LSC BASEBALL

Tarleton State and Abilene Christian lead the Lone Star Conference after two weeks of league action. The Texans won three of four against West Texas A&M, while the Wildcats went 3-1 versus Texas A&M-Kingsville last week

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 130-85-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 10-8 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 29-9 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Peter Creamer, Eastern New Mexico University, SR, Catcher, Boston, Mass., Santa Rosa CC

Creamer was 8-for-17 (.471) with two doubles, seven RBI, six runs scored and was a perfect 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts in five games. He was 1-for-3 with a double and run driven in a 6-4 victory against New Mexico Highlands. He started the series against Cameron by going 1-for-5 at the plate with a runs scored and RBI but followed with a 3-for-3 performance at the plate with a double, three RBI and three runs scored. In the first game of the doubleheader on Sunday, Creamer was 2-for-3 at the plate including a single in the sixth that turned into the game-winning run. He finished the series versus the Aggies by driving in a run and going 1-for-3.

Ryan Small, Tarleton State University, SR, 2B, Longview, Texas, Spring Hill HS

Small led the Texans this weekend, hitting .500 at the plate and helping guide Tarleton to a 3-1 LSC series win over West Texas A&M in Canyon. The junior second baseman went 5-for-5 and hit for the cycle in what became a two-day series finale due to strong winds in the Panhandle. Small hit a double, triple and home run on Saturday before the game was suspended then came back on Sunday to record a pair of singles. For the week, Small hit .444 with a pair of doubles, the triple and home run, stole three bases, scored three runs and had six runs batted in. He led the team with 15 total bases and an .833 slugging percentage.

PITCHERS

Aaron Lambrix, Abilene Christian University, SR, RHP, North Tustin, Calif., Foothill HS

Lambrix on Saturday fired a complete-game one-hitter at the No. 10 Texas A&M-Kingsville Javelinas in a 4-0 shutout win. Lambrix was brilliant as he retired the first nine batters he faced before giving up a leadoff double to Ben Villafuerte in the fourth inning. After a two-out walk to Matt Perez put runners at first and second, Lambrix got Cash Barker to fly out to end the inning. That fly ball out was the start of a string of 10 straight batters Lambrix retired to end the game. Lambrix (3-2 on the season) struck out five Javelins and threw just 79 pitches. Lambrix started the season in the bullpen, but since rejoining the rotation on March 12 he is 2-1 through three starts with two complete games and a 1.42 ERA, He has also tossed 19 innings, struck out 11, and is holding opponents to a .179 batting average.

Taylor Taska, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, RHP/1B/DH, Kingwood, Texas, Kingwood HS

Taska, who has twice been named LSC Hitter of the Week, showed off his versatility this week earning a pair of wins as he moved to 4-0. He tossed six innings of shutout baseball on Tuesday in his first career start against Texas A&M-International. The junior, who set a then-school record with nine saves as a freshman before having Tommy John surgery, also earned the win in Sunday's series finale with ACU. He pitched the final 4-1/3 innings scattering four hits, striking out four and walking two. Taska has now gone 16-1/3 innings without allowing a run over six appearances. He last allowed an earned run to ACU on Feb. 4 in the final game of the Astros in Action Division II Invitational in which he earned the win in relief.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Beto Rodriguez, West Texas A&M University, hit a team-best .688 last week in five starts at second base...Had four RBI and three runs scored...Had multi-hit games in four of the five games, while recording RBIs in three... Went a career-best 4 of 4 with two run scored and two RBI against Wayland Baptist...Was hitting .308 prior to this week with four hits on the year...Now hitting .517 for the season with 15 hits in 29 at bats in 19 games with nine starts.

Thomas Galvan, Cameron University, was a force for the Aggies in the top of their lineup during the series with Eastern New Mexico. Galvan went 7-11 in four games played with five walks. He had a hitting percentage of .636, and an on base percentage of .750. In the final game of the series, Galvan was perfect at the plate with four hits. Over the course of the weekend Galvan saw his season hitting percentage climb from .254 to .314.

Andrew LaCombe, Angelo State University, hit .429 with six hits, four RBI and four runs scored last weekend in the Rams' series win at Incarnate Word. LaCombe opened the series with a home run and also had a triple in the series. He finished the series with a .786 slugging percentage, a .500 on-base percentage and with two walks. The senior catcher played the final two games of the series in left field and made key catches. He is now hitting .353 on the season with 24 RBI.

Seth Spivey, Abilene Christian University, crushed his second home run of the season as part of a 7 for 18

weekend (.389) as the Wildcats took 3 of 4 at No. 10 Texas A&M-Kingsville. Spivey ripped 3 hits in game one as the Wildcats came back from deficits of 3-0 and 5-1. He then added three more hits and scored two runs during a Saturday doubleheader sweep, and on Sunday went 1 for 4 with two runs in a one-run loss. Spivey's efforts pushed his season batting average to .400 (40-100). He also ranks among the league leaders with 36 runs and has a solid on-base percentage of .527. Spivey also leads ACU with a .540 slugging percentage.

Ben Villafuerte, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led Kingsville with a .385 average on the week. Six of Villafuerte's seven hits on the week were extra-base hits. He accounted for both Javelina runs in the first game on Saturday homering for the second time this season and tripling. In the second game, he had Kingsville only hit of the game with a double to leadoff the fourth. His string of reaching safely in every game he played was snapped at 26 in Sunday's win.

Scott Cone, West Texas A&M University, went 1-0 on the week with a midweek win over Wayland Baptist as he went five innings of one-hit baseball combining on a one-hit shutout for a 12-0 win...He then saw action in two games against Tarleton State as he pitched 2.2 innings allowing five hits with two strikeouts in relief...The hit he allowed against Wayland Baptist was an infield hit in the one-hitter...It was the first one-hitter for the Buffs this season.

Jake Albert, Angelo State University, went 2-0 in two relief appearances against Incarnate Word last week, striking out eight and allowing only one run in 9.2 inning of work. Albert threw 7.2 inning in the series finale after coming into the game in the first inning and held the Cardinals in check as the Rams overcame a 3-0 deficit to win 4-3. Albert held UIW hitters to a .156 batting average and had a 0.93 ERA during his 9.2 inning weekend. The junior is now 3-1 on the season with a 3.79 ERA in eight appearances out of the ASU bullpen.

Jaspreet Shergill, Eastern New Mexico University, started his second career game and first at home in the third game of the series versus Cameron. After a shaking first inning in which he gave up a run on three hits, Shergill settled down and allowed just two base runners and one hit over the final six innings as the Greyhounds won 2-1. In the contest, he struck out three and did not walk a batter as the Aggies were held to a .182 batting average. His complete game was the first for ENMU this season and he improves to 2-2 on the year

Troyal Yosko, Tarleton State University, collected a spot-start win for the Texans this weekend, giving up just two hits in 4.0 innings of work. He opened the game getting the first 10 batters out before giving up his first hit. He walked none and stuck out two batters in the game.

Angelo State

The Rams improved to 10-3 on the road this season with a 3-1 series win over Incarnate Word last weekend at Sullivan Field. ASU and UIW played four one-run decisions in the series with the Rams taking the first two games and the series finale. ASU hit two home runs, four triples and four doubles in the series, while its pitching staff held UIW to a .268 batting average. Senior Bryant Rutledge appeared in each of the four games and posted a 0.00 ERA in 6.2 innings with four strikeouts and only one walk. Jake Albert earned two wins in the series in relief work, while Christian Summers hit .500 with six hits against the Cardinals. Senior Lee Neumann hit three triples, a home run and drove in five runs, while Quaid McKinnon had five hits and five walks.

Cameron

The Cameron baseball team was winless this week, losing in a single game against Southeastern Oklahoma on March 19, 9-3, and then getting swept in a four game series on the road at Eastern New Mexico (10-3, 20-10, 4-3, and 2-1). The Aggie offense was stalled against the storm, only getting seven hits and three runs. In game one against the Greyhounds the Aggie offense once again couldn't get a run going, getting out hit 13-6. CU finally got some offensive production on Saturday; unfortunately it was when ENMU scored 20 runs. Brandon Raidy had four of the Aggies RBI's while Colton Davis came off the bench and drove in two more. Sunday, Aaron Kleekamp went the distance in game one, giving up four earned runs, and striking out three. Tomas Galvin was 4-4 with two runs scored in the game. In the final game of the of the series two Aggie pitchers held the Greyhounds to only two runs but the CU offense could only score one their own. CU will continue their LSC road trip with a series against Incarnate Word, Mar. 29-31.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 5-0 on the week including a series sweep of Cameron at home. The Greyhounds snapped a nine-game losing streak with a 6-4 victory at home against New Mexico Highlands. With the win, ENMU won the season series over the Cowboys for the first time since 2009. In the contest versus NMHU, senior outfielder Luis Quinones went 4-for-5 to record the 200th hit of his career and to become just the fourth Greyhound to ever record at least 200 career hits. The series sweep of the Aggies was the first Lone Star Conference series sweep for ENMU since taking a three-game series at home from Northeastern State on April 29 & 30, 2011. It was also the first four-game series sweep since April 25 & 26, 2008 at West Texas A&M. In the third game of the Cameron series, senior Jaspreet Shergill started his second career game and first at home. He threw the first Greyhound complete game as he gave up just one run on four hits in a 2-1 ENMU victory. For the week, senior Ryan Pruitt was 1-0 with 2 saves, a 2.25 ERA in eight innings of work over three games. Seniors Brooke Brooks and Peter Creamer both batted .471 (8-17) over the week. Brooks scored seven runs while Creamer had seven RBI and was 3-for-3 stealing bases.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 1-4 last week and were only 1-3 at home against Angelo State. All five games were decided by one run. The team has played seven consecutive games decided by one run and are only 1-6 in those contests. Derrick Walls had another strong week going 6-for-13 with five runs, eight walks and four stolen bases. He leads the conference with 36 runs and 23 stolen bases. Alexis Garza made his first appearance on

the mound since February 26 on Sunday. He showed no signs of being rusty after tossing 5.0 shutout innings while allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out two. He owns a 0.74 earned run average in 24.1 innings for the season. The Cardinals will look to get back on track this weekend with a four game series against Cameron at home.

Tarleton State

The Texans went 3-1 against West Texas A&M this weekend and improved to 7-1 overall in LSC play... The Texans are in first place in the LSC, a game ahead of Abilene Christian... Ryan Small hit .444 for the Texans this past week, which included hitting for the cycle in the series finale against the Buffs... Tarleton hit .247 for the week, collecting nine doubles, three triples and one home run... Tarleton's pitching staff combined for a 3.61 earned run average, giving up just 19 runs in 42.1 innings of work... Alvaro Moreno and Nico Moran's hitting streaks came to an end this weekend; Moran's streak was snapped at 19 straight games, while Moreno's stopped at 18 games... Troyal Yosko, Miguel Ramirez and Seth Hallmark all collected wins on the mound this week... Ramirez stuck out five batters in his 8.0 innings of work on Friday... Britt Robertshaw stuck out six batters he faced in his two appearances over the weekend... Tarleton moved into the No. 7 spot in the NCBWA's South Central Regional poll last week... The Texans also received votes in the Collegiate Baseball top-30 poll... Tarleton heads into this weekend's action 18-8-1 overall... The Texans will travel to Kingsville and play a pair of doubleheaders on Thursday and Friday.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelina baseball team climbed as high as No. 10 in the national rankings this past week following its 3-1 series win over Angelo State. They also climbed to second in the region behind St. Mary's...With James Black's walk-off single against Abilene Christian on Sunday, the Javelinas snapped its longest losing streak of the year at three. They have lost more than three in a row during the regular season since losing seven consecutive during the 2011 season. The streak also included a three-game sweep by Incarnate Word which marked the last time Kingsville was swept in a conference season. The Javelinas did lost four straight games last season during the postseason losing two games at the LSC tournament and two in the NCAA regional...Dallas Ponder had his streak of scoreless snapped at 16-2/3 when ACU's Seth Spivey belted a solo home run...Taylor Taska, who has twice been named LSC Hitter of the Week, showed off his versatility this week earning a pair of wins as he moved to 4-0. He tossed six innings of shutout baseball on Tuesday in his first career start. The junior, who set a then-school record with nine saves as a freshman, also earned the win in Sunday's series finale with ACU. He pitched the final 4-1/3 innings scattering four hits, striking out four and walking two. Taska has now gone 16-1/3 innings without allowing a run over six appearances. In the second game, he had Kingsville only hit of the game with a double to leadoff the fourth...The one-hit Kingsville has was the fewest since being one-hit by Incarnate Word during the 2008 season.

West Texas A&M

The West Texas A&M baseball team had a week of highs and lows as it posted a 12-0 win over Wayland Baptist in midweek play tossing a combined one-hitter for the first time this season...WT struggled going 1-3 against Tarleton State in the first weekend of home conference play as the Texans won 3-2 in nine innings to open the series, while the Buffs came back to win 5-4 in 10 innings in the nightcap, but Tarleton State took the final doubleheader which took two days as a severe wind came over the Panhandle late Saturday afternoon forcing the final 3.2 innings to be moved to Sunday afternoon...TSU won 6-2 in game three Saturday and 9-7 in the suspended game after leading 7-4 when the game was called in the bottom of the fifth...Junior Beto Rodriguez went 11 for 16 for the week as he hit .688 to lead the team...He had just four hits entering the week and went a career-best 4 for 4 against Wayland Baptist...The Buffs moved to 3-4 in one run games and 1-3 in extra-inning games.
