LSC BASKETBALL

The Tarleton State men continued its hot start into the New Year, and are the only undefeated Lone Star Conference squad at 11-0. On the women's side, TSU and West Texas A&M top the standings with just one loss apiece.

League action dominates the schedule this week with only one non-conference game on the women's side. On Wednesday, the WT women host Midwestern State in a rematch of last year's tournament final, which the Mustangs won 85-83 in overtime.

The LSC men have a 65-29 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 19-8 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 1-3 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 56-39 overall. The women's squads are currently 12-10 combined against the Heartland, and 7-6 versus RMAC teams, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Tommy Woolridge, Angelo State University, JR, Guard, Chicago, Edwin G. Foreman HS

Woolridge hit five 3-pointers and finished with 19 points to help lead Angelo State to a 75-70 exhibition win over UTEP last Saturday in its lone game of the week. The five 3-pointers were a career-high for Woolridge. The junior guard has five double-digit scoring games this season and is averaging 7.8 points per game.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Xavier Blackburn, Midwestern State University, JR, Forward, New Iberia, La., St. Thomas More HS (North Dakota State Science)

Blackburn erupted for his first double-double of the season notching career bests with 17 points and 16 rebounds Wednesday against Oklahoma Wesleyan. The 6-4 junior just missed his second double-double of the week with 15 points and nine rebounds in Saturday's Lone Star Conference opening win over one-loss Texas A&M-Commerce. Blackburn averaged 16.0 points and 12.5 rebounds for the week while shooting 55.6 percent from the field to go along with three blocked shots and two steals.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Brianna Bledsoe, Tarleton State University, SR, Guard, Stephenville, Texas, Stephenville HS

Bledsoe was on fire from the floor last week, shooting .600 from the field on 12-20 shooting, .556 from beyond the arc on 5-9 shooting as well as going 6-8 at the charity stripe en route to 17.5 points per game in Tarleton's two wins this week. The senior began her week with a 17-point effort against Texas College in just 21 minutes of game time before. In Thursday's 114-39 win over the Steers, she also tied her career high with six assists and added five rebounds. In Saturday's LSC opening victory against Texas Woman's, Bledsoe continued her offensive pace with 18 points, two assists and three rebounds.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, SR, Center, Pittsburg, Texas, Pittsburg HS

Wright was a dominant force for the TexAnns' defense that allowed opponents to shoot just .291 from the floor and average 54.0 points in two games at Wisdom Gym. The senior center led Tarleton with 18 rebounds in the last two games - including 10 on the defensive end. She also had eight steals in the last two games, including five in Tarleton's Lone Star Conference opening win against Texas Woman's. For the week, she averaged 24.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 steals per game to lead Tarleton to back-to-back wins. She also recorded her seventh double-double of the season Saturday against TWU.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Chuck Guy, Tarleton State University, continued his dominance at the free throw line this week, netting a perfect 10-for-10 effort and extending his free throw streak to 30 consecutive shots made from the charity stripe. The Fort Worth native led the Texans in scoring for the fourth game this year and has registered double-figures in 10 of his 11 games after scoring 19 points in Tarleton's 11-point win over South Dakota Mines on Saturday.

Antjuan Ball, West Texas A&M University, continued to lead the potent Buffs offense this past Friday night as WT topped Hillsdale Baptist, 85-65 at the First United Bank Center in Canyon. The Collirene, Alabama native went 9-of-10 from the floor as the high flying junior forward connected on an incredible seven dunks while blocking two shots to go along with two assists and one steal while grabbing 12 rebounds (5 offensive, 7 defensive) for the double-double. Ball scored the opening six points of the second half for the Buffs in the 85-65 win to open-up their 2014 schedule.

DeJuan Plummer, Midwestern State University, splashed in a career-high five 3-pointers to finish with 21 points to lead Midwestern State to a decisive 84-73 win in its Lone Star Conference opener Saturday at Texas A&M-Commerce. The 5-10 guard from Detroit knocked down four treys in the opening half to help the Mustangs break open a close game and finished the night going 8-for-13 from the field to match a career high scoring output set earlier this season against East Central (Okla.). Plummer recorded a 15-point, 3-assist effort Wednesday against Oklahoma Wesleyan to bring his weekly scoring average to 18.0 points per game.

Cornelius Cammock, Eastern New Mexico University, helped lead Eastern New Mexico to a 2-0 record during

the week as he averaged 13.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 2.0 blocks and 1.5 blocks per game while shooting 54.2 percent from the field. Cammock recorded the Greyhounds first double-double of the season with a 17-point, 11-rebound performance in a 68-63 win over South Dakota School of Mines & Technology. Of his 11 rebounds, six were defensive and five came on the offensive glass. He shot a season-high 8-for-10 (80.0%) from the field while making 1-of-2 free throws while getting two steals and blocked a shot. Cammock followed by just missing his second straight double-double with 10 points and nine rebounds against Johnson & Wales (Colo.). Although he shot 5-for-14 (35.7%), Cammock tied his career-high he set earlier this season with three blocks. He was also credited with an assist and steal. Cammock is now averaging 11.1 ppg and 6.3 rpg.

Emmanuel Andrews, Tarleton State University, registered his best defensive effort in a Texan uniform on Saturday as he pulled down a career-high five rebounds and recorded a career-high three steals. His 23 minutes off the bench helped propel the No. 9-ranked Texans to a 79-68 win over South Dakota Mines, which extended Tarleton's home win streak to 16 straight games that dates back to last season. The current 16-game home win streak is the fourth longest in school history.

David Gibbs, West Texas A&M University, had one of his best games as a Buff this past Friday as West Texas A&M opened-up their 2014 schedule with an 85-65 victory over Hillsdale Baptist at the First United Bank Center. The East Hartford, Connecticut native went 5-of-9 (.556) from the floor including 1-of-3 from deep and a perfect 2-of-2 from the free throw line while registering three assists, two blocks and two steals to go along with 11 rebounds (4 offensive, 7 defensive) in the victory over the Saints.

Devone Davis, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 10.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.0 steals a game as Eastern New Mexico won both of their games during the week. His defensive performance helped the Greyhounds hold their opponents to 59.5 ppg while shooting 42.1 percent. Davis scored seven points with five assists and two rebounds against South Dakota School of Mines & Technology. He was 1-for-2 from the field and made his lone three-point attempt while going 4-of-8 at the free throw line. The next day Davis scored a team-high 14 points and four steals. It was his third straight game with two or more steals and seventh of the season. ENMU held Johnson & Wales (Colo.) to 37.3 percent from the field and 16.7 percent (3-18) on three-pointers. Davis made 5-of-8 field goal attempts including 2-for-4 on three-pointers along with a 2-of-3 performance at the charity stripe. He continues to lead the conference with 2.4 steals per game.

Kenny Williams, Angelo State University, helped Angelo State to a 75-70 exhibition win over UTEP with strong play on both sides of the court. Along with scoring 20 points, the senior also secured nine rebounds - six defensively. He also had a block for the Rams in the win in El Paso. He is averaging 17.8 points per game and 8.2 rebounds per game.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Amanda Weaver, Angelo State University, led Angelo State with 16 points in its LSC opening night win against Texas A&M-Commerce. The sophomore, who is tops in the league in three pointers made with 46.2-percent, hit three from behind the arc. The Center Point native also made 45.5-percent from the floor. Weaver grabbed four rebounds and had one steal in the win.

Dianna Jones, Midwestern State University, led team in a 1-1 week of Lone Star Conference action ... Jones scored 17 points in MSU's 71-64 loss at Texas A&M-Commerce and led the team with three assists, while she nearly double-doubled with eight assists and nine points in the Mustangs 70-59 win over Texas Woman's. The 5-9 junior guard from Hewitt, Texas/Midway shot 43.5 percent from the floor for the week (10-of-23) and nailed 6-of-7 from the foul line (85.7 percent). She averaged 5.5 assists with a 3.67 assist/turnover ratio and 2.5 steals fro the week as well.

Andrea Carter, Midwestern State University, recorded her fifth and sixth double-doubles of the season in leading Midwestern State to a split of games during the week. The 5-10 junior forward from Angleton, Texas, set and equalled her season-best with 13 rebounds in the 70-59 win over Texas Woman's and in the 71-64 loss at Texas A&M-Commerce. She scored 12 points against TWU and 15 versus A&M-C to average 13.5 points for the week to go with her 13.0 rebounds. Carter shot 47.8 percent from the floor (11-of-23) including 1-of-2 from the 3-point arc (50.0 percent) and 4-of-6 from the free throw line (66.7 percent). She averaged 4.0 assists for the week with 1.0 steals as well.

Angelo State

The Rams earned a 75-70 exhibition win over UTEP last Saturday in their only game of the week. ASU hit 11 3-pointers in the game against the Miners in El Paso. Kenny Williams scored 20 points and secured nine rebounds, while Tommy Woolridge had 19 points. Bryan Hammond led the Rams with five assists with Thomas Brandsma adding seven points and five rebounds. The Rams return to action at 8 p.m. on Wednesday against Tarleton State in Stephenville and will host Texas A&M-Commerce on Sunday at the Junell Center.

Cameron

Cameron went 1-0 last week taking down South Dakota School of Mines 55-53 at the Aggie Gym on Sunday. Will Cook led the Ags with 16 points and shot 50% from the field; he also sank the winning free throws in the final :30 seconds to give CU the win. The Aggie men also played an exhibition on New Year's Eve at UT-San Antonio. Cameron led a good part of the game before falling 64-56 late. Tank Mayberry lead the Aggies with a double-double and four blocks. Cameron will start LSC action at Eastern New Mexico and West Texas A&M this week.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 2-0 last week as they won at South Dakota School of Mines (68-63) and against Johnson & Wales (85-56) in Rapid City, S.D. Cornelius Cammock recorded the first double-double of the season for a Greyhound with a 17-point, 10-rebound performance versus the Hardrockers. He followed with 10 points and nine rebounds against the Eagles. Devone Davis averaged 10.5 ppg, 3.5 apg, 3.5 rpg and 3.0 spg while Rodney Blackmon put up 12.0 ppg, 2.5 apg and 2.5 rpg. Rafael Love also put up 12.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg and 2.0 apg in the two games. This week the Greyhounds begin conference play as they host Cameron on Wednesday night before traveling to face Midwestern State Saturday evening

Midwestern State

Midwestern State split a pair of games last week falling to Oklahoma Wesleyan before taking its Lone Star Conference opener at Texas A&M-Commerce... The loss against Oklahoma Wesleyan snapped MSU's 48-game winning streak against non-NCAA Division I/II competition dating back to the 1997-98 season... The Mustangs claimed a win in its third straight LSC opener with an 84-73 victory at Texas A&M-Commerce... MSU is now 10-8 in LSC lid lifters since joining the conference prior to the 1996-97 season including a 7-6 mark in openers away from D.L. Ligon Coliseum... Interestingly, the Mustangs have played their LSC opener on the road in 13 of its 18 seasons in the conference... The win over Texas A&M-Commerce was MSU's 60th with Nelson Haggerty at the helm... Senior guard Monzaigo Williams posted his second career double-double with 17 points and 10 assists Saturday at Texas A&M-Commerce. He recorded 14 points and 10 assists last season at Ouachita Baptist... Williams has scored in double figures in 14 straight games dating back to last season... Senior forward Eddie D'Haiti banged in two 3-pointers to finish with eight points and seven rebounds Saturday at A&M-C... Senior guard DeJuan Plummer splashed in a career-best five 3-pointers to match a career-high with 21 points Saturday at Texas A&M-Commerce... Junior forward Tavarion Nix had a season-high 11 points to go along with seven rebounds and four blocks Wednesday against Oklahoma Wesleyan... Junior forward Xavier Blackburn erupted for his first double-double of the season with 17 points and 16 rebounds with two blocks and a steal Wednesday against Oklahoma Wesleyan... Blackburn followed with a 15-point, 9-rebound effort Saturday at A&M-C... Senior guard Cam Adderley posted a season-high nine rebounds in each of his last two games... Junior forward Abiodun Adegoke posted season highs with six points and 11 rebounds in 13 minutes Saturday at A&M-C...

Tarleton State

The No. 9-ranked Texans moved to 11-0 on the season with a 79-68 non-conference win over South Dakota Mines on Saturday and extended its home winning streak to 16 straight games dating back to last season ... Tarleton's current 16-game home win streak is the fourth longest in school history ... In nine home games this year, Tarleton is averaging just under 94 points per game and its average margin of victory is +31.8 ppg ... The Texans have scored at least 75 points or more in 11 straight games this season - the most consecutive games in school history ... Tarleton has 16 straight wins against non-conference foes following Saturday's win ... Tarleton has four players averaging double figures on the season and are paced by Chuck Guy's 16.7 points per contest ... Guy also leads the squad with 67 assists and 22 steals ... Guy was a perfect 10-for-10 from the charity stripe on Saturday, extending his free throw streak to 30 consecutive attempts made ... The Texans will open up LSC play this week, hosting Angelo State on Wednesday and then traveling to Kingsville on Saturday to compete in its first official road game of the season.

West Texas A&M

The Buffaloes of West Texas A&M used the power

WT was led offensively by Antjuan Ball with 19 points and 12 rebounds for the double-double followed by Tez Dumars with 18, Drimir Ferguson with 14 and David Gibbs with 13 points to go along with 11 rebounds for the double-double while Gatewood finished 12 points. The Buffs went 33-of-73 from the floor including 9-of-30 from deep and 10-of-17 from the charity stripe to shoot 45.2% with 46 rebounds, 27 assists and just nine turnovers to go along with nine steals and four blocks. The Buffs open up Lone Star Conference action on Wednesday night as they host the rival Mustangs of Midwestern State in a First United Bank Highway 287 Challenge Cup matchup with the women starting things off at 5:30 p.m. followed by the men at the First United Bank Center.

The Angelo State women's basketball team is 7-4 overall and 1-0 in conference play ... The Belles defeated Texas A&M-Commerce 55-54 to open conference play ... It is the fifth-straight year the Belles have opened conference play with a win ... Weaver is tops in the LSC in three pointers made at 46.2-percent ... The Belles leading scorer, Hillari Adam, is sixth in the league in scoring and fourth in rebounding overall ... ASU is the LSC leader in scoring defense at 53.0 points per game while also limiting teams to a conference low 34.8-percent shooting from the field ... Haylee Oliver is sixth in the league averaging 3.3 assists per game ... Karli Kellermeier is fifth in the league in steals with 2.0 per game ... The Belles will play three conference games this weekend with a game at Tarleton State and home games against Texas Woman's and Texas A&M-Commerce.

Cameron was off officially this last week but they played North Texas in an exhibition on Jan. 4 at The Super Pit in Denton, Texas. Christina Caddy led the Aggies with 12 points and seven rebounds, Sasha Carter came up big with nine boards. Midwestern State

Midwestern State is 9-4 overall, 1-1 in Lone Star Conference action ... The Mustangs 71-64 overtime loss at Texas A&M-Commerce snapped a six-game winning streak for MSU and was the first loss to the Lions since Dec. 17, 2008 when A&M-Commerce beat MSU 79-72 in Wichita Falls ... A&M-C's 71 points marked just the fourth time this season MSU has allowed an opponent 70 or more points, with MSU 2-2 in those games ... It was also the fourth time MSU has scored less than 70 points, again sporting a 2-2 record when doing so ... MSU connected on just 29.3 percent of its shots (24-of-82) against A&M-C ... The Mustangs were 1-of-20 from the 3-point arc against the Lions (5.0 percent), attempting the most 3-point shots while only connecting on one in the Noel Johnson era. MSU has not made a three in a game three times in the Johnson era, but took a maximum of 10 attempts ... MSU opened the week

by beating Texas Woman's 70-59 at home in Ligon Coliseum ... The Mustangs are 18-3 in Lone Star Conference games at Ligon Coliseum since the start of the 2011-12 season and have won three straight LSC contests at home dating back to last season ... MSU had outrebounded six straight opponents before losing the board war to A&M-Commerce (59-44). Still the Mustangs are outrebounding their opponents for the season ... Junior forward Andrea Carter of Angleton, Texas recorded her fifth and sixth double-double of the season during the week with her 12 points/13 rebounds against TWU and her 15 points/13 rebounds at A&M-C ... Carter has recorded three consecutive double-doubles and was a rebound shy at Texas-Permian Basin from having five consecutive double-doubles ... Carter's 13 rebounds over the last two games are season highs in board work for her and MSU ... Carter is still third in scoring (15.0) and rebounding (9.1) in the LSC, while ranking sixth in field goal percentage (54.4 percent, 74-of-136), fourth in blocked shots (0.5 per game), 10th in steals (1.6 per game) and 11th in free throw percentage (73.7 percent, 42-of-57) ... Junior Dianna Jones of Hewitt, Texas/Midway, is second in the LSC in assist/turnover ratio (1.90) and is third in assists (4.54 per game). Jones is seventh in the league in steals (1.77 per game), ninth in free throw percentage (76.8 percent, 53-of-69) and 13th in the scoring (11.2 ppg) ... Senior Kirsti Degelia of Denton, Texas/Krum is fifth in the LSC in assists (3.38 per game), fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.52), 10th in 3-point percentage (35.6 percent, 16-of-45), 11th in 3-pointers per game (1.2), 13th in steals (1.46 per game) and 18th in scoring (10.4 ppg) ...

Tarleton State

Tarleton State went 2-0 to begin the 2014 calendar year, starting with a 114-39 victory over Texas College on Thursday. This is the seventh time Tarleton has topped the century mark since joining the NCAA and the first time since Feb. 1, 2012. The TexAnns had a quick turnaround to host Texas Woman's on Saturday in the Lone Star Conference opener and pushed their winning streak to seven with an 87-69 win. The victory over TWU on Saturday was also Ronnie Hearne's 200th career victory in his 11 years at Tarleton.

TWU opened the Lone Star Conference schedule with two tough losses on the road. The Pioneers fell at Midwestern State, 70-59, on Jan. 2 before dropping an 87-69 decision at Tarleton State on Jan. 4. Freshman Kenesha Saygo came off the bench and led the team on offense with 11.5 points per game. Junior Ria Pateraki averaged 11.0 points and was the top rebounder with 8.5 rebounds per game. On the season senior Rebekah Cluley leads the team with 11.2 ppg while Saygo is second with 10.1 ppg. Cluley is also the leaders in assists (32) and steals (15). Pateraki is averaging a team-best 4.7 rebounds.
