LSC SOFTBALL

Lone Star Conference action starts this week. West Texas A&M tops the standings at 14-1, with six other teams posting double-digit win totals as well.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 114-74 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 50-32 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 11-3 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER

Haley Colwell, Texas Woman's University, JR, OF, Sadler, Texas, S&S Consolidated

Colwell became the sixth player in NCAA history and third player in Division II to hit two grand slams in the same inning. She hit her first and second home runs of the season in the third inning against Northeastern State on Monday, Mar. 4 and helped the Pioneers to a perfect 5-0 record during the week. Colwell recorded .500 batting average, six runs, 10 RBI, .929 slugging percentage and .562 on base percentage for the week. On the season she batting .388 with 18 RBI and 12 runs.

PITCHER

Kat Batey, Midwestern State University, FR, Pitcher, Plano, Texas, Plano HS

Batey hurled the fourth perfect game in school history by retiring each of the 15 batters she faced in a 9-0 win over Oklahoma Panhandle State on Sunday. The freshman from Plano allowed eight hits in a 11 innings over two starts which also including a 13-5 run-rule win over Northeastern State. Batey posted 10 strikeouts and three walks while holding the opposition to a .200 batting average.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Courtney Bingham, Midwestern State University, bashed five doubles and a triple driving in 14 runs while hitting .667 (10-of-15) to lead Midwestern State to a perfect 5-0 showing at the Courtyard by Marriott Invitational over the weekend at Mustangs Park. The senior from Arlington extended her hitting streak to 11 games contributing four multiple-hit games over the weekend driving in at least four runs in three of the five contests. Bingham is hitting .556 (20-for-36) during the streak with six doubles, two triples and 20 RBIs.

Rachel Moore, Angelo State University, led the Rambelles in hitting this past weekend with a .667 average. She recorded four hits, five RBI's and a .667 slugging percentage. She extended ASU's one-run lead in game one with a single up the middle that scored two runs in the seventh to secure the victory. The sophomore went three-for-three in game two scoring two RBI's. Moore is hitting .414 for the season and is third on the team with 11 RBI's.

Rose Stubbs, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, batted .615 going 8-of-13 at the plate in the team's four wins. She drove in three runs and scored five to lead the team. She had two walks as well for a .667 on-base percentage. She was 6-of-6 at the plate in the doubleheader with Huston-Tillotson with four runs scored.

Keanna Winkfield, Abilene Christian University, led the Wildcats with a .500 average during ACU's 3-2 weekend at the Midwestern State Invitational. She went 8-for-16 with four runs, three extra-base hits with two triples and four RBI. She also provided three sacrifice hits. Winkfield started the week going 2-for-4 with a season high four RBI in a shortened 10-2 win vs. Oklahoma Panhandle. She then scored the game's first run in a 3-1 win over Emporia State and pushed an insurance run into scoring position with a sacrifice bunt. Later in the week, she provided a seventh-inning hit to keep the inning alive in a 2-1 win over Northeastern State. The Wildcats pushed their go-ahead run across the plate on the very next at-bat.

Elizabeth Velasquez, Eastern New Mexico University, hit safely in all four games, last week, with extra base hits in all but one. She batted three-for-three with two runs, two RBIs, a double and a walk in a win over Texas-Permian Basin. She also hit two-for-four with two doubles, in Eastern's second-ever win over St. Edwards. Four of Velasquez's seven hits went for doubles, and she didn't strike out in 14 at bats.

Arianna Rodriguez, Tarleton State University, was the table-setter for the TexAnn offense in a doubleheader against Oklahoma Christian last weekend. In a rescheduled DH against the Eagles, Rodriguez went 3-6 in two games with a walk, a double, three runs scored, one driven in and a .571 on-base percentage which led to a perfect 3-3 weekend stealing bases.

Alyssa Lemos, West Texas A&M University, highlighted a 4-0 weekend by the #3 Lady Buffs as she hit .600 with two doubles, one triple and two home runs to drive in 9 RBI for a slugging percentage of 1.600. Lemos hit her third and fourth homeruns of the season in the opening game of a doubleheader against UT-Permian Basin on Saturday afternoon in Canyon as she drove in three runs on the game.

Brenna Hennen, Tarleton State University, was spectacular from the circle in the second game of a Saturday doubleheader against Oklahoma Christian. The sophomore from Burkburnett tossed her second complete game shutout of the season, blanking the Eagles for seven innings en route to a 7-0 Tarleton win. Hennen kept Oklahoma Christian off balance all day, holding them to just a .192 hitting percentage in the outing and

allowing just five hits and four walks while striking out a career-high 10.

Katie Hines, Texas Woman's University, picked up three of TWU's five wins last week and improved her season record to 7-1. She struck out 10 batters while allowing just one run in 13.1 innings. Hines tossed 2.1 hitless innings in relief in a come from behind win against Oklahoma Christian on Feb. 26 and then pitched 4.0 shutout innings in relief in another come from behind win against St. Mary's on Feb. 28. She also earned a complete-game win against Northeastern State on Mar. 4. Hines also contributed on offense with .563 batting average, 8 RBI, 2 home runs, 2 doubles, 6 runs, 1.063 slugging percentage and .611 on base percentage. On the season she is the leader on both offense and pitching with .431 batting average, 29 RBI, 7 home runs, 1.62 EAR and 7-1 record.

Katrissha Arocha, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, was 2-0 on the mound with complete game wins over Houston-Victoria and Huston-Tillotson. In 12 innings the sophomore transfer allowed one run on nine hits. She had 11 strikeouts, while walking just three. Opposing batters hit just .209 against the sophomore. With the two wins she moved to 5-5 on the season.

Shelby Hall, Abilene Christian University, won both her starts this week at the Midwestern State Invitational, improving her season record to an impressive 5-1 and lowering her ERA to 0.98. Hall made her first start vs. Oklahoma Panhandle and pitched all 5.0 innings of a shortened 10-2 game. She retired the six first batters she faced before running into a little bit of trouble in the third and fourth innings; however, she escaped a bases loaded fourth-inning jam with a 3-2 fielder's choice and fly ball to center. Hall started again in a 2-1 win vs. Northeastern State, and after giving up the run in the first, she retired 21 of the next 24 batters. She also retired NE State in order in the 3rd, 5th and 6th innings.

Alberta Medina, Eastern New Mexico University, struck out eight batters last week, over 10 innings of work, without allowing a walk. She held the opposition to a team-best .282 batting average and earned a save against Texas-Permian Basin after 1.1 innings of shutout relief. At the plate, two of Medina's three hits left the park, as she drove in six runs.

Angelo State

The Rambelles moved its record to 13-5 on the season after winning two games at home against Texas A&M International. ASU hit .429 as a team over the weekend scoring 17 RBI's and 19 runs. Rachel Moore led the Rambelles with a .667 average with four hits and five RBI's. Sandra Serna and Mary Kate McKay both earned wins. Morgan Spearman is the team's leading hitter with a .472 average and a .774 slugging percentage. Serna has an 8-2 overall record with a 2.39 earned-run average.

Cameron

Cameron split its weekend games with USAO this weekend; 12-0, 1-2. Sonora Zukerman got things going offensively for the Aggies with a solo home run in the second inning. Cameron kept up the momentum for the rest of the game. The Aggies had a big fifth inning: scoring six runs, including a grand slam by Leslie Martini. Pitcher Samantha Betts pitched a one-hitter to get her fourth win of the year. In the next game, Cameron took an early 1-0 lead,

but both teams would go scoreless until the bottom of the fifth. USAO tied it up 1-1 with an unearned run off of a single. Then in the bottom of the sixth, the Drovers would knock in the go ahead run with a double to take the lead 2-1, and eventually get the win. Leslie Martini went 2-8 on the day, and had 1 run and 5 RBI's. Her sister Tara went 3-6, and had 4 RBI's and a run. Next for the Aggies will be a double-header against Southwestern Oklahoma St. on March 6 in Weatherford, Ok.

Eastern New Mexico

The Zias continued their home stand last week and split double headers with Texas-Permian Basin and St. Edwards. Eastern's record for the current homestand is 4-4, which included a sweep of Oklahoma Panhandle. In Eastern's win over UTPB, they drew nine walks. The Zias 13 runs in the fourth inning marked the first time Eastern reached double figures in an inning since February 9, 2008. Saturday's win over defending Heartland Conference Champion, St. Edwards. This week, ENMU will conclude its home stand, with the Lone Star Conference opening series, against Midwestern State.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals have been off since February 16, but are back in action this week. They host St. Edward's in a doubleheader on Wednesday and then travel to Abilene Christian for the opening weekend of conference play.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State swept five games at the Courtyard by Marriott Invitational claiming two wins over Northeastern State and single victories over No. 13 Emporia State, St. Mary's and Oklahoma Panhandle State... The Mustangs posted four consecutive run-rule victories and now have seven on the season... MSU leads the Lone Star Conference with an impressive .403 team batting average through 20 games with a 1.016 OPS (on-base + slugging)... The Mustangs have slugged out 10-or-more hits in each of their last six games and in 13 of 20 games this season... Midwestern boast three of the top five hitters in the LSC including league leader Elena Bennett (.541), Kim Jerrick (.538) and Kelley Schaefer (.474) while Courtney Bingham (.426) and Shelby Carter (.382) give the Mustangs five in the Top 15... Junior catcher Kim Jerrick leads the LSC in hits (35), runs scored (30), RBIs (27), home runs (7) and total bases (65) and is second with nine doubles... Jerrick is tied for the program's all-time lead in home runs with former All Americans Mallory Mooney and Kristen Stonecipher as she slugged her 28th homer to lead off the Northeastern State game on Sunday... Sophomore third baseman Kelley Schaefer is tied with Jerrick for the LSC RBI lead with 27 while senior Elena Bennett leads the league with 21 stolen bases... Freshman pitcher Laci Belovsky hurled the fifth no-hitter in program history in an 8-0 run-rule win in five innings on Saturday night and followed with her third shutout of the season in a three-hit 14-0 win over Northeastern State on Sunday... Freshman pitcher Kat Batey spun the fourth perfect game in school history in a 9-0 win over Oklahoma Panhandle State on Sunday. It was her second shutout of the season... Midwestern hit .481 as a team during the five-game Courtyard by Marriott Invitational as six hitters contributed .500-or-better averages including freshman Katelyn Vinson (.692), senior Courtney Bingham (.667), senior Elena Bennett (.600), freshman Shelby Carter (.538), junior Kim Jerrick (.500) and sophomore Kelley Schaefer (.500)...

Tarleton State

After weather conditions forced the TexAnn's to alter their weekend plans, Tarleton stayed home and hosted Oklahoma Christian for a Saturday afternoon doubleheader. The TexAnn pitching was masterful as Randi Fentress flirted with perfection in the first game, going 5 2/3 perfect innings and ultimately winning the game 6-2 after Amber Clifford's first career grand slam put the game out of reach. In the second game, Brenna Hennen followed suit by throwing a complete game shutout with a career-high 10 strikeouts.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas hit .356 as a team last week and outscored Huston-Tillotson 25-1...In four games last week Rose Stubbs batted .615 going 8-of-13 at the plate in the team's four wins. She drove in three runs and scored five to lead the team. She had two walks as well for a .667 on-base percentage. She was 6-of-6 at the plate in the doubleheader with Huston-Tillotson with four runs scored...Three other Javelina starters hit over .400 for the week. Carynn Gonzales batted .462 with five RBI and three runs scored and a steal. Adela Gomez proved the power on the weekend with two home runs and now leads the team with three. ...Katrissha Arocha was 2-0 on the mound with complete game wins over Houston-Victoria and Huston-Tillotson. In 12 innings the sophomore transfer allowed one run on nine hits. She had 11 strikeouts, while walking just three. Opposing batters hit just .209 against the sophomore. With the two wins she moved to 5-5 on the season. Denise Arnold went 2-0 in 11 innings holding opponents to a .220 average and allowing a 1.27 ERA. She struck out 10 in 11 innings of work. Both Arocha and Arnold each moved to 5-5 on the season. The three Javelina pitchers had a combined 0.88 ERA.

Texas Woman's

The Pioneers won all five games last week to improve their record to 18-5 on the season and extended their win streak to eight games. Junior Haley Colwell became the sixth player in NCAA (DI, DII and DIII) history to hit two grand slams in the same inning. She is third player in Division II to accomplish the feat and first since Tatiana Casis of Saint Leo did it four years ago on March 4, 2009. In the second game of the doubleheader against Northeastern State on Monday, Mar. 4, TWU sent 17 batters to the plate in the third inning and scored 14 runs highlighted by four home runs. Senior Jordan Readicker led the Pioneers with a .667 batting average while Colwell drove in 10 runs. Junior Katie Hines also batted .563 with eight RBI and six runs. She also picked up three wins in the circle with a 0.53 ERA and 10 strikeouts. On the season Hines leads the team on both offense and pitching with .431 batting average, 29 RBI, 7 home runs, 1.62 EAR and 7-1 record. Junior Brandie Lander also has a 7-2 record with a 1.85 ERA and a team-best 49 strikeouts. The Pioneers as a team were perfect 14-for-14 in stolen bases in the five games last week.

West Texas A&M

The #3 Lady Buffs went 4-0 this past weekend as they swept doubleheaders against UT-Permian Basin and St. Edward's at Schaeffer Park in Canyon, Texas. The Lady Buffs hit an impressive 10 homeruns on the weekend including a rare feat in the finale against St. Edward's when Lacey Seidl and Mercedes Garcia connected on back-to-back inside the park homeruns in a five run third inning in a 14-9 win.
