjoy the view from one of the Allen Event Center's luxury suites. This marks the second straight year for the LSC Basketball Championship to be played in Allen, with the tournament again featuring eight men's and eight women's teams. The format is set to change slightly this year, with all games being played in doubleheader sessions throughout the event. Every doubleheader session will consist of a women's game followed by a men's game, including Saturday night's final session that features both the men's and women's championship games.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Jamahl Brown, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, Guard, Washington, D.C., Surrattsville HS

Brown led the Javelinas in scoring with 21 points per game which accounted for a third of the team's points last week. He totaled 18 at home against Tarleton State and followed that up with a career-high 24 points at Texas A&M-Commerce to raise his overall season average 1.2 points to 10.6. The junior, who missed the team's prior two games, was 17-of-27 (.630) from floor including 8-of-13 in the win over the Texans and 9-of-14 in the loss to the Lions. Against A&M-C, he was 5-of-10 from three-point range which is the most made behind the arc in a game this season by a Hoggie. He is now averaging 12.3 points a game in Lone Star Conference action.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Jon Cathey-Macklin, Tarleton State University, JR, Forward, Milwaukee, Wis., Washington

Cathey-Macklin continues to be a strong force on defense for the Texans, as he recorded 10 blocked shots this week. He recorded three blocked shots against Texas A&M-Kingsville on Wednesday and then tallied a career-high seven blocked shots in Tarleton's win over Incarnate Word Wednesday. His seven blocks was just one shy from tying the all-time school record of eight blocked shots. Cathey-Macklin averaged 6.5 boards on the week as well, collecting 10 defensive rebounds combined in both games.

CO-WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE**Peyton Adamson, Tarleton State University, JR, Guard, Rockwall, Texas, Rockwall HS**

Adamson shot lights out for Tarleton State last week as she led the TexAnn to back-to-back wins over Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word. The junior from Rockwall was 14-26 shooting from the floor and a 13-18 from beyond the 3-point line. She also went 14-14 from the charity stripe, including setting a school record for free throw percentage in a game with 1.000 and a minimum of 10 attempts with a 10-10 effort against UIW Saturday. She also became the second TexAnn this season to record a 30-point performance versus TAMUK and followed it up with 25 against UIW.

Mackenzie Lankford, Abilene Christian University, JR, Guard, Weatherford, Texas, Weatherford HS

Last week's Lone Star Conference Offensive Player of the Week, Lankford was back at it last week, averaging 24.5 points per game as she led the Wildcats to road wins over Midwestern State and Cameron and into first place in the Lone Star Conference with two weeks to go. In last Wednesday's 85-72 win at Midwestern State, Lankford poured in 33 points on 10 of 16 shooting from the field, including 5 of 9 from 3-point range. She scored 20 points in the first half when the Wildcats took control of the contest. She left the game early in the second half with an ankle injury and ACU's lead dropped to seven points before she re-entered the game. Shortly after she came back into the game she buried back-to-back 3-pointers to push ACU's lead back to 13 points and the Wildcats would not be threatened the rest of the way. In Saturday's 72-53 win over Cameron, Lankford scored 16 points and had five assists as the Wildcats moved into sole possession of first place in the league standings.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE**Lauren Holt, Angelo State University, JR, Forward, Christoval, Texas, Christoval HS**

Holt recorded two double-doubles this past week to help Angelo State to a 2-0 record. She averaged 16 points and 11 rebounds as the Rambelles held opponents to just 49 points and 29.4 percent shooting. She scored 16 points and grabbed 10 rebounds in a big road win at Midwestern State and scored 16 points with 12 rebounds versus Cameron. The two double-doubles were her seventh and eighth of the year for the junior. Holt shot 61.9-percent from the field (13-21) and grabbed 11 offensive and 11 defensive boards during the week.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Chuck Guy, Tarleton State University, poured in a game-high 23 points and Tarleton held off Incarnate Word on Saturday to push the Texan's record to 8-6 in the LSC and in a tie for third-place with the Cardinals. Guy also scored 23 points in Kingsville on Wednesday, giving him eight straight games and 11 of the last 13 scoring in double-figures. He has now scored 23 or more points in four of the last five games for the Texans. Guy averaged 23.0 points on the week, while going 18-for-32 (.563) from the field. He had 10 rebounds and dished out six assists this past week as well.

Craig Foster, Cameron University, came up huge in their overtime win at Angelo State nailing a three-pointer as time expired to send the game into overtime. The Aggies would later win 76-72, as Foster led CU with 27 points off 10-of-18 shooting from the field with seven assists. On Saturday, Foster spread the ball around and racked up 17 points in their 67-62 overtime win versus Abilene Christian. He was an assist short of a double-double with nine and pushed his season average to 5.71 per game. For the week, Foster averaged 22.0 points per game off of 50 percent shooting from the field, nailed eight three-pointers, and averaged eight assists per game.

Reggie Sutton, Angelo State University, continues to elevate his game as the regular season comes to a close. The freshman recorded a double-double in an overtime loss to Cameron last Wednesday before scoring nine points in the Rams' win over Midwestern State last Saturday in Wichita Falls. Sutton averaged 14 points and eight rebounds a game last week.

The ACU men lost another heartbreaker on Saturday, falling 62-57 in overtime at Cameron. ... The loss was ACU's third straight by five points and second overtime loss in its last three games. ... ACU has been involved in 16 games this season that have been decided by nine points or less, and the Wildcats are 4-12 in those games, including 3-10 in Lone Star Conference play. ... The Wildcats' 16 LSC games have been decided by a total of 16 points ACU having scored 1,066 points and the opponents having scored 1,082 points. ... ACU's conference opponents have averaged 67.6 points per game in LSC games against ACU's 66.6 points per game in LSC games.

Angelo State

The Rams went into Wichita Falls and knocked off the Mustangs last Saturday to end a number of streaks and delay MSU from claiming the regular-season title. ASU led 34-19 at halftime and withstood a charge by the Mustangs to take a 53-50 win. The victory snapped an eight-game losing streak this season, a 24-game road losing streak and 20 straight losses in Wichita Falls. The Rams' win followed a heartbreaking overtime loss to Cameron last Wednesday where the Aggies tied the game with 1.1 seconds remaining in regulation. ASU returns to action next Wednesday at Texas A&M-Kingsville before hosting Incarnate Word in its final game of the season on Saturday, March 2 in the Junell Center.

Cameron

The Cameron University men won their program best 11th Lone Star Conference game of the season after beating Abilene Christian 67-62 in overtime at the Aggie Gym on Saturday night. Cameron's win was their 12th in a row at home and they are presently a perfect 10-0 this season in Lawton. Earlier this week, Cameron played at Angelo State and like their game on Saturday the Ags needed overtime to get the 76-72 win. Craig Foster led the Aggies in scoring averaging 22.0 points per game, eight assists per game last week, and pushed his season average for assists up to 5.71 per game. Tim Johnson racked up an Aggie career high 17 points vs. Abilene Christian on Saturday night and is averaging 9.8 points per game this season. The Aggies will host Tarleton State on Wednesday at the Aggie Gym at a 8 p.m.

Eastern New Mexico

Did not play this week. Hosts Texas A&M-Kingsville Thursday night and Incarnate Word on Saturday.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals lost both games last week and are now on a season high four game losing streak. Dionelle Rucker had an outstanding week despite the two losses. He averaged 23.5 point and 10.0 rebounds per game. He had 19 points and nine rebounds against Texas A&M-Commerce and then poured in 28 points and grabbed 11 rebounds at Tarleton State. He has five double-doubles on the season and has scored 20 points six times during the year. The Cardinals have six players averaging in double figures for the year. Rucker leads the team with 17.4 points per game while Andre Corley and Denzel Livingston follow with 12.4 and 12.0 points per game, respectively. Corley will not be able to play enough games this year to qualify for national rankings in free throw percentage. However, he is shooting 92.5 percent from the foul line this year.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State clinched a share of its seventh Lone Star Conference title with a 60-55 win over Abilene Christian Wednesday night at D.L. Ligon Coliseum then took its second home loss of the season by a 53-50 count to Angelo State on Saturday night... The Mustangs can clinch an outright LSC championship with a win over Texas A&M-Commerce on Wednesday or at Tarleton State on Saturday or one loss by Cameron this week against either of the same teams... The Mustangs have claimed league titles in five of the last seven seasons... Midwestern State's win over Abilene Christian closes the second longest running series in program history at 83 games... MSU won the last 10 meetings of its series with the Abilene Christian and 17 of the last 18. The Mustangs boast a 54-29 overall edge in the series that dates back to the 1946-47 season... Angelo State's 53-50 win over the Mustangs Saturday was its first win at D.L. Ligon Coliseum since Jan. 7, 1988 -- a span of 25 years and 20 games... Senior forward Corbin Thomas notched his seventh double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Wednesday against ACU then had 14 points and nine rebounds Saturday against Angelo State... Thomas has scored 10-or-more points in each of his last three games... Senior guard Kevin Grayer scored 13 points in both games last week and posted double-figure performances in seven of his last eight outings... Sophomore guard Derrell Gibbs has connected on a 3-pointer in each of his last eight games while going 13-for-22 (59.1 percent) from beyond the arc during the stretch... Gibbs has snagged at least five rebounds in each of his last five games...

Tarleton State

The Texans are now tied with Incarnate Word for third-place in the LSC after defeating the Cardinals 77-71 in Stephenville on Saturday... Despite falling to Texas A&M-Kingsville (85-86) on Wednesday, the Texans still have a chance to win the regular-season championship with just four games remaining... Tarleton averaged 66.0 points this week, but opposing teams scored 63.5 points - more than five points what Tarleton was averaging heading into the week... Chuck Guy scored 23 points on both nights this week, while shooting 56.3 percent from the field.... Brian Word averaged 12.5 points this week; he scored 21 points against UIW, with 18 of those points coming in the second half... Jon Cathey-Macklin was a monster on defense this week, collecting 10 blocked shots

this week... He had seven blocks against UIW, coming within one block shy of tying the school's all-time record... Tarleton's last four games prove to be tough for the Texans as they have lost to three of the four teams they face these next two weeks... The Texans head to Cameron this Wednesday before hosting Midwestern State in Stephenville on Saturday.

Texas A&M-Commerce

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas snapped a four-game losing streak with a 56-55 win over Tarleton State on Wednesday night. It was the Javelinas ninth win of the season at home...Jamahl Brown led the Javelinas in scoring for the week averaging 21 points in the team's two wins which accounted for a third of the team's 21 points. He scored 18 at home against the Texans and followed that up with a career-high 24 points on Saturday at Commerce. He raised his overall season average 1.2 points a game for the week. The junior who missed the team's prior two games was 17-of-27 from floor for 63%. Brown was 8-of-13 in the win over Tarleton State and 9-of-14 at Commerce. He was 5-of-10 from 3-point range which is the most made 3-point buckets in a game this season by a Hoggie. He is now averaging 12.3 points a game in Lone Star Conference action. The 24 points were also the most by a Javelina this season other than Rashad Basey...Kingsville held off a late rally for the Texan win as Kingsville did not score in the final 4:23 after Daymon Warren converted a 3-point play...TSU had the last chance to score in the game, but Adonis Bailey blocked a Chuck Guy shot out of bounds with .4 seconds left. Bonds knocked away the ensuing inbounds pass...Led by Jamahl Brown with five, the Javelinas tied a season-high with nine 3-point field goals made. It was the third time the Javelinas had hit nine in a game.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Chontiquah White, West Texas A&M University, down two with 54 seconds left, she stole the inbound pass, scored and was fouled for the old-fashion three-point play as the Lady Buffs pulled out a 60-57 win at Texas Woman's on Wednesday. She tallied her seventh double-double as the Lady Buffs battled back from a 12-point second half deficit for the win. White scored 26 points and tallied a career-high 17 rebounds in the game and had an outstanding second half as she went 4 of 5 from the field and an impressive 12 of 13 from the free throw line in the second half alone with nine rebounds in the second stanza. She was the only player for WT to go to the line in the second half and made 10-straight charity tosses down the stretch as the Lady Buffs finished the final four minutes with a 12-3 run. In the final minute alone, White went 5 for 5 from the line, the game winning steal and score a block and a rebound.

Sheana Jones, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, Guard, Oklahoma City, Ok., Putnam City North HS, Sheana Jones became the first Javelina to score 30 points in a game since the 2007-08 season as she scored 31 points on Saturday at Commerce. LaKeisha Jones had 30 against A&M-International on Dec. 29, 2007. The 31 were the most since Felicia Soza had 29 against the Dustdevils on Dec. 30, 2009. Jones was 8-of-11 from the floor including 5-of-7 from the 3-point line. She added five rebounds, three assists

and two steals against the Lions. She had 10 points at home against Tarleton, with four rebounds, four assists and a steal.

Ashlyn Green, University of the Incarnate Word, had an outstanding week for the Cardinals. She had 19 points, seven rebounds, four assists, two blocks and five steals in a win over Texas A&M-Commerce on Wednesday. She came back with a season high 22 points in a loss at Tarleton State. She had seven rebounds, three assists and two steals in the game. She shot 40.6 percent from the field and went 12-of-16 from the foul line. She averaged 20.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the week.

Tara Johnson, Eastern New Mexico University, poured in 19 points at Texas Woman's, to lift the Zias to a critical road win in Lone Star Conference play. In addition to her scoring, she provided four rebounds and five assists, which turned into 11 points for ENMU. Johnson shot 54.5 percent from the floor, 50 percent from three-point range and 83.3 percent from the free throw line, during the game. Five of her points came during the overtime period.

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, averaged as many rebounds last week as she did points in helping the TexAnns to a pair of wins over Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word. The junior center grabbed 33 boards over the past two games, 22 of them coming on the defensive end. She also recorded six steals while anchoring a defense which held its opponents to just 68.5 points and 42-percent shooting.

Nelsha Peteson's, Eastern New Mexico University, defense helped the Zias pick up a key win over Texas Woman's, in the chase for one of the remaining spots in the upcoming Lone Star Conference tournament. She provided eight defensive rebounds, which helped limit the Pioneers to just four second-chance points. Peterson an the ENMU defense limited TWU to just one field goal over the final 5:05 of play.

Chontiquah White, West Texas A&M University, put the Lady Buffs on her back and led a 12-point comeback in the second half with one of her best performances of her career as she tallied her seventh double-double of the season with a career-high 17 rebounds and 26 points in the 60-57 win at Texas Woman's Wednesday. In the final minute alone, White stole the inbound pass, scored and was fouled to give the Lady Buffs their first lead since early in the game. She went 5 for 5 in the final minute from the line and 12 of 13 in the second half alone. She tallied a block and had her career-best 17th rebound in the final minute to help preserve the win. She was the only player to go to the free throw line in the second half for WT and made her final 10 in a row. White and the Lady Buffs finished the game on a 12-3 run over the final four minutes.

Abilene Christian

The Wildcats moved into sole possession of first place in the Lone Star Conference standings last week with road wins at Midwestern State (85-72 on Wednesday) and Cameron (72-53 on Saturday). ... ACU is one-half game ahead of second-place Tarleton State and one game ahead of third-place MSU going into the final two weeks of the season. ... First-year head coach Julie Goodenough has certainly put her stamp on the program in her first season as ACU's 19 wins so far this season are the second-most of any ACU head coach in their first season in program history behind the 26 Wayne Williams won in 1997-98 and tied with the 19 Shawn Lavender's team posted in 2003-04. ... ACU's 19 regular-season wins are the sixth-most

in program history, and with wins in their final three regular season games the Wildcats would post 22 regular-season wins, which would be the third-most in program history behind the 31 the 1980-81 team racked up and the 25 posted by the 1995-96 team that finished third at the NCAA Division II Elite Eight. ... The Wildcats' 19 wins are already their most wins in a season since 2004-05 when the Wildcats finished 20-10 and qualified for the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament. ... The 19 regular-season wins are the most in a regular season since the 1998-99 squad posted a 21-6 regular season record on its way to a Lone Star Conference championship and a final record of 24-7. ... The Wildcats are on pace to post the most wins in a season since those 24 wins in 1998-99. ... Junior guard Mackenzie Lankford averaged 24.5 points per game in last week's two wins, and she is now sixth in the league in scoring at 14.3 points per game. ... She now has 1,255 career points, which leaves her just 117 from passing Pat Bidwell (1,371 points from 1985-89) for 15th place on ACU's all-time scoring list. ... In 70 career games as a Wildcat, Lankford is averaging 17.9 ppg and with 33-point effort last Wednesday at Midwestern State has now topped the 30-point mark nine times in her career.

Angelo State

The Angelo State Belles got two big wins to move to 11-12 overall and 8-9 in the Lone Star Conference. The Belles defeated Cameron 60-50 and went on the road to defeated Midwestern State 54-58. ASU is the No. 2 team in the league in field goal percentage defense, rebounding margin, rebounding offense and defensive rebounds. The Belles are tops in the LSC in blocked shots and defensive rebound percentage. Lauren Holt is ranked in the top 10 of five statistical categories and Haylee Oliver is in the top 10 of eight categories. ASU will face TWU on Saturday.

Eastern New Mexico

The Zias picked up a crucial win at Texas Woman's, on Saturday, to vault into eighth in the Lone Star Conference standings. Tara Johnson paced ENMU with a season-best 19 points, including five in overtime. Over the final 5:05 of play, the Zias limited Texas Woman's to just one field goal. This week, Eastern will host Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word.

Incarnate Word

Ashlyn Green had an outstanding week for the Cardinals. She had 19 points, seven rebounds, four assists, two blocks and five steals in a win over Texas A&M-Commerce on Wednesday. She came back with a season high 22 points in a loss at Tarleton State. She had seven rebounds, three assists and two steals in the game. She shot 40.6 percent from the field and went 12-of-16 from the foul line. She averaged 20.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the week. Ify Mora tied the school record with six blocks against A&M-Commerce. She leads the team with 20 blocks on the season and is second on the team with 43 steals and 44 assists. The Cardinals shot a season high 50 percent in the loss to Tarleton State. The team went 7-of-11 from three-point range during the game.

Midwestern State

The Mustangs are 18-5 overall, 13-4 in Lone Star Conference play to sit in third place in the LSC ...

MSU had the second-longest winning streak in school history snapped at 11 games with an 85-72 loss to Abilene Christian last Wednesday, then dropped a 54-48 decision to Angelo State on Saturday to fall out of the LSC lead ... The back-to-back losses matched the pair suffered on the road in December of this season for the Mustangs ... It was also the first consecutive losses at Ligon Coliseum since MSU suffered losses to Tarleton State (67-59) and Angelo State (65-60) on Feb. 21 and 23, 2011 ... the losses ended MSU's best-ever start at 18-3 ... The Mustangs allowed Abilene Christian the most points by an opponent this season (85) ... Angelo State held MSU to a season low 48 points and it marked the first time this season that a team scoring less than 60 points (54 for ASU) defeated the Mustangs ... After holding opponents to under 40 percent from the floor since the start of 2013, MSU allowed ACU to shoot 53.2 percent, the second-best against the Mustangs this season and then let Angelo State hit 41.5 percent from the floor ... Sophomore Andrea Carter of Angleton, Texas chalked up 22 points with 16 rebounds against ACU, recording her 12th double-double of the season to rank in Division II's top 10 ... Carter remains second in the LSC and among the Top 20 in NCAA Division II in rebounding with 10.3 boards a game to go with her 2.4 steals that's second in the LSC and among the top 90 in the NCAA II ... Carter remains ninth in the LSC in scoring (12.5 ppg), fourth in the LSC in field goal percentage (.500, 103-of-206) and sixth in blocked shots (0.8 per game) ... Junior Kirsti Degelia of Denton, Texas/Krum has slipped to fourth in the LSC in scoring with 15.6 points an outing ... Degelia is fourth in the league in assists (3.4 apg), fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.1), fifth in free throw percentage (.787, 122-of-155), seventh in steals (1.7 spg), 10th in 3-point field goals per game (1.2), 13th in blocked shots (0.5 per game) and leads the LSC in minutes played (34.1 per game) ... The Mustangs game on Wednesday against Texas A&M-Commerce will be delayed telecast on the Time Warner Cable SportsChannel that is featured on many TWC systems including Dallas/Fort Worth, Waco, Austin, San Antonio, Corpus Christi, El Paso and the Rio Grande Valley ...

Tarleton State

Tarleton State won both games last week, including a major LSC battle against Incarnate Word in Wisdom Gym Saturday night. Peyton Adamson led the team with 30 and 25 points in the respective games against Texas A&M-Kingsville and UIW. Kiara Wright also dominated the boards for Tarleton, grabbing 33 rebounds in two games.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

Sheana Jones became the first Javelina to score 30 points in a game since the 2007-08 season as she scored 31 points on Saturday at Commerce. LaKeisha Jones had 30 against A&M-International on Dec. 29, 2007. The 31 were the most since Felicia Soza had 29 against the Dustdevils on Dec. 30, 2009. Jones was 8-of-11 from the floor including 5-of-7 from the 3-point line. She added five rebounds, three assists and two steals against the Lions. She had 10 points at home against Tarleton, with four rebounds, four assists and a steal...The 74 points by the Javelinas at Commerce were the second most this season and the most in a Lone Star Conference game this season. The season-high in all games for the Javelinas is 78 which came back in November against Our Lady of the Lake. The 63 points against Tarleton is the fifth highest point total...Led by Sheana Jones five 3-point

baskets the Javelinas connected on a season-high 10 treys.
