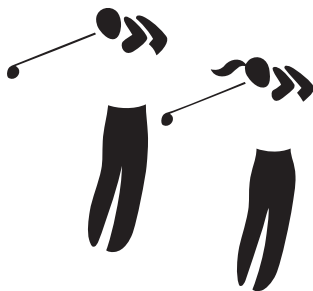

Glory Jangthongsiri, West Texas A&M University, SO, Bangkok, Thailand, Yothinburana School

Jangthongsiri finished third at the Cal Baptist Women's Invitational this week on the Victoria Club Course. She fired rounds of 73 and 79 on the par 73 course for a 6-over 152. Jangthongsiri led the team to finish third in the team standings. Her 73 to open the tournament was one of just three rounds of par or better for the tournament. She was the only Lady Buff to shoot both rounds in the 70s and one of just seven for the tournament of the 62-player field. It was Jangthongsiri's fifth top three finish in six tournaments this season.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Hayley Dambold, Midwestern State University, led Midwestern State to a fourth place team finish at the California Baptist Invitational in Riverside, Calif. ... The true freshman from Highland Village, Texas/Flower Mound Marcus fired her season-low with a 2-over 73 on the par 73, 5,842 yard Victoria Club in the first round. She finished ninth with a 156, her third top 10 performance of the season. It was the first time Dambold led MSU at a tournament this season.

The Midwestern State women placed fourth at the 12-team California Baptist Invitational ... MSU has a first and a fourth in their two spring tournaments this season ... the team that has one junior, one sophomore and the balance true freshmen placed fifth in their first fall tournament and have not placed lower than fourth since then as they have recorded a win, a second, a third and two fourths ... The MSU women are open until the MSU Invitational on March 17-18 at The Champions Course at Weeks Park in Wichita Falls ... Freshman Hayley Dambold posted her best score of the season with her 2-over-par 75 at the CBU Invitational. She led MSU with a ninth place finish at 156, recording her third top 10 performance of the season ... Junior Brenna Moore's streak of five straight top 10 finishes ended at the Cal Baptist Invitational as she placed 11th at 160, two strokes from the top 10. This followed her last three tournaments of a pair of seconds and the win at the Jack Brown Memorial in Laredo ... Moore continues to lead the Mustangs with a 74.55 scoring average ...

The Midwestern State men were idle last week after finishing third at the San Antonio Shootout to start the fall season ... The Mustangs third place finish was the third time MSU has finished in the top 4 in 2013-14 and the fourth top 10. The 11th place finish at the season opening Ryan Palmer Invitational in September is the only tournament the Mustangs haven't been ninth or better ... Junior Derek Oland leads MSU with a 71.69 scoring average with four rounds in the 60s and eight of his 13 rounds of par or better ...

Tarleton State

The No. 7-ranked TexAnns were off this week and will return to action this Sunday and Monday, Mar. 2-3, at the Las Vegas Desert Classic, hosted by Missouri-St. Louis ... The event will be held at Paiute Golf Club in Las Vegas ... Sophomore Isabel Jimenez-Perea enters the next tournament averaging 71.9 strokes per round, which still ranks No. 1 in the nation among DII players ... Four of her 10 rounds this season have been played under-par.

The Lady Buffs finished third at the Cal Baptist Women's Invitational this week on the Victoria Club course in Riverside, Calif..The Lady Buffs carded rounds of 310 and 332 for a 642 score and edged LSC member Midwestern State by three strokes for third...Sophomore Glory Jangthongsiri finished third with a 6-over 152 score on rounds of 73 and 79...She earned her fifth top three finish in six tournaments this season and was the lone Lady Buff to shoot both rounds in the 70s and one of seven for the tournament...She opened with a 73 as just three of the 62-player field had par or better in a round in the tournament...It was a nice rebound from a disappointing performance last week in San Antonio at the Lady Rattler Invitational where WT finished 9th.
