LSC SOFTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The eight-team field has been determined for this week's Lone Star Conference Softball Championship, which will be played over three days at Schaeffer Park on the campus of West Texas A&M University in Canyon, Texas, starting on Friday, May 3.

The top eight teams qualified for the single-elimination event which is part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival. The field includes Texas Woman's, West Texas A&M, Angelo State, Midwestern State, Tarleton State, Incarnate Word, Abilene Christian, and Cameron.

TWU is the top seed after winning the LSC Championship for the first time with a 21-6 league record. WT is No. 2 followed by ASU, MSU, Tarleton, UIW, ACU and CU.

Tournament play will begin on Friday, May 3, with four quarterfinal games scheduled to be played at 11:30 a.m., 2 p.m., 4:30 p.m., and 7 p.m.

On Saturday, May 4, two semifinal games will be played at 12 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.

The conference championship will be decided on Sunday, May 5, at 1 p.m.

All games will be played at Schaeffer Park in Buffalo Sports Park located on the northeast corner of the WT

An all-festival pass, which includes admission to the baseball and track & field championships, will be \$25 for adults and \$10 for youth. Single day passes are \$15 for adults and \$6 for youth. All seats are considered general admission and are on a first-come, first-serve basis.

For fans that can't make it out to the games, all of the tournament action will be broadcast online via a free live webcast. The webcast will include both video and audio with viewers needing only a computer with a high-speed DSL or cable modem connection to the internet. The webcasts will be carried on www. foxsportssouthwest.com.

LSC SOFTBALL

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason.

LSC softball teams are 287-231 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 72-46 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 12-4 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Sonora Zukerman, Cameron University, FR, 3B, Honolulu, Hawaii, MacArthur HS

Zukerman carried the CU offence to a 4-1 record this last week and pushed them into the LSC Tournament with a .750 batting average in five games played. During the week, Zukerman had nine hits, a double, triple, a pair of homers, and seven RBI. She had an on base percentage at .786 and a slugging percentage a 1.500. In the three game series against Eastern New Mexico she hit .857 at the plate with slugging percentage sitting at a robust 2.143.

PITCHER

Larisa Garcia, Texas Woman's University, SR, P, New Braunfels, Texas, New Braunfels HS

Garcia picked up two of the three TWU wins and helped the Pioneers capture their first ever Lone Star Conference title. With TWU needing two wins against West Texas A&M on the final day of the regular season, she recorded a complete game victory while allowing just one unearned run in the first game of the doubleheader. Garcia came in relief in the second game with TWU trailing 2-1 and tossed 1.2 hitless innings while allowing the Pioneers rally to a 3-2 win. She faced WT's heart of the order in the final inning and struck out the final two batters to seal the victory. On the season Garcia is 14-1 with 2.47 ERA including a perfect 8-0 in the conference.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Alberta Medina, Eastern New Mexico University, hit safely in two of three games, last week. She registered a two-for-three performance at the plate, in the second game of a doubleheader at Cameron.

Kodie Garner, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led the way for Kingsville with a .533 average. She had teambests in walks with seven, runs batted in, and six runs scored. Garner finished with a .682 on-base percentage. With the strong week, the senior raised her season average to .284 on the team which was third on the team

Katelyn Vinson, Midwestern State University, became the first player in Midwestern State history to slug 20 homers in a season when she connected on two bombs in an 8-0 win over Cameron Wednesday afternoon in Lawton. She added her 21st in Friday night's 9-1 victory at Abilene Christian. The freshman from Southlake continues to lead the Lone Star Conference with a .513 batting average while ranking second with 21 homers. Vinson hit .500 (9-of-18) for the week with two doubles, three homers and eight RBIs for a 1.111 slugging

Morgan Spearman, Angelo State University, led the charge for the Rambelles in a sweep of Texas A&M-Kingsville. The junior hit four home runs in three games including two in back-to-back innings. She drove in seven RBI's and scored six runs in four games during the week.

Melody Mayse, Tarleton State University, was a spark at the top of the TexAnn lineup, hitting .400 last week leading Tarleton to a 3-1 record including a sweep of Incarnate Word over the weekend. Mayse was 6-15 at the plate with a double, two home runs and four RBIs while scoring a team-high five runs. She also led the team with 13 total bases and was a perfect 3-3 in stolen base attempts, including a steal of home against Incarnate Word. She also led the TexAnns with a slugging percentage of .867.

Jordan Readicker, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers to 3-1 record and to their first ever Lone Star Conference title. She hit two key home runs and led the team with .818 slugging percentage. Readicker's first home run came with TWU trailing 3-2 in the bottom of the eighth against Tarleton State on Wednesday. A two-run blast gave the Pioneers a walk-off win. Her second long ball also came with TWU trailing 2-1 in the bottom of the sixth against West Texas A&M in the final game of the season. Readicker tied the game with a solo shot before the Pioneers scored the winning run to capture the title. On the season Readicker has 19 home runs and 54 RBI

Mary Kate McKay, Angelo State University, earned two victories and a save to help ASU go 4-0 last week. She held teams to a 1.65 earned-run average in 17 innings of work. She only allowed seven runs, four earned, in her three appearances. The junior is now 12-9 on the season.

Laci Belovsky, Midwestern State University, posted a perfect 3-0 mark last week taking a decision at Cameron and two at Abilene Christian. The freshman from Grangerland scattered seven hits to earn her LSC-leading seventh shutout of the season against Cameron before allowing a run on three hits in five innings Friday against Abilene Christian. She allowed five earned runs to outlast the Wildcats in a 9-8 win in nine innings on Saturday. Belovsky allowed six earned runs on 25 hits in 23 innings last week while going 3-0 with a save. She notched 15 strikeouts and walked two while limiting the opposition to a .266 batting average.

Samantha Betts, Cameron University, was in all four of their wins in the last week to push them into the LSC Tournament. Betts made three starts and finished a fourth and earned the win during each outing. In 23 innings tossed, Betts held batters to a .250 batting average and she struck out 12. She also had the rare feat of being the pitcher of record in a three game sweep against Easter New Mexico going 3-0. Her other win game against Midwestern State who was nationally ranked.

The Rambelles went 4-0 last week by sweeping the season series with ACU and Texas A&M-Kingsville. Morgan Spearman hit four home runs during the Texas A&M-Kingsville series. Mary Kate McKay went 2-0 with a save in three appearances. ASU will open up Lone Star Conference tournament play with Incarnate Word on Friday at 11:30 a.m.

Cameron

The Cameron softball team went 4-1 in the last week and put themselves on a position to make the Lone Star Conference Tournament. Sonora Zukerman led the Aggies with an outstanding .750 batting average with a double, triple, a pair of homers, and seven RBI. Leslie Martini pushed her all-time home run total to 43 after hitting two in the last week. Freshman Carly Allerheiligen went .500 at the plate with eight hits and three runs scored. Samantha Betts was a factor getting four wins in the circle with 12 strike outs and holding hitters to a .250 batting average. Cameron will face Texas Woman's in the first round of the LSC Tournament on May 3 at 7 p.m.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University softball team concluded its 2013 season, last weekend, with a three-game series at Cameron. Over the season, the Zias' nine home wins were the most since the 2010 season. Elizabeth Velasquez and Kyra Sirag led ENMU for the season, with .364 batting averages, while Erica Armendarez drove in a team-high 40 runs.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals were swept by Tarleton State on the road to close out the season and finished in sixth place in the league. They will take on Angelo State in the first round of the LSC Tournament, a team they defeated 2-1 during the season series. Briana Sanchez needs just two more strikeouts to reach 200 strikeouts for the third time in her career. She has a school record 944 strikeouts in her career. If she pitches three more innings she will eclipse 200.0 innings for a third straight year. Senior third baseman Monica Acuna has had a great year leading the team in batting average (.388), hits (59), doubles (16), RBI's (36), total bases (89) and slugging percentage (.586) while playing strong defense at third base. She has also been called upon to play catcher a few times this year.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State went 3-2 last week with a midweek doubleheader split with Cameron before taking two of three from Abilene Christian over the weekend... MSU clinched its 40th win with a 9-1 victory Friday at Abilene Christian. It marks the fifth time in program history the Mustangs have won at least 40 games in a season including three of the last four... The Mustangs racked up nine more home runs and rank second in NCAA Division II with 83 long balls this season. Only Humboldt State (Calif.) has more with 97... Midwestern State had a streak of 25 consecutive games with a home run snapped in an 8-1 set back in Game 1 Saturday at Abilene Christian... The Mustangs connected on 49 home runs from March 23 against Angelo State to April 26 against Abilene Christian... MSU has swatted multiple home runs in five of its last six games and in 27 games this season... The Mustangs continue to lead the Lone Star Conference with a .365 batting average including the top three hitters in the league in freshman Katelyn Vinson (.513, 21 HR, 63 RBI), junior Kim Jerrick (.436, 19

HR, 54 RBI) and sophomore Kelley Schaefer (.426, 12 HR, 67 RBI)... Jerrick mashed her 40th career home run with a blast over the center-field fence in the first inning of Game 1 Wednesday at Cameron... Vinson became the first player in MSU history to connect for 20 homers in a season with her third multiple-homer game of the campaign Wednesday at Cameron before adding her 21st Friday night against Abilene Christian... Vinson has accounted for 2-or-more hits in 27 games this season and needs three to match Elena Bennett's school record of 30 set in 2011... Senior outfielder Courtney Bingham is htting .435 (10-for-23) with a double, a triple and a homer while driving in 11 runs during her current six-game hitting streak... Freshman pitcher Laci Belovsky leads the Lone Star Conference with 25 wins this season. She is just the fourth pitcher in MSU history to win as many games in a season joining Brittney Tanner (31 wins in 2011), Brittany Willson (29 wis in 2006) and Katie Petersen who won 26 in 2008 and 25 in 2007 and 2010... Belovsky weaved her seventh shutout of the campaign with an 8-0 at Cameron on Wednesday...

Tarleton State

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas hit .343 in their final weekend series and .326 for the season...Kodie Garner led the way for Kingsville with a .533 average. She had team-bests in walks with seven, runs batted in, and six runs scored. Garner finished with a .682 on-base percentage. With the strong week, the senior raised her season average to .284 on the team which was third on the team...Aside from Garner, three other Javelinas hit over .400 in the week's five games. Adela Gomez hit .529, Corina Noel averaged .444 and Rose Stubbs .417...In the season finale, the Javelinas finished with 14 runs and 18 hits. The 14 runs tied the season-high for the Javelinas in runs, while the 18 hits were the tops this season...Rose Stubbs finished the season with a .396 average which is the third-highest mark in school history and finished fourth with 192 hits. The most impressive number of her career is her strikeout total. In 541 at bats, the senior struck out just 25 times in her career. After striking out 12 times in 192 at bats in her first season, Stubbs went down on strikes just 13 times in her last two seasons a span of 349 at bats...Three seniors – Denise Arnold, Stubbs and Garner – played their final seasons together on Sunday.

Texas Woman's

TWU posted a 3-1 record last week and captured its first ever Lone Star Conference title. After an emotional pregame tribute to Abby Burns on Wednesday night, the Pioneers captured a 4-3 win over Tarleton State on a two-run, walk-off home run by senior third baseman Jordan Readicker in the eighth inning. After dropping a nine-inning thriller to open the series against WTAMU on Friday, TWU needed to win both games of Saturday's twin bill to capture the conference title. The Pioneers defeated WTAMU, 5-1, in game one to set-up the winner take-all game two. In that decisive game, TWU rallied from a two-run deficit to knock off the Lady Buffs, 3-2. The Pioneers scored the tying and winning runs in the bottom of the sixth. Readicker also hit the game-tying long ball against WT in the final game. Senior Larisa Garcia tossed a complete-game and allowed just one unearned run against the Lady Buffs in the first game of the doubleheader on Saturday. She struck out five batters for her 13th win of the season. Garcia also tossed 1.2 hitless innings in the final game for her 14th win. Junior Haley Colwell led the team with .500 batting average last week and drove in the winning run in the final game. Junior Brandie Lander started three of the four games last week and tossed 22.1 innings while striking out 21 batters.

West Texas A&M

The #5 Lady Buffs of West Texas A&M went 2-2 this past week to wrap-up the 2013 regular season as they took their single game from Eastern New Mexico before dropping two of three games in Denton, Texas to #8 Texas Woman's this past weekend. The Lady Buffs now turn their attention to this weekend's LSC Tournament at Schaeffer Park in Canyon, Texas as they open up action on Friday afternoon at 2 p.m. against 7th seeded Abilene Christian.
