### LSC BASEBALL

The top six Lone Star Conference baseball teams will meet in Canyon, Texas, May 3-6, for the annual LSC Baseball Championship.

The tournament features six teams and is taking place as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival. The double-elimination event begins on Friday and concludes on Monday. All games will take place at Wilder Park on the campus of West Texas A&M University.

LSC Champion Tarleton State is the top seed and earned its first league title. Texas A&M-Kingsville is the No. 2 seed, while Angelo State is third, followed by West Texas A&M, Abilene Christian, and Incarnate Word.

An all-festival pass, which includes admission to the baseball and track & field championships, will be \$25 for adults and \$10 for youth. Single day passes are \$15 for adults and \$6 for youth. All seats are considered general admission and are on a first-come, first-serve basis.

For fans that can't make it out to the games, all of the tournament action will be broadcast online via a free live webcast. The webcast will include both video and audio with viewers needing only a computer with a high-speed DSL or cable modem connection to the internet. The webcasts will be carried on www.foxsportssouthwest.com.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason.

LSC baseball teams are 216-171-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 14-12 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 29-9 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

### DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### HITTERS

**Noah Ringenberger, Tarleton State University, SR, OF, Flower Mound, Texas, Flower Mound HS**

Ringenberger was masterful at getting on base this weekend and then staying on base and coming around to score when he could. The senior outfielder had five hits in eight official at bats to bat .625 on the weekend against Cameron. He also had six walks and was hit by a pitch to push his on-base-percentage to .800 over the final four games of the season. When on base, Ringenberger stole six bases in six attempts and scored a team-high six runs in a weekend where the Texans claimed its first-ever LSC Championship.

**Taylor Taska, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, 1B/DH/P, Kingwood, Texas, Kingwood HS**

Taska continued to prove how valuable he is to the Javelinas versus Incarnate Word. At the plate, the junior hit .467 for the week, led the Javelinas with seven RBI, and hit a solo home run in the eighth inning to win the regular-season finale to clinch the second seed in the LSC Championship by a game. The home run was his seventh of the year to claim the home run crown in the LSC. Taska also tossed eight innings for a complete game in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader as Kingsville won 12-1 via run rule. He scattered five hits, struck out four and walked one with an efficient 91 pitches on the day.

#### PITCHERS

**Dylan James, West Texas A&M University, JR, P, Las Cruces, N.M., Mayfield HS**

Had another outstanding outing as the Buffs run-ruled Eastern New Mexico 10-0 in the opener Friday. James went all seven innings, scattering five hits with four walks and 11 strikeouts in the complete game, shutout win. He set the school single-season record with 83 strikeouts breaking the previous record of 80 set in 1998. He allowed just one extra-base hit in the game and held the Greyhounds to a .192 average. It was his fifth complete game and first full shutout as he improved to 4-2 on the year and dropped his ERA to 2.09 in 10 starts. James is third in the league in ERA and second in strikeouts.

**Matt Rhodes, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, LHP, Pearland, Texas, Pearland HS**

Rhodes tossed his second complete game as a Javelina going eight innings in Saturday's series finale at Incarnate Word. He held the Cardinals scoreless until the sixth inning when the hosts got one run in. Rhodes allowed just three hits and only one was for extra bases. Only three runners reached second in the contest as he struck out three and walked one improving to 6-3.

### OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Tyler McKnight, West Texas A&M University, hit a team-high .588 in four starts this past week. He went 10 of 17 from the plate with three RBI and a double. McKnight scored five runs on the week and tallied 11 total bases. He slugged .647 and reached base at .556. He was the most effective base stealer going 3 for 3 and had 12 put outs in 13 chances. He currently has a nine-game hitting streak which leads the team.

Peter Creamer, Eastern New Mexico University, ended his career by going 6-for-11 (.545) as Eastern New Mexico split a four-game series against rival West Texas A&M. He scored twice, drove in a run, stole a base, walked four times and recorded a hit in all four games including two in both games of the doubleheader on Saturday. Creamer ended the season with a .422 batting average, the fourth highest in program history.

Lee Neumann, Angelo State University, had six hits in the Rams' 3-1 series win over Abilene Christian.

Neumann had a double and five singles and added two RBI as the Rams bounced back from opening the series with a loss to take the final three games. Neumann finished the regular season with 43 singles, 10 doubles, seven triples and six home runs.

Kyle Kesmarki, Eastern New Mexico University, closed out both games of Saturday's doubleheader versus West Texas A&M. For the week he pitched 2.2 innings without allowing a hit or run, walked two and struck out one. In the first game on Saturday, Kesmarki pitched 1.2 hitless innings with a strikeout and two walks to record his third save of the season. He then came back and needed just 10 pitches in the second contest to get three outs and get his fourth save. His four saves on the year is tied for the sixth most in a season in school history and tied for the eighth most in a career.

Jake Feckley, Angelo State University, held ACU to a .167 batting average in a complete-game win last Saturday in his final regular-season appearance. Feckley cruised through the Wildcats, striking out only two but throwing only 63 pitches in the win. Feckley (9-3) has won his last five starts and finished the regular season with a 2.08 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 65 innings of work. He also has three saves this season.

Matt Buckmaster, Tarleton State University, picked up his eighth win of the season on Saturday and the victory he delivered gave Tarleton its first-ever LSC Baseball Championship. The senior left-hander gave up just two runs in Tarleton's 9-3 win over the Aggies and struck out eight batters in his 7.1 innings of work.

**Angelo State**

The Rams closed out the regular season with a 3-1 series win over Abilene Christian after dropping the series opener. ASU used two strong pitching performances from Jake Feckley and Mike Weatherly to sweep Saturday's doubleheader and had redshirt freshman Hunter Choate deliver a three-run double in the top of the eighth to claim a 4-2 comeback win in the finale. Graylon Brown claimed his first win of the season after throwing the final four innings and not allowing a run and striking out three. The Rams open the LSC tournament against WT at 7 p.m. on Friday. The Rams and Buffs split their season series in San Angelo earlier this year.

**Eastern New Mexico**

Eastern New Mexico ended their season by splitting the series against rivals West Texas A&M. After dropping the first game in seven innings 10-0, the Greyhounds came back and won 6-3 and 4-2 on Saturday and nearly came back to win on Sunday but fell 6-4. ENMU finishes the year 21-27 and 8-20 in the LSC. It is the first time with 20 wins in a season since 2010. The Greyhounds won 17 games at home, tied for the most in a year in program history with the 2009 squad. Luis Quinones recorded a hit in Sunday's contest to end his career with 224 hits. Andres Enriquez hit a solo home run on Sunday for his first career homer. Defensively, Brooke Brooks did not record an error against the Buffaloes to become the first ENMU player to record a perfect career fielding percentage with at least 100 chances. Daniel Binz ended the season third on the school's list for most chances (372) and putouts (357).

**Incarnate Word**

The Cardinals went 0-5 during the week losing a game at St. Edward's before dropping four in a row at home to Texas A&M-Kingsville. They enter the LSC Tournament as the #6 seed and will play Tarleton State. The Cardinals have won the first game at the LSC Tournament in each of the past two years and are 3-4 all-time in the tournament.

**Tarleton State**

The No. 21-ranked Tarleton Texans won the program's first-ever Lone Star Conference Championship with a pair of wins over the Cameron Aggies on Saturday and then swept the series with another pair of wins on Sunday... The Texans 9-3 win over CU in game two of Saturday's doubleheader gave Tarleton the LSC title outright and the Texans earn the LSC Championship tournament's No. 1 seed and will play at noon this Friday against No. 6-seeded Incarnate Word... The Texans batted .324 over the weekend and had a combined 2.25 earned run average as a pitching staff... Noah Ringenberger hit .625 on the weekend, but had an even more impressive .800 on-base-percentage as he went 5-for-8 at the plate with six walks and one hit-by-pitch... Ringenberger was 6-for-6 in stolen bases as well... Evan Robinson led the squad with five runs batted in on the weekend... Landon Thompson hit his first home run of the season on Sunday... Tarleton honored 12 seniors on Sunday, which included starters Ringenberger, Fola Lajide, Ryan Small, Pete Perez, Miguel Ramirez, Matt Buckmaster and closing pitcher Britt Robertshaw... Tarleton wraps up the regular-season hitting .313 as a team and having a 3.54 earned run average from the pitching corps... Tarleton tallied 81 doubles, 17 triples, 23 home runs and stole 120 bases... Texan batters were beamed a school-record 107 times on the year... Texan pitchers allowed just 148 earned runs on the season and fanned 316 batters... Tarleton's current 32 wins on the year gives head coach Bryan Conger his second year with 30+ win in just his fifth season with the team.

**Texas A&M-Kingsville**

Taylor Taska continued to prove how valuable he is to the Javelinas. At the plate, the junior hit .467 for the week, led the Javelinas with seven runs batted in, and hit a solo home run in the eighth inning to win the regular-season finale to clinch the second seed in the LSC Championship for the Javelinas by a game. His home run was his seventh of the year as he claimed the home run crown in the conference. He also tossed eight innings for a complete game in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader as Kingsville won 12-1 via run rule. He

scattered five hits, struck out four and walked one. He threw just 91 pitches on the day...Matt Rhodes tossed his second complete game as a Javelina tossing eight innings in Saturday's series finale at Incarnate Word. He held the Cardinals scoreless until the sixth inning when the hosts go one run in. He allowed just three hits and only one was for extra bases. Only three runners reached second in the contest. He struck out three and walked one improving to 6-3...In his first start in nearly a month and his first in Lone Star Conference play since March 23, Cody Williams pitched 5-1/3 innings of shutout baseball fanning five and scattering three hits. He held hitters to .176 to improve to a 5-3 won-loss record. He gave way to Jeremy Flores who tossed the final 1-2/3 innings to earn his ninth save. He is now one save shy of the single-season mark set last year by Cameron Dullnig...After posting a robust 7.84 series in sweeping Eastern New Mexico last week, the Kingsville pitching staff recovered in a big way. They posted a 2.32 ERA allowing more than a run in just one of the four games...Weston Silverburg earned his first career save in the series opener. He entered with two runs on and the Javelinas up 10-6. He forced a pop up to get out of the inning and then retired the side in the eighth after the offense added six runs...Ben Villafuerte scored seven runs on the weekend to lead the way and passed Taylor Taska for the team lead to finish with 45 on the season. Taska scored 44 runs. No other Javelina crossed the plate more than 29 times...Dallas Ponder overcame eight walks to earn his ninth win in the series opener. He is 9-0 on the season. He is tied for the third most wins in a single season by a Javelina pitcher...Kingsville is 19-17 all-time in the LSC Championship for baseball. They have reached the championship title four times winning four tournament titles. The Javelinas last won a conference game in 2008 when they last won the tournament.

### West Texas A&M

The Buffs got off to a good start with a 10-0, run-ruled win Friday at Eastern New Mexico as junior Dylan James threw a complete game, shutout as he scattered five hits and fanned 11...His 11 strikeouts set a school-record for a single season with 83 as he surpassed Chris Carson who had 80 K's in 1998...Junior Tyler McKnight had an outstanding series at he was 10 of 17 from the plate with five runs scored and three RBI and went 3 for 3 in stolen bases...WT struggled in Saturday's doubleheader leaving 19 men on base as it dropped both games...WT responded on Sunday with a 6-4 win to earn the series split and the No. 4 seed in the upcoming LSC Baseball Tournament with the 3-1 head-to-head series win over Abilene Christian as both teams finished with a 15-13 mark in conference play...WT is 29-19 on the year which is the same record it had last year...The 29 wins ties for fifth-most in school history with 34 wins being the best set in 1997.
