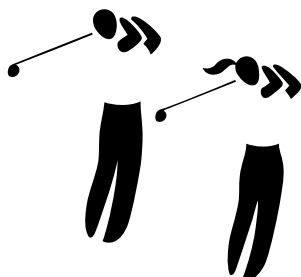

Ashley Rivera, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SR, McAllen, Texas, McAllen HS
Rivera's first round score of five-under-par 67 at the UHV Fall Shootout shattered the school record, previously held by her sister Brandy Rivera, who set the mark last season. The senior concluded the first day tied for second place with a six-under-par 138, three strokes behind leader Heather Shake. Rivera finished the UHV Fall Shootout with a one-under-par 215 (67-71-77), good for third place.

Brenna Moore, Midwestern State University, SR, Burkburnett, Texas, Burkburnett HS
Moore set the school 54-hole standard by firing a 215 (+2) to help Midwestern State to a ninth-place showing at the GolfWeek Invitational in Sunriver, Oregon. The senior from Burkburnett carded rounds of 73, 72 and 70 to place fourth on the individual leaderboard. Moore, who delivered her 10th career sub-par round, ranks 15th nationally in the latest GolfStat rankings.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Mattye Mason, West Texas A&M University, finished fifth at the Lady Buff Stampede with a 5-over 147 on rounds of 74 and 73. She earned all-tournament honors as she helped lead the team to a second place finish this week. It was Mason's best finish of her young career.

Midwestern State Women's Golf finished ninth at the GolfWeek Fall Invitational played at the Sunriver (Ore.) Resort's Meadows Golf Course... The Mustangs are ranked 45th in the most recent GolfStat rankings with an average team score of 307.00... Senior Brenna Moore ranks 15th individually in GolfStat rankings after finishing tied for fourth at the GolfWeek Fall Invitational with a 2-over, three-round total of 215... Moore's 54-hole total of 215 at the GolfWeek Fall Invitational is the lowest in school history bettering the previous mark of 222 set by Kendra Whittle, Kyla Whittle and Lindsay Burkhart at the 2011 Lone Star Conference Women's Championship... Moore delivered her 10th career Par-or-better round firing a 1-under 70 in the final round... Sophomore Sierra Campbell delivered three team-countable scores to finish tied for 22nd with a three-round total of 227 (+14)... Talk about a quick start. A year after finishing second in the inaugural University of Houston-Victoria Fall Shootout, Texas A&M-Kingsville began its 2014-15 campaign shooting a program record 292 in the first round on day one of the UHV Fall Classic on Monday morning at the Victoria Club at Colony Creek. The score was good enough to give the Javelinas a slight edge over host and defending champion UHV, but TAMUK ended the first day of competition in second place with a two-round score of 601, also a school record. The Javelinas closed out the event in third place with a score of 905, behind host and champion Houston-Victoria (869) and Mary Hardin-Baylor (897).
