LSC BASEBALL

This week marks spring break for many schools along with the start of Lone Star Conference action. Seven of the eight league teams have double-digit win seasons after non-conference play. LSC series to watch this week include Texas A&M-Kingsville at Angelo State and Incarnate Word at Abilene Christian.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 91-46-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 8-6 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 28-8 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Jarvis Smith, West Texas A&M University, SR, OF, Waco, Texas, Midway/Germantown HS

Led the team going 4 for 7 for a .571 average along with one double and four RBI...Slugged .714 and reached base at a .750 clip...Walked four times and stole a base...Scored the game-winning run in the 6-0 win at McMurry Monday and has a two-run single in the Buffs' comeback attempt in the second game against the War Hawks Monday.

Tyler Coughenour, Angelo State University, JR, 2B, Wichita, Kan., Wichita Collegiate

Coughenour went 3 for 4 in ASU's 6-4 win over Bellarmine University last Tuesday at Foster Field. Coughenour had three singles and also stole a base. The junior has now stolen 12 bases on 12 attempts this season and is hitting .323 going into a seven-game schedule this week.

PITCHERS

Ryan Houston, West Texas A&M University, SR, RHP, Amarillo, Texas, Amarillo HS

Had a masterful performance in the opener of a doubleheader at McMurry Monday...Went 5.1 innings allowing just one hit with three strikeouts and two walks...The War Hawks hit just .059 against him as he combined for the shutout with senior Paul Pulley in the 6-0 win. It was Houston's second win of the season (2-1) as he dropped his ERA to 4.07, while leading the team in innings pitched with 24.1.

Brady Rodriguez, Abilene Christian University, JR, RHP, Plymouth, Mich., Dearborn Divine Child HS

Rodriguez earned two saves through three appearances as the Wildcats this weekend took two of three from visiting Bellarmine. In Thursday night's 5-2 win, Rodriguez faced the minimum nine batters over the final three innings with one strikeout, and then in game two, he got Cody Scheler to line out to left with the tying runs on base, giving ACU a 4-2 victory. Rodriguez dealt a 1-2-3 ninth in ACU's game three loss to the Knights, 5-4. This season, Rodriguez has pitched 21.1 innings, in which he has allowed just two earned runs for a 0.84 ERA. He also has 13 Ks.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Bryant Rutledge, Angelo State University, struck out seven and didn't allow a walk in a 6-4 non-conference win over Bellarmine last Tuesday at Foster Field. Rutledge limited the Knights to two runs on four hits and to a .235 team batting average. Rutledge has walked only one batter and has struck out 15 this season in 16.1 innings of work. He is the probable starter for Tuesday's opener against Southeastern Oklahoma State at Foster Field.

Travis Schuetze, Abilene Christian University, extended his hitting and reached base streaks to 11 and 19, respectively, following a 5-for-12 weekend at the plate vs. Bellarmine. His efforts lifted his season batting average to a team best .443. Schuetze doubled and singled in two runs during Thursday's 5-2 win over the Knights, and then went 2-for-4 with an intentional walk in game two's 4-2 victory. On Saturday - a game that ACU lost 5-4 - Schuetze was walked in the seventh, but was able to extend his hitting streak in the ninth with a single up the middle. Schuetze's hitting streak is the team's longest since Chuck Duarte and Reed Watson each had an 11-game one last season. Duncan Blades and Tyler Eager each reached base in 20+ games a season ago as well.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico did not play last week as their scheduled game at the University of the Southwest was cancelled. The Greyhounds will play at New Mexico Highlands Tuesday afternoon and open conference play at Tarleton State on Friday.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals suffered their first losing streak of the season last week dropping a 3-2 game at Texas A&M-International and a 7-2 game at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Despite the losses the team remained in the top 25, but fell to #4 in the NCBWA South Central Region. The team hosts A&M-International on Tuesday night before heading to Abilene Christian this week for the first Lone Star Conference series of the season. Shortstop Derrick Walls stole his 16th base of the season last week matching his total from last year. He is perfect on all 16 stolen base opportunities this year and has stole 22 consecutive bases since last being thrown out. Catcher Zac Russell has 11 hits on the season and nine of them have gone for extra bases. He has eight doubles and a home run.

Tarleton State

The Texans had just one game last week, defeating McMurry 9-6 in Abilene... Tarleton will not play again until this Friday, Mar. 15 when the team hosts Eastern New Mexico for its first LSC series of the season... The Texans head into this weekend's series at 11-6-1 overall and have won a season-high five straight games... The Texans are currently fourth in the league hitting .317 as a team and third in the LSC with a combined earned run average of 3.55... The Texans top the LSC with 10 triples and 52 stolen bases heading into this week... Tarleton's pitching is fourth in the LSC with 126 strikeouts, but the Texans are tied for the league-lead with six saves... Alvaro Moreno leads the LSC with his 20 runs batted in... Matt Buckmaster is just one of two pitchers in the conference to have thrown two complete games.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

James Black led the Javelinas offensively with a .455 average against Fisher College over the weekend. He led the team with six RBI over the weekend and had a .545 slugging percentage. He knocked in three RBI in the series opener and had two as he went 2-for-3 with a double...Dallas Ponder picked up his fifth win in as many starts on Friday tossing a 7-inning, completegame shutout. He fanned a career 12 batters in the win and allowed just three hits. His ERA is now 1.86 on the season...The Javelina starting pitchers were nearly unhittable lover the weekend. In 20 innings, the starters allowed just seven hits and fanned 25 as a group. The starters combined to allow just two unearned runs...Four different players homered for the Javelinas over the weekend. Julian Duran, Mario Siller, Chris Ballou, and Taylor Taska all homered as the Javelinas doubled their total for long balls entering the weekend. Duran's homer was an inside-the-park that got past a diving Falcon fielder and rolled to the wall...In the final game of the Fisher series, Julian Duran went 4-for-4 with steals. As a team, Kingsville finished 18-of-19 in steals. The team is now 50-of-59 on the season...The Javelinas used their bench over the weekend with 16 players getting at least three official at-bats. Of those 16, 15 had at least one hit. Fourteen different Hoggies crossed the plate on the weekend.

West Texas A&M

Went 1-2 over the week with an 8-3 loss to St. Edward's at home on Sunday along with splitting a doubleheader at McMurry on Monday...WT won the opener at McMurry 6-0, and battled back to tie the War Hawks at five in the nightcap, but a walk-off single by McMurry in the bottom of the seventh won the game for McM...the Buffs had a strong pitching performance from senior Ryan Houston as he threw a one-hitter in 5.1 innings with three strikeouts in the opener against the War Hawks...Senior Jarvis Smith went 4 for 7 for the week with a double and four RBI to lead the team.
