LSC SOFTBALL

West Texas A&M started the season with a perfect 5-0 record at the Desert Stinger Invite for the second straight year. Lone Star Conference teams continue non-conference play this week.

LSC teams playing a single round-robin schedule with a four games against each league opponent. Teams will face schedule partners in doubleheaders at split sites, and all other opponents in a 3-game series (doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day) plus one game at the LSC Showcase, which will be hosted by MSU in Wichita Falls, March 13-16.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 2-3, at the No. 1 seed.

LSC softball teams are 31-24 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 10-10 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 6-1 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER

Kendra Sancet, Texas Woman's University, JR, 1B, Magnolia, Texas, Magnolia HS

Sancet helped the Pioneers to 4-1 record at the Desert Stinger Invite with a team best 11 RBI, four home runs and seven runs. She recorded a .500 batting average (8-for-16), 1.313 slugging percentage and .579 on base percentage in the five games. Five of Sancet's eight hits were extra base hits including four long balls. On the season she leads the Lone Star Conference with 16 RBI, five home runs, five doubles and 15 hits. Sancet also has a team-best 1.094 slugging percentage.

CO-PITCHERS

Brandie Lander, Texas Woman's University, SR, P, Gun Barrel City, Texas, Mabank HS

Lander posted a 0.71 ERA with a 2-0 record and one save in four appearances at the Desert Stinger Invite. She tossed 19.2 innings and allowed just two earned runs while striking out 10 batters. Lander also tossed two complete games and one shutout while holding the opponent batters to a .225 batting average. On the season she has 5-0 record with five complete-game wins, 1.71 ERA and 27 strikeouts. Lander also leads the Lone Star Conference in wins and innings pitched (41.0) and second in ERA.

Rita Hokianga, West Texas A&M University, JR, P, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand, Hukarere Girls College

Hokianga dominated the Desert Stinger Invite in Las Vegas during her first weekend as a Lady Buffs as the junior lefty went 4-0 with a 2.40 ERA in 23.1 innings pitched with seven walks to go along with 35 strikeouts. The Hawke's Bay, New Zealand native took a perfect game into the fifth inning against No. 1 Central Oklahoma on Saturday afternoon while registering a pair of 12 strikeout performances against CSU-Pueblo and UC-Colorado Springs in a complete game shutout while allowing an opponent batting average of .186.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Bailey Offill, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, continues to be off to a strong start for her senior campaign with the Javelinas. In last week's twin-bill with Huston-Tillotson, Offill led the way with a .600 average (3-of-5) at the plate in two starts, a 1.000 slugging percentage and .667 on-base percentage. The second baseman finished with a .476 batting average leading the team. She also led the team with four doubles, five runs batted in and six runs scored. Offill had a .667 slugging pct and .533 on-base percentage.

Renee Erwin, West Texas A&M University, picked-up where she led off last season during her All-American campaign as she hit .500 with two doubles and two dingers to drive in a team high eight RBI with a slugging percentage of .944 on the weekend while also going a perfect 4-for-4 on stolen bases for the No. 8 Lady Buffs as they went 5-0 to leave the Desert Stinger Invite in Las Vegas unbeaten for the second straight season.

Emily Nix, Cameron University, hit .400 in three games for the Aggies in 10 at bats. Nix had her first career grand slam at Cameron against Henderson State and followed that with a homer later in the day. She had seven RBI and racked up a 1.000 slugging percentage over the course of those three games.

Darian Dunn, Angelo State University, led the Rambelles with nine RBIs and two home runs at the George McCorkle Classic. Her 3-run home run against Drury was the difference maker in the 3-1 win. The sophomore had a slugging clip of .786 and finished with 11 total bases over the weekend. Dunn ended up with a .357 average in the five games.

Tylor Romero, Eastern New Mexico University, drove in four runs in the Zias' victory over University of the Southwest. Over her two games, she has posted a .500 slugging percentage and .429 on-base percentage.

Kat Tapley, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, earned her first win as a member of the Javelinas in her start against Huston-Tillotson. The sophomore transfer tossed 5.0 shutout innings without allowing a hit or run. She struck out seven batters before Ariel Kellogg completed the shutout with two innings versus the Rams.

Sandra Serna, Angelo State University, went 1-1 over the weekend including a three-hit shutout of Texas A&M-International. The senior limited teams to a .183 batting average and only allowed six runs, five earned, in four appearances. She threw 17.1 innings including two complete games. Against Texas A&M-International, Serna threw seven innings only allowing three hits and one walk while striking out two.

The TWU softball team posted a 4-1 record at the Desert Stinger Invite in Las Vegas, Nev., last week and improved its overall mark to 7-3. Junior Kendra Sancet led the team with 11 RBI, four home runs, 1.313 slugging percentage and seven runs. She also recorded a .500 (8-for-16) batting average and .579 on base percentage. Five of Sancet's eight hits were extra base hits including four long balls. Junior Sarah Wittenburg led the team with a .538 batting average while freshman Alyssa Galaz recorded a .500 batting average, seven RBI and .778 slugging percentage. In the circle Brandie Lander posted a 2-0 record with a 0.71 ERA and two complete games. She also had a save. Senior Amanda Ruiz started in the circle in one game for the first time in over a year and picked up a win. On the season Sancet leads the Lone Star Conference with 16 RBI, five home runs, five doubles and 15 hits. Sancet also has a team-best 1.094 slugging percentage while Lander has a LSC best 5-0 record.

West Texas A&M

The No. 8 Lady Buffs of West Texas A&M left the Desert Stinger Invite in Las Vegas, Nev., unbeaten for the second straight season as they picked up wins over CSU-Pueblo, St. Mary's, No. 1 Central Oklahoma, Western New Mexico and UC-Colorado Springs to move to 5-0 on the season. The Lady Buffs return to action next weekend as they host the Woodward WT Invitational at Schaeffer Park in Canyon with scheduled games against Adams State, Metro State, Colorado Mesa, Fort Lewis and CSU-Pueblo in the three-day event.
