LSC SOFTBALL

Midwestern State leads the Lone Star Conference with an 11-1 league record. The Mustangs have won nine straight games including a sweep of Texas A&M-Kingsville last week.

This week's schedules includes MSU at Angelo State, Tarleton State at West Texas A&M, Texas Woman's at Eastern New Mexico, and Cameron at TAMUK.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 2-3, at the No. 1 seed with the top six teams qualifying.

LSC softball teams are 142-107 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 42-26 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 28-11 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTER

Tara Martini, Cameron University, JR, LF, Moore, Okla., Moore HS

Martini had a hit and a RBI in all seven games for the Aggies last week. In total she collected 14 RBI off of 13 hits with a pair of homers, doubles, and a triple. Martini averaged .433 at the plate while stealing four bags; she would record nine putouts this week and maintained a 1.000 fielding percentage for the season. At Oklahoma Panhandle she was a homer short of the cycle with four hits, three RBI, and a pair of stolen bases. In the series opener against #11 Angelo State Martini had three hits with a pair of runs scored. She would carry the Aggies to a win with a bottom of the ninth with a solo homer to center field. This was the first win for Cameron against Angelo State in 11 tries and third overall in program history. Heading into this week, Martini has an 11-game hitting streak and an eight game streak with an RBI recorded. For the season she is hitting .416 at the plate with 10 doubles, eight homers, 41 RBI with 11 stolen bases.

CO-PITCHERS

Brenna Hennan, Tarleton State University, JR, Pitcher, Burkburnett, Texas, Burkburnett HS

Hennan was spectacular in Tarleton's four-game sweep of Eastern New Mexico last weekend, winning both of her pitching performances against the Zias. The junior hurler threw her second complete game shutout of the season in the second game of Friday's doubleheader as the TexAnns knocked off ENMU 8-0 in five innings. She followed up by keeping the Zias in check during the tightest game of the weekend, holding ENMU to one run in a complete-game, 2-1 win in Saturday's finale. For the weekend, she pitched 12 innings allowing just one earned run for a 0.58 ERA allowing 11 hits – only one of which went for extra bases – with three walks and six strikeouts.

Rita Hokianga, West Texas A&M University, JR, Pitcher, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand, Hukarere Girls College

Hokianga continued to roll for the #1 Lady Buffs this past weekend as WT went 3-1 on the road at #18 Texas Woman's to move to 27-4 overall with an 8-4 mark in Lone Star Conference play. The junior lefty from Hawke's Bay, New Zealand went 2-0 with a pair of complete game run-rule victories, striking out 15 batters in 12.0 innings of work while allowing three runs on 11 hits for an opponent average of .239. Hokianga moved to 12-2 on the season with a 2.16 ERA and a league leading 140 strikeouts in her 97.0 innings of work.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Taylor Wells, Tarleton State University, was on fire at the plate for the TexAnns last weekend as the sophomore catcher lifted Tarleton past Eastern New Mexico in four-game sweep. Wells hit .583 for the weekend with seven hits in 12 at-bats with two walks. She led the team in hits (7), runs scored (5) and total bases (9). She had a .750 slugging percentage and a .643 on-base percentage in addition to not striking out a single time all weekend. Wells also added a perfect fielding percentage of 1.000 behind the plate for the weekend to add on to her superb performance.

Ambra Hill, Angelo State University, led the No. 11 Rambelles with a .545 average to a split against Cameron. She scored three runs and stole four bases. She put down three sacrifice bunts and finished the weekend with six total hits.

Katelyn Vinson, Midwestern State University, went 7-of-13 (.538) with two doubles, a triple and a home run to help Midwestern State to a series sweep of Texas A&M-Kingsville last weekend at Mustangs Park. The LSC-leading Mustangs have won nine straight and 13 of their last 14. The Southlake Carroll product scored the lone run in Saturday's opening game delivering a leadoff single in the seventh inning then stole second and scored on Erin Knox's single through the left side of the infield. Vinson delivered a two-run double to help MSU to an 8-4 win in Game 2, then really ripped the ball on Sunday. She went 2-for-2 with a double and a triple while scoring two runs in a 10-1 win in Game 1, then was 3-for-4 with five RBIs while hitting her fourth homer of the



season as the Mustangs rolled to a 16-5 win in Game 2.

Mallory Wyatt, West Texas A&M University, had a huge weekend for the #1 Lady Buffs as they senior catcher hit .462 with a triple and two home runs to drive in six RBI for a slugging percentage of 1.077 with an on-base percentage of .462 as WT went 3-1 on the road against the rival #18 Pioneers of Texas Woman's in Denton.

Amanda Martinez, Eastern New Mexico University, paced the Zias over six games last week, with a .375 batting average and went a perfect seven-for-seven on stolen base attempts. She hit safely in four of the six games and registered an outfield assist in the opener at Tarleton State. On Tuesday, Martinez stole five bases in a doubleheader against University of Colorado-Colorado Springs and tied Jessica Rowley for seventh (17) on the ENMU single-season list for that category. She also became the fourth player in ENMU history to register at least three stolen bases in a game.

Sandra Serna, Angelo State University, struck out a season-high seven batters over six innings against Cameron. The senior allowed four runs on six hits but finished with a 2.33 ERA on the day. She limited the Aggies to a .240 batting average.

Caillin Garmon, Eastern New Mexico University, pitched in five of the Zias six games last week and posted a 3.5 earned run average with 17 strikeouts. She went the distance in the finale at Tarleton State and allowed just one earned run on five hits. On Monday, she fanned a career-high eight batters against University of Colorado-Colorado Springs.

LSC NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

Angelo State

ASU moved to 24-9 and 9-3 in the LSC after splitting the season series with Cameron this past weekend ... The Rambelles lead the conference in average (.454), runs (282), hits (319), RBIs (252), total bases (522) and stolen bases (68) ... Kenedy Urbany set the record for most innings pitched in a single game with 11.0 ... ASU will host conference leader Midwestern State for a four-game series on Friday and Saturday.

Cameron

The Cameron University softball team went 5-2 in seven games last week. The Aggies started off with a 10-8 win at Oklahoma Panhandle State on Tuesday. Then the next day CU swept USAO 8-1, 8-0 at home. The week ended with a four game series at home against Angelo State which Cameron split with the Rambelles. The Aggies took game one on Friday with a walk-off home run in the ninth by Tara Martini and scored five runs in the bottom of the seventh in game two to get another win. The next day Cameron and ASU went 11 innings in game one before CU fell, 9-8. Then the Aggies went on to lose the final game of the series, 11-3. Martini led Cameron by going 13-28 with 16 RBIs and nine runs. Senior Misty Dooley also had a big week, going 11-25 and scoring 11 runs. In game two against USAO, Junior Kelsey Watson pitched a six inning shutout and allowed only one hit.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University softball team received strong efforts from Amanda Martinez and Caillin Garmon, last week. Martinez went a perfect 7-for-7 on stolen base attempts and batted .375, while Garmon appeared in five of Eastern's six games and fanned 17 batters. On Monday, Martinez tied Jessica Rowley for seventh on ENMU's single-season list for

stolen bases, while Garmon struck out a season-best eight batters in the first game of a doubleheader against University of Colorado-Colorado Springs. The Zias will visit Oklahoma Panhandle State tomorrow, before hosting Texas Woman's, on Friday and Saturday.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State swept its four-game series with Texas A&M-Kingsville to improve to 23-9 on the season and to 11-1 in LSC play... The Mustangs own a two-game lead over Angelo State and are three games ahead of West Texas A&M... MSU ran its season-best winning streak to nine games which is the Mustangs' longest winning streak since taking 10 straight from April 6-20 in 2013... Midwestern has won 13 of its last 14 after starting the season with a 10-8 mark... The Mustangs' pitching staff has posted a 1.99 ERA while limiting the opposition to a .241 batting average during the 14-game stretch to lower its ERA from 5.07 to 3.81... MSU leads the league with a 1.97 staff ERA in LSC play... MSU freshman Katlyn Holmes is 4-0 with a LSC-best 1.15 ERA during league play, while sophomore Kat Batey ranks third (3-1, 2.47 ERA) and freshman Erin Knox is fourth (4-0, 2.52 ERA) during LSC play... Holmes weaved her second shutout of the season allowing six hits with two strikeouts and a walk in a 1-0 win over Texas A&M-Kingsville in Game 1 Friday night... Knox has won her last nine decisions dating back to Feb. 3... Batey has struck out 10 and walked two in nine innings over her last three appearances with two wins and a save... The Mustangs posted back-to-back run-rule wins for the second time this season Sunday against Texas A&M-Kingsville... MSU has posted seven mercy wins this season... Midwestern State leads the league with 52 home runs this season and has struck for a long ball in 28 of 32 contests this season... Senior catcher Kim Jerrick ranks fourth in the LSC with a .418 batting average while junior shortstop Katy Vandewater is seventh (.405) and sophomore outfielder Katelyn Vinson is 10th (.391)... Vandewater is hitting .500 (15-for-30) with two doubles, three homers and 15 RBIs during her current nine-game hitting streak... Vinson is hitting .550 (11-for-20) during her current seven-game hitting streak with two doubles, a triple, two homers and 10 RBIs... Jerrick connected for her third collegiate grand slam Sunday against Texas A&M-Kingsville which also resulted in her 200th career run scored... Jerrick now has 51 career home runs and needs six more to pass LSC record holder and former West Texas A&M standout Kim LeComte (56, 2009-12)...

Tarleton State

Tarleton State earned its first series sweep of the season last weekend, taking four from Eastern New Mexico last weekend. Tarleton won 10-2, 8-0, 7-3 and 2-1 and had some milestone moments along the way. Head coach Julie Mata won her 500th game at Tarleton in Friday's 8-0 win while senior pitcher Randi Fentress topped the 500-innings pitched and 400-strikeout marks for her career.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas went 0-4 in the weekend series with Midwestern... Myrissa Sanchez led the Javelinas with a .417 average for the weekend with 2 RBI and two runs scored as Kingsville hit .297. Adela Gomez and Bailey Offill each had a .308 average... Offill led the Javelinas with three RBI, while Sanchez had two... Valerie Ramirez, Jaeleen Castro, and Gomez each had one... On the season, Offill leads the Javelinas with a .316 average while Gonzales is second at .284. Offill

and Gomez lead the team with 18 runs scored... Gomez also leads the Javelinas with 15 RBI. Offill and Valerie Ramirez each has 15 runs knocked in... Carlie Clark moved 3-11 on the season for the Javelina pitching staff. She fanned five batters and walked seven for the weekend.

Texas Woman's

The TWU softball team is 20-10 on the season and 6-7 in the Lone Star Conference after dropping three out of four against #1 West Texas A&M over the weekend. In a 4-2 win against the Lady Buffs senior Katie Hines shut down WT's high powered offense for six innings allowing just two hits in the final game of the four-game series. On the season junior Kendra Sancet leads the team with a .418 batting average, 12 home runs and 40 RBI. Sophomore Tealey Farquhar is second in batting average (.388) while senior Bailey Vrazel is third with a .385 average and leads the team with 28 runs. Vrazel is also 23-for-25 in stolen bases. Senior Brandie Lander leads the pitching staff with a 2.77 ERA, 13-3 record, two saves and 84 strikeouts.

West Texas A&M

The #1 Lady Buffs of West Texas A&M went 3-1 this past weekend to move to 27-4 with an 8-4 mark in Lone Star Conference play to sit in third place in league play following a four game series at rival #18 Texas Woman's. The Lady Buffs return to the friendly confines of Schaeffer Park this weekend as they host the TexAnns of Tarleton State in a four game LSC series starting on Friday with a doubleheader at 5 p.m. Texas Oncology will sponsor Strike Out Cancer Weekend in conjunction with the Shout Out For Roni campaign with all proceeds benefiting the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition.
