LSC SOFTBALL

With three Lone Star Conference series remaining, Texas Woman's has a one-game advantage in the standings. Teams are playing mid-week league games this week in addition to the weekend series.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 239-184 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 72-46 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 12-4 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-HITTERS

Madison Buckley, Abilene Christian University, JR, LF, Coppell, Texas, Coppell HS

Buckley recorded an .800 batting average (8-for-10) last weekend in Abilene Christian's three-game sweep of Cameron that pushed them ahead of the Aggies by 2.0 games in the LSC Standings. Buckley started the series with a bang, clubbing a home run in the first inning that gave a ACU a 2-0 lead. She would later single and score a run in a four-run second that allowed the Wildcats to run-rule the Aggies in game one, 10-2. During the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, Buckley was a perfect 3-for-3 with a RBI double that pushed ACU's lead to 4-2. The Wildcats would hang on to win that game, 5-4. In game two of the twin bill, Buckley singled again three times and scored three runs in a 10-2 win. Her three hits and three runs were both career single-game highs.

Katelyn Vinson, Midwestern State University, FR, Outfield, Southlake, Texas, Carroll HS

Vinson led Midwestern State to a perfect 5-0 week with a pair of wins over Texas-Permian Basin before taking an LSC sweep at Tarleton State. The Southlake product hit .529 (9-of-17) with three doubles and three homers while driving in 15 runs. Vinson mashed a walk-off grand slam in an 8-0 win over UTPB, had a key three-run blast in a 6-1 over Tarleton State on Friday night then matched a school record with a 6-RBI effort in a 17-8 win over the TexAnns on Saturday. Vinson has hits in 16 of her last 17 games hitting .607 (34-of-56) with 13 homers and 37 RBIs.

PITCHER

Briana Sanchez, University of the Incarnate Word, SR, SP, San Antonio, Texas, Marshall HS

Sanchez had a big weekend and nearly pulled off a trifecta of victories over #2 West Texas A&M. In the series opener, she shutdown the vaunted Lady Buffs offense on just two hits and three walks while striking out 10. She came back in the night cap and pitched 2.0 innings of shutout relief to earn a second victory. In the final game of the series, she lost a 4-3 decision after tossing a complete game while striking out nine batters. She piled up 21 strikeouts on the weekend and improved to 15-7 for the season. She limited the Lady Buffs to a .143 batting average.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Kodie Garner, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led the Javelinas with a .667 batting average in three games last week. The senior was 6-of-9 for the weekend to raise her average 38 points. She drove in a run and was perfect in 18 fielding opportunities.

Elizabeth Velasquez, Eastern New Mexico University, turned in a strong performance last week, with a .600 batting average with two doubles and two walks over four games. She reached base safely in all four games, starting with a three-for-four outing against University of the Southwest. Velasquez drew two walks in the series opener at Texas A&M-Kingsville and hit three-for-five over the final two games of the series. She scored a run in all four games.

Melanie Padilla, University of the Incarnate Word, hit .400 against #2 West Texas A&M and had the biggest hit of the series when she cracked a walk-off home run in the second game to give the team a 4-3 win. She had at least one hit in each game and also scored a run in the series finale, a 4-3 loss.

Lizzy Kelly, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers to the series win against Angelo State with a .375 batting average, .875 slugging percentage and .583 on base percentage. She drove in the winning-run in the third game to clinch the series victory. Kelly also scored two runs in a 6-1 win in game one. On the season she second on the team and tied for third in the conference in runs (49) and doubles (15).

Mary Jo Granger, Eastern New Mexico University, scattered eight hits, all singles, over 6.1 innings at Texas A&M-Kingsville. Her efforts allowed the Zias to clinch their second consecutive series win over the Javelinas.

Adriana Garcia, West Texas A&M University, had her best weekend as a Lady Buff during WT's South Texas road swing this past weekend as she went 2-0 in the circle with a 1.05 ERA including a complete game win. The El Paso, Texas native picked up the two WT wins on the weekend as she threw 13.1 innings, giving up three runs (2 earned) on nine hits as opponents hit .200 off of the senior left hander.

Caitlyn Crain, Abilene Christian University, appeared in all three games last weekend vs. Cameron and went 2-0 with a save. The two wins improved her season mark to 11-9 and her save was her fourth of the year, tying her for first in the LSC. Crain allowed just two runs on eight hits with three strikeouts to earn the win in game

Brandie Lander, Texas Woman's University, posted a 2-1 record in the series win against Angelo State. She posted a 1.91 ERA and .211 opponent batting average while striking out six batters. Lander tossed 4.0 shutout innings in game-one victory and four more shutout-innings in game-three win. On the season she is the team leader in ERA (2.00), wins (16) and strikeouts (104).

Kat Batey, Midwestern State University, rolled to a perfect 3-0 week helping Midwestern State to a key sweep of Tarleton State over the weekend in Stephenville. The Plano native posted a 2.45 ERA allowing seven earned runs on 17 hits in 20 innings while limiting the opposition to a .233 batting average. Batey held Texas-Permian Basin to two run-on five hits in a 3-2 win in eight innings on Tuesday before claiming two wins over the TexAnns to improve to 14-5 on the season.

Katrisha Arocha, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, earned her first win in Lone Star Conference play in Friday's second game. She went seven innings scattering eight hits allowing four runs with three earned. She fanned five hitters and did not walk a batter.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University softball team bounced back from a mid-week loss to University of the Southwest, to claim the third series win over Texas A&M-Kingsville, in program history. It also marked the first time the Zias took a series from the Javelinas on the road. After posting the first road shutout win in two years, to claim the opener, 2-0, the Javelinas won Friday's nightcap by a 7-4 score. Katie Ramsay cracked a two-run homer in the finale, as Eastern went on to the 6-0 win. The Zias will visit second-ranked West Texas A&M, for a mid-week doubleheader, before hosting Abilene Christian.

The Cardinals picked up an important LSC series win over #2 West Texas A&M. They won the opener, 3-0 and the second game, 4-3 before losing the final game, 4-3. Midwestern State

Midwestern State completed a 5-0 week taking two from Texas-Permian Basin on Tuesday before sweeping Tarleton State in Lone Star Conference play last weekend in Stephenville... The Mustangs have won their last seven games against Tarleton State including regular season series sweeps in each of the past two seasons and a 9-8 win over the TexAnns in the opening round of the LSC Postseason Tournament last season... The Mustangs extended their current winning streak to six games and have won 10 of the last 11... Midwestern State continues to lead the Lone Star Conference in team batting average (.370) and home runs (65)... MSU's 65 home runs betters the old program record of 60 set in 2011... The Mustangs boast the top three hitters in the league including freshman outfielder Katelyn Vinson (.508), sophomore third baseman Kelley Schaefer (.453) and junior catcher Kim Jerrick (.440)... Junior catcher Kim Jerrick rides an 11-game hitting streak (.462, 4 2B, 4 HR, 18 RBI). It's the fifth hitting streak of at least 10 games by an MSU player this season as Jerrick had a 17-game streak earlier this season while Kelley Schaefer, Courtney Bingham and Katelyn Vinson have each posted an 11-game hitting streak... Freshman Katelyn Vinson has hits in 16 of her last 17 games hitting .607 (34-for-56) with 13 homers and 37 RBIs... Senior outfielder Courtney Bingham is hitting .583 (14-of-24) with five doubles, a homer and 10 RBIs during her current six-game hitting streak... Sophomore third baseman Kelley Schaefer matched a single-game school record with five hits in Game 2 Friday night at Tarleton State. It was just the third 5-hit game in program history and the second for Schaefer this season... Freshman outfielder Katelyn Vinson tied a program single game record with six RBIs Saturday at Tarleton State. It's the fourth 6-RBI performance in MSU history as Kim Jerrick performed the feat earlier this season against Western New Mexico while Kristen Stonecipher drove in six runs on consecutive days in 2007... Senior outfielder Courtney Bingham drilled her 20th double of the season to set a single-season high water mark Friday night at Tarleton State ... Midwestern

State has homered in each of its last 18 games totaling 34 long balls...

Texas Woman's

The TWU softball team captured the series win against Angelo State to stay on top of the LSC standings. Junior Bailey Vrazel led the team with .615 batting average while senior Lizzy Kelly scored a team-best five runs. Kelly also drove in the winning run in game-three to clinch the series victory. Junior Katie Hines drove in four runs in the series and hit her 21 home run of the season. Senior Jordan Readicker hit her career-best 15 long ball of the year. Junior Brandie Lander appeared in all three games and posted a 2-1 record with a 1.91 ERA.

West Texas A&M

The #2 Lady Buffs of West Texas A&M took a roadtrip to South Texas this past weekend as they dropped two of three games to Incarnate Word in San Antonio before splitting a doubleheader with St. Edward's in Austin on Sunday afternoon. Sunday's win marked the 600th career victory for WT head coach Kevin Blaskowski. The Lady Buffs enter the weekend with a 32-7 overall record and a 13-5 mark in the Lone Star Conference to sit in second place. WT starts an eight game homestand this Tuesday as they host Southern Nazarene at Schaeffer Park in Canyon.
