LSC SOFTBALL

The Lone Star Conference boasts three softball teams with double-digit win totals along with another trio of squads with nine victories as non-conference action continues.

It was a successful trip to the NFCA Division II Leadoff Classic last weekend for West Texas A&M (5-1), Texas Woman's (5-1) and Abilene Christian (4-2). WT finished second and TWU was third in the gold bracket, while ACU won the bronze bracket.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 73-56 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 27-22 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 11-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTED

Courtney Flanary, Abilene Christian University, JR, First Base, Bartonville, Texas, Flower Mound HS

Flanary slammed two home runs during the final two games of the NFCA D-II Leadoff Classic, helping the Wildcats win the Bronze Bracket and finish the weekend with a 4-2 record. ACU lost its first two games, but then won its last four. Flanary recorded at least one hit in all six games, including three with two doubles versus Grand Canyon. She then ripped two hits against Nova Southeastern and homered versus Minnesota State Mankato and San Bernardino to finish with six RBI.

PITCHER

Lauren Heinrich, West Texas A&M University, FR, Pitcher, Lubbock, Texas, Cooper HS

Heinrich proved to be the go-to pitcher out of the WT bullpen this past weekend as the Lady Buffs went 5-1 to claim second place at the NFCA DII Leadoff Classic in Tucson, Arizona as WT moved to 10-1 this season. Heinrich, a Lubbock, Texas native, registered a 0.57 ERA with a 2-0 record in four appearances for the Lady Buffs, giving up one run on seven hits with 11 K's. The Cooper HS alum allowed an opposing batting average of just .163 while walking just two batters. Heinrich stepped into tournament opener against #24 Dixie State in a key situation with runners on, but the freshman right hander responded with a victory, giving up no runs on two hits with four strikeouts in her 4.2 innings of relief.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Courtney McCoy, University of the Incarnate Word, with starting third baseman Monica Acuna out with an injury, McCoy stepped in and played flawless defense while giving the Cardinals a jolt on offense. She helped the Cards go 4-0 with sweeps at St. Edward's and over Colorado Christian. She handled four chances without an error at St. Ed's in the first game and then was put into the lineup in the second game and responded by going 2-for-2 with a walk and an RBI in a 3-2 extra-inning win. On Saturday, she was 1-for-2 in a 5-0 win over the Cougars in the first game and then went 1-for-3 with a game-tying two-run double in the fourth inning of an eventual, 3-2 win. She hit .571 for the week with a number of important hits.

Bailey Vrazel, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers to 5-1 record and a third place finish at the 2013 NFCA Leadoff Classic last week. She led the team on offense with .478 batting average, 11 hits, six runs, six RBI, .500 on base percentage and 9-for-9 stolen bases. Vrazel hit her first career home run (in the park grand slam) on Friday against Regis. She has reached base in 10 straight games and has nine multiple hit games this season. On the season Vrazel leads the Pioneers on offense with .460 average, 14 runs and 15 stolen bases.

Renee Erwin, West Texas A&M University, cemented herself in the three hole for the Lady Buffs this past weekend as WT went 5-1 at the NFCA DII Leadoff Classic in Tucson, Arizona to move the Lady Buffs to 10-1 overall this season. The sophomore from Anna, Texas led the team in hitting with a .409 average this past weekend with two doubles and one home run to drive in 7 RBI while also stealing three bases and registering 14 total bags. Erwin broke the game against Colorado Mesa open on Saturday afternoon as she connected on her first homerun of the year in the top of the sixth inning in a 7-4 win.

Katie Ramsay, Eastern New Mexico University, batted .381 last week and hit safely in five of seven games, with three multi-hit games. She drove in six runs with a two-for-three performance against University of the Southwest, with two doubles. Ramsay also notched a two-hit outing with a double against Arkansas Tech.

Arianna Rodriguez, Tarleton State University, slugged a pair of homers in four games for Tarleton in the St. Leo Tournament in Florida last weekend. She also led the team in RBIs (4), slugging percentage among hitters with more than one at-bat (.692), total bases (9) and hits (3).

Vanessa Ramirez, Eastern New Mexico University, earned her first collegiate win, last Wednesday, with a complete-game shutout against University of the Southwest. For the week, she allowed the opposition a .250 batting average with just one extra-base hit.

Whitney Waltrip, University of the Incarnate Word, pitched well for the Cardinals going 2-0 with a save in three appearances. She began the week with a 4-3 win at St. Edward's. She allowed eight hits, three runs and two walks while striking out three. She also added a home run at the plate that proved to be the decisive run in

the game. In the second game of the doubleheader, she was called upon in the eighth inning to hold onto a 3-2 lead and pitched a perfect inning. Finally, she tossed her first shutout of the season in a 5-0 win over Colorado Christian. She allowed three hits and a walk while striking out three in 7.0 innings. She had a 1.46 ERA and held opponents to a .211 batting average for the week.

Caitlyn Crain, Abilene Christian University, improved to 4-2 on the season after going 2-0 with a save this last weekend at the NFCA D-II Leadoff Classic. Crain made two starts and two relief appearances, totaling 20.1 innings pitched. Crain made her weekend debut as a reliever and struck out three Nova Southeastern batters in 3.1 IP. The following day she made her first start of the tournament and shutout Regis on three hits and four Ks. Against New Haven, Crain earned her first save as a Wildcat after coming into the game in the fifth as a reliever for Peyton Mosley. Crain struck out four Chargers in 3.0 innings. In her final appearance of the weekend, Crain pitched her second complete game vs. Cal State San Bernardino and allowed just three runs while striking out 2.

Brandie Lander, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers to 5-1 record and a third place finish at the 2013 NFCA Leadoff Classic. She had a hand in four of the Pioneers' five wins over the weekend. Lander recorded two wins and two saves while striking out a team-best 14 batters. On the season she leads TWU with a 5-1 record, 2.16 ERA, 2 saves and 29 strike outs.

Randi Fentress, Tarleton State University, was a dominant pitcher for Tarleton in a tournament against a tough field at the St. Leo Tournament last weekend. The junior hurler threw 14.1 innings allowing five earned runs on 12 hits and five walks while amassing eight strikeouts. Fentress also kept the hitters of the tournament to just a .233 batting average.
