LSC BASEBALL

Tarleton State and Abilene Christian remain on top of the Lone Star Conference standings with identical 9-3 league records. The Texans split with Texas A&M-Kingsville and the Wildcats won three of four versus Eastern New Mexico last week.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 146-101-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 10-8 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 29-9 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Alvaro Moreno, Tarleton State University, JR, 3B, McAllen, Texas, McAllen HS

Moreno had the highest batting average of any player in Tarleton's series against Kingsville as he hit .571, collecting eight hits in 14 trips to the plate. He walked twice and finished the weekend with a .625 on-base percentage as well. Moreno drove in a run and scored two runs to help the Texans move to 9-3 in LSC play and stay in first-place for a third straight week.

Kyle Conwell, Abilene Christian University, SR, LF, Renton, Wash., Tahoma Senior HS

Conwell tied an Abilene Christian and Lone Star Conference single-game record this weekend after crushing three home runs to lead the Wildcats to a 5-4 victory over Eastern New Mexico Friday night at Crutcher Scott Field. Conwell helped ACU sweep that evening's doubleheader and ultimately take 3 of 4 from the Greyhounds. ACU has won its first three LSC series and remains tied for first in the conference at 9-3. Prior to Conwell, the last and only other Wildcat to hit three HR in a game was Joel Wells, who did it against Tarleton State in 2006. Conwell's home runs were his first three of the season and all sailed over the wall in left field. The Renton, Wash., native hit his first two home runs off Brian Kennedy in the fourth and fifth innings to pull the Wildcats within a run at 4-3. And then in his final at-bat leading off the seventh inning, he clubbed a walk-off shot vs. reliever Dylan Montano (0-1) on a 3-2 pitch. Conwell's dramatic blast was ACU's first walk-off home run since 2008 (Mike Elkerson vs. East Central).

PITCHERS

Dylan James, West Texas A&M University, JR, RHP, Las Cruces, N.M., Mayfield HS

Had a masterful game as he tossed a complete game, two-hitter along with a career, school-record and LSC season-high 14 strikeouts topping his previous best of 13 set earlier this season. James' performance helped lead the Buffs to a 3-1 win for just the second win at Angelo State in school history. It was his first win of the season (1-1) and WT career as he lowered his ERA to 2.86. He has a team-high 46 strikeouts on the year in six starts with two complete games. The opposition is hitting just .175 against him.

Dallas Ponder, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, RHP, Flatonia, Texas, Flatonia HS

Ponder threw his second complete game shutout of the season in the series opener with league-leader Tarleton State. It was the fourth start on the year by Ponder in which the Javelinas shutout an opponent. He allowed just two runners into scoring position the entire evening.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Zac Russell, University of the Incarnate Word, led the Cardinals to a four-game sweep of visiting Cameron. He got the weekend started on the right foot by going 2-for-2 with two runs and a three-run homer in an opening 12-0 victory. In the nightcap he was 2-for-4 with a triple in a 6-4 win. On Saturday, he went 2-for-3 with a double, run scored and an RBI in a 6-4 win in the first game. In the finale, he was 0-for-3, but reached base via hit by pitch in a 3-2 win. He batted .500 for the week with a 1.000 slugging percentage and did not commit an error in 29 chances.

Quaid McKinnon, Angelo State University, continues to be one of the most consistent hitters in the conference after hitting .400 with three doubles last weekend against West Texas A&M at Foster Field. McKinnon, who is hitting .354 on the season with 26 walks, also scored four runs against the Buffs. The senior has 40 hits this season, including 11 doubles.

Taylor Taska, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, had another solid week at the plate. He opened the series going 2-of-3 with a triple, run scored and an RBI. In the second game, he not only earned the win as the starting pitcher tossing six scoreless innings, but he was 1-of-4 with a double and a run scored. In the series finale he went 3-of-5 with three RBI, two home runs and two runs scored. It was the first time since April 14 a year ago that a Javelina hit two home runs in a single game.

Dylan Boss, University of the Incarnate Word, was at his best this weekend against Cameron. He started Game 1 of a four game series sweep. Jake Feckley, Angelo State University, struck out seven and threw his second complete game of the season in Angelo State's 7-3 win last weekend against West Texas A&M. Feckley scattered six hits in the first game of Friday's doubleheader to improve to 5-3 on the season. The junior has now struck out 39 in 38 innings of work and has a 2.61 ERA on the season.

The Rams split their series last weekend against West Texas A&M at Foster Field after winning the first two games and then dropping the final two. ASU is now 6-6 in conference play. The Rams hit .298 against the Buffs in the series with Quaid McKinnon hitting .400 and Hunter Choate hitting .385 with five hits to lead the way. Lee Neumann added five hits and two RBI, while Andrew LaCombe led the team with four RBI on three hits. Jake Feckley and Bryant Rutledge earned wins on the mound with Feckley striking out seven in a complete-game victory, while Rutledge earned his win in relief of starter Mike Weatherly in the series opener. Weatherly struck out six in 6.2 innings in the no-decision. Christian Summers and Tyler Coughenour each had four hits in the series. ASU plays at St. Mary's on Tuesday in a single game before traveling to Eastern New Mexico this weekend.

Cameron

The Cameron baseball team was swept by Incarnate Word in San Antonio this last weekend as the Aggies have dropped their last ten games in a row. Cameron had their chances in three of the games but either failed to hold a lead or get a clutch hit. Keaton Green led the Ags with a .400 batting average in 15 at bats; Nick Smith went .385 with five runs scored, and a homer. The Aggies will host a four game series with Texas A&M Kingsville starting on April 5.

The Cardinals went 4-0 last weekend against Cameron. They outscored the Aggies 27-10 in the series and got back to .500 in conference play for the year. Senior catch Zac Russell led the Cardinals to a four-game sweep of visiting Cameron. He got the weekend started on the right foot by going 2-for-2 with two runs and a three-run homer in an opening 12-0 victory. In the nightcap he was 2-for-4 with a triple in a 6-4 win. On Saturday, he went 2-for-3 with a double, run scored and an RBI in a 6-4 win in the first game. In the finale, he was 0-for-3, but reached base via hit by pitch in a 3-2 win. He batted .500 for the week with a 1.000 slugging percentage and did not commit an error in 29 chances. Dylan Boss was at his best this weekend against Cameron. Derrick Walls scored five times, walked six times and stole five bases. He leads the conference in all three categories with 41 runs, 35 walks and 28 stolen bases.

Tarleton State

The Texans salvaged a split series at Texas A&M-Kingsville this weekend, picking up a pair of wins in Friday's doubleheader after dropping both games to the Javelinas on Thursday... Tarleton finished the weekend hitting .314 with five doubles, a triple and one home run... The pitching staff had a combined 4.80 earned run average on the weekend, but tallied 28 strikeouts and limited TAMUK hitters to just a .291 batting average over the four games... Alvaro Moreno led the Texans at the plate this weekend as he hit .571 win an RBI and two runs scored... Colten Boothe led the team with three doubles and Rustin Thomas had Tarleton's lone home run of the weekend... Garrett Kelly and Kody Thiebaud both picked up wins in relief for the Texans... Kelly gave up just two hits and struck out six batters in 4.1 innings of his two appearances... Tarleton's Ryan Small was named the South Central Region's player of the week by the NCWBA last week... The Texans return back to Cecil Ballow Baseball Complex this weekend, hosting Incarnate Word in a four-game set that begins on Friday in Stephenville.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

Taylor Taska had another solid week at the plate. He opened the series going 2-of-3 with a triple, run scored and an RBI. In the second game, he not only earned the win as the starting pitcher tossing six scoreless innings, but he was 1-of-4 with a double and a run scored. In the series finale he went 3-of-5 with three RBI, two home runs and two runs scored. It was the first time since April 14 a year ago what a Javelina hit two home runs in a single game...Ponder threw his second complete game shutout of the season in the series opener with league-

leader Tarleton State. It was the fourth start on the year by Ponder in which the Javelinas shutout an opponent. He allowed just two runners into scoring position the entire evening...With Ponder's shutout in the series opener, Kingsville has now posted seven shutouts this season breaking the prior school record of six set twice during the 1990s. With the seven shutouts, the Javelina pitching staff has been able to post a miniscule 3.21 ERA which is well below the 3.62 ERA school record which has been set twice most recently last year. Ponder is one shutout shy of the single-season record set in 1994 by Noe Ramos...In three games behind the plate over the weekend, catcher Cash Barker threw out six of eight would be base stealers. Offensively, Barker, who was moved to No. 2 in the order over the weekend, had a team-best three multi-hit games while hitting .467 for the weekend. Matt Perez hit a team-best .500 for the week including the first home run of his career as a Javelina... The loss in the series finale with Tarleton marked the first time that the Javelinas lost a game when leading after seven innings and just the second when ahead after six complete games.

West Texas A&M

The West Texas A&M baseball team earned its first split at Angelo State this past week winning the final two games of the four-game set...The Buffs won 3-1 in the nightcap on Friday and closed with a dominating 14-3, run-ruled game Saturday...In the 3-1 win, junior pitcher Dylan James recorded his first win of the season (1-1) and second complete game with a career-best, school record and LSC season-high 14 strikeouts as the Buffs tallied just their second win in school history in San Angelo...His 14 K's topped his previous school and career-best and LSC season-high 13 set earlier in the year...WT senior Justin Henderson tallied his first career home run against Angelo State...The 14 runs given up by the Rams were the fourth-most this season...ASU tallied seven errors in the game.
