LSC SOFTBALL

Lone Star Conference play continues this week with a match-up of top teams as West Texas A&M plays at Midwestern State. The Lady Buffs and Mustangs each have 19 wins and boast nine-game winning streaks.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 135-95 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 52-38 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 11-3 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER

Renee Erwin, West Texas A&M University, SO, OF, Anna, Texas, Anna HS

Erwin continued her hot streak at the plate this past week as the sophomore hit an incredible .645 with three doubles, two triples and three home runs including two grand slams to drive in 17 RBI on the week as the #3 Lady Buffs improved to 19-1 (3-0 LSC). The Anna, Texas native had a huge doubleheader against Northwestern Oklahoma State on Tuesday at Schaeffer Park in Canyon, driving in seven RBI in the opener including a grand slam to finish the day with 9 RBI against the Rangers.

PITCHER

Larisa Garcia, Texas Woman's University, SR, P, New Braunfels, Texas, New Braunfels HS

Garcia posted a 3-0 record with 0.00 ERA in three starts. She tossed two complete-games including a shutout. Garcia pitched 17.0 innings and allowed one unearned run while holding the opponents to .161 batting average and striking out 18 batters. On the season she has a 1.79 ERA, 7-1 record, 40 strikeouts and .204 opponent's batting average. Garcia has tossed five complete games including two shutouts this season.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Kacie Easley, Angelo State University, led the Rambelles to a sweet of Cameron while batting .800. The senior went 4-of-5 at the plate and drew six walks over the weekend. Her home run in game three tied the game in the fifth inning. She scored four runs and recorded five RBI's.

Rose Stubbs, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, continued her trend of hot hitting last week averaging .529 in a 5-game stretch. She was 9-of-17 with a double, triple and four RBI. She was 3-of-6 in doubleheader at St. Mary's and then opened conference play going 6-of-8 in three games against TWU. The senior is now hitting .500 on the season with 13 RBI and 18 runs scored. She had an 18-game hitting streak snapped Saturday and has posted a hit in all but two games.

Jacqueline Candelaria, Eastern New Mexico University, hit safely in two of the Zias three games against 22nd-ranked Midwestern State. Her home run was Eastern's only hit, in the series opener.

Kim Jerick, Midwestern State University, became Midwestern State's all-time leader in home runs with a three-run blast to left field in the sixth inning of a 15-5 win over Eastern New Mexico Friday afternoon in Portales. The junior catcher from Belle Plaine, Kan. added her 30th career jack with a three-run shot to center in a 10-2 Saturday at Zia Field. Jerick hit .444 for the series while going 4-for-9 with two homers and six RBIs. She leads the LSC in hitting (.527), runs scored (36), RBIs (33), homers (9) and total bases (75).

Kendra Sancet, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers to 4-1 record on the road last week including 3-0 in the Lone Star Conference. She led the team with .875 slugging percentage, 5 RBI, and 4 doubles. Sancet batted .438 with four runs, 3 walks and .526 onbase percentage. Sancet drove in the winning run in two of the three LSC wins over the weekend. She also recorded 32 putouts at first base with three assists and 1.000 fielding percentage. On the season Sancet has a .337 batting average, 21 RBI, 4 home runs, 7 doubles, and .566 slugging percentage.

Laci Belovsky, Midwestern State University, claimed each decision while leading No. 22-ranked Midwestern State to a three-game sweep of Eastern New Mexico last weekend in Portales. The freshman right-hander from Grangerland allowed two runs on six hits in 11 1/3 innings with 13 strikeouts and two walks while limiting the Zias to a .154 batting average. Belovsky has won her last 10 decision in the circle and leads the Lone Star Conference with 12 wins this season.

Briana Sanchez, University of the Incarnate Word, started the week with a rough outing against St. Edward's and was dealt her first loss of the year. However, she bounced back with two wins at Abilene Christian to get the team going in LSC action. After allowing five runs in 5.0 innings against St. Edward's she pitched a pair of complete games at ACU. In the first game she allowed one earned run and three walks while striking out a season high 10 batters in a 7-4 win. In the series finale she picked up her first shutout of the year after scattering four hits and one walk while striking out seven.

Hannah Newcomb, West Texas A&M University, continued to impress for the #3 Lady Buffs this past week as she picked up all three wins against rival Tarleton State in a series sweep on LSC opening weekend at Schaeffer Park in Canyon. The freshman righthander went 3-0 on the week with a 2.52 ERA as she also added her first collegiate save. Newcomb gave the #3 Lady Buffs the series win against Tarleton State on Saturday afternoon

as she threw a three hit shutout in game two of the series in the complete game win.

Sandra Serna won her ninth and 10th games of the season striking out six and only giving up two runs. Lauren Smith leads the LSC in doubles with 11 and Ambra Hill is fourth in stolen bases with .45 per game. ASU hosts Eastern New Mexico this Friday and Saturday at the ASU Softball Complex.

The Eastern New Mexico University softball team dropped a three-game series to 22nd-ranked Midwestern State, over the weekend. Marley Pinion's first inning grand slam in the second game, brought Eastern's total to three, for the season. This weekend, ENMU will face Angelo State.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 2-3 during the week. They lost two games at home to St. Edward's last Wednesday. They bounced back by taking 2-of-3 from Abilene Christian on the road in the first LSC series of the year. This week they host UT-Permian Basin on Tuesday in a doubleheader and then welcome Cameron over the weekend. Briana Sanchez started the week with a rough outing against St. Edward's and was dealt her first loss of the year. However, she bounced back with two wins at Abilene Christian to get the team going in LSC action. After allowing five runs in 5.0 innings against St. Edward's she pitched a pair of complete games at ACU. In the first game she allowed one earned run and three walks while striking out a season high 10 batters in a 7-4 win. In the series finale she picked up her first shutout of the year after scattering four hits and one walk while striking out seven. Senior Kim Hanson cracked a pair of home runs during the week and now leads the team with three on the season. Shelby Waltrip came up big in the team's wins. In the opener at ACU, she went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBIs in a 7-4 win. In the final game of the series, it was her sacrifice fly that scored the only run of the game.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State extended its season-best winning streak to nine games with a three-game sweep of Eastern New Mexico last weekend in Portales... The last seven Mustangs' wins have come via run rules... The 9-game winning streak is the longest since MSU won 13-straight games from Feb. 13-March 6, 2011 on the way to a 54-14 and national semifinalist showing... Midwestern State leads the Lone Star Conference with a team batting average of .405 including a .423 team average in last weekend's sweep of Eastern New Mexico... MSU boasts five of the top seven hitters in the LSC including league leading Kim Jerrick (.527)

and second Elena Bennett (.514) as well as No. 5-7 in Katelyn Vinson (.457), Kelley Schaefer (.455) and Courtney Bingham (.441)... Junior catcher Kim Jerrick became the program's all-time leader when she blasted her 29th career homer in the sixth inning of a 15-5 win over Eastern New Mexico on Friday then added her 30th with another 3-run blast in the third inning of a 10-2 win on Saturday... Sophomore third baseman Kelley Schaefer extended her team-best active hitting streak to seven games by collected hits in each of MSU's wins over ENMU over the weekend including a pair of homers. She is hitting .500 (17-of-34) with a double, four homers and 17 RBIs during the hitting streak... Freshman outfielder Haley Howerton has raised her batting average from .105 to .340 by hitting .485 (16-for-33) over the past 12 games... The Mustangs mashed ENMU pitching for seven homers over the weekend including a pair of blasts by junior catcher Kim Jerrick, freshman designated player Katelyn Vinson and sophomore third baseman Kelley Schaefer and another by freshman shortstop Shelby Carter... Freshman pitcher Laci Belovsky has won her last 10 decisions in the circle to improve to 12-2 on the season to lead the LSC in wins...

Texas A&M-Kingsville

Rose Stubbs continued her trend of hot hitting last week averaging .529 in a 5-game stretch. She was 9-of-17 with a double, triple and four RBI. She was 3-of-6 in doubleheader at St. Mary's and then opened conference play going 6-of-8 in the first three games against TWU. The senior is now hitting .500 on the season with 13 RBI and 18 runs scored. She had an 18-game hitting streak snapped Saturday and has posted a hit in all but two games... Carynn Gonzales is the only other Javelina averaging .300 or better this season. She is at .301 on the year...The numbers for Kingsville starting pitchers Denise Arnold and Katrisha Arocha are nearly interchangeable. Arnold is 5-8 with a 3.76 ERA in 82 innings, with 39 walks and 49 strikeouts. Arocha is 5-7 with 50 strikeouts and 37 walks. Opponents are hitting .302 against each.

Texas Woman's

The Pioneers posted a 4-1 record on the road to improve their overall record to 22-5. TWU swept the three-game series at Texas A&M-Kingsville before splitting the doubleheader at Texas A&M-International. Junior Bailey Vrazel posted a team-best .550 batting average while sophomore Kendra Sancet led the team with .875 slugging percentage. Senior Lizzy Kelly scored six runs to lead the Pioneers. Senior Larisa Garcia dominated in the circle with 3-0 record and 0.00 ERA in three starts. She tossed two complete-games including a shutout while striking out 18 batters. On the season Vrazel is the team leader with .436 average, 28 runs and 22 stolen bases. Kelly also scored a team-best 28 runs while junior Katie Hines leads the team with 8 home runs and 32 RBI. Hines also has a team-best 1.68 ERA in the circle. Both Garcia and Hines have a 7-1 record while junior Brandie Lander is 8-3 with a team best 56 strikeouts.

West Texas A&M

The #3 Lady Buffs went 5-0 this past week including 3-0 against rival Tarleton State to open up the 2013 Lone Star Conference Schedule in style at Schaeffer Park in Canyon. WT enters the week at 19-1 overall with a 3-0 mark in the LSC. The Lady Buffs hit .361 as a team with 14 doubles, four triples and five homeruns

this past week to drive in 49 runs. WT was led at the plate by Renee Erwin who hit .645 with 17 RBI and a slugging percentage of 1.625 on the week. WT will hit the road this weekend as they head to Wichita Falls for a three game LSC series against the #22 Mustangs of Midwestern State starting on Friday night.
