LSC SOFTBALL

West Texas A&M continued to cruise last week and improved to 17-0, which extended the best start to a season in program history. The Lady Buffs Allie Cranfill made history as she connected on her sixth career grand slam to tie the NCAA Division II record with former teammate Meghan Slattery.

Lone Star Conference teams begin league play this week with Texas A&M-Kingsville at Texas Woman's, Eastern New Mexico at Cameron, Angelo State at Tarleton State, and WT at Midwestern State.

LSC teams are playing a single round-robin schedule with a four games against each league opponent. Teams will face schedule partners in doubleheaders at split sites, and all other opponents in a 3-game series (doubleheader one day and single 7-inning game the other day) plus one game at the LSC Showcase, which will be hosted by MSU in Wichita Falls, March 13-16.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 2-3, at the No. 1 seed with the top six teams qualifying.

LSC softball teams are 82-53 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 33-23 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 28-9 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER

Jessica Sipe, West Texas A&M University, SR, Third Base, Phoenix, Ariz., Mountain View HS

Sipe continued to lead the charge offensively for the No. 2 Lady Buffs this past week as they moved to 17-0 with doubleheader sweeps of Oklahoma Christian, Texas A&M-International and Newman to extend their best start in program history as WT heads into conference play this weekend at Midwestern State. The senior third baseman hit .714 on the weekend with three doubles, one triple and three home runs to drive in 11 RBI with four walks and a stolen base while registering a .929 fielding percentage with three putouts and 10 assists at the hot corner. Sipe tallied an incredible 1.714 slugging percentage on the week with an on-base percentage of .750 while scoring seven of WT's 59 runs during the week. The Phoenix, Arizona native hit .750 with a double, triple and home run to drive in four RBI during a doubleheader sweep of Oklahoma Christian on Tuesday in Oklahoma City. The senior registered the first hit, RBI and triple in OC's brand new facility.

PITCHER

Hannah Newcomb, West Texas A&M University, SO, Pitcher, Frisco, Texas, Wakeland HS

Newcomb dominated the circle for the No. 2 Lady Buffs this past week as they won all four games during the 2014 Lady Buff Invite in Canyon with doubleheader sweeps of Texas A&M-International and Newman at Schaeffer Park to go along with a doubleheader sweep of Oklahoma Christian on Tuesday afternoon. The sophomore right-hander from Frisco went 3-0 in the circle with a 0.00 ERA, tossing three complete game shutouts while only allowing seven hits, six walks and striking out 16 opposing batters to allow a batting average of just .119 on the week as the Lady Buffs moved to 17-0 to extend their best start in school history. Friday night saw the sophomore toss a complete game shutout against Texas A&M-International, allowing just two hits while walking one and striking out five DustDevils in the 10-0 victory in five innings.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Morgan Spearman, Angelo State University, hit .667 in a doubleheader sweep of UTPB. The senior scored three runs and plated three RBIs with one double. She was one of three players with a 1.000 slugging clip and was second on the team with a .625 on-base percentage.

Alyssa Galaz, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers to a doubleheader sweep against St. Edward's in the home opener on Saturday. In the two games last week she drove in five of the eight runs with a .600 batting average and 1.200 slugging percentage. On the season the freshman is batting .315 with 18 RBI, 3 home runs, 3 doubles and 7 runs.

Breezy McComas, Cameron University, went 5 for 9 for the Cameron Aggies last weekend in four games with a .556 batting average and robust 1.889 slugging percentage. Each of the hits from the true freshman were either triples or a homer. On Friday in game one against Newman in a 7-2 win, McComas matched a league mark with two triples. She added her third three-bagger of the weekend in game one against Texas A&M International. To wrap up the trip to Canyon, McComas had back-to-back two run homers in a 10-1 win in five innings over A&M International.

Kim Jerrick, Midwestern State University, notched three multiple-hit games and blasted her Lone Star Conference leading seventh homer while going 10-for-20 with two homers while driving in three runs and scoring seven more last weekend at the St. Mary's Rattler Invitational. The senior from Belle Plaine, Kan. slugged her sixth home run Saturday against Western Oregon before connecting on a solo shot Sunday against St. Mary's to break up a Vianna Gutierrez' run of nine-straight outs in the fourth inning.

Kyra Sirag, Eastern New Mexico University, batted .400 over five games last weekend and hit safely in four of them. She registered a base hit against 14th-ranked St. Mary's and hit .500 against Oklahoma Christian's pitching in two contests. Sirag split time at catcher and outfield and posted a perfect fielding percentage, with one base stealer tossed out.

Katie Hines, Texas Woman's University, tossed a complete game against St. Edward's and picked up her second win of the season. She struck out a career-high 8 batters to help the Pioneers to their seventh straight

win. Hines also drove in two runs in the doubleheader against SEU.

Kenedy Urbany, Angelo State University, limited UTPB to only four hits in seven innings pitched to move to 6-1 on the season. The freshman only allowed one run and struck out four to finish the doubleheader sweep for ASU.

Vanessa Ramirez, Eastern New Mexico University, posted a 1.85 earned run average over four appearances, which included 8.2 innings against No. 14 St. Mary's and defending NCAA Division II National Champion, Central Oklahoma.

Angelo State

The Rangelles moved to 11-5 overall after a doubleheader sweep of UTPB ... ASU has the No. 4, 5 and 6 hitters in average with Morgan Spearman, Darian Dunn and Micherie Korla ... Dunn leads the team with eight multi-hit games and nine multi-RBI games this season ... Dunn is the conference leader with 32 RBIs ... Serna and Urbany are fourth and fifth in ERA in the league ... Urbany moved to 6-1 on the season after holding UTPB to five hits on Saturday ... ASU will host St. Mary's this Thursday before opening conference play against Tarleton State in Stephenville on Friday.

Cameron

Cameron went 3-1 last week in Canyon, Texas splitting a doubleheader with Newman and sweeping Texas A&M International. The Aggies on Friday matched a LSC record with a four triple game in a 7-2 win over the Jets. Breezy McComas hit .556 with a 1.889 slugging percentage, of her five hits last week three were triples and two were homers. Makenzie Burk went 7 for 9 with five stolen bases and a .778 average. In the circle, Sam Betts went 2-0 with a 1.17 ERA, and nine strikeouts. Cameron has won 11 of their last 12 games and they will host Eastern New Mexico to open league play at home on Friday and Saturday.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University softball team posted yet another dramatic win, with Amanda Martinez driving in the game-winning run in the Zias' final at bat against Rogers State. ENMU also made strong showings against #14 St. Mary's, defending national champion Central Oklahoma and Oklahoma Christian, last weekend. For the weekend, Cailin Garmon and Kyra Sirag batted .400 and .429, while Vanessa Ramirez posted an ERA of 1.85. This weekend, the Zias will open Lone Star Conference play at Cameron.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State posted a 2-4 mark in the St. Mary's Rattler Invitational last weekend in San Antonio... The Mustangs played in seven straight games and nine of 10 contests which were decided by three runs or less... MSU has connected for at least one home run in 16 of 18 games this season for a total of 29 or 1.6 per game... Sophomore outfielder Haley Howerton hit .500 (21-of-42) with eight doubles, a triple and five stolen bases during a career-best 12-game hitting streak from Feb. 2-22... Junior shortstop Katy Vandewater is riding a season-best nine-game hitting streak while hitting .464 (13-of-28) during the run with two doubles, two homers and seven RBIs... Senior catcher Kim Jerick .500 (10-for-20) with three walks with two homers and three RBIs while scoring seven runs from the leadoff spot with two stolen bases

last weekend at the St. Mary's Rattler Invitational... Jerick posted three consecutive multiple-hit games and has nine games with 2-or-more hits this season... Freshman Baylee Voigt struck for her fourth home run in her 26th at bat of the season Sunday against Western Oregon... Freshman Erin Knox has won her last three starts posting a 2.95 ERA over 19.0 innings allowing 19 hits with 10 strikeouts and four walks... Sophomore pitcher Kat Batey hasn't allowed run in her last nine innings of relief... Batey boasts a 1.31 ERA allowing seven hits in 10 2/3 innings as a relief pitcher this season... Freshman pitcher Katlyn Holmes allowed 25 hits in 14 innings of work last weekend in the St. Mary's Rattler Invitational, but only one of those went for extra bases... Junior first baseman Katelyn Potts posted back-to-back two-hit efforts driving in a total of four runs against Oklahoma Christian and St. Mary's... Of Potts' five hit this, four have gone for extra bases including two doubles and two homers...

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Texas A&M-Kingsville softball team went 0-2 last week with only a mid-week doubleheader with St. Edwards. They lost game one of the twin bill 4-2 before dropping the second game 5-0 to fall to 5-11 on the season. Kingsville has lost six straight contests... The Javelinas travel to Denton for the start of Lone Star Conference play against Texas Woman's... Taylor McGill was the lone Javelina to get more than one hit on the day going 2-for-3 with the double. She finished with a team-best .333 average. Along with Carynn Gonzales, McGill was one of two Hoggies to record a double in the loss... Ariel Kellogg suffered the defeat in the 5-0 loss and was hurt by defensive errors. She allowed just one earned in the outing and didn't walk a hitter... Bailey Offill entered the doubleheader with a 13-game hitting streak, but went 0-for-5 with a walk.

Texas Woman's

The TWU softball team made its 2014 home debut on Saturday with a doubleheader sweep against visiting St. Edward's and improved its overall record to 14-3. Pitching played a prominent role in the Pioneers success as TWU senior Brandie Lander tossed a complete game shutout in game one and fellow TWU senior Katie Hines tossed a complete game and struck out a career-high eight batters in game two. Freshman Alyssa Galaz drove in a total of five runs in both games for the Pioneers, including four in game two. On the season junior Kendra Sancet leads the team on offense with a .444 average, 6 home runs, 6 doubles, 21 RBI and .889 slugging percentage. Lander leads the pitching staff with an 11-0 record, 1.07 ERA, 5 complete-game shutouts and 50 strikeouts.

West Texas A&M

The #2 Lady Buffs continued to roll this past week as they picked up doubleheader sweeps of Oklahoma Christian, Texas A&M-International and Newman to run their season record to 17-0 to extend their best start to a season in program history. The Lady Buffs hit .405 as a team during their six games this past week with 13 doubles, five triples and 11 homeruns to score 59 runs while only allowing six. The WT pitching staff registered four complete game shutouts on the week with a staff ERA of 1.20 with 45 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .168. WT's Allie Cranfill made history on Saturday afternoon as she connected on her sixth career grand

slam to tie the NCAA Division II record with former teammate Meghan Slattery, who was in attendance. The Lady Buffs open-up Lone Star Conference play this weekend as they head to Wichita Falls, Texas for a Highway 287 Challenge Cup matchup with the rival Mustangs of Midwestern State. The three game series will start on Friday night at 7 p.m. followed by a Saturday doubleheader with first pitch set for 1 p.m.
