GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S

Derek Oland, Midwestern State University, JR, McKinney, Texas, Boyd HS

Oland placed fourth individually and led Midwestern State to a fourth place team finish at the Central Regional Crossover held at the Buffalo Dunes Golf Course in Garden City, Kan. Oland fired a 2-under-par 142 in the event that was weather-shortened to 36 holes. Oland sports the lowest stroke average in the Lone Star Conference with a 71.60, which is sixth in Division II.

WOMEN'S

Katie Johnston, Cameron University, FR, Crowley, Texas, Crowley HS

Johnston finished first overall at the Lion Invitational after carding a 155 (75-80) two strokes ahead of the field this last week. The individual win by Johnston was also the first in program history for women's golf at Cameron. As a true freshman, Johnston has a pair of top-3 finishes this season and has averaged 81.38 per round.

The Cameron women's golf team won the Lions Invitational by 20 strokes after carding a 643 for their second team win of the season. Katie Johnston was the overall invite winner by two strokes after carding a 155 (75-80) and she is the first women's golfer in program history to individually win a regular season invite. Lindsey Alexander finished on the All-Tournament team with a 159 (84-75) for fifth place, her second round score was tied for the lowest of the 71 players competing. Cameron will return to the course on March 17-18 for 36 holes in Wichita Falls, Texas.

The Midwestern State men finished fourth in the Central Regional Crossover hosted by Colorado Mines at the Buffalo Dunes Golf Course in Garden City, Kan. ... MSU was the only Lone Star Conference team in the 16-team field that included most of the Rocky Mountain and Heartland Conference schools ... MSU had two finishers in the Top 15, with junior Derek Oland fourth at 2-under-142 and senior Jeremy LeGuen at 2-over 146 ... The tournament was halted during the third round after extremely high winds and cold temperatures made conditions unplayable ... MSU is fifth in scoring in the South Central Region according to GolfStat with an average score of 295.40, with Derek Oland third in the region in scoring with a 71.60 stroke average ... The Mustangs are ranked 46th nationally by GolfStat ... The Mustangs host the MSU Invitational on Monday and Tuesday, March 17-18, at the Wichita Falls Country Club.

The Mustangs women were idle last week ... MSU is ranked 25th nationally by GolfStat, and is 15th in Division II in scoring, averaging 311.91 a tournament ... Junior Brenna Moore is seventh in scoring, with a 74.55 stroke average ... The Mustangs host the MSU Invitational on Monday and Tuesday, March 17-18, at the Champions Course at Weeks Park.
