LSC BASKETBALL

With one week of regular season games remaining, the Lone Star Conference Basketball Championship field of 16 teams is set.

The eight teams on the men's side are led by Midwestern State, who claimed its fifth LSC title in seven years and will be the No. 1 seed. Cameron is the second seed, while the remainder of the seeds will be determined between Incarnate Word, Tarleton State, Eastern New Mexico, Texas A&M-Commerce, West Texas A&M and Texas A&M-Kingsville.

On the women's side, Abilene Christian, Midwestern State, Tarleton State, Incarnate Word, West Texas A&M, Angelo State, Texas A&M-Commerce and Eastern New Mexico have earned berths. The seeding will be set as the season wraps up with games February 27 and March 2.

The LSC champion will be the regular season winner determined by conference games, while the postseason tournament winner is designated as LSC Tournament Champion and earns the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. The top eight teams in the final conference standings qualify for the postseason tournament set for March 6-9 in Allen, Texas.

The LSC men have a 132-110 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 18-18 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 3-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 133-137 overall. The women's squads are currently 17-12 combined versus Heartland teams, and 5-1 against the RMAC, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

LSC BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP: TICKETS ON SALE NOW

Lone Star Conference officials revealed a new team spirit pass option as advance tickets are on sale now for the 2013 LSC Basketball Championship, set for March 6-9 at the Allen Event Center in Allen, Texas.

The pass, featuring modest pricing of \$30 for adults and \$20 for students, will cater to those fans whose primary interest is simply to follow their favorite team instead of attending all of the tournament's seven sessions. Available only for purchase at member schools through Feb. 21, team spirit passes entitle the bearer to admission to all games (up to three) played by a men's or women's team from the school of choice.

Those wanting access to all seven sessions can purchase all-session tickets at a reduced rate of \$45 through Feb. 27 at member schools. After the advance purchase deadline, the adult price moves to \$60 for all-session tickets or \$15 per session. Student prices will be \$32 for all-session tickets or \$10 by session.

Tickets are also available at the Allen Event Center Box Office or through Ticketmaster (www.ticketmaster.com). Another option available to fans is to enjoy the view from one of the Allen Event Center's luxury suites. This marks the second straight year for the LSC Basketball Championship to be played in Allen, with the tournament again featuring eight men's and eight women's teams. The format is set to change slightly this year, with all games being played in doubleheader sessions throughout the event. Every doubleheader session will consist of a women's game followed by a men's game, including Saturday night's final session that features both the men's and women's championship games.

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Corbin Thomas, Midwestern State University, SR, Forward, Chicago, Ill., Seton Academy (Missouri State)

Thomas erupted for a season-high 27 points and pulled down 15 rebounds as Midwestern State clinched its fifth Lone Star Conference championship in the last seven years Wednesday night against Texas A&M-Commerce. The transfer from Missouri State added his ninth double double of the season with a 19-point, 12-rebound effort Saturday at Tarleton State. The 6-8 senior forward shot 60.7 percent from the field (17-of-28) and was a 11-of-14 from the charity stripe (78.6 percent) and even connected on his first 3-pointer of the season against A&M-Commerce. For the week, Thomas averaged 23.0 points and 15.0 rebounds in 31.5 minutes per game.

Texans. The junior forward pulled down 10 rebounds for the team as well and tallied a season-high two steals in Tarleton's upset over Midwestern State on Saturday. Cathey-Macklin's defensive presence helped Tarleton limit opponents to shoot just 32.4 percent from the floor and average just 56.5 points this week.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Devin Griffin, West Texas A&M University, JR, Forward, Lubbock, Texas, Coronado HS

Averaged a double-double with 25.0 points and 10.5 rebounds in two wins over Incarnate Word and Texas A&M-Kingsville. Went 17 of 38 from the field and 16 of 19 from the line, while pulling down 21 rebounds. Had nine assists, along with three blocks and 10 steals. Had a career-high 31 points in the Lady Buffs' 79-67 win over TAMUK Saturday. It was her team-best seventh and eighth double-doubles of the year. Her nine field goals made against TAMUK ties her career-high and her 13 of 15 from the free throw line is her best individual game of her career and the 13 makes ties her career-high set earlier this season. She set her career-high with six steals against Incarnate Word as the Lady Buffs pulled into a tie with the Cardinals for fourth in the conference standings.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Andrea Carter, Midwestern State University, SO, Forward, Angleton, Texas, Angleton HS

Carter directed the Midwestern defense as they remained in the hunt for an LSC title with a pair of second half come-from-behind victories last week. The 5-10 sophomore from Angleton, Texas recorded her 13th and 14th double-doubles of the season with 15 points and 14 rebounds in the Mustangs first win in Stephenville since Dec. 2, 2003 with a 71-63 win at Tarleton State. She also tallied 11 points and 12 rebounds in a 70-62 win over Texas A&M-Commerce. Carter averaged 13.0 points and 13.0 rebounds and 3.5 steals for the week, to go with her 2.0 assists as well. She also recorded one blocked shot (at Tarleton) on the week, as she helped MSU hold their opponents to 62.5 points a game and shooting 36.1 percent from the floor. She grabbed exactly one-third of MSU's rebounds during the two games.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Dionelle Rucker, University of the Incarnate Word, carried the Cardinals this past week averaging 24.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game. He scored a career high 30 points, grabbed six rebounds and had five steals in a 69-67 win at West Texas A&M. He had 18 points and five rebounds at Eastern New Mexico in a loss. He shot 58.1 percent from the field for the week and continues to lead the conference with 18.0 points per game.

Rafael Love, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 19.0 points, 12.5 rebounds and 3.5 steals in two games. He recorded his fifth and sixth double-doubles of the season as well. In Eastern New Mexico's first game in 12 days, Love scored 18 points and grabbed 13 rebounds in 39 minutes of action in a set back at home to Texas A&M-Kingsville. He followed up with a 20 point, 12 rebound, and tying his career-high of four steals in 37 minutes during a 16-point victory over Incarnate Word at home.

De'Andre Upchurch, Tarleton State University, helped carry the Texans to a 15-point win over Lone Star Conference champion Midwestern State on Saturday as he scored a career-high 23 points in 22 minutes off the bench. The junior guard was 5-for-7 from the field, 2-for-3 from beyond the arc and he was flawless from the charity stripe, converting a perfect 11 out of 11 from the free throw line.

Reid Wallace, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, posted his second highest point total with 17 at West Texas to lead A&M-Kingsville. In a game decided at the buzzer, Wallace kept his team in the running as his total points matched the output of the team's four other starters. He was efficient in hitting 60.0 of his shots including 4-of-8 threes. In the win against Eastern New Mexico, he nearly had a double-double with nine points and eight rebounds. He had a key three against the Greyhounds with just over three minutes to go and pair of free throws with less than two minutes left. Both stopped rallies and were key in clinching a playoff berth.

Lawrence Domingo, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 13.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists in two key conference games at home. Versus Texas A&M-Kingsville, he grabbed seven rebounds, scored six points, dished out two assists and was credited with a steal. Domingo then exploded for a career-high 21 points and tied his career-best of eight rebounds versus Incarnate Word.

Denzel Livingston, University of the Incarnate Word, had a key steal that led to a fast break layup late in the game at West Texas A&M in a 69-67 win. The steal allowed the Cardinals to tie the game at 64-64. He finished the game with three steals and two blocks. He came back on Saturday and had a strong all-around performance with 12 points, five assists and four blocks in a loss at Eastern New Mexico. He averaged 9.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and 2.0 steals per game for the week.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico was 1-1 last week at home as they fell to Texas A&M-Kingsville on Thursday and beat Incarnate Word Saturday afternoon. The Greyhounds are currently alone in fifth place in conference entering the final week of the regular season. Junior guard Rafael Love recorded two double-doubles to give him six on the year. He averaged 19.0 points, 12.5 rebounds and 3.5 steals per game and tied his career-high in steals with four against Incarnate Word. Freshman forward Lawrence Domingo scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed a career-best tying eight rebounds versus the Cardinals in the 16-point victory. Junior guard Rodney Blackmon contributed 20 points with six assists and four rebounds against UIW as well. Saturday's contest was the first time this season that a trio of Greyhounds scored 20-plus points in a single-game. ENMU finishes the last week of regular season action on the road at Tarleton State on Wednesday and hosts Texas A&M-Commerce Saturday afternoon for senior night.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals are in a battle with Tarleton State and Eastern New Mexico for the #3 seed in the conference tournament. They are currently tied with the Texans for third while the Greyhounds are one game back with two to play. Last week the Cardinals went 1-1 on the road. They picked up an important win at West Texas A&M on Thursday. Lyn'Dale Brown's put back with under two seconds to play was the difference in the game. Denzel Livingston had a key steal that led to a fast break layup late in the game at West Texas A&M in a 69-67 win. The steal allowed the Cardinals to tie the game at 64-64. He finished the game with three steals and two blocks. He came back on Saturday and had a strong all-around performance with 12 points, five assists and four blocks in a loss at Eastern New Mexico. He averaged 9.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and 2.0 steals per game for the week. Dionelle Rucker maintained his spot as the top scorer in the conference. He poured in a career high 30 points and had five steals at West Texas A&M. He came back with 18 points at Eastern New Mexico. He is averaging 18.0 points per game, the seventh best figure in school history.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State clinched its seventh Lone Star Conference championship and fifth in the last seven seasons with an 85-67 win over Texas A&M-Commerce Wednesday night at D.L. Ligon Coliseum... Midwestern fell to 32-2 in games it carried a lead into halftime over the past two seasons... The Mustangs have won 58 LSC games over the past five seasons which is six more than Tarleton State, who has won the second most... MSU five LSC titles in seven seasons are the most since Central Oklahoma won five in seven years from 1993 to 1998... Since Midwestern State joined the league in 1997-98, no other team has claimed more conference championships as MSU has seven, Central Oklahoma and West Texas A&M have three, Tarleton State has two and Northeastern State and Texas A&M-Commerce have one... Senior forward Corbin Thomas notched his eighth and ninth double doubles of the season with 27 points and 18 rebounds against Texas A&M-Commerce and 19 points and 12 rebounds at Tarleton State... Sophomore guard Derrell Gibbs has knocked down a 3-pointer in each of his last 10 games including three treys to finish with a career-high 14 points Saturday at

Tarleton State... Gibbs is 18-of-33 (54.5 percent) from the arc over his last 10 games... Senior forward Jeff Grayer connected on a season-high four 3-pointers to finish with a campaign-best 13 points Wednesday against Texas A&M-Commerce... Junior forward Eddie D'Haiti connected on his second and third trey of the season to finish with eight points Saturday at Tarleton State...

Tarleton State

The Texans went 1-1 last week, falling earlier in the week to Cameron on a waning moments three-pointer, but then upsetting Midwestern State at Wisdom Gym on Saturday... Chuck Guy scored a career-high 26 points in Wednesday's game, going 9-for-16 from the field that included a 6-for-8 effort from beyond the arc... De'Andre Upchurch scored a career-high 23 points in Saturday's win over MSU, going 5-for-9 from the field and a perfect 11-for-11 from the charity stripe... The Texans shot 47.2 percent from the field this week and were 11-of-23 (47.8%) from behind the three-point line... Jon Cathey-Macklin and Damion Clemons led the team with 10 rebounds each this week... Cathey-Macklin added a team-high four blocks as he continues to lead the lead in blocked shots... With the win over the Mustangs and Incarnate Word's loss to Eastern New Mexico on Saturday, the Texans can still get the No. 2 seed in the upcoming LSC Tournament in Allen... Tarleton will host the Greyhounds this Wednesday for Senior Night... Tarleton will honor its lone senior, Brian Word... The Texans then hit the road for the final game of the 2012-13 season, heading to Canyon to face West Texas A&M on Saturday.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas finished 8-of-16 from 3-point range on Saturday at West Texas A&M. The eight just missed the season high for made threes, while the 50% mark was the second-best percentage for the team. In two games against the Buffaloes this season, Kingsville connected on 17-of-30 treys for 56.7%... In downing Eastern New Mexico last Thursday night, the Javelinas attempted a season-high 32 attempts from the foul which is one more than the prior season-mark of 31 versus Angelo State. The 19 made foul shots was the second most this season... Rebounding for the Javelinas in their two games last week was like night and day. On Thursday against Eastern New Mexico, the Javelinas snared a season-high 50 rebounds en route to a win. In the loss at West Texas, Kingsville had a season-low 18 rebounds... With Saturday's 1-point loss to the Buffs, Kingsville and West Texas have now played 85 minutes of basketball this season with just two points separating the teams. In Kingsville, the Javelinas won 64-61 in overtime, while West Texas won Saturday with a shot as the clock expired in regulation... The Javelinas have had four games come down to the final possession in LSC action this season and are 2-2 in those games. In all, Kingsville has played 16 games decided by 10-points-or-less this season. The Javelinas are 7-of-9 in those games... When Kingsville limited Eastern New Mexico to 36.5 shooting it was the tenth time the Javelinas held an opponent to 40%-or-below from the field. The Hoggies are second in the LSC to only Midwestern State in defensive field goal percentage - 40.0% to 40.1%... With 11 rebounds at ENMU, Adam Mughmaw tied Daymon Warren's season-high in rebounds. It was Mughmaw's second double-digit rebounding performance of the season... Reid Wallace

led the Javelinas with 17 points on Saturday and was 4-of-8 from behind the three-point line. His 17 points matched the total output of the four other Javelina starters in the game. Only Jamahl Brown, who came off the bench, joined Wallace in double-digit points with 14.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Breanna Harris, Texas A&M University - Commerce, continued to pace A&M-Commerce, scoring 18 points and 11 rebounds in both games against Midwestern State and Cameron this past week as the Lions clinched their first LSC tournament bid since 2008-09. She shot 44.4% from the floor and was a solid 12-15 from the line, including 6-of-7 against the Aggies to help secure the victory. 12 of her 22 rebounds were offensive as she notched her 12th and 13th double-doubles of the season and is averaging a double-double per game at 15.3 points and 10.3 boards per game.

Kirsti Degelia, Midwestern State University, led the attack that saw the Mustangs post two second half come-from-behind victories last week including MSU's first win at Tarleton State since Dec. 2, 2003 with a 71-63 victory. The 5-8 junior from Denton, Texas/Krum led Midwestern with 18 against the TexAnns after leading the team with 16 points in a 70-62 win over Texas A&M-Commerce as the Mustangs clinched no lower than a number two seed in the LSC Tournament in Allen. Degelia averaged 17.0 points for the week with 3.5 assists and hit 17-of-20 free throws, 85.0 percent. She also blocked a shot and recorded a steal.

Nelsha Peterson, Eastern New Mexico University, registered the Zias second double double of the season, with a 24 points and 11 rebounds against Incarnate Word. Both totals represented career highs. She shot .615 from the floor against UIW, in addition to an eight-for-nine performance at the free throw line. Peterson also scored three points in a key win over Texas A&M-Kingsville and blocked a shot.

Leah LeMaire, Angelo State University, recorded her second double-double of her career with 11 points and 14 rebounds in a win over Texas Woman's. LeMaire grabbed 11 of her 14 rebounds on the defensive end. The junior was a part of a defense that held TWU to 30-percent shooting for the game and 17.6-percent from the 3-point line. LeMaire shot 67-percent from the field and hit two 3-pointers in the win.

Hannah Altheide, Eastern New Mexico University, was a key part of a Zia defense last week, which limited the opposition to 62 points per game and a .369 field goal percentage. Eastern was especially tough on the perimeter and limited Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word to a .188 conversion rate on three-point attempts. Altheide had three steals, five assists, a .700 shooting percentage and 15 points against the Javelinas. She followed with six defensive rebounds, a steal and seven points against Incarnate Word.

Lauren Holt, the LSC's top shot blocker, is ranked in the top 10 in six statistical categories. Haylee Oliver is in the top 10 of eight different statistical categories. Leah LeMaire recorded her first double-double of the season and second of her career with 11 points and 14 rebounds against TWU. The Belles will play at Texas A&M-Kingsville on Wednesday and host Incarnate Word in the season finale on Saturday.

Cameron

Cameron women's basketball snapped a nine game losing streak in a big way by beating Tarleton State in the Aggie Gym on Wednesday, Feb. 20, with of score of 52-50. The Aggies limited their turnovers and played tough defense holding the TexAnns to 30.2 percent shooting on the floor. However on Saturday, Feb. 23 the Aggies were eliminated from the Lone Star Conference Tournament following a 65-58 loss in Commerce, Texas. Eastern New Mexico

The Zias continued their strong play, last week, sweeping the season series from Texas A&M-Kingsville and extending Incarnate Word to overtime. The effort helped to clinch Eastern's second trip to the Lone Star Conference tournament, in Allen, Texas. The trip marks the first time Eastern has reached the postseason in consecutive season, since the late 1990's. Over the two games, last week, Tara Johnson and Nelsha Peterson registered ENMU's first double doubles of the season. This week, the Zias will close the regular season against Tarleton State and Texas A&M-Kingsville.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 1-1 last week with a loss at West Texas A&M and an overtime come back victory at Eastern New Mexico. The team will likely be the #4 or #5 seed. They can move up to a #3 seed if they win both games this week and Tarleton State loses both of their games. The team is currently tied with West Texas A&M for fourth place and they hold the tie-breaker thanks to a win over Midwestern State earlier in the season. Ashlyn Green posted her team-high third double-double of the season in the win at Eastern New Mexico. She led the team with 17

points, 10 rebounds and four steals. She remains the conference leader with 3.4 steals per game. She has 74 steals on the season which is tied for 6th in school history. With six more steals she would become only the fourth player to ever reach 80 steals in a season. Guard Ify Mora is quietly moving up UIW's blocked shots lists. MSU clinched the number two seed in the Lone Star Conference Tournament in Allen with the win over Tarleton State ... With a game to play against Texas Woman's, MSU is a half-game behind leader Abilene Christian and holds the tiebreaker with the Wildcats in case of a tie thanks to the sweep of Tarleton ... Midwestern won it's 20th game with the Tarleton win, marking the first time MSU has hit the magic 20 mark since the 2002-03 season when it posted a 21-9 record ... MSU was ranked third in the first NCAA II South Central Regional rankings last week ... The Mustangs 71-63 win at Wisdom Gym in Stephenville was the first for MSU since Dec. 2, 2003 when MSU took an 84-80 win ...
