LSC SOFTBALL

Texas Woman's is in sole possession of first place after four weeks of Lone Star Conference play. The Pioneers are 11-1, with West Texas A&M and Angelo State behind them at 9-3.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 202-150 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 68-44 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 11-3 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER

Katelyn Vinson, Midwestern State University, FR, DP, Southlake, Texas, Carroll HS

Vinson hit a robust .737 with six homers and 14 RBIs while leading Midwestern State to a 4-2 showing last week against Central Oklahoma, Incarnate Word and Ouachita Baptist. The freshman from Southlake posted a 1.789 slugging percentage connecting on six homers in a six-game stretch with bombs in four consecutive contests including a two-homer effort Saturday at Incarnate Word. Vinson has posted multiple hits in each game of a career-best eight-game hitting streak while hitting .720 (15-of-25) with two doubles and seven homers while driving in 15 runs. She leads all Lone Star Conference active hitters with a .506 batting average while becoming the second frosh in MSU program history to hit 10 homers.

CO-PITCHER

Briana Sanchez, University of the Incarnate Word, SR, SP, San Antonio, Texas, Marshall HS

Sanchez was a workhorse for the Cardinals last week going a perfect 3-0 with three complete games against top competition. She picked up a win over #22 St. Mary's Tuesday. She allowed six hits, three earned runs and two walks while striking out seven in a 6-5 win. Over the weekend, she picked up two wins over Midwestern State, the top hitting team in the nation. In the first game of the series, she allowed 11 hits, five runs and two walks while striking out eight. In the final game of the series, she tossed all 9.0 innings of the game giving up a total of four hits and four runs. She walked six and struck out six in the 5-4 win.

Sandra Serna, Angelo State University, JR, Pitcher, Albuquerque, N.M., Sandia HS

Serna held the No. 1 West Texas A&M, the second best slugging team in the nation, to a .231 average and a 3.82 earned-run average in 11 innings. She started game two of the series going seven inning and striking out six while giving up six earns but only five were earned. In game three of the series, Serna came in relief to pitch four inning of three hit ball and only allowed one run for her 15th win of the season. She twice got out of bases loaded games in the fourth and sixth inning in game three.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Amber Clifford, Tarleton State University, was a force at the plate for Tarleton last weekend against Cameron. The sophomore first baseman led the team with a .667 average en route to winning two of three against the Aggies. Clifford also led the team in hits (6), RBIs (5), total bases (10), slugging percentage (1.111) and on base percentage (.700). Her weekend was highlighted with her second career home run - a three-run blast to straight away center field Thursday.

Keanna Winkfield, Abilene Christian University, extended her hitting streak to 10 games with a 7-for-11 (.636) weekend as the Wildcats captured their first conference series win of the season at Kingsville. Winkfield went 4-for-4 (all singles) in game one with 3 RBI and a run, and followed that performance with a 2-for-4 effort that included two late-inning runs in the fifth and seventh as ACU held on to win 6-3. Winkfield's four hits tied her season and ACU career high. It was her second four hit game of the season and third of her two-year career with the Wildcats. She has 13 multi-hit games this season, and has raised her average over 30 points during her

10-game hitting streak. Winkfield scored two more runs and drove in another during ACU's 8-7 loss to the Javelinas Saturday.

Jordan Readicker, Texas Woman's University, helped the team to a three-game sweep against Eastern New Mexico with a team-best .625 batting average, 1.500 slugging percentage and .700 on base percentage. She drove in three runs and scored three more on two home runs and a double. Readicker has hit eight home runs in the last seven games and is currently second on the team and in the Lone Star Conference with 13 long balls on the season. She is batting .391 for the year with 42 RBI and .765 slugging percentage.

Adela Gomez, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, finished the week in sizzling sensation hitting two home runs in each of the final two games of the series with Abilene Christian becoming the first Javelina since Lindsey Brown had a pair against Ouachita Baptist on March 6, 2011...Gomez entered the week with four home runs on the season so she doubled her home run total...After going 0-of-3 versus ACU in the opener, Gomez was 2-of-4 with two homers, three RBI and two runs scored accounting for all of the Javelina runs in a 6-3 loss. In the series finale, she powered Kingsville to its first LSC win with a 3-for-3 performance with two home runs, four RBI, and two runs scored. She was also hit by a pitch in the game. For the series, she finished with 17 total bases while hitting .500. Gomez finished with a 1.700 slugging percentage and a .545 on-base percentage. Defensively, she was error free in 30 chances.

Kacie Easley, Angelo State University, had one of the biggest hits of her career this past weekend. Bottom of the seventh inning and her Rambelles down 3-2, the senior stepped to the plate with one on second base and one out. The second pitch she saw she drove into the wind in left field over the fence for a game-winning home run. It was her 38th career home run. Easley hit .444 (4-for-9) over the weekend and drove in four runs and score three.

Aurelia Sandoval, Eastern New Mexico University, led the Zias with a .400 batting average and a .500 on-base percentage against eighth-ranked Texas Woman's, last week. She batted two-for-three in the finale, with a double.

Monica Acuna, University of the Incarnate Word, had a big week for the Cardinals and played a key role in a 4-1 week. In a doubleheader sweep of St. Mary's, she went 1-for-3 with a double, two RBI's and a run scored in a 6-5 Game 1 victory. She came back in the second game walking twice and scoring twice in another 6-5 win. On Friday night, she went 3-for-3 with an RBI in a 6-5 comeback win over Midwestern State. On Saturday, she went 1-for-3 with an RBI in a 10-3 loss in the first game, but saved her best for last. In the series finale, she hit a walk-off two-out, three-run homer with the Cardinals trailing by two in the bottom of the ninth to give the team a 5-4 win. She went 6-for-16 at the plate for the week with seven RBI's and four runs scored as the team went 4-1.

Brandie Lander, Texas Woman's University, recorded a win and a save in a three-game sweep against Eastern New Mexico. She posted 0.78 ERA while striking out 15 batters in the two appearances. Lander posted a complete-game victory in game two and then tossed three innings in game three for the save. She allowed just one earned run in nine innings. On the season Lander is the team leader with 1.98 EAR, 14 wins, 3 saves and 97 strikeouts.

Caitylyn Crain, Abilene Christian University, finished the weekend at Kingsville with 19 strikeouts as ACU won its first conference series of the season. Crain struck out 11 batters, including the side in the seventh inning of game two, as the Wildcats swept

their doubleheader vs. the Javelinas by scores of 6-0 and 6-3. Crain whiffed eight batters to earn the complete-game shutout victory in game one, and then returned to the circle in the seventh inning of game two after starter Shelby Hall allowed the first two batters to reach on base hits. Crain promptly loaded the bases on a bunt single, but came back to strike out Jaeleen Castro, Adela Gomez and Carynn Gonzales in order to end the game. Crain also started the third game and struck out eight through 5.2 innings. Her eight strikeouts tied her season and ACU career highs. She previously struck out eight batters vs. Kingsville (3/23/12), Incarnate Word (5/5/12).

The Mustangs continue to lead the Lone Star Conference in hitting at .373 and is third with 45 home runs... Freshman Katelyn Vinson leads all active Lone Star Conference hitters with a .506 average... MSU continues to boast four of the top five on-base percentage performers in the league including Kim Jerrick (.559), Elena Bennett (.554), Katelyn Vinson (.542) and Kelley Schaefer (.519)... Vinson (.857) and Jerrick (.856) rank second and third in slugging percentage behind TWU's Katie Hines (.952)... Freshman pitcher Laci Belovsky leads the LSC with 18 complete games and four shutouts... Freshman pitcher Kat Batey has won her last three starts to improve to 10-4 on the season. Batey has yielded just 10 hits over her last 14 innings of work while posting 11 strikeouts... Freshman Katelyn Vinson extended her career-best hitting streak to eight games by going 2-for-3 with a double and a home run Monday at Ouachita Baptist (Ark.)... Vinson has connected on a homer in each of her last four games including a twohomer game against Incarnate Word on Saturday... Vinson is hitting .720 (15-of-25) during the eightgame hitting streak with two doubles, seven homers and 15 RBIs... Vinson has posted at least two hits in each contest during an eight-game hitting streak... Vinson became just the second freshman in MSU program history to connected on 10 homers joining Kim Jerrick, who hit 11 in 2011...

They tied the game on Gomez's 3-run bomb in the sixth and won it on a walk-off base hit by Jaeleen Castro in the seventh for their first LSC win...Denise Arnold tossed 5-2/3 innings of relief in Friday's finale scattering three hits. She allowed just one run while fanning four...With the four home runs on Friday, Gomez now has eight this season. She is tied for the third most home runs in a single season. The record is 11 by Quesha Torres set in 2007. Torres had nine the season before which is the second most. Gomez has 32 RBI which is eighth most by a Javelina in a season... Jaeleen Castro has been hit by eight pitches this season which is the fourth most in any given season... With a .462 average, Rose Stubbs continues to have the best single-season average in school history.

Texas Woman's

The Pioneers swept the three-game series against Eastern New Mexico to improve their record to 33-7 overall and 11-1 in the Lone Star Conference. The overall mark tied the best start in school history (1999). Senior Jordan Readicker led the team on offense with a .625 batting average, 1.500 slugging percentage and .700 on base percentage. She has hit eight home runs in the last seven games. Junior Katie Hines drove in four runs while junior Amanda Ruiz led the Pioneers with 5 RBI. Junior Brandi Lander posted a team-best 0.78 ERA and 15 strikeouts. She recorded a win and a save.

West Texas A&M

The #1 Lady Buffs dropped their first back-to-back games of the season this past weekend after taking game one from the Belles of Angelo State on Friday night. ASU took both games of the Saturday doubleheader from WT, highlighted by a walkoff two run homerun in the nightcap to drop WT to 27-4 (9-3 LSC) on the season.
