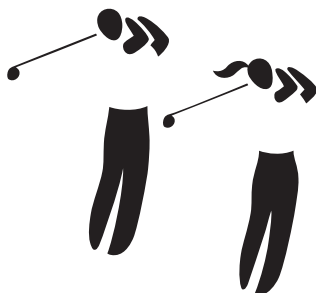

GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S

Alex Carpenter, Abilene Christian University, SR, Little Rock, Ark., Arkansas Baptist HS

Carpenter added to his growing legend earlier this week when the ACU senior fired a 2-under-par 70 to win the individual medalist title at the Dallas Baptist Classic, the record 20th NCAA victory of his unmatched career. Carpenter -- playing in the final regular-season invitational of his career -- fired a three-round total of 6-under-par 210 over the par-72, 6,964-yard Hackberry Country Club. He shot rounds of 69-71 on Monday and followed it with Tuesday's closing-round 70 to finish five shots in front of runner-up Trey Lawson of Cameron (three-round total of 215). Carpenter is believed to hold the NCAA career record for individual collegiate wins, having surpassed the previous record of 16 set by Phil Mickelson from 1989-92. Carpenter dominated the longer holes on the Hackberry course, finishing an amazing 11-under-par on the par-5s during the tournament. He also carded 14 birdies, the second-best total in the tournament, and his average of 4.13 on the par-4s was the best in the field.

WOMEN'S

Jessica Pickwick, Tarleton State University, SO, Kilmore, Australia, Broodford Secondary School

Pickwick fired off her best two rounds of golf all year on her way to earning her first individual title and guiding the TexAnns to a first place finish at the Doc Housewright Invitational. The native Australian posted season-low rounds of 73 on both Monday and Tuesday to finish 2-over-par and two strokes ahead of her next competitor in the tournament. Pickwick now has finished in the top-10 in all eight tournaments this season. She heads into next week's LSC Championship averaging 75.01 strokes per round.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Trey Lawson, Cameron University, posted his best career finish at the DBU Classic placing second with a three round score of 215 (73-72-70). Lawson for the season has had three top-5 finishes, and five top-10 finishes for the Aggies. In 21 rounds played during the 2012-13 season Lawson is averaging a 73.47 score.

Abby Bobo, Angelo State University, finished in a tie for third place at Tarleton State's Doc Housewright Invitational at Harbor Lakes in Granbury after shooting 152 (75-77). The top-5 finish was the second of the season and career for the sophomore.

The Rambelles finished cut 14 strokes off their first round and finished third by shooting a 305 team total in the final round of Tarleton State's Doc Housewright Invitational at Harbor Lakes in Granbury for their best showing of the regular season. Abby Bobo led the team with a third place finish, while Courtney Rutledge finished in a tie for 12th. Maury McCormick was 20th after shooting 81-78-159. Sophomore Ashley Bartholomew finished 24th after carding a final round 73 which cut 15 strokes off her first round.

Incarnate Word

The University of the Incarnate Word women's golf team finished in sixth place at the CenturyLink Doc Housewright Invitational hosted by Tarleton State University at the Harbor Lakes Golf Course on Monday and Tuesday. The Cardinals carded rounds of 317 and 322 on the par-72 course for a 639 total. Junior Flower Castillo (San Antonio/Lee HS) was the only Cardinals player to post a final round in the 70s and finished with a 76-77=153 total. She ended up in a tie for sixth place. Senior Jessica Cornish (San Antonio/Randolph HS) finished as the team's No. 2 golfer with a 79-82=161 showing to take 24th place. Samantha Martinez (San Antonio/Southside HS) had the second lowest round of the day for the Cardinals with an 80 and finished with a 164 total. The UIW men's team was off and both teams will be competing at the LSC Championships next week.

The No. 4-ranked TexAnns wrapped up regular-season tournament play with a first place win at the Doc Housewright Invitational, which was held at Harbor Lakes Golf Club in Granbury... Sophomore Jessica Pickwick earned her first-career individual title shooting a season-low 73 in both rounds on the way to a 2-over-par performance... The TexAnns led No. 3-ranked St. Edward's by just four strokes going into the Tuesday's final round before carding a 301... St. Edward's finished with a 302 on Tuesday... The TexAnns have three first place wins on the year and finished at least third in all eight events... Tarleton will now prepare for the upcoming LSC Championships... The TexAnns enter play next Monday in Fort Worth as the five-time defending LSC Champion.
