#### LSC BASEBALL

Tarleton State and Abilene Christian lead the Lone Star Conference standings with two weeks remaining in the regular season. The Texans split with Angelo State last week, while the Wildcats took three of four from Cameron

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The top six teams qualify for the championship to be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 183-134-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 13-9 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 29-9 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

#### DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### HITTERS

#### Derrick Walls, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, SS, San Antonio, Texas, Reagan HS

Walls led the Cardinals to a 4-1 week, including a series sweep over visiting Eastern New Mexico. He had a pair of 3-hit games and 2-hit games. He was 3-for-4 with two runs, two walks, an RBI and a stolen base in a 7-6 loss to St. Edward's. In the opener against ENMU, he went 3-for-4 with three runs, a double and a stolen base in a 13-1 win. He was 2-for-4 with two runs, a double and a stolen base in a 10-1 win in the second game. In the finale, he was 2-of-6 with a double and a RBI in a 6-5 win. He hit .476, scored eight runs and had three stolen bases in the week.

# Quaid McKinnon, Angelo State University, SR, First base, Phoenix, Ariz., Arcadia HS

McKinnon hit three home runs and finished last week with a .895 slugging percentage for the Rams who went 3-2 in their final home stand of the season. McKinnon, who hit .368 during the week, is now hitting .333 on the season with 21 RBI. The senior had seven hits last week and 35 for the season. His three home runs last week were the first three of the season with two coming against Tarleton State following one against McMurry.

#### **PITCHERS**

#### Dallas Ponder, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, P, Flatonia, Texas, Flatonia HS

Ponder tied a pair of Kingsville school records on Friday when he pitched his third shutout of the season and third of his career versus West Texas A&M. Ponder threw nine innings of two-hit baseball for the 1-0 victory. His 12 strikeouts tied his career best set earlier this season against Fisher College. He now has the lowest ERA in school history when tossing 50 innings or more at 1.76 and also is the only Javelina to hold opposing hitters below .200 at the plate. He is limiting opposing hitters to .197.

# Jake Feckley, Angelo State University, JR, RHP, Wylie, Texas, Wylie HS

Feckley shut down Tarleton State in a one-hit complete game win in the first game of last Saturday's doubleheader. Feckley (7-3) struck out five and held the Texans to a .045 batting average in the 1-0 win. The junior has now struck out 48 batters in 52 innings this season and has a 2.42 ERA through seven starts and 14 appearances.

## Drew Reidt, Cameron University, JR, RHP, Gray Summit, Mo., St. Louis CC

Reidt earned his second career win for Cameron tossing a complete game shutout on Friday night against Abilene Christian. Reidt only needed 101 pitches and allowed six singles and only one base runner getting as far as third. He also struck out a pair of Wildcat hitters in the 8-0 win. For the season Reidt has 3.38 ERA in ten starts for the Aggies.

## **OTHER TOP PERFORMERS**

Patrick Ramirez, West Texas A&M University, hit .538 and tied for the team-high seven hits for the week as the Buffs went 3-2. He slugged .923 and reached base at a .571 clip, while scoring three runs and tallying five RBI. He had 16 put outs in 21 chances with no errors and went gunned down one of three attempted steals behind the dish. Had a three-run home run which broke a 13-13 game at Wayland Baptist giving the Buffs the lead for good in a 20-13 win Tuesday.

Matt Perez, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, hit .455 as a senior going 5-of-11 with a pair of doubles in the series with West Texas A&M. He had a .636 slugging percentage and a .538 on-base percentage. Perez shared the team lead in RBI with three and runs scored with three.

Travis Schuetze, Abilene Christian University, was ACU's most consistent hitter this past weekend for the Wildcats as they took 3 of 4 games from Cameron at Crutcher Scott Field. After getting off to a 1-for-5 start vs. the Aggies in games one and two, Schuetze rebounded in game three with a 3-for-4 performance that included a game-tying RBI with one out in the bottom of the seventh. Shortly after his hit, ACU won the game on a throwing error by the Cameron catcher who was trying to throw Mason Smith out at third base on a double steal. In the fourth and final game of the series, Schuetze went 2-for-5 with a double, single and runs scored during ACU's five-run fourth and sixth-run sixth that clinched the Wildcat victory.

Geno Encina, University of the Incarnate Word, appeared in three games for the Cardinals last week. He picked up a pair of extra-inning relief wins against Eastern New Mexico in the final two games of the series. He

It was team-high fourth complete game of the season as he leads the team with 63 strikeouts in 51.2 innings of work and a 2.61 ERA.

Carter Hahn, Abilene Christian University, went the distance in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader vs. Cameron, pitching ACU to a 2-1 win. Hahn was dominant as he allowed just four hits and one walk in seven complete innings while striking out nine Aggies. He only faced six batters over the minimum and from the end of the third through the top of the seventh he retired 12 of 13 batters he faced. In the top of the seventh, he gave up a pair of two-out singles before getting Kevin Lum to foul out to Kyle Giusti at third base to end the game. ACU posted single runs in the fourth and fifth innings to take the lead, and that was all Hahn needed as he improved to 7-2 with the victory.

Miguel Ramirez, Tarleton State University, improved to 6-1 on the season with his team-leading fourth complete game of the year in Tarleton's 4-2 win over the Rams in San Angelo on Saturday. The senior starter gave up just two runs on seven hits while striking out a season-high nine batters in 7.0 innings of work. He now leads the team with a 2.08 earned run average and 57 K's on the season.

#### West Texas A&M

In a wild week, the Buffs went 3-2 and stayed in a tie with Texas A&M-Kingsville as the teams split a four game set...WT opened the week with a 20-13 win at Wayland Baptist on Tuesday as the Buffs jumped out to a 9-0 lead, but WBU plated 12 runs in the sixth inning to lead 12-9...The Buffs came back with four runs in the seventh for a 13-12 lead and tallied seven more runs in the final two innings for the win...Senior Mitch Tybroski went 4 for 4 in the game with seven RBI coming within one RBI of the school record...The Buffs headed to TAMUK and pitching dominated the opener as junior Dylan James tallied 10 strikeouts and scattered five hits, but TAMUK won 1-0. The Buffs came back with a 6-1 win Saturday and lost 6-4 to split the twin bill, but responded with a 13-8 win Sunday for the series split...The Buffs remained in a tie with TAMUK as both teams are 10-10 in league play...WT outscored TAMUK 23-16 for the series and hit .311 for the week, while holding the opposition to .250.
