LSC SOFTBALL

After five weeks of Lone Star Conference games, West Texas A&M and Texas Woman's are tied for first place with matching 12-3 league records. WT plays at Incarnate Word this week, while TWU hosts Angelo State.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a three-game series against every other team. Each series consists of a doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into the NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 3-5 in Canyon, Texas, as part of the LSC Spring Championships Festival.

LSC softball teams are 221-167 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 69-45 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 12-4 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-HITTER

Alyssa Lemos, West Texas A&M University, JR, Shortstop, Grapevine, Texas, Grapevine HS

Lemos continued to spark the high powered Lady Buff offense this past weekend as the junior shortstop hit .556 from the leadoff spot with two big home runs on Friday night as she drove in four runs on the weekend while scoring six herself. The Grapevine, Texas native made the weekend a special one on Friday night as she hit two bombs to left center field in a run-rule win over ACU during Turnin' 2 For Cancer Weekend that is dedicated to Alyssa's mother, Roni, who lost her battle with Ovarian Cancer in 2008. Lemos registered a hit in all three games this weekend to stretch her hitting streak to an impressive 20 games.

Monica Acuna, University of the Incarnate Word, SR, 3B, San Antonio, Texas, Holmes HS

Acuna had a big week for the Cardinals who went 3-2 on the road, including a pair of wins at No. 23 Angelo State. She hit safely in all five games and hit .500 for the week. She went 3-for-5 with two runs, two doubles and an RBI while scoring the game-winning run in an 8-6 win at A&M-International. She scored two more runs in a 5-4 loss in the second game of the doubleheader at TAMU. She started the weekend by going 2-for-3 with an RBI in a 4-3 loss in 9 innings. In the second game of the series at ASU she was 1-for-2 with two runs and an RBI in a 3-0 win. In the series finale she provided an RBI double that scored the only run in a 1-0 victory.

PITCHER

Whitney Waltrip, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, SP, Orangevale, Calif., Casa Robles HS

Waltrip factored in four decisions for the Cardinals going 3-1 on the week. On Wednesday, she picked up a win in relief at Texas A&M-International and then was tagged with a 5-4 loss while pitching a complete game in the nightcap. Over the weekend, she was untouchable at No. 23 Angelo State. She tossed a complete game, three-hit shutout in the second game of the series, walking three and striking out four in the 3-0 win. On Sunday, she tossed six shutout innings allowing four hits and a walk while striking out nine in a 1-0 victory. She posted a 1.91 ERA for the week and is now 11-7 on the year.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Kendra Sancet, Texas Woman's University, led the Pioneers with 10 RBI and 1.556 slugging percentage in the three-game series against Midwestern State. After walking three of the four at bats in game-one on Friday, she exploded for .750 batting average, 1.750 slugging percentage and .778 on base percentage in the doubleheader on Saturday. Sancet drove in six runs in game-two and hit a game-tying two-run home run with two out in the seventh in game-three. On the season she is batting .326 with 33 RBI, seven home runs, 11 doubles and .574 slugging percentage.

Melody Mayse, Tarleton State University, was the catalyst for the TexAnn offense which scored 23 runs in three games en route to winning their fourth straight conference series. At ENMU over the weekend, the

freshman outfielder hit .636 at the plate, earning seven hits in 11 at bats while drawing one walk. Of her seven hits, three went for extra bases off the bat with a double, a triple and a home run while two more led to an extra base as she was a perfect 2-2 in stolen bases. She led the team in slugging (1.182) and on base percentage (.667) as well as runs scored (4).

Jaeleen Castro, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, had a tremendous weekend at Cameron. In the three game series, Castro hit .571 with a 1.145 slugging percentage and a .556 on-base percentage. She had a double and her second home run of the season. She tied for the team lead in RBI and was the only Javelina to score more than one run crossing the plate twice.

Tara Martini, Cameron University, helped carried the Aggies to a three game sweep of Texas A&M Kingsville last weekend. Martini batted .500 at the plate, scoring four runs, with three RBI, and a pair of stolen bases. She had a three hit day in the series opener with RBI and helped CU run-rule Kingsville in six innings. For the season, Martini is second on the team with a .395 batting average, with 26 runs scored, and 29 RBI.

Katelyn Vinson, Midwestern State University, continued her torrid pace at the plate by going 7-for-14 with three homers and seven RBIs to help Midwestern State to a 4-1 showing last week including a twin bill sweep of Henderson State before claiming two of three over No. 7-ranked Texas Woman's University over the weekend. The freshman from Southlake has accounted for multiple hits in 11 of her last 13 games while hitting 10 home runs during the stretch, but had her season-best 11-game hitting streak snapped when TWU pitched around her with nine-run lead in Game 1 Saturday. Vinson went 2-for-4 with a solo home run as the Mustangs came back for a 4-3 win over the Pioneers on Friday before slugging a two-run homer while going 2-for-3 with four runs to help the Mustangs outlast TWU 14-13 in the series finale on Sunday.

Kyra Sirag, Eastern New Mexico University, batted .412 last week and registered at least one hit in all but one of her five games. In the Zias' win over New Mexico Highlands, she hit two-for-three with a three-run homer and a walk. Sirag followed with a two-for-three outing, which included a double, in Eastern's first win over Tarleton State since the 2007 season.

Kelsy Hebert, Cameron University, pitched two stellar games in the circle for Cameron and earned two wins last weekend against Texas A&M Kingsville. In 10.1 innings of work she held batters to a .179 batting average and only two earned runs. Hebert went the distance in the first game of the series tossing six innings of work and giving up only an unearned run.

Despite suffering a loss in the series opener to Eastern New Mexico, Randi Fentress, Tarleton State University, bounced back to earn the victory in games 2 and 3, including a spectacular showing in the rubber game Saturday. With the series tied at one game a piece, Fentress went to the circle and tossed a gem. The junior hurler took a no-hitter down to the final batter of the game and eventually earned a complete game shutout victory to give the TexAnns their fourth straight conference series victory.

Katie Ramsay, Eastern New Mexico University, registered a win over Tarleton State and a save against New Mexico Highlands. She also led ENMU at the plate, with a .417 batting average, 1.000 slugging percentage, two home runs and a double. She tossed 5.1 innings in her victory over Tarleton State and batted two-for-three in the game with a RBI and a double.

Angelo State

The Rambelles dropped their first Lone Star Conference series to Incarnate Word this past weekend to fall to 25-12 overall and 10-5 in the LSC. ASU is No. 3 in the conference in fielding percentage with percentage of .960. Morgan Spearman is No. 4 with .38 stolen bases per game and Ambra Hill is No. 6 at .36. Kacie Easley averages .70 walks per game this season and is No. 3 in the LSC. Sandra Serna has the second-most wins with 17 and is No. 3 in shutouts with three. Easley is one home run away from tying the ASU career record for home runs. ASU will travel to Denton this weekend to face TWU on Friday and Saturday.

Cameron

The Aggie softball team stepped up big in a key conference series with Texas A&M-Kingsville, getting the three-game sweep of the Javelinas this weekend. In the doubleheader on Friday Cameron got a convincing 9-1 run rule victory over A&M-Kingsville, but had to battle in game two, the Aggies scored the winning run in the bottom of the sixth and then stranding the bases loaded in the top of the seventh to get the 4-3 win. In the final game of the series on Saturday, CU used two run first and fourth innings to get another 4-3 win over the Javelinas. Kelsey Hebert recorded two wins and went 10.1 innings while giving up two earned runs and striking out two Javelina batters. Samantha Betts went 9.2 innings, gave up two earned runs and struck out 13, recording a win and a save on the weekend. The Aggie offense was powered by Tara Martini, who 5-10 with four runs scored, three driven in, and two stolen bases, and Sonora Zukerman, who was 4-8 with a run scored, three driven in and her ninth homer of the season. The Aggies are scheduled to play Oklahoma Panhandle State on April 10 for a double header at Cameron Field.

Eastern New Mexico

After splitting a doubleheader at New Mexico Highlands, the Zias returned home to take an 8-6 decision from Tarleton State. The win marked ENMU's first win over the TexAnns, since splitting a four-game series in 2007. Tarleton State went on to win the next two games. The setback has Eastern one game behind Abilene Christian, for eighth in the Lone Star Conference standings. This week, the Zias will visit University of the Southwest and Texas A&M-Kingsville.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 3-2 for the week. They split a series at Texas A&M-International and then took 2-of-3 at No. 23 Angelo State. Whitney Waltrip factored in four decisions for the Cardinals going 3-1 on the week. On Wednesday, she picked up a win in relief at Texas A&M-International and then was tagged with a 5-4 loss while pitching a complete game in the night cap. Over the weekend, she was untouchable at No. 23 Angelo State. She tossed a complete game, 3-hit shutout in the second game of the series. She walked three and struck out four in the 3-0 win. On Sunday, she tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing four hits and a walk while striking out nine in a 1-0 win. She posted a 1.91 ERA for the week and is now 11-7 on the year. She also cracked

Midwestern State

Midwestern State rolled up a 4-1 week with a doubleheader sweep at Henderson State (Ark.) Tuesday before taking two of three from No. 7 Texas Woman's University last weekend at Mustangs Park... MSU is 6-4 against teams ranked in the NFCA Division II Top 25 this season... The Mustangs continue to lead NCAA Division II in team batting average at .368... MSU has connected on home runs in each of the last 13 games and have posted multiple long balls 18 times this season... Midwestern leads the Lone Star Conference with 57 home runs this season which is three shy of the program's all-time high of 60 set in 2011... The Mustangs needed just five innings to connect on a program single-game team record of five homers in Tuesday's 10-1 win over Henderson State... MSU boasts four of the top five hitters in the LSC this season including senior Elena Bennett (.523), freshman Katelyn Vinson (.505), sophomore Kelley Schaefer (.444) and junior Kim Jerrick (.435)... Jerrick drilled three homers last weekend and now has 15 bombs this season to match former teammate Mallory Mooney (2011) for the home runs in a single season in program history... Vinson has struck for 10 homers in her last 39 at bats dating back to March 23 against Angelo State. She is hitting .641 with a 1.462 slugging percentage while posting multiple hits in 11 of 13 games during the stretch... Vinson had her season-best 11-game hitting streak snapped when she was pitched around with Texas Woman's leading by nine runs in the fourth inning Saturday at Mustangs Park... Vinson's 12 home runs this season are the most hit by a freshman in MSU history surpassing the 11 hit by Kim Jerrick in 2011... Midwestern State battered the top two pitching staffs in the Lone Star Conference (TWU and West Texas A&M) to the tune of a .352 team average with nine home runs in six games while scoring 7.2 runs a contest. TWU and West Texas A&M boast team ERAs of 2.42 and 2.91 this season... The Mustangs suffered their worst loss in program history in a 15-1 run-rule rout in five innings in Game 1 Saturday against Texas Woman's University... MSU has allowed 14-or-more runs just four times in program history and three of those have come this season including 15 by TWU (4/6), 14 by Arkansas Tech (2/16) and 14 by West Texas A&M (3/16)... Four different MSU hitters boast hitting streaks of 10-or-more games this season including Kim Jerrick (17), Courtney Bingham (11), Katelyn Vinson (11) and Kelley Schaefer (11)... Eight different Mustangs have accounted for multiple hits in 10-or-more games this season including Kelley Schaefer (18), Katelyn Vinson (18), Kim Jerrick (16), Courtney Bingham (15), Elena Bennett (15), Christina Roomsmales (12), Haley Howerton (11) and Shelby Carter (10)...

Tarleton State

Tarleton traveled to Eastern New Mexico and took two out of three from the Zias. They dropped the opener but bounced back to win two straight. In the rubber game Saturday, Tarleton's Randi Fentress took a no-hitter down to the final batter and ended with a complete game shutout to notch Tarleton's fourth straight LSC series victory.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

Jaeleen Castro had a tremendous weekend at Cameron. In the three game series, Castro hit .571 with a 1.145 slugging percentage and a .556 on-base percentage. She had a double and her second home run of the season. She tied for the team lead in RBI and was the only Javelina to score more than one run crossing the plate twice...With a home run in the second game of the Cameron, series Adela Gomez had hit five bombs in a four-game stretch. She now has nine home runs on the year which is tied for second most in a season in school history. She is just two behind Quesha Torres who had 11 in 2007. With three RBI over the weekend, Gomez now has 35 on the season to move to eighth...Gomez hit .400 on the weekend and is now second on the team with a .298 average. She is not only first in home runs and RBI, but now first with 22 runs scored...Gomez now has six bombs in LSC play which is fourth this ...With 4-3 loss in each of the final two games of the Cameron series, Kingsville has now gone 1-5 in LSC games decide by two or fewer runs.

Texas Woman's

The Pioneers 34-9 on the season and 12-3 in the Lone Star Conference. TWU hit six home runs in the three-game series at Midwestern State to set a new single season team record for long balls with 54. The Pioneers broke the record set by last year's team with 52. Junior Katie Hines also drove in six runs to set a new single season RBI record with 61. She broke the record set by fellow teammate Kendra Sancet (60) in 2012. On the season Hines leads the team with .445 batting average, 20 home runs, RBI and .985 slugging percentage. She also has a 10-2 record in the circle. Junior Bailey Vrazel leads the Pioneers with 48 runs, six triples and 40 steals and second with .405 batting average. Junior Brandie Lander has a team-best 2.01 ERA, 14-4 record and 98 strikeouts.

West Texas A&M

The No. 2 Lady Buffs got back on the winning track this past weekend as they swept a three game Lone Star Conference series from the rival Wildcats of Abilene Christian during Turnin' 2 For Cancer Weekend at Schaeffer Park in Canyon. WT moved to 30-4 (12-3 LSC) on the season as the wins moved them into a tie for first place in the league. The Lady Buffs hit the road for five games this weekend as they take on Incarnate Word in a three game LSC series followed by a doubleheader at St. Edward's on Sunday afternoon.
