LSC BASEBALL

Tarleton State has a two-game lead in the Lone Star Conference standings at 12-4. The Texans won three of four games versus Incarnate Word last week.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 3-6 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC baseball teams are 165-117-1 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 12-8 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 29-9 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

DIAMOND PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Colten Boothe, Tarleton State University, JR, 1B, Buda, Texas, Buda HS

Boothe had a great weekend at the dish, going 6-for-11 and drawing five walks while helping the Texans earn a 3-1 series win over Incarnate Word. The junior first baseman hit a pair of home runs to go along with a double on the way to a 1.182 slugging percentage in the four-game set. He led the team with a .688 on-base percentage, scored four runs and had three runs batted in as well.

Mitch Tybroski, West Texas A&M University, SR, OF, Carlsbad, Calif., La Costa Canyon HS

Had a team-high .538 average in a 3-1 series win over Abilene Christian over the weekend. Tybroski led the team with seven hits and three doubles, along with five RBI, while tallying 10 total bases and a .769 slugging percentage. He started all four games in the series and reached base at a .538 clip.

PITCHERS

Miguel Ramirez, Tarleton State University, SR, RHP, Gallup, N.M., Gallup HS

Ramirez picked up his team-leading fifth win of the season on Saturday as he threw a four-hit complete game in Tarleton's win over Incarnate Word. He allowed just one unearned run in contest, walked a pair of batters and fanned five. After giving up a lead off single to UIW, Ramirez settled in and retired the next 11 batters on the way to recording his third complete game of the season. He shutdown the Cardinal lineup in order in five of his seven innings pitched.

Michael Lange, Angelo State University, SR, RHP, Columbus, Neb., Columbus HS

Lange turned in two strong outings for the Rams - one in relief and one in a start. Lange (3-2) earned a win in relief over St. Mary's after throwing six scoreless innings last Tuesday after coming into the game in the fourth inning. He followed up the relief win with six strikeouts in six innings on Sunday in the series finale against ENMU. Lange left the game with a 7-1 lead and was in line for his second straight win. For the week, Lange held opponents to a .159 batting average and struck out eight while walking only one.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Cash Barker, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led Kingsville with a .538 average at the plate with a .625 on-base percentage. He had a team-best six runs batted and was 4-for-4 in steals. Barker was 6-of-7 in the final two games of the series with six RBI. With the big weekend, Barker raised his season average to .408 and now has enough at bats to qualify as the team leader. His average ranks sixth in the league and he is tied with five others for sixth in the Lone Star Conference with 13 steals.

Derrick Walls, University of the Incarnate Word, was one of the few bright spots for the Cardinals on offense last week. He went 7-for-14 at the plate as the team went 1-3 at Tarleton State. He went 3-for-4 with two RBI's, a run scored and a stolen base in the teams lone win. He scored a run in each of the final three games and had a double in each of the final two games. He also swiped his 29th stolen base of the year in the opener.

Andrew LaCombe, Angelo State University, continues to be a steady force in the ASU lineup in his senior season. He hit .450 last week with nine singles and added four RBI for the Rams who won their LSC series over ENMU after earning a non-conference win over nationally ranked St. Mary's in San Antonio. LaCombe had two hits against the Rattlers and then had seven hits in Portales in the series. He now leads the Rams this season with a .362 batting average and has drove in 32 runs.

Aaron Kleekamp, Cameron University, guided the Aggies to a 7-2 win over Texas A&M Kingsville on Saturday pitching a complete game. Kleekamp gave up only one earned run while striking out six Javelina batters and walking none. For the season, he is leading the Aggies with three complete games and two saves, while holding opposing hitters to a .209 batting average.

Matt Rhodes, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, moved to 4-1 on the season with a win in the season finale. He allowed two runs with one unearned. He fanned four and walked one.

Alexis Garza, University of the Incarnate Word, improved to 4-0 on the season with the team's only win on the road at Tarleton State last weekend. He pitched six solid innings giving up just one run before tiring in the seventh when the team lead 15-1. He finished with 6.1 innings, six hits, five walks, three runs and three strikeouts.

After his NCBWA National Pitcher of the Week honor, Dylan James, West Texas A&M University, came back with a complete game win Friday night versus Abilene Christian as WT won 7-3. He pitched all nine innings, allowing just five hits, three earned runs, with one walk and seven K's. ACU hit just .167 against him as the WT pitching held the Wildcats to hit just .184 for the series. It was James' second win of the season (2-1) and third

Angelo State

The Rams are working their way up the conference standings after earning a 3-1 series win over ENMU in Portales last weekend and find themselves in third place with three LSC series to play. ASU also added a 5-2 non-conference win over nationally ranked St. Mary's to its resume last week and are now 24-13 in the 2013 season. ASU is 14-4 on the road this season and will look to improve its 10-9 record at home this week with a non-conference game against McMurry on Tuesday before playing its final four home games of the season in a series against Tarleton State at Foster Field. ASU is hitting .308 as a team and have a pitching staff ERA of 4.94 through the first 37 games of the season.

Cameron

Cameron split their season series with Texas A&M Kingsville over the weekend. The Aggies ended a 10 game losing streak with a comeback win after trailing 4-2 in the bottom of the ninth inning. Aaron Kleekamp tossed a gem on Saturday going seven innings, giving up one earned run, and striking out six batters. The Aggies would drop their final two games of the series 7-4 and 15-2. Cameron will play East Central on April 9 before returning to Lone Star Conference action for a four game series starting on April 11 at Abilene Christian.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 2-3 on the week with a 6-4 win over Wayland Baptist on Tuesday and a come from behind victory over Angelo State (8-7) on Sunday. The Greyhounds' three losses were to the Rams. Brett Ackerman and Luis Quinones both hit .375 (6-16) with two runs scored apiece. Quinones drove in three runs, one of four Eastern players with three RBI on the week. On the mound, Alberto Blanco got his first career start against the Pioneers and pitched a career-high five innings as he got his first career victory. Ryan Pruitt threw his first career complete game in the series finale versus ASU. For the week, he was 1-0 with a save, 6.30 ERA and six strikeouts in 10 innings of work. On Friday, Brian Kennedy pitched 4.2 innings of hitless relief and allowed just two walks. In the five games, ENMU committed only three errors and had a fielding percentage of .984 compared to their opponents .963 percentage.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 1-3 last week at Tarleton State. Alexis Garza improved to 4-0 on the season with the team's only win on the road at Tarleton State last weekend. He pitched six solid innings giving up just one run before tiring in the seventh when the team lead 15-1. He finished with 6.1 innings, six hits, five walks, three runs and three strikeouts. Tarleton State

The Texans moved 12-4 in Lone Star Conference with a 3-1 series win over Incarnate Word in Stephenville... Tarleton is now two games ahead of Abilene Christian for first place in the LSC with 12 more conference games to play... Colten Boothe and Rustin Thomas led the Texans at the plate this weekend, as they each hit .545 and had a slugging percentage of 1.182 each... Boothe hit two home runs on the weekend and Thomas had a double, triple and dinger as well... Alvaro Moreno connected on his first-career grand slam for the Texans on Friday... Miguel Ramirez and Matt Buckmaster each picked up a win in their respective starts over the weekend... Both starting pitchers have five wins on the year... Tarleton hit .346 on the weekend with five home runs and 27 runs batted in... The Texans outscored the Cardinals 32-20 in the four-game set... Tarleton will host #5 St. Mary's on Wednesday before returning to LSC action against Angelo State this weekend.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas posted a season-high 23 hits in Sunday's 15-2 win in the series finale... Seven of nine Javelina starting hitters had multiple hits and 13 total had at least one in the game. Ben Villafuerte scored three runs and Wagner crossed the plate twice with 12 Hoggies in all crossing plate... For the fourth time this season Kingsville had a pair of triples in the game. The Javelinas are tied for first in the LSC with 17 triples... Cash Barker led Kingsville with a .538 average at the plate with a .625 on-base percentage. He had a team-best six runs batted and was 4-for-4 in steals. Barker was 6-of-7 in the final two games of the series with six RBI. With the big weekend, Barker raised his season average to .408 and now has enough at bats to qualify as the team leader. His average ranks sixth in the league and he is tied with five others for sixth in the Lone Star Conference with 13 steals... Matt Rhodes moved to 4-1 on the season with a win in the season finale. He allowed two runs with one unearned. He fanned four and walked one. With a save in Saturday's second game, Jeremy Flores posted the 17th save of his career to become the all-time saves leader at A&M-Kingsville. The prior record of 16 was originally set by Juan Obregon... Joe Tallerine returned in the series after missing the prior nine games with an injury. The Javelina lead-off hitter brought an immediate spark. He played in all four games starting the final three. After picking up a pinch hit RBI in game one, he would go 5-of-11 in three starts to finish 6-of-12 on the weekend. He scored four runs and drove in two. The Hoggies went 5-5 without Tallerine and are 20-7 with him healthy... The win in Saturday's second game snapped a streak of three straight losses in Lone Star Conference play in which the Javelinas led heading into the final two innings. Kingsville has outscored foes 175 to 89 in the first six innings. However, opponents have outscored the Javelinas 53-40 in the final three games of regulation.

West Texas A&M

The Buffs went 3-1 this week over Abilene Christian... It was the first conference series win for WT this season as they improved to 8-8 in league play... WT hit .328 for the series, out-hitting ACU 38-21, including 12 extra-base hits on eight doubles, two triples and two home runs... The staff held the Wildcats to just .184 for the series on 21 of 114 with seven extra-base hits on four doubles, two triples and a home run... WT outscored ACU 21-9 for the series, while the Buff pitching was spot on as it tallied a 1.97 ERA as opposed to ACU's 6.52 ERA... It was the first four-game series win over ACU since 1997 (3-1) and third in school history (1995)... WT also has two three-game series wins against ACU.
