### LSC BASEBALL

West Texas A&M took three of four from Tarleton State to remain atop the Lone Star Conference standings.

This week's schedule includes Cameron at WT, Tarleton State at Texas A&M-Kingsville, and Eastern New Mexico at Angelo State.

In 2014, LSC teams are playing a 10-week schedule with a four-game series and three-game series against every other team. Each four-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday, a 7x7 doubleheader Saturday and 9-inning contest Sunday, and each three-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday and a 7x9 doubleheader Saturday.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 8-10, at the No. 1 seed with the top four teams qualifying.

LSC baseball teams are 97-66 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 17-6 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-5 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### HITTERS

**Christian Summers, Angelo State University, SR, Shortstop, San Angelo, Texas, Central HS**

Summers led the ASU offense throughout the weekend against Texas A&M-Kingsville, going 7-for-12 with two doubles, a triple and three RBI. The senior also walked twice and was 2-for-2 on stolen base attempts. He also recorded a save on the mound for the Rams, finishing off the Javelinas with a strikeout on Saturday in his first pitching appearance of his career.

**Dylan Dyson, West Texas A&M University, JR, INF, Tucson, Ariz., Flowing Wells HS**

Went .333 from the plate with seven hits in 21 at bats, including scoring three runs and driving in a team-high six. He tallied a .571 slugging percentage with two doubles and a home run, while reaching base at a .440 clip helping WT to a 4-1 record on the week and its fourth conference series win of the season.

#### PITCHERS

**Matthew Artalejo, Eastern New Mexico University, JR, RHP, Westminster, Colo., Stanley Lake HS/Northeastern JC**

Artalejo pitched a school-record 11 innings in a complete game, 1-0 shutout over Cameron in the second game of the series. The Westminster, Colo. native struck out four while allowing just four hits and two walks as he held the Aggies to a .118 batting average. He put CU batters down in order six times and had seven assists. For the season, Artalejo is now 4-2 with a 3.20 ERA and 23 strikeouts.

**Josh Weyker, West Texas A&M University, SR, RHP, Tucson, AZ, Sahuaro HS**

Weyker tossed his fifth complete game and fourth complete game shutout in a 7-0 victory at Tarleton State to take a 3-0 series lead. Weyker improved to 5-2 on the year and dropped his ERA to 0.98. Weyker pitched seven innings, allowing four hits with two walks and five strikeouts as the Texans hit just .174 against him. The five complete games and four shutouts leads the team.

### OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Ryan Scott, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, entering the weekend, the Javelinas had not posted a save all season after having 17 a season ago. It all changed this weekend as Scott picked up the save in all three wins over the Rams. Scott pitched three innings on the scattering two hits and striking out two. On the year, Scott has a 0-0 record with a 2.35 ERA. He has limited opposing hitters to a .185 average in 7-2/3 innings of work on the season. He has held opponents scoreless in nine outings with only St. Mary's scoring against him.

Brian Schwabe, Cameron University, pitched seven innings of no-hit ball while only allowing two walks in seven innings of work on Saturday against Eastern New Mexico. Despite the no-hit bid the Aggie offense could not push across a run to give Schwabe the win and no-hitter as he went onto receive a no-decision in the contest. So far this season in six appearances Schawbe has a 3.06 era and 28 strike outs.

Blake Bass, Angelo State University, improved to 3-1 on the season by striking out six in a 3-2 ASU win over Texas A&M-Kingsville on Saturday at Foster Field. Bass, who now has a 1.08 ERA through 33.1 innings of work this season, scattered five hits on Saturday and helped lead the Rams to their lone win of the weekend. He has 24 strikeouts and only two walks this season and is limiting the opposition to a .220 batting average through five starts and six appearances.

### LSC NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

#### Angelo State

A midseason slump continued for the Rams last weekend with a 1-3 LSC series loss to Texas A&M-Kingsville at Foster Field. ASU has dropped seven of its last eight games after starting the season with a 16-5 record and a 6-2 LSC mark. The Rams were limited to a .209 batting average against the Javelinas and dropped the series despite another solid weekend from their starting pitchers. Jake Feckley (4-2) received his second consecutive loss despite another strong game. Feckley matched a career high with nine strikeouts in 9.1 innings, while Jason Zgardowski threw a complete-game and recorded five strikeouts in a loss. The Rams return to action

this weekend with a four-game series against Eastern New Mexico at Foster Field.

### Cameron

Cameron went 3-1 last week against Eastern New Mexico in Lawton. Brain Schwabe pitched seven innings of no-hit ball while only allowing two walks in seven innings of work on Saturday against Eastern New Mexico. Despite the no-hit bid the Aggie offense could not push across a run to give Schwabe the win and no-hitter as he went onto receive a no-decision in the contest. On Sunday the Aggies rallied from eight runs back and scored 16 in the seventh and eighth inning to win 19-11 over the Greyhound in their largest scoring outburst since the 2011 season. Cameron will travel on Friday for a four game series at West Texas A&M.

### Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 1-3 over the weekend at Cameron. The Greyhounds dropped the series opener 4-2 but took the first game on Saturday 1-0 in 11 innings. ENMU dropped the second game Saturday 4-3 and lost an eight-run lead in the finale to fall 19-11 on Sunday. Right-hander Matthew Artelejo pitched a school record 11 innings in the complete-game shutout while holding the Aggies to just four hits and a .118 batting average. Sam Hedrick drove in the winning run on a sacrifice fly in the contest. Both Chad Highberger and Dylan Nault drove in four runs in the series while Hedrick plated three. Pacing the team with four hits were Brett Ackerman, Ryan Forkel and Rawley Gomez. Gomez was also 2-for-2 in stealing bases and Nault swiped one. In the 11-inning contest, Blake Cooper set a LSC record with 23 putouts while playing first base. He held the record for 3 hours and 12 minutes until West Texas A&M's Aaron Blair posted 24 putouts in a 15-inning marathon at Tarleton State. Nault tied the school record with nine assists in the contest as well. Ben Monticello threw his third complete game of the year in the series opener, which is the most by a Greyhound pitcher since 2008. This week Eastern plays a four-game series at Angelo State beginning Friday at 5:30 p.m. MT to finish up an eight-game road trip.

### Tarleton State

The Texans closed out its series against West Texas A&M with a win, but the #4 Buffs managed to take the first three games away from Tarleton this past weekend ... The Texans and Buffs went through a city-wide power outage on Saturday, a 15-inning first game on Saturday and a one and a half hour weather delay on Sunday ... Tarleton hit just .192 and scored just 11 runs over the four-game set, with most of that production coming in Sunday's 6-3 win ... Garrett Kilgore and Rustin Thomas led the Texans at the plate with four hits each over the weekend series ... Thomas blasted his league-leading sixth home run and Christopher Patton, who went yard on Friday, hit his first home run April 27, 2012 ... Kyle Gottardy picked up Tarleton's only win on the mound this weekend, giving up three runs on six hits in 5 1/3 innings on Sunday ... Garrett Kelly worked the final 3 1/3 innings on Sunday to pick up his first save of the season ... Jared Musgrove now leads the LSC in hitting with a .426 average ... Musgrove was 2-for-9 over the weekend with one run batted in and he scored a run as well ... In addition to leading the league in home runs, Thomas also leads the LSC with 58 total bases ... The Texans will open an eight-game road swing this weekend against Texas A&M-Kingsville.

### Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas went 3-2 on the week including a 3-1 performance at Angelo State in a battle of the two teams in the Lone Star Conference in second and third entering the week...It was a tremendous week for the Javelinas on the mound. Including the loss to St. Edward's on Tuesday, Kingsville posted a 2.63 ERA for the week. The ERA lowered to 1.92 in the four weekend games at San Angelo. In their three wins Hoggie starters allowed four earned runs in 20 innings...Entering the weekend, the Javelinas had not posted a save all season after having 17 a season ago. It all changed this weekend as Kingsville's Ryan Scott picked up the save in all three wins over the Rams. Scott pitched three innings on the scattering two hits and striking out two. On the year, Scott has a 0-0 record with a 2.35 ERA. He has limited opposing hitters to a .185 average in 7-2/3 innings of work on the season. He has held opponents scoreless in nine outings with only St. Mary's scoring against him...Brian Frazier started all five games this past week after having not started prior. He finished the week with a .333 average. He had a solo home run against St. Mary's in Kingsville's only run of the game...With the three wins over Angelo State, the Hoggies are now 7-7 on the season when playing team's ranked in the South Central Region. Kingsville was 1-3 vs. West Texas, 2-2 vs. Eastern New Mexico, 3-1 versus Angelo State, 1-0 against St. Mary's and 0-1 versus St. Edward's...The Javelinas play a non-LSC game versus Texas A&M-International in Laredo on Tuesday. They return home to host Tarleton State in a 4-game LSC series. It will be the final 4-game series for the Javelinas this season in LSC action...This past weekend's 4-game series marked the first time the Javelinas have actually played a conference game on Sunday. Because of inclement weather concerns, the first three series had been changed to two doubleheaders as opposed to a Saturday doubleheader sandwiched by single games on Friday and Sunday...Dallas Ponder had his longest outing of the season on Friday at Angelo State. The senior picked up his fourth win of the season as he went eight innings. He allowed one run on four hits while striking out seven batters. His fourth win gives him 19 in his Javelina career pushing him to fourth in Javelins history. He is two behind Raul Trevino and Josh Livingston for second all-time. Ricky Sandate had 25 wins in his four seasons to set the school record...Ponder is also climbing the career record in strikeouts. With 43 this season, Ponder is now two shy of 200Ks is 42 behind Mike Adams record of 240.

### West Texas A&M

The Buffs improved to 24-5 on the year and a league-best 13-3 in conference play with a 4-1 record during the week...WT opened the week with a come-from-behind 10-6 win at Southwestern Oklahoma State on Tuesday and followed with a hard-fought, 3-1 series win at Tarleton Stat...The Buffs own a three-game lead in the conference race heading into the final week of the first half of the conference season...Texas A&M-Kingsville is second at 10-6 in league play...The series win over Tarleton State was the fourth series win of the LSC season for WT...The Buffs won the first three games of the series, including a 15-inning marathon in the opener on Saturday, 2-1...The 15-inning game was the longest of the season in the LSC, topping the Buffs' 13-inning win over Angelo State the previous week...Junior Aaron Blair had a LSC record 24 put outs in the game as Eastern New Mexico set the previous record earlier that day with 23 put outs by one player in a win over Cameron...WT held the opposition to hit just .205 for the week and held a 2.00 ERA for the week...Senior Josh Weyker tossed

his fifth complete game and fourth shutout to win the series in the nightcap Saturday...The 25-4 record and 13-3 mark in conference play are the best start(s) in school history for WT.
