LSC BASEBALL

Lone Star Conference teams opened league play last week. Conference play continues this week with Cameron at Texas A&M-Kingsville, West Texas A&M at Eastern New Mexico, and Tarleton State at Angelo State for a four-game series.

In 2014, LSC teams are playing a 10-week schedule with a four-game series and three-game series against every other team. Each four-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday, a 7x7 doubleheader Saturday and 9-inning contest Sunday, and each three-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday and a 7x9 doubleheader Saturday.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 8-10, at the No. 1 seed with the top four teams qualifying.

LSC baseball teams are 61-31 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 16-5 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-5 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Rustin Thomas, Tarleton State University, SR, OF, Mansfield, Texas, Mansfield-Timberview

Thomas batted .538 on the weekend, going 7-for-13 at the dish and scoring a team-high six runs as well. The Mansfield product hit three home runs in the four-game set over Eastern New Mexico, which included back-to-back dingers in Tarleton's 11-4 series-finale-win over the Greyhounds. Thomas knocked in eight runs over the two-day span and tallied 16 total bases for a slugging percentage of 1.231. He walked twice and was 1-for-1 in stolen base attempts.

Beto Rodriguez, West Texas A&M University, SR, 2B, Brownsville, TX, Lopez HS

Almost hit for the cycle with a home run, triple and double in an 11-1 win over Texas A&M-Kingsville for a doubleheader sweep on Friday. It was his team-leading second round-tripper of the season. For the week, he went 5 of 10 from the field with two runs scored, a double, a triple and the home run along with three RBI...He slugged 1.100 and reached base at a .545 clip...Rodriguez had seven put outs and 11 assists at 2B, while being a part of turning three double plays.

PITCHERS

Denver Diefenbach, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SR, RHP, Victoria, TX, St. Joseph HS

The Javelinas won Saturday's 7-inning contest 1-0 as Denver Diefenbach threw a complete game. He scattered four hits and walked two in the contest without allowing a run. He fanned three batters. He permitted just two runners to reach second base.

Dylan James, West Texas A&M University, SR, RHP, Las Cruces, N.M., Mayfield HS

Senior Dylan James continued his outstanding season as he tossed another complete game with a three hit, one earned run game with no walks and 10 strikeouts in an 11-1 win over Texas A&M-Kingsville for a doubleheader sweep of the Javelinas Friday...James allowed three hits and one earned run in the first inning, but retired the next 13 in order and had only one base runner following the first inning. He improved to 3-0 on the year and dropped his ERA to 0.93 with three complete games in four starts. James has fanned 39 and walked just five this season as teams are hitting just .111 against him.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Tyler Coughenour, Angelo State University, led the Rams last week by driving in four runs in ASU's series against Cameron. Coughenour finished the week hitting .375 with six hits, including two doubles. He also went 4-for-4 on stolen base attempts and now has 14 steals through the first 17 games played this season.

Steven Moore, Eastern New Mexico University, had two home runs including what would be the game-winning grand slam as Eastern New Mexico ended a 15-game skid to Tarleton State in the third game of the series. He had six RBIs which is the most by a Greyhound in two seasons. He also added a double and drove in a run in the series finale as all three of his hits in the series went for extra bases. In the field, Moore had 13 putouts and two assists in recording a perfect fielding percentage.

Jason Zgardowski, Angelo State University, had a dominant performance against Cameron last Friday, striking out nine and scattering six hits in 8.1 innings. Zgardowski has now struck out 19 in his past two starts after striking out 10 against Colorado School of Mines two weeks ago. The junior is 2-0 on the season with 30 strikeouts and a 2.31 ERA through 23.1 innings of work this season. He has made three starts and two appearances from the bullpen and has only walked two.

Brian Schwabe, Cameron University, tossed a 8 1/3 innings in a scheduled seven inning game for the Aggies against Angelo State. Cameron would take the game in the bottom of the ninth 6-5 over the Rams but they wouldn't have had a chance without Schwabe's five strikeouts and holding Ram hitters to a .188 batting average.

Kyle Gottardy, Tarleton State University, pitched eight complete innings to pick up his first win of the season in Tarleton's 11-4 victory over ENMU in the series finale on Saturday. The Spring Branch native gave up three runs (just one earned) over seven hits and he struck out a team-high over the weekend, six batters.



Jonathan Joy, Eastern New Mexico University, made two appearances out of the bullpen at Tarleton State. He gave up just one run, off a home run, in five innings while striking out three. In the series finale, Joy pitched four innings, allowing just three base runners. Texan hitters only managed a .067 batting average against him as he posted a 1.80 ERA for the series.

Angelo State

The Rams opened LSC play by winning three of four from Cameron after dropping the series opener. ASU also played a non-conference game, falling to No. 5 St. Mary's in a 3-2 decision. The Rams are hitting .317 this season with 30 doubles, seven triples and four home runs. The pitching staff has a 2.92 ERA with 143 strikeouts and only 42 walks. The Rams host Tarleton State this weekend at Foster Field in a four-game series.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 1-3 last week at Tarleton State to open Lone Star Conference play. The victory in the third game of the series snapped a 15-game winless streak against the Texans for the Greyhounds. It was also ENMU's first win in Stephenville since Mar. 7, 2009. Sam Hedrick led the team with a .538 batting average as he was 7-for-13 at the plate with four RBIs and three runs scored. Brett Ackerman had two stolen bases and was 5-of-14 at the plate. Blake Cooper hit two to increase his season total to four. In the third game, Steven Moore hit a two-run homer and a grand slam which turned out to be the game winner. On the mound, Matthew Artalejo improved to 3-0 on the year while Keigan Basso picked up his first collegiate save. Jonathan Joy posted a staff-low 1.80 ERA in two appearances out of the bullpen. He allowed just one run off a solo home run in five innings and struck out three. Texan batters hit just .067 off of him. This week, ENMU hosts rival West Texas A&M for a four-game series schedule to begin Friday at 5 p.m. MT.

Tarleton State

The Texans are in a three-way tie for first place in the LSC following the first weekend of conference games - going 3-1 over the weekend against Eastern New Mexico ... Tarleton swept Friday's games over the Greyhounds, but then snapped a 17-game winning streak against ENMU with Saturday's 10-9 game-one loss ... Tarleton bounced back though with an 11-4 win, in a game where senior outfielder Rustin Thomas hit a pair of home runs ... Thomas finished the weekend going 7-for-13 at the plate with three bombs and eight runs batted in ... Andrew Jacobi had a great weekend at the plate as well, going 5-for-7 (.714) with a pair of doubles, a home run and driving in seven RBI ... Kyle Gottardy picked up his first win for the Texans this season, giving up just an earned run while striking out six in his appearance on Saturday ... Colton Burleson and Jacob French also picked up wins for the Texans on the mound ... The Texans will make its first LSC road trip this weekend with a three-day, four-game set at Angelo State ... The series will get underway on Friday at 6:30 p.m. from Foster Field in San Angelo.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas opened Lone Star Conference play this past weekend going 1-3...The Javelinas won Saturday's 7-inning contest 1-0 as Denver Diefenbach threw a complete game. He scattered four hits and walked two in the contest without allowing a run. He fanned three batters. He permitted just two runners to reach second base...Three of four Javelina pitchers had tremendous starts over the weekend. Aside from Diefenbach, Dallas Ponder and Taylor Taska combined to pitch 11 innings in their start. The duo each allowed just one earned run. Ponder scattered five hits in six innings with four Ks, while Taska allowed six hits with one walk. The trio allowed one extra-base hit in 18 combined innings with an ERA of 1.00...Matt Rhodes had a 3.00 ERA entering the weekend and had been the most consistent starter until Friday when he allowed nine earned runs in 2-1/3 innings of work... Junior catcher Clint Wallace led the Javelina offense. He was one of three regulars to .333 and had a team-high four RBI. He drove in three runs as the Javelinas built a 6-1 lead in the series opener including his first home run of the season...Ryan Guedry and Derrick Walls joined Clint Wallace with .333 averages, while Taylor Taska batted .308. As a team, Kingsville hit .218...The Javelinas return home to host Cameron this weekend in a 4-game series. The Javelinas are 5-3 at home, but 1-4 on the road.
