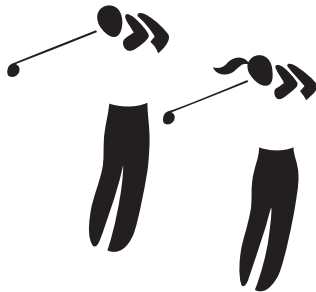

GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S

Alex Carpenter, Abilene Christian University, SR, Little Rock, Ark., Arkansas Baptist

Carpenter continued his blistering start to the 2013 spring season as he set the course record at the Mission Viejo Country Club en route to winning his 18th career individual medalist title at the Southern California Intercollegiate. Carpenter shot a career-low round of 63 Tuesday as he rallied from five shots back to win the individual title by nine strokes over Jered Stone of Cal State-Monterey Bay. The previous course record was a 68, and before Tuesday, Carpenter's career-best round was a 64. But Carpenter blistered the par-71 course on Tuesday to win the individual medalist title for the second straight week. After firing rounds of 1-over-par 71 in each of Monday's two rounds, Carpenter's 8-under-par 63 on Tuesday left him at 6-under-par 207 for the tournament and a winner by nine shots over Stone, who fired a 67 of his own on Tuesday after shooting rounds of 74-75 on Monday. Carpenter made his living on the par-3s and the par-5s on Monday and Tuesday as he played the par-3s at 3-under and the par-5s at 5-under. He led the tournament in birdies with 16 and eagles with two, and he was second in par-4 scoring at plus-two.

WOMEN'S

Sara Diaz, Texas A&M University - Commerce, JR, San Antonio, Texas, MacArthur HS

Diaz was named to the 2013 Texoma Chevy Dealers Lion Intercollegiate All-Tournament team after placing fifth with a 14-over 158. Diaz shot a pair of 79s on the tournament, notching the first top-10 finish of her career as she lowered her scoring average to a 78.71. She has competed in all seven events for the Lions this season with one top-five finish and an 11th-place showing at the World Golf Invitational in February.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Lindsey Alexander, Cameron University, had a solid weekend (85-75=160) for the Aggie women's golf team picking up 10 strokes in the second round of the Texoma Chevy Dealers Lion Intercollegiate on Monday and Tuesday this last week. Alexander shot the second lowest score in round two of the 20 schools competing in the invite and helped the Ags pick up 21 strokes as a team moving from eighth to fourth.

The team took advantage of good weather conditions the next day, and was able to pick up 21 strokes, shooting a 318, to finish in 4th place. Lindsey Alexander (85-75) and Jaqueline Strickland (80-80) led the way for CU with a score of 160 each. That put them tied for 8th individually. Kyle Johnson (87-79) also put up a good score for the Aggies with a 166. Johnson finished tied for 21st place. Cameron's next event will be at Midwestern State, March 30-April 2.
