### LSC SOFTBALL

The Lone Star Conference softball season continues with non-conference play amid a few interruptions from weather including snow in West Texas and New Mexico.

West Texas A&M tops the standings at 10-1, with four other teams posting double-digit win totals as well.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 83-68 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 36-29 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 11-3 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### HITTER

**Lauren Smith, Angelo State University, SR, OF, Waxahachie, Texas, Cornerstone Christian HS**

Smith hit .833 last week with five hits and five RBI's. The senior scored five runs to the lead the Rambelles in two victories over Texas A&M International. Smith hit her first home run and triple of the season and finished the week with an .857 on base percentage. The Waxahachie native is No. 3 in the LSC with 18 RBI's.

#### PITCHER

**Larisa Garcia, Texas Woman's University, SR, P, New Braunfels, Texas, New Braunfels HS**

Garcia tossed a complete-game shutout against the host St. Edward's to help the Pioneers to a first place finish at SEU Tournament. She lost a no-hitter with two outs in the seventh, allowing a bloop single on a two-two count for the only hit. On the season she has a 3-1 record, 16 strikeouts, 2.65 ERA and team-best .207 opponent batting average.

### OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Rose Stubbs, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, had a tremendous week hitting .579 with three RBI and four runs scored. She raised her season average to .466 with her performance which is fifth in the league. She belted her first home run of the season and had a .737 slugging percentage. Stubbs hit in all six games this week and is in the midst of a 10-game hitting streak. She has reached safely in all but one game this season and has nine multi-hit games.

Kuuleiokealoaha VonSchriltz, Eastern New Mexico University, hit safely in both of last week's games, to extend her hitting streak to a career-best four games. Over the doubleheader against New Mexico Highlands, she hit .429, with one run batted in and committed no errors in the field.

Katie Hines, Texas Woman's University, helped the team to 3-1 record and to a first place finish at the St. Edward's Tournament over the weekend. She led the Pioneers with eight RBI, three home runs and a 1.071 slugging percentage. Hines also started in the circle in one game and tossed five shutout innings in an 8-0 (6) win over Texas A&M-International. On the season she is the team leader with 21 RBI, five home runs and a .786 slugging percentage.

The Aggies went 1-3 this weekend after facing #8 ranked UCO and #12 ranked Emporia State. UCO swept the Aggies on Saturday. Cameron had plenty of chances to score early, but couldn't capitalize and would lose 4-0. Still, the Aggies had strong pitching from Samantha Betts, who struck out three and gave up no earned runs. The second game between the team had plenty of offense from both sides. Lead-off hitter Spencer Ferrell went 3-5, and had a run and an RBI. Sophomore Tara Martini went 2-3 with two RBI's and Freshman Sonora Zukerman went 2-4 with two solo home runs, but the Aggies lost 10-8. The next day Cameron split the double-header with Emporia State. The Hornets got an early lead in the 1st inning 3-0, but Aggie Senior Sonia Foutch would answer with a solo home run. After that though, the ESU got on a roll and scored 17 runs over the next four innings to beat the Cameron, 20-1 in five innings. The next game, the Aggies got an early 2-0 lead and kept it until the fifth inning. Then in the bottom of the seventh tied 4-4, Sonia Foutch hit a two-run, walk-off home run to get the win for the Aggies, 6-4. Pitcher Samantha Betts went the distance, striking out seven and allowing four runs. Spencer Ferrell went 2-4 and scored a run for Cameron, Foutch went 1-3 with 2 RBI's, and shortstop Misty Dooley also went 1-3 with 2 RBI's.

Midwestern State was idle last week... The Mustangs received votes in the National Fast-pitch Coaches' Association Top 25 for the first time since receiving 45 votes on Feb. 22, 2012... MSU's slated doubleheader with No. 8 Central Oklahoma on Tuesday was postponed to March 26 at 3 and 5 p.m. at Mustangs Park... The Mustangs play host to the 6-team, 15-game Courtyard by Marriott Invitational Friday, Saturday and Sunday at Mustangs Park. The field includes MSU, St. Mary's (Texas), Northeastern State (Okla.), Oklahoma Panhandle State, Abilene Christian and Emporia State (Kan.)... Junior catcher Kim Jerrick has collected a hit in a school-record 21-straight games dating back to last season.... Jerrick is hitting .522 (36-for-69) during the 21-game hitting streak with nine doubles, seven homers and 25 RBIs... Jerrick has recorded a hit in 31 of her last 33 games dating back to last season while hitting .500 (53-for-106) with 12 doubles, 11 homers and 37 RBIs... Jerrick's 21-game hitting betters teammate Elena Bennett, who posted a 21-game hitting streak as a sophomore in 2011... Jerrick has reached base in each of her last 33 games... Senior outfielder Courtney Bingham is riding a season-best six-game hitting streak batting .476 (10-of-21) with a double, a triple and six RBIs... Freshman shortstop Shelby Carter is batting .333 (6-for-18) on a current six-game hitting streak with two doubles and a pair of RBIs...

**Texas A&M-Kingsville**

Senior Rose Stubbs had a tremendous week hitting .579 with three RBI and four runs scored. She raised her season average to .466 with her performance which is fifth in the league. Her 27 hits is tied for first in the LSC. She belted her first home run of the season and had a .737 slugging percentage. Stubbs hit in all six games this week and is in the midst of a 10-game hitting streak. She has reached safely in all but one game this season and has nine multi-hit games. Stubbs had four multi-hit games this last week...Carynn Gonzales hit .389 over the past week and has a 5-game hitting streak. She had three doubles during the week with two RBI and three runs score ...Adela Gomez had six RBI for the week to lead the team. She had three in one game at home against St. Mary's and had a single RBI in three other games. Gomez now has 14 RBI on the season to lead Kingsville which is more than twice as many as the player with the second most RBI on the team. Gomez is tied for fourth in the conference with six doubles... After recording no home runs as a team in the first three games of the season, Kingsville hit three during the tournament at St. Edward's. Jaleen Castro, Gomez and Stubbs each knocked the ball out of the park... With 11 walks, senior Kodie Garner is tied for the LSC lead...With 58.2 innings pitched Katrisha Arocha leads the LSC in innings pitched and is tied for the lead with nine starts, while Denise Arnold is second with 14 appearances.

**Texas Woman's**

No. 14 Texas Woman's posted a 3-1 record over the weekend at St. Edward's Tournament to improve its season record to 13-5. After dropping the first game on Friday, four Pioneer pitchers combined to tossed three shutouts including two complete-game shutouts. Junior Katie Hines led the team with eight RBI and three home runs. She also started in the circle in the second game and tossed five shutout innings for her fourth win of the season. Junior Brandie Lander went 1-1 with two complete games including a complete-game shutouts and six strikeouts against Texas A&M-International on Saturday. Senior Larisa Garcia also tossed a complete-game shutout against the host St. Edward's on Saturday. She lost a no-hitter with two outs in the seventh, allowing a bloop single on a two-two count for the only hit. Garcia struck out one batter and picked up her third win of the season. Senior Lizzy Kelly scored a team-best five runs and drove in four runs. The Pioneers stole 11 bases to add to their season total (48). Junior Bailey Vrazel recorded three steals and has 18 on the season.
