MEN'S

Jay Cox, Texas A&M University - Commerce, JR, Paris, Texas, North Lamar HS

Cox fired a tournament-low 69 in the opening round of the Jack Brown Memorial Invitational at Laredo Country Club, and followed that up with a 74 in the second round to claim the tournament's individual title by one stroke. The final round was cancelled due to inclement weather in the Laredo area. He was the only player in either round of the seven-team field to shoot a round in the 60s, and his 69 was one of only five sub-par rounds in the tournament.

Jaqueline Strickland, Cameron University, JR, Weatherford, TX, Weatherford HS

Earned her fourth top-10 finish this season for the Aggies at World Golf Invitational in Florida with a seventh place tie with an 151 (80-71). In a tough tournament field that included No. 1 Lynn, No. 7 Flagler, and No. 10 Saint Leo, Strickland battled a soaked golf course in the opening round to card an 80 but shot the second lowest score in the invite field in day two carding a 71 off of five birdies.
