LSC BASEBALL

Non-conference competition continues for Lone Star Conference baseball teams. Incarnate Word, which boasts a seven-game winning streak, and Eastern New Mexico top the standings with just one loss each.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 46-23-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 3-2 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-3 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Derek Crenshaw, Eastern New Mexico University, SR, OF, Pinalo Valley, Calif., Solano CC

Crenshaw turned in a stellar performance last weekend for the ENMU baseball team, leading the Hounds to their first series win at New Mexico Highlands since the 2000 season. He hit safely in all four games, with three multi-hit performances. In the finale, Crenshaw batted 4-for-5 with two runs and three runs batted in. In the second game, he homered and drove in three runs. For the week, Crenshaw hit .588 with 10 hits and 10 RBIs.

Derrick Walls, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, SS, San Antonio, Texas, Reagan HS

Walls was the catalyst for the Cardinals offense last weekend as they swept visiting Colorado Christian four straight games. He reached base via hit or walk at least two times in each game and scored a total of seven runs. As the lead-off hitter, he reached base and scored in the first inning in three of the four games and was a key reason why the Cards never trailed the entire weekend. He had a phenomenal week on the base paths as he was a perfect 8-for-8 in stolen base attempts. He tied the school record on two occasions with three steals in a game. He hit .538 with four RBI's and was flawless in the field handling 13 chances at shortstop without an error.

PITCHERS

Dylan Boss, University of the Incarnate Word, SO, LHP, Boerne, Texas, Boerne HS

Boss was dominant in his win over Colorado Christian. He pitched 6.0 innings and scattered two hits and a walk while not allowing a run. He picked up seven strikeouts and retired 10 of the last 11 batters he faces. He required only 74 pitches to get through six innings in a 7-1 victory.

Nick Duncan, West Texas A&M University, JR, LHP, Carrollton, Texas, Creekview HS

Went 1-0 with a 7-0 win over Colorado Mines on Saturday. He combined with senior Paul Pulley for the shutout as it was the first Buff shutout since Apr. 8, 2012. Duncan was top-notch in the game as he scattered four hits over seven innings while walking one and fanning six as CSM hit .174 against him. He became the lone WT starter to start 2-0 on the year and lowered his ERA to 0.73 with the combo shutout. He has pitched 12.1 innings allowing nine hits, two runs - one earned, 13 strikeouts to just three walks in his two starts as the opposition is hitting just .205 against him.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Spenser Smith, West Texas A&M University, tallied a WT career-high four doubles in three starts for the Buffs against Colorado Mines over the weekend. He tallied a team-high six hits, including the four two-baggers, which came at clutch times, along with scoring the winning run in a 5-1 win over CSM to clinch the series Sunday sixth inning as the Buffs plated four runs in the frame breaking a 1-1 tie. Smith tallied 10 total bases with two walks and no strikeouts as he slugged an impressive 1.111 and reached base at a .727 clip. Defensively, he helped turn three double plays. He had four of the 11 doubles by the team in the series.

Chris Ballou, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, had a stellar opening game to the series going 3-for-4 with three runs driven in and a run score. The senior belted a two-run home run to left for the just third homer for the Javelinas this season. Ballou, who has reached safely in all nine games in which he has appeared, is in the midst of a 5-game hitting streak. The senior has posted a hit in eight of the nine games in which he has played. He is third on the team with a .406 average and leads the way with 11 runs batted in.

Quaid McKinnon, Angelo State University, hit three doubles and finished last weekend with a .417 batting average against Lubbock Christian at Foster Field. McKinnon is hitting .341 for the season with seven doubles and went last weekend without a strikeout and with a .500 on-base percentage. Last year's conference tournament MVP leads the Rams with six walks this season and has 15 hits through the first 11 games of the year.

Ryan Pruitt, Eastern New Mexico University, held New Mexico Highlands to no runs on one hit for four innings, to earn his first win of the season. Of the 13 batters he faced, only two reached base, one on a fielder's choice and the other on a fifth-inning double.

Matt Rhodes, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, had the lone victory of the weekend against Oklahoma Christian. He tossed seven innings allowing one run on seven hits. The JUCO transfer permitted just one run and did not walk a batter. He is now 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA.

Jake Feckley, Angelo State University, struck out five in 3.0 innings of relief work on Saturday to earn a victory

The Rams dropped their first series since the 2011 season after a 2-1 series loss to Lubbock Christian last weekend at Foster Field. ASU (8-3) earned it lone win in dramatic fashion with a two-out walkoff home run by Reggie Rodriguez to cap a three-run ninth inning on Saturday. The home run was Rodriguez's second of the season. Lee Neumann and Quaid McKinnon each had three doubles in the series, while Rodriguez and Christian Summers hit home runs in the series. Eastern New Mexico

The Greyhounds won three of four games at New Mexico Highlands, for their first series win over the Cowboys since the 2000 season. For the weekend, Eastern batted a sizzling .411 and stole nine bases in 11 attempts. After dropping the opener in a 22-16 shootout, Eastern claimed wins by 5-2, 6-5 and 13-5 scores. At 7-1, ENMU is off to one of its best starts in program history. Six starters hit .412 or better for the weekend. This week, the Hounds host Lubbock Christian and Metro State.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals stretched their win streak to seven games after winning four straight against Colorado Christian at home. They are now ranked #24 in the nation according to Collegiate Baseball News and are #4 in the NCBWA South Central Region rankings. Dylan Boss was dominant in his win over Colorado Christian. He pitched 6.0 innings and scattered two hits and a walk while not allowing a run. He picked up seven strikeouts and retired 10 of the last 11 batters he faces. He required only 74 pitches to get through six innings in a 7-1 victory. Fellow starting pitchers Geno Encina and Alexis Garza each had good outings as well. Encina pitched 7.0 innings allowing five hits, one run and no walks while striking out 10 to improve to 2-0 on the year. Garza went 5.0 innings allowing three hits, one earned run and a walk while striking out seven to run his record to 3-0. The streak however came to end in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader as Kingsville fell 4-3 in 10 innings. In the second 9-inning game on Saturday, the Javelinas could not avoid the big inning allowing a 5-run inning and a 7-run inning in a 12-3 loss...Chris Ballou had a stellar opening game to the series going 3-for-4 with three runs driven in and a run score. The senior belted a two-run home run to left for the just third homer for the Javelinas this season. Ballou, who has reached safely in all nine games in which he has appeared, is in the midst of a 5-game hitting streak. The senior has posted a hit in eight of the nine games in which he has played. He is third on the team with a .406 average and leads the way with 11 runs batted in... Second baseman Ben Villafuerte has reached safely in all 11 games, while Taylor Taska and Matt Perez had 10 game streaks snapped in the series finale with Oklahoma Christian...The Javelina starting rotation has been nearly unhittable. In 11 games, the 4-man rotation of Zachary Pettiford, Dallas Ponder, Matt Rhodes, and Cody Williams are 6-2 with a 2.09 ERA. Pettiford leads the way with a 0.46 ERA, while Ponder has a team-best 3-0 mark with all three wins against ranked opponents. Ponder has held batters to a .177 average at the plate and the unit has limited hitters to a .206 mark. The starters have combined for 58 strikeouts in 64.2 innings, while walking just 12 as a staff...Pettiford did not figure in the decision in his last start but tossed seven innings of 5-hit baseball. He allowed one unearned run and fanned five. He has not allowed an earned run in his last 16-1/3 innings pitched...Rhodes had the lone victory of the weekend against Oklahoma Christian. He tossed seven innings allowing one run on seven hits. The JUCO transfer permitted just one run and did not walk a batter. He is now 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA

West Texas A&M
