LSC BASEBALL

Non-conference games continue for Lone Star Conference baseball teams. Incarnate Word tops the standings with two defeats, followed by Texas A&M-Kingsville.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 80-41-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 4-3 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 28-8 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

John Zule, University of the Incarnate Word, SR, 2B, San Antonio, Texas, Stevens HS

Zule led the Cardinals to a 4-1 week by going 11-for-14 at the plate. He went 4-for-4 with three runs, an RBI, a double and a triple in a 10-9 win over No. 24 St. Edward's on Tuesday. He played in one game of a Thursday doubleheader at UH-Victoria and was 1-for-3. Over the weekend, he went 6-for-7 with four runs, four RBI's, three doubles, two walks and a stolen base in a doubleheader sweep at home of UH-Victoria. He is riding a 9-game hitting streak and raised his batting average from .280 to .462 over the week.

Alvaro Moreno, Tarleton State University, JR, 3B/DH, McAllen, Texas, McAllen HS

Moreno led the Texans with a .526 batting average over the weekend, collecting 10 hits in four games at the ACU/Whitten Inn Classic. The McAllen native drove in a team-high eight runs and scored two runs as well. The junior also collected a pair of steals in three attempts.

PITCHERS

Bryce Zak, Angelo State University, JR, RHP, San Angelo, Texas, San Angelo Central HS

Zak continues to baffle hitters and moved to 3-0 on the season with a scoreless six-inning outing in Monday's 2-0 win for Angelo State over Bellarmine. Zak struck out seven batters in the game and didn't allow a walk or a runner to advance to third base in the game. He has now thrown 15 straight scoreless innings for the Rams.

Carter Hahn, Abilene Christian University, SR, Right-Hand Pitcher, San Antonio, Texas

Hahn improved to 3-0 through four starts after pitching the Wildcats to a 8-2 win over Cameron during the final day of ACU's Whitten Inn Classic. Hahn lasted 7.1 innings (90 pitches) and struck out five, raising his season total to 33. He also walked just one batter and scattered six hits before being relieved in the eighth by Brady Rodriguez. Hahn faced the minimum three batters on three occasions and twice was helped by the double play. And until the eighth, he had stranded four runners with none advancing past second base. Hahn's season ERA is tops among ACU starters at 2.30.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Ryan Greer, Angelo State University, led Angelo State with three hits in the Rams' 4-0 win over Bellarmine on Monday at Foster Field. Greer, who is now hitting .345 on the season, had three of the six ASU hits on the night. Greer has 20 hits through the first 16 games of his senior season.

Rafael Romo, Eastern New Mexico University, drove in a team-high five runs as Eastern New Mexico competed in the Whitten Inn Classic in Abilene, Texas. Romo batted .636 with two runs scored in three games. In the first game versus Abilene Christian, he was 1-for-2 at the plate and drove in two of the Greyhounds three runs. Romo then went 3-for-5 against Tarleton State with a RBI and run scored. He finished the weekend by going 3-for-4 at the plate with two runs driven in and scoring once versus Cameron.

Matt Redfearn, West Texas A&M University, went 3 for 7 for the Buffs in two starts at shortstop against Lubbock Christian. Had one of back-to-back home runs against the Chaps in Sunday's home contest. He scored three runs and tallied two RBI. He had four put outs with five assists and no errors.

Travis Schuetze, Abilene Christian University, extended his season-long reached base streak to 16 and hitting streak to eight following a 4-for-11 weekend at ACU's Whitten Inn Classic. The Wildcats went 2-1 this week as they followed a loss to Tarleton State with victories vs. Eastern New Mexico and Cameron. Schuetze is now batting .449 on the season and leads the team in hits with 22 and doubles with six. After going 1-for-2 vs. the Texans, Schuetze reached base four times and drove in three vs. the Greyhounds in an 18-3 win, and against the Aggies recorded an RBI single.

Geno Encina, University of the Incarnate Word, won his third straight starting appearance with a 12-1 win at UH-Victoria on Thursday. He scattered five hits and two walks in 7.0 innings and did not allow a run until the sixth inning. He struck out seven batters and now has struck out 24 while walking only four batters on the season.

Angelo State

The Rams were off last weekend and earned a 4-0 non-conference win over Bellarmine on Monday night at Foster Field in the first of a two-game set between the two teams. Angelo State received great pitching from starter Bryce Zak (3-0) who threw six scoreless innings before Mike Weatherly and Austin Church came into the game to preserve the shutout. Weatherly and Church each recorded two strikeouts each in their appearances. Ryan Greer led the Rams with three hits, while Reggie Rodriguez hit his third home run of the season with a solo shot to left-center field and Tyler Coughenour had two RBI. The Rams and Knights finish the set at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday.

Cameron

The Aggies went 1-2 last weekend in the ACU Tournament. Cameron lost Fri. March 1 to Tarleton State (9-6) and the next day to host Abilene Christian (8-2). On the final day of the tournament though, the Aggies picked up a win against Eastern New Mexico (14-8). The Aggies were led on offense by Brandon Raidy, Kaz Sanders, and Brad Blumer. Raidy went 5-12 on the weekend, with 5 runs and an RBI. Sanders went 4-12 with 4 runs and 2 RBI's. Blumer also went 4-12, and had 2 runs and 4 RBI's. Next for Cameron is a seven inning double-header against Panhandle State on March 6 in Goodwell, Ok.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico played three games in the Whitten Inn Classic hosted by Abilene Christian and dropped all three contests. The Greyhounds fell to the host Wildcats 18-3 in seven innings, 7-5 to Tarleton State and 14-8 to Cameron. Junior second baseman Colton Sims extended his hitting streak to 16 games and finished the Classic with a .727 batting average while scoring thrice and driving in two runs. Fellow classmate Rafael Romo hit .636 with a team-best five RBI. Seniors Daniel Binz and Luis Quinones both stole a base as well. On the mound, senior Jaspreet Shergill saw action in two games out of the bullpen and did not allow a run in 2.1 innings while striking out three. Junior Kyle Kesmarki had a strike out in one scoreless-inning of work versus the Aggies. The Greyhounds only play once this week, a road game at the University of the Southwest on Wednesday afternoon.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 4-1 last week. They defeated #24 St. Edward's 10-9 on Tuesday. They split a doubleheader at UH-Victoria on Thursday losing 3-2 and winning 12-1. On Saturday, they swept a doubleheader at home against UH-V, 4-2 and 15-7. UIW is ranked #2 in the region and continues to move up in the national polls. They are #12 in Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, #14 in d2baseballnews.com and #23 in College Baseball Lineup. They were #15 in the NCBWA poll last week. Tarleton State

The Texans went 4-0 at the ACU/Whitten Inn Classic over the weekend, collecting non-conference wins over ACU, Cameron and ENMU... The Texans met Bellarmine for the first time in school history on Sunday and defeated the Knights 10-7 on Sunday... The Texans combined to hit .394 as a team in the four games in Abilene, totaling 52 hits and scoring 42 runs... Pete Perez, Miguel Ramirez and Matt Buckmaster each got wins in their starts over the weekend, while Garrett Kelly notched Sunday's win in a relief effort... The four-game win streak is the longest of the season so far... The Texans will face McMurry in non-conference action on Tuesday and will then be off for 10 days before returning to action next Friday, Mar. 15 to host ENMU for its first LSC series of the season.
