LSC SOFTBALL

After three weeks of Lone Star Conference play, West Texas A&M and Texas Woman's are tied atop the standing with 8-1 records, while Angelo State sits a game back at 7-2. The series to watch this week is WT at ASU.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 180-133 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 64-44 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 11-3 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Katie Hines, Texas Woman's University, JR, OF/P, Beaumont, Texas, West Brook HS

Hines led the team with five home runs, 13 RBI, 23 total bases and seven hits to help the Pioneers to a threegame sweep on the road at Cameron. She drove in the game-winning RBI in all three games and posted a .500 batting average, 1.643 slugging percentage and scored six runs. With five home runs over the weekend, Hines set a new TWU single-season home run record (14) with 16. She also picked up a win in the circle in game one after tossing 4.1 inning in relief. Hines currently leads LSC in RBI (51), home runs (16), slugging percentage (.924) and total bases (109), second in doubles (12), third in hits (49), seventh in runs (31) and tied for fifth in wins (9-2) and opponent batting average (.250).

PITCHER

Alberta Medina, Eastern New Mexico University, SR, Pitcher, Las Cruces, N.M., Las Cruces HS

Medina posted a 2.76 earned run average over four appearances last week and picked up wins over Oklahoma Panhandle and Incarnate Word. For the week, she limited the opposition to a .186 batting average, fanned 10 batters and walked just four. She also batted .400 for the week, with a four-for-five performance, three doubles and five RBIs in the finale against Incarnate Word.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Victoria Silva, University of the Incarnate Word, started the year on the bench, but has worked her way into the starting lineup and she had an unbelievable week for the Cardinals. She helped the team to a doubleheader sweep of NAIA #5 Oklahoma City. In the first game she walked, was hit by a pitch, scored a run and drove in a run in an 8-3 win. In the nightcap she was 2-for-3 with a double and a run scored in a 6-4 win. Over the weekend she went 5-for-7 with four walks, two runs and five RBI's at Eastern New Mexico. She cracked a grand slam in the series finale, a 16-14 loss. The Cards split the first two games of the series. She hit .636 with 8 RBI's and six walks during the week.

Kyra Sirag, Eastern New Mexico University, batted .588 with two doubles and five runs batted in, over five games, last week. On Friday, she drove a walk-off single to center field, off LSC earned-run-average leader Briana Sanchez, to help the Zias pick up a win over Incarnate Word. Sirag hit safely in four games, with a fourfor-five outing at Oklahoma Panhandle. Over the two wins against UIW, she batted five-for-seven, scored four runs and drove in three.

Jessica Sipe, West Texas A&M University, continued to lead the Lady Buffs at the plate as the top ranked team in the country swept the visiting Javelinas of Texas A&M-Kingsville at Schaeffer Park in Canyon to move to 24-2 (8-1 LSC) on the season. The Phoenix native hit .444 with one triple and two home runs for a slugging percentage of 1.333 while driving in 10 RBI in three games. Sipe connected on a pair of three run bombs on the weekend to extend her HR total to nine, which leads the Lady Buffs while also upping her RBI total to 43 RBI which also leads the team.

Carynn Gonzales, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, with a base hit in each game of the series, she extended her team-best, streak of reaching base safely in a game to 20 consecutive games. She surpassed Rose Stubbs' streak of 18 games in the process. Gonzales is now batting a second-best .311 on the season.

Melody Mayse, Tarleton State University, was pivotal in the leadoff spot for the TexAnns last week. The freshman led the team in hits (6), runs scored (4) and total bases (8) while leading the TexAnns to three wins in five games - including a series win at Abilene Christian last weekend. She also drove in the go-ahead run in the first game of the series against ACU.

Amber Spencer, West Texas A&M University, moved her overall record to 7-1 on the season this past weekend with a victory in game two of the #1 Lady Buffs' LSC series against Texas A&M-Kingsville at Schaeffer Park in Canyon. The Colorado Springs native registered a complete game shutout in the nightcap of Friday's doubleheader as she gave up just three hits with no walks and one strikeout in her 5.0 innings of work. Spencer is 7-1 on the season with a 2.58 ERA.

Brandi Lander, Texas Woman's University, posted two complete games victories to help the Pioneers to a three-game sweep on the road at Cameron. Under difficult weather conditions in Lawton, Okla., she tossed 14 innings and struck out 11 batters. Lander held the opposing batters to .214 average and allowed just four runs. On the season she leads the TWU pitching staff in ERA (2.10), wins (13), strike outs (82) and innings pitched (93.1). Lander is currently tied for second in LSC in wins, fifth in strikeouts and tied for third in complete games (10).

Brenna Hennan, Tarleton State University, was spectacular from the circle for Tarleton last week, earning two wins in both of her starts against St. Mary's and Abilene Christian. She led the team with a 2.76 ERA over 12.2 innings while striking out 16 batters in just under 13 innings.

Angelo State

ASU moved to 22-9 and 7-2 in the Lone Star Conference after taking two of three from No. 19 Midwestern State. The Rambelles are 10-2 on the road this season. Sandra Serna won her 13th game of the season on Thursday and is No. 2 in the LSC in shutouts with three. Kacie Easley is the ASU's leader in hitting with a .400 average. The Rambelles will host No. 1 West Texas A&M with the series starting on Thursday at 6 p.m.

Cameron

The Aggie softball team went 1-4 this week at home as they split a double header with Oklahoma Christian, winning 8-7 in the first game and falling 8-5 in game two. They also got swept in a home series against Texas Woman's, losing all three games (15-7, 9-2, and 10-2). The Aggies were led by freshman Sonora Zukerman, who was 6-17 with eight RBI's and two homers this week. Zukerman got most of this production in the first game with TWU, going 3-3, hitting two long balls, and driving in five runs. Additionally, Sonia Foutch had a solid week hitting the ball, going 7-16 with six RBI's. In the circle, CU's ace went 20.2 innings and struck out 16 in three starts this week. The Aggies are now 9-18 and 2-7 in conference games. They will host Southwestern Oklahoma State for a doubleheader on March 26.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University softball team posted a 3-2 record last week, after splitting a doubleheader at Oklahoma Panhandle and winning a Lone Star Conference series from Incarnate Word. Against the Cardinals, ENMU held a .376-.337 edge in hitting and did not allow a stolen base. Elizabeth Velasquez hit .636 with an .818 slugging percentage, while five players batted at least .400 for the weekend. This week, the Zias will visit Texas Woman's University.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 3-2 during the week winning a pair of games from NAIA #5 Oklahoma City before dropping 2-of-3 games on the road to Eastern New Mexico. In the series finale against the Zias, the team lost a 16-14 game. It was the most combined runs in a game in school history. Victoria Silva started the year on the bench, but has worked her way into the starting lineup and she had an unbelievable week for the Cardinals. She helped the team to a doubleheader sweep of NAIA #5 Oklahoma City. In the first game she walked, was hit by a pitch, scored a run and drove in a run in an 8-3 win. Midwestern State

Midwestern State suffered through a 1-3 week with a single loss to No. 16 Central Oklahoma last before dropping two of three to Angelo State over the weekend at Mustangs Park... MSU senior center fielder Elena Bennett suffered a broken leg while attempting to make a play on UCO's Brooke Zukerman's walkoff grand slam last Tuesday in Edmond... Bennett closes her career as the MSU's all-time leader in batting average (.396), runs scored (174), sacrifice hits (43) and stolen bases (124). She finishes five hits shy of Kristen Stonecipher's mark of 270 career hits... Midwestern State continues to lead the Lone Star Conference with a .383 team batting average... The Mustangs boast four of the top five hitters in the league including senior outfielder Elena Bennett (.523), sophomore third baseman Kelley Schaefer (.494), junior catcher Kim Jerrick (.468) and freshman designated player Katelyn Vinson (.441)... Schaefer hit .500 (6-for-12) at the plate including her seventh homer of the season Tuesday at Central Oklahoma... Schaefer has collected multiple hits in five of her last seven games and now has two-or-more hits in 15 games this season... Junior catcher Kim Jerrick failed to reach base for the first time this season in Friday night's 8-2 loss to Angelo State. The Belle Plaine, Kan. native had reached base in 45 consecutive games dating back to last season... Vinson launched her fourth homer of the season in Game 1 Saturday against Angelo State. She has collected 30 hits in her first 23 collegiate games... Freshman pitcher Laci Belovsky notched her fourth shutout of the season with a four-hit complete game win in Game 3 over Angelo State Sunday afternoon... Belovsky fanned 11 batters in an 8-2 loss to ASU Friday night... Belovsky leads the Lone Star Conference with 14 wins...

Tarleton State

Tarleton hosted St. Mary's for a non-conference doubleheader last Tuesday and split the games - dropping game one and winning a rain-shortened game two. The TexAnns then carried the momentum of the game two win into Abilene where they won the first two games of the series to claim the series win.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelina softball team returns Hubert Field to host Abilene Christian this Thursday and Friday. When the series opens it will have been 19 days since Kingsville played at home where they are 4-7...With LSC series against West Texas A&M, Texas Woman's and Tarleton State, the Javelinas have faced three of the top five teams in conference...With a base hit in each game of the series, Carynn Gonzales has extended her team-best, streak of reaching base safely in a game to 20 consecutive games. She surpassed Rose Stubbs' streak of 18 games in the process. Gonzales is now batting a second-best .311 on the season... Rose Stubbs recorded her sixth three-hit game of the season on Friday at West Texas. She has recorded 16 multi-hit games this season and is batting .477. She is on pace to finish her career as the all-time leading hitter in Javelina history.

Texas Woman's

The Pioneers swept the three-game series on the road at Cameron to improve their record 30-7 on

the season. TWU blasted 12 home runs as a team and outscored the Aggies 34-11. Junior Bailey Vrazel stole eight bases and set a new Lone Star Conference career steals record with 184. She passed Kim Nichols of Southeastern Oklahoma State, who compiled 182 steals from 1999-2003. Senior Jordan Readicker hit three home runs in the first game of the series to set a new TWU single-game record and tie the LSC record. She also led the team with five home runs, .600 batting average, 2.100 slugging percentage and .714 on base percentage. TWU junior Katie Hines was the team leader in home runs (5), RBI (13), total bases (23) and hits (7). Junior Brandie Lander posted two complete game victories while striking out 11 batters. The Pioneers as a team also hit a TWU single-game record six home runs in game-one.

West Texas A&M

The #1 Lady Buffs continued their hot start to the 2013 season this past weekend as they swept a Lone Star Conference series from the Javelinas of Texas A&M-Kingsville at Schaeffer Park in Canyon, Texas to move their overall record to 24-2 with an 8-1 mark in LSC play to sit in a tie for first place. WT used a pair of complete game shutouts by Hannah Newcomb and Amber Spencer on Friday night in Canyon as the Lady Buffs rolled to a pair of run-rule wins. Saturday's finale saw TAMUK take the early 2-0 lead but the potent WT offense scored 10 unanswered runs for the series sweep in a 10-2 victory in five innings. The Lady Buffs return to action on Tuesday as they head to Odessa, Texas for a doubleheader against UT-Permian Basin before traveling to San Angelo, Texas on Thursday for a three game LSC series against rival Angelo State.
