

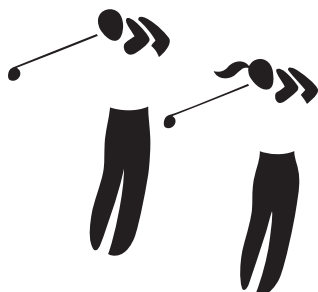

GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S

Logan Leggett, West Texas A&M University, SR, Amarillo, Texas, Randall HS

Fired an 8-under 208 (69-70-69) in the 2013 Ryan Palmer Foundation Invitational Monday and Tuesday at the Tascosa Golf Club in Amarillo and finished tied for fifth. He was the top LSC finisher in the tournament as both Cameron and Midwestern State were in the 16-team field. The Buffs carded rounds of 283, 290 and 287 for an 860 and tied for sixth. Leggett averaged a 69.3 for the first tournament of the year.

WOMEN'S

Glory Jangthongsiri, West Texas A&M University, SO, Bangkok, Thailand, Yothinburana School

Jangthongsiri set a school record with a 5-under 67 in the first round of the ASU Concho River Classic on Monday. Jangthongsiri won the 36-hole tournament with a 3-under 141 (67-74) for her second career win. She won the LSC Championship as a freshman last spring. The 5-under topped the previous school record of 4-under set by head coach Meredith Jameson in 2005. For the two tournaments this season, Jangthongsiri has a 71.25 stroke average for four rounds. Along with her championship Tuesday, she has a runner-up finish in the first tournament of the season.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Jaqueline Strickland, Cameron University, led the Aggies for the second week in a row at the Concho River Invite with a third place finish individually carding a 144 (74-70). Strickland helped keep Cameron in the hunt giving them a lead in the first day of the invite and carded the second lowest score in day two keeping Cameron in the top-three and finishing tied with Tarleton State. In her third season for CU has a second and third place finish, and had only one top five prior to this year. Presently, Strickland is hitting five strokes better than her career average in the Black & Gold.

Isabel Jimenez-Perea, Tarleton State University, carded a two-over-par 146 (73-73) to finish in a tie for fifth place in Tarleton State's first tournament of the season at the Concho River Classic in San Angelo. Jimenez-Perea shot one-over-par both days to help lead the TexAnns to a third place finish in the event.

The Cameron University golf teams both finished in the top six of their respected tournaments in deep fields. The women's team opened the Concho River Classic with a 299, which was the best team score in the first day. They would follow their first round score with a 304 to finish tied for third with Tarleton State. This was second top three finish for the Cameron women who are averaging a program best 300.25 per round this season. Jaqueline Strickland led the Aggies at the Concho River Invite with a third place finish individually carding a 144 (74+70). On the men's side, for the second week in a row Dylan McClure led the Aggies firing off a 1-under, 215 in the three-round Ryan Palmer Invite. The Cameron men improved in each round picking up 10-strokes over the course of the invite. Both teams will be off for the next couple of weeks before hitting the course one again.

The TexAnns finished in a tie for third place in the team's first event of the season, carding a two-day score of +27 (307-296=603) at the Concho River Classic in San Angelo... The TexAnns tied for the team-low round on Tuesday after scoring 11 strokes higher on Monday... Tarleton State's Isabell Jimenez-Perea fired a two-day score of +2 (73-73=146) and finishing in a tie for fifth place overall... True freshman Beatriz Prados carded a +4 (73-75=148) in her very first event for the TexAnns, finishing in a tie for seventh place... Maraea Durcie, a junior transfer for the TexAnns, led all individual players with a two-day score of +8 (78-73=151), finishing in a tie for 14th place... The TexAnns will have a three week layoff before getting back onto the course Oct. 14-15 at the DBU Classic in Dallas.

The West Texas A&M men's and women's golf teams were both in action this week as the men hosted the Ryan Palmer Foundation Invitational Monday and Tuesday at Tascosa Golf Club in Amarillo...The men finished tied for sixth in the 16-team field with a 54-hole score of 860 as they played some of the top teams in the region... Senior Logan Leggett finished tied for fifth with an 8-under 208 (69-70-69)...He was the top LSC finisher in the tournament...The Buffs opened the tournament with a great round of 283 and had a 287 and a 290 for the final two rounds...The women's team finished sixth at the ASU Concho River Classic, but had a career-outing by sophomore Glory Jangthongsiri...She set the school, low-round record of 5-under (67) in the first round and Jangthongsiri won her second career tournament...She won the 2013 LSC Championship last spring...WT dropped seven strokes from the first round to the second as sophomore Elise Strutt and junior Judy Papenfus each dropped a team-high six strokes...All four of the Lady Buffs' counting scores were in the 70s in the final round.
