LSC BASEBALL

After one week of Lone Star Conference play, Tarleton State jumped to the top of the standings with a series sweep, while Texas A&M-Kingsville and Abilene Christian won their league matchups 3-1. LSC series to watch this week include ACU at TAMUK and Tarleton at WT.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 111-66-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 9-7 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 28-9 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Kyle Giusti, Abilene Christian University, JR, 3B, Santa Fe, Texas

Giusti led the Wildcats in hitting last week as ACU went 4-2 at home vs. No. 1 Delta State and No. 24 Incarnate Word. Giusti batted .550 (11-20) with two extra-base hits, seven RBI and four runs. Giusti recorded at least one hit in each game and tied a season high with four hits in the Wildcats' 12-8 win in game one vs. the Cardinals. One game earlier, he tied his season high with four RBI as the Wildcats coasted to a 10-4 victory over the Statesmen.

Taylor Taska, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, 1B/DH/P, Kingwood, Tx, Kingwood HS

Taska hit .444 for the week and was 6-of-15 in the series at Angelo State. Of his eight hits on the week, four were doubles and one was a home run. He finished with an .833 slugging percentage and had a .545 on-base percentage. Taska had four RBI and six runs scored. He scored three runs in the series opener with Angelo and two in the finale of the series. Against St. Mary's in a mid-week game, Taska was 2-for-3 at the plate and tossed a 1-2/3 innings of scoreless baseball with two strikeouts.

PITCHERS

Dallas Ponder, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SR, RHP, Flatonia, Tx, Flatonia HS

Ponder moved to 6-0 on the season in as many starts on Friday. He was part of a second straight shutout on the game and won for the fourth time versus a ranked opponent. He allowed just four hits and struck out five. Just three Angelo runners advanced into scoring position in the game. Ponder has not allowed a run in over 14 innings.

Ty Taylor, Abilene Christian University, JR, LHP, Cleburne, TX

Taylor recorded a pair of gutsy performances as ACU's starting pitcher in games this week vs. No. 1 Delta State and No. 24 Incarnate Word. Taylor earned the game two start vs. the Statesmen, and despite allowing eight hits, he also struck out five and walked just one batter as the Wildcats cruised to a 10-4 win. Taylor tossed 5.2 innings, during which he escaped three jams with at least two runners on base. The only run charged to his record was an unearned run in the sixth that scored as a result of a passed ball. Taylor got off to a rough start against the Cardinals, but surrendered just three more hits after the second inning, which allowed his teammates to come back and tie UIW later in the game at 3-3. He also struck out a career and season high nine Cardinals in 6.0 innings pitched. Unfortunately, he did not receive the win as a result of a blown save attempt, but the Wildcats prevailed in the end, 5-4, in 10 innings.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Matt Redfearn, West Texas A&M University, hit .500 for the series at Cameron as he tallied a team-high 10 hits with seven runs scored, three doubles and two RBI. He tallied 13 total bases to tie the team-lead, while slugging .650 and reaching base at a .500 clip.

Andrew LaCombe, Angelo State University, led the Rams in their series against Texas A&M-Kingsville with six hits, including three doubles. LaCombe had two doubles in the series finale and finished the series with three RBI. He went 9 for 20 last week with the addition of the three non-conference games against Southeastern Oklahoma and is now hitting .338 on the season with a team-leading 11 doubles and has 20 RBI.

Kenny Acosta, Cameron University, hit a pair of homers over the weekend against West Texas A&M while hitting a .333, he also had seven RBI. Acosta also scored two runs and hit a double while drawing a walk in 12 at hats last weekend

Jake Feckley, Angelo State University, had seven strikeouts and threw a complete game to lead Angelo State to a 2-1 win over Texas A&M-Kingsville last Saturday. Feckley also earned a save in the Rams' midweek series against Southeastern Oklahoma and finished the week with nine strikeouts and only two walks. The junior has been used as a starter, reliever and closer this season and 27 strikeouts in 25 innings of work and a 2.88 ERA.

Dylan James, West Texas A&M University, tallied a complete game in a 3-1 loss at Cameron. Despite the loss, James fanned 13 Aggies for the Lone Star Conference season-high strikeouts by one player this season. He allowed just four hits, three earned runs and walked two along with the 13 K's. The Aggies hit just .182 against him.

The Rams opened conference play with a disappointing 3-1 series loss to Texas A&M-Kingsville last weekend after earning a 2-1 series win over Southeastern Oklahoma. ASU's 3-4 week takes it to 15-9 on the season and to 8-7 at Foster Field. The Rams hit .343 as a team in the seven games, but struggled on the mound with a pitching staff ERA of 8.35. The Rams return to action this week on the road at Incarnate Word.

Cameron

It was a rollercoaster weekend for Cameron that had a doubleheader sweep sandwiched in-between a pair of offensive outbursts by West Texas. The Ags got offensive numbers from catcher, Kenny Acosta who hit a pair of homers over the weekend while hitting a .333, he also had seven RBI. Kaz Sanders led CU in hitting with a .467 average and seven hits. Drew Reidt tossed a complete game for Cameron on Saturday earning a win and complete game. Cameron will play a single nine inning game on Tuesday, March 19 at Southeastern Oklahoma.

The Eastern New Mexico University baseball team dropped a Lone Star Conference series at Tarleton State, last weekend. This week, ENMU will host New Mexico Highlands and Cameron University.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas went 3-2 during the week facing ranked opponents in every game. They are now 6-2 against ranked opponents this season...Dallas Ponder recorded his second-straight shutout on Friday. He has now tossed 14 innings in a row without allowing a run. It was also the fifth time this season that he won a start against a ranked opponent...By going 3-1 at Angelo State to open conference play, the Javelinas are now 6-1 on the road. With a 6-1 mark in neutral site games they are now 12-2 away from Nolan Ryan Field...With two saves in the series with Angelo State, senior reliever Jeremy Flores now has six saves on the season. He has now tied Juan Obregon's career mark of 16 saves...Senior second baseman Ben Villafuerte is on an unbelievable run to start the season. The No.-2 hitter in the Javelina lineup has reached safely in all 22 games he has played in this season. Three other Javelinas have a streak of at least 11 games reaching base safely. Matt Perez and James Black have both reached in 12 straight while catcher Cash Barker has reached safely in 11 games...Kingsville finished with 20 hits in Sunday's finale marking the second time this season that the Javelinas have posted at least 20 hits in a game. The first was 21 against Arkansas-Monticello in the second game of the season. In Saturday's game each position player that appeared in the game recorded at least one hit... Dustin Aguilar recorded four hits in Sunday's game. It is the fourth time a Javelina player has recorded four hits in a game this season. Taylor Taska has recorded four hits twice and Matt Perez has done it once...Four players hit over .412 on the week for the Hoggies. Taylor Taska and Chris Ballou each hit .444 on the week, while Ben Villafuerte averaged .421 and Matt Perez for .412...Several Javelinas have moved into the top 10 in career rankings offensively. Trent Wagner is tied for fifth with 104 career runs scored, while Ben Villafuerte is ninth with 99 runs. Villafuerte is seventh with 150 hits, while Cash Barker is seventh with a .456 on-base percentage. Villafuerte and Wagner are fourth and fifth in games played with 153 and 150 respectively. Three players are in the top nine in steals. Wagner is second with 48, Villafuerte seventh with 38 steals, and Dustin Aguilar with 29. Barker, Villafuerte and Wagner are top five in time hit by a pitch. Barker is second with 28, Villafuerte fourth with 21, and Wagner fifth with 17...Scoring early and first have been key to the Javelinas success. Kingsville is 8-1 when scoring in the first inning and the Javelinas are 15-2 when scoring first. Another key indicator is posting more hits than the opponent. Kingsville is 15-1 when out-hitting their opponent.

West Texas A&M

Buffs went 2-2 this past week at Cameron as they tallied 37 runs, along with 53 hits as they hit .356 for the series...WT scored a season-high 20 runs in the opener in a 20-8 win...WT tallied 10 doubles, three triples and one home run during the series as they reached base at a .448 clip and slugged .483... WT went 10 of 11 in stolen bases...The pitching staff tallied a 4.05 ERA as it had 36 strikeouts to 19 walks as the Aggies hit .276 against them...WT allowed 22 runs with 15 earned runs in 33.1 innings...The teams played an 11-inning game which originally was scheduled for seven with Cameron winning 7-6... Junior Dylan James set the LSC season-high mark for strikeouts in a game with 13 in a 3-1 loss on Saturday... The Buffs really struggled Saturday in leaving runners on base as they had 24 left on in the doubleheader and, for the series, had 45 left on as Cameron left 39... After the doubleheader sweep Saturday, WT came back with a 10-4 win on Sunday to even the series... Junior Josh Weyker pitched six innings, allowing five hits, two runs - one earned, three walks and four strikeouts.
