LSC BASEBALL

The field is set for the Lone Star Conference Baseball Championship with Tarleton State, Texas A&M-Kingsville, Angelo State, Abilene Christian, West Texas A&M and Incarnate Word earning the six spots. Seeding will be determined as regular season play concludes this weekend. The championship is May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason.

LSC baseball teams are 199-154-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 13-11 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 29-9 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

James Black, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, 3B, Spring, Texas, Klein Collins HS

Black had a stellar week at the plate. In five games, the Javelina third baseman hit .632 for the week. After going 2-of-3 in the final home game of the regular season against St. Edward's, Black was 10-of-16 in the four games at Eastern New Mexico. The junior belted his third home run of the season in the second game of the series and averaged two RBI a game. Black had two or more hits in every game of the series. In the 9-6 win in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, he drove in Kingsville's final three runs of the game.

Lee Neumann, Angelo State University, SR, Designated Hitter, Brenham, Texas, Brenham HS

Neumann went off last weekend at Cameron with three home runs, eight RBI and nine total hits for the Rams. The senior had a 1.056 slugging percentage and also stole five bases to help lead ASU to a 3-1 series win in Oklahoma. Neumann's biggest output of the weekend came on a two-home run game where the Rams won 21-7 in Saturday's second game. He is now hitting .352 on the season with six home runs, 43 RBI, nine doubles and seven triples. He has also stolen 18 bases and leads the Rams with 58 hits.

PITCHERS

Dylan James, West Texas A&M University, JR, P, Las Cruces, N.M., Mayfield HS

Had another strong outing as the Friday night starter as he went six innings, scattering five hits, one walk and he fanned nine in a 22-0, run-rule win over UIW. He allowed just one extra-base hit as the Cardinals hit just .227 against him. It was his first combined shutout of his WT career as he lowered his ERA to 2.34 and improved to 3-2 on the year, while recording 72 strikeouts.

Miguel Ramirez, Tarleton State University, SR, RHP, Gallup, N.M., Gallup HS

Ramirez allowed the first batter he faced to reach base on a hit-by-pitch, but the right-handed senior came back to record 14 consecutive outs and take a no-hitter into the sixth inning against Abilene Christian on Saturday. His no-hitter was broken up with the first batter he faced in the sixth inning and he yielded just one more hit on the day while earning his team-leading seventh victory of the season in a complete-game two-hitter. Ramirez faced the minimum in the final inning to secure a 3-1 win for the Texans. He stifled the ACU bats to just a .095 batting average and struck out six on the day.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Mitch Tybroski, West Texas A&M University, helped lead the Buffs to a 3-1 series win over Incarnate Word over the weekend in four starts. He went 8 of 14 from the plate with four runs scored, along with a double and four RBI. He slugged .643 and reached base at a .600 clip. He walked once. He had an infield single Sunday that began a six-run inning en route to a 12-7 victory for the 3-1 series win.

Ryan Small, Tarleton State University, had eight hits on the weekend with four of them going for doubles on his way to batting .533 in Tarleton's 3-1 series win over Abilene Christian. The senior second baseman led the team with five runs batted in, a .563 on-base percentage and an .800 slugging percentage to help keep the Texans ahead in the LSC standings. Small tallied 12 total bases on the weekend and had a team-high five runs batted in.

Andres Enriquez, Eastern New Mexico University, started all five games this past week for Eastern New Mexico at third base. He hit .500 (10-20) with four RBI, three doubles, scored three times and walked once. He began the week by going 1-for-5 with a double and run scored in a one-run loss at Wayland Baptist and in the first game versus Texas A&M-Kingsville he had a hit in three at bats. On Saturday, Enriquez was 2-for-3 with a double, run scored and plated a run in the first game of the doubleheader. His hot bat continued as he was 4-for-5 in the second game in which he doubled, drove in three and laid down a sacrifice bunt. In the series finale versus the Javelinas, Enriquez had two hits in four at bats and scored one time. Along with his hot bat, he also played stellar defense at the hot corner by not committing an error in 13 chances.

Jake Feckley, Angelo State University, continues to be one of the top pitchers in the conference on a weekly basis and turned in another gem last Saturday to carry the Rams to a 6-2 win over Cameron. Feckley (8-3) struck out four and did not allow an earned run in six inning of work. The junior limited the Aggies to a .208 batting average with the wind blowing out at McCord Field and only walked two. He has now struck out 52 batters in 58 innings this season and enters the final weekend of the regular season with a 2.17 ERA.

Spring Championships Festival May 3-4-5-6, 2013 | Canyon, Texas



Ty Taylor, Abilene Christian University, improved to a game over .500 at 5-4 and came within an inning of delivering his second complete game of the season Sunday, leading ACU to a 7-2 win over first-place Tarleton State. Taylor scattered eight hits over 8.0 innings of work and walked just one batter, while striking out seven two shy of his career high.

Drew Reidt, Cameron University, pitched his second straight complete game in a row on Friday, April 19 against Angelo State in a 8-3 win for the Aggies. Reidt struck out five Ram batters while walking only one. He also held Angelo State to a .229 batting average in the win. For the season, Reidt is now 3-3 in 11 starts with a 3.32 era for the season on the mound for Cameron.

Angelo State

The Rams continued there road dominance this season with a 3-1 series win over Cameron at McCord Field in Lawton. ASU outscored the Aggies 39-24 in the series and improved to 17-5 on the road this season. ASU hit .352 in the series with five home runs and nine doubles, while its pitching staff held the Aggies to a .294 batting average and had a 3.48 staff ERA during the series. Freshman David Goggin had a .583 batting average with seven hits, while Lee Neumann had eight RBI on nine hits. Andrew LaCombe drove in another six runs with Ryan Greer hitting .412 with seven hits and three RBI. Jake Feckley, Mike Weatherly and Bryce Zak picked up wins on the mound.

Cameron

Cameron went 1-4 last week with their lone win coming against Angelo State on Friday, April 19. Brad Blumer led the Aggies in batting average with a .400 and had six hits, while Brandon Raidy had five hits, six RBI, and a grand slam homer. Drew Reidt gave Cameron another great pitching performance with his second complete game in a row, giving up only three runs, and he had five punch outs. The Aggies however are out of contention for the Lone Star Conference post season; they will close out their season on the road at Tarleton State starting on Friday, April 26.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 0-5 last week as they fell on the road to Wayland Baptist on a walk-off hit and were swept at home by Texas A&M-Kingsville. The loss to the Pioneers was the third straight with two outs and two strikes in the final inning. The Greyhounds held a lead against the Javelinas in all four games of the series. Brett Ackerman led the team with a .571 batting average while Andres Enriquez (.500) and Matthew Spradlin (.545) all hit .500 or better on the week. Jacob Rogers hit two home runs against TAMUK, including a grand slam in Friday's game, to give him a team-high five on the season. He also scored seven times and drove in six during the week, all coming against the Javelinas. Luis Quinones ended the week with 223 career hits, seven shy of tying for second place on the school's career list. ENMU finishes their season this weekend as they host rival West Texas A&M.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 1-4 last week with a loss at St. Mary's and they went 1-3 at West Texas A&M. Alexis Garza improved to 6-0 on the season and has a 2.59 ERA. Derrick Walls is just three steals away from tying the school record of 37. He leads the LSC in steals, walks, runs, hits and on-base percentage. Jordan Scelfo hit his first two career home runs in the team's lone win at West Texas A&M. Dylan Boss was dealt a tough defeat when he tossed 9.1 innings in the third game at WT and lost, 2-1.

Tarleton State

The Texans moved one win away from securing at least a share of the Lone Star Conference Championship after taking a 3-1 series win over Abilene Christian in Stephenville this weekend... The Texans can win the conference title outright with two wins over Cameron this weekend... It would be Tarleton's first ever LSC title in school history... The Texans batted .350 as a team on the weekend, while the pitching staff held ACU to just .179 at the plate... Tarleton yielded just a 2.53 earned run average over the four-game set while ACU's pitching corps finished the weekend with a monster ERA of 7.45... Tarleton outscored the Wildcats 26-14 to go up three games over ACU in the conference standings... Ryan Small hit .533 on the weekend with four doubles and five runs batted in... Colten Boothe hit .400 against ACU, smashed his team-leading sixth home run and stole four bases... Miguel Ramirez took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before giving up his first hit to the first batter in the top of the frame... He had retired 14 consecutive ACU hitters before the single to right field... Matt Buckmaster won in his appearance on Friday, so both he and Ramirez are now tied for the team lead with seven wins on the year... Tarleton had 10 stolen bases on the weekend, pulling them within 22 more of tying the school record... The Texans broke a school record with its 97th hit batter over the weekend... The previous record of 96 HBP set back in 2009 was broken in the bottom of the sixth inning in game two on Saturday when Boothe was plunked by ACU's Aaron Lambrix... The Texans and Aggies will meet in Stephenville this weekend for the regular-season series finale... Game one on Friday in a four-game set is scheduled to begin at 3 p.m.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

Junior third baseman James Black had a stellar week at the plate. In five games, the Javelina third baseman hit .632 for the week. After going 2-of-3 in the final home game of the regular season against St. Edward's, Black was 10-of-16 in the four games at Eastern New Mexico. He belted a his third home run of the season in the second game of the series and averaged two RBI a game. Black had two or more hits in every game of the series. In the 9-6 win in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, he drove in Kingsville's final three

runs of the game... For the series Kingsville hit .377 as a team and outscored its hosts 48-33. James Black led the way with a .625 mark and led the team along with Laird with eight runs batted in the series. Taska and Villafuerte each scored six runs for the Javelinas. Cash Barker had a team-best four steals and Taska three as the Javelinas finished 15-of-17...Matt Rhodes became the second Javelina to put forth a 9-inning, completegame effort in two weeks. Rhodes, who was making his third start in the last eight days, moved to 5-3 as he permitted 13. He allowed five runs all earned and struck out three. He did not walk a batter and threw 121 pitches. The complete game was welcomed after the Javelinas had to use a season-high seven pitchers in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader in a game that saw 34 runs scored combined...The 34 runs in Saturday's second game of the doubleheader were the most since Kingsville scored 34 runs at St. Edward's in a 20-14 win on March 8, 2006. The most combined runs between the Javelinas occurred on May 9, 1998, versus Tarleton State in the LSC Tournament as the Javelinas won 21-20. In the game prior Kingsville won 19-17 over Central Oklahoma. Meanwhile, the last time Kingsville had scored as many as 18 runs was at Nolan Ryan Field against Northeastern State in 2009 in 18-8 win...With a loss on Tuesday to St. Edward's at Nolan Ryan Field the Javelinas finished 12-11 at home. They have had tremendous success away from home posting a 13-3 mark at the opposing team's field. The Hoggies are also 6-1 at neutral sites. In Lone Star action Kingsville was 5-7 at home but have gone 9-3 away from South Texas...The Javelinas swiped 15 stolen bases in 17 attempts in the series at Eastern New Mexico. They now have 100 stolen bases in 119 attempts. It is the third time in school history the team has swiped 100 bases. The record of 120 steals was established in 2004. Last year's team reposted 109 steals...Thanks to a pair of four run innings in the seventh and eighth innings of the series opener at ENMU, Dallas Ponder was able to avoid his first loss of the season. He is 8-0 on the year.

West Texas A&M

The Buffs continued to play well in conference play at home as they took 3-of-4 from visiting Incarnate Word... WT opened the series with a run-rule, 22-0 win in the most runs scored by WT this season...It also marked the most lopsided loss for UIW this season and the most runs allowed for the Cardinals in a game this season... Junior pitcher Dylan James went six innings, scattering five hits, one walk and he fanned nine...James leads the team with 72 strikeouts on the year...Saturday's doubleheader saw UIW come back for a 10-8 win as it was up 9-3 before a fierce WT rally...In the nightcap, the Buffs responded for a 2-1 win in 10 innings on a walk-off walk... On Sunday, WT plated 12 runs between innings 4-7 for a 12-7 win...WT hit an impressive .371 for the series with 52 hits, including 11 extra-base hits, while scoring 44 runs and allowing 18. The staff had a 4.36 ERA for the series with 31 strikeouts to 12 walks as UIW hit .252.
