

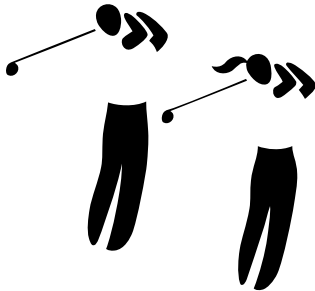

MEN'S

C.J. Clem, Texas A&M University - Commerce, SR, Rockwall, Texas, Rockwall HS

Clem opened up his senior season in style, placing fourth at the Newman Fall Invitational in Wichita, Kan. with 4-under 140. Clem's final round was one for the record books as he carded a 6-under 66, a new personal-best, logging eight birdies, eight pars and just two bogeys to help lead the Lions to a fourth-place finish. A 2013 NCAA Regional qualifier, Clem now has five top-10 finishes as he enters his second season at A&M-Commerce.

WOMEN'S

Jaqueline Strickland, Cameron University, JR, Weatherford, Texas, Weatherford HS

Strickland powered the Aggies with a career high second place finish after shooting a pair of 73s (2-over) at the Texas Wesleyan Invite. Her score helped carry Cameron to their first tournament win since the 2007 Lone Star Conference Championship, and their lowest team score in program history (598).

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Dylan McClure, Cameron University, fired off a 139 (70+69) at the Newman Invite finishing runner up in his Cameron debut. McClure, a junior transfer from the University of Kansas provided the stability at the top of the Aggie five to make a 15-stroke improvement from their first round score. On Tuesday, CU carded an invite low 287 to give them a 589 score finishing in third place.

Glory Jangthongsiri, West Texas A&M University, continued where she left off last season as she finished second at the CSU-Pueblo Invitational/RMAC #1. Jangthongsiri carded rounds of 73 and 71 for a an even par 144 on the par 72, 6,143-yard Desert Hawk Golf Club. She led her team to the second place finish as a team, just one stroke behind the host Thunderwolves. She was just two strokes behind medalist Hee-Leina Kim of CSUP. Both players tallied under par scores on Sunday, Kim with a 69 and Jangthongsiri with a 71.

The Cameron golf programs had a stellar opening week to their season with both teams getting top-three finishes. However, the highlight was the women's golf team getting their first regular season win in program history and first overall tournament win since the 2007 Lone Star Conference Tournament. The Cameron women shot a 598, a program low, and won after a three way playoff for the championship. On the men's side Cameron picked up 15-strokes in the second round of the Newman Invite to finish in third place with a 589 (302+287). Both teams will be in action again this next week with the women traveling to San Angelo for the Concho River Classic and the men heading to Amarillo for the Ryan Palmer Invite.

WT fired a 608 for the 36-hole tournament and was one shot behind the host Thunderwolves...
