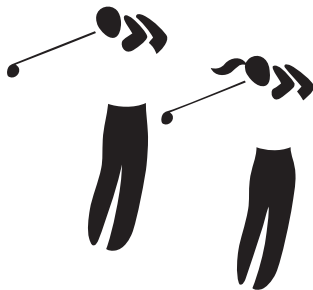

MEN'S

Cullen Stahl, Cameron University, SO, Lawton, Okla., Lawton-Eisenhower HS

Stahl picked up 13 strokes and fired off a 69 in the second round of the St. Edward's Invite this week. Stahl's score was the third lowest of the 16 schools participating which included number-1 ranked Barry. Freezing temperatures proved to be a struggle for teams in Austin, Texas with Stahl carding a 151 (82-69) which was good for 30th place to lead the CU group.

WOMEN'S

Isabel Jimenez-Perea, Tarleton State University, SO, Cobena, Spain

Jimenez-Perea won her fourth individual title of the 2013-14 season, picking up individual honors at the Las Vegas Desert Classic this past week. Jimenez-Perea paced the TexAnns to a first place finish in team competition as well with a two-day score of +5 (77-72=149).

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Ethan Peterson, West Texas A&M University, finished tied for 35th at the St. Edward's Invitational with a 36-hole score of 152 on rounds of 74 and 78. Peterson led the way for the Buffs who finished 12th in the tournament. Peterson was just one of two Buff golfers to shoot both rounds in the 70s.

Cameron picked up 33 strokes and fired off a 293 in the final round of the St. Edward's Invitational but they could only climb up to 13th. In the opening round the Aggies struggled out of the gates carding a 326, highest of all 16 schools participating in the invitational; the 619 two round total was one back of West Texas A&M for 12th place. Cullen Stahl picked up 13 strokes and fired off a 151 (82+69) which was good for 30th place to lead the CU group. Dylan McClure finished in 51st place after a 155 (80+75) and Michael Kelly placed 65th carding a 158 (82+76). Justin Jang had the largest improvement for Cameron by picking up 16 strokes and carded a two round total of 162 (89+73). Corey Bounds rounded out the Aggie five with a 163 (82+81). The Cameron men's golf team will have a week off before traveling south of the Red River on March 17-18 to play in Midwestern State's Mustang Classic.
