### LSC BASEBALL

West Texas A&M remains atop the Lone Star Conference standings after splitting its series with Cameron. Angelo State and Texas A&M-Kingsville each won three of four games.

This week's schedule includes WT at TAMUK, CU at ASU, and Tarleton State at Eastern New Mexico for a three-game series.

In 2014, LSC teams are playing a 10-week schedule with a four-game series and three-game series against every other team. Each four-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday, a 7x7 doubleheader Saturday and 9-inning contest Sunday, and each three-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday and a 7x9 doubleheader Saturday.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 8-10, at the No. 1 seed with the top four teams qualifying.

LSC baseball teams are 97-66 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 17-6 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-5 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### HITTERS

##### Matt Redfearn, West Texas A&M University, SR, SS, Upland, Calif., Upland HS

Redfearn went a team-best 8 for 16 from the plate with a team-high six runs scored, two doubles, one triple and four driven in for the Buffs over the weekend. Redfearn helped lead WT to two wins in the final two games to salvage a split with Cameron. He slugged .750 and reached base at a .556 clip, while going a team-best 3 for 3 in stolen bases. He is in the midst of a season-long eight game hitting streak, which is the second-best streak on the team at this point.

##### Christian Summers, Angelo State University, SR, Infield, San Angelo, Texas, Central HS

Summers continued his midseason surge by going 7-for-15 with four RBI last weekend in a 3-1 series win for the Rams over ENMU. Summers hit his second home run of the season in the series and scored six runs for the Rams. On the bases, he went 3-for-3 on stolen base attempts and is now tied for the team lead with 21 RBI this season. Summers also shined on the mound again this weekend with seven strikeouts in three innings of work. It was only his second pitching appearance of his career.

#### PITCHERS

##### Robert Baker, Tarleton State University, SR, RHP, Garland, Texas, Lakeview Central HS

Baker tossed a four-hit, complete-game shutout against Texas A&M-Kingsville on Saturday. Baker's superb pitching performance was key in Tarleton's 1-0 win over the Javelinas as the senior right-hander recorded five strikeouts and walked just one batter on the way to his fourth win of the season.

##### Jason Zgardowski, Angelo State University, JR, RHP, San Antonio, Texas, Madison HS

Zgardowski has been dominant all season and continued that trend last weekend with a career-high 11 strikeouts in a complete-game win against ENMU in Saturday's first doubleheader game. Zgardowski limited the Greyhounds to four hits (.167 average) and allowed only one run in the 2-1 win. For the season, the junior has a 1.94 ERA and leads the Rams with 55 strikeouts in 51.0 innings of work. He has thrown four complete games and has walked only 10 batters the entire season.

### OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Matthew Burks, Eastern New Mexico University, led Eastern New Mexico with a .450 batting average as he went 9-for-20 with three doubles, a home run, two RBIs, seven runs scored and was hit by a pitch against Angelo State. He had a hit in all four games with three being multi-hit contests. He recorded three base knocks in game one, two being doubles, and game three. Burks came around to score three times in the series opener and twice in the third and fourth games. He hit his fourth home run of the season, tied for the third most in the LSC, in the series finale while driving in runs in games three and four.

James Black, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, hit .375 on the week going 6-of-13 with three doubles. He scored a team-best three runs in the process. Black scored twice in Sunday's win.

Codey McElroy, Cameron University, smashed three homers over four games at #3 West Texas A&M and helped Cameron split the season series. Prior to the weekend, WT pitching allowed only five homers and Cameron had one as a team heading into the league series. McElroy also had a pair of doubles, four runs scored, with a 1.000 slugging percentage, and six RBI off of WT's pitching staff. On the field he also recorded seven put-outs and 15 assists.

Dylan Montano, Eastern New Mexico University, picked up his first career victory in Sunday's finale at Angelo State. He pitched two scoreless innings of relief with a strikeout and giving up just one hit. The Rams hit just .167 off him.

Ryan Scott, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, continued to emerge as one of the top closers in the Lone Star Conference. The junior picked up three saves over the last week. After having no saves prior to the game at Angelo State on Mar. 21, Scott has six since in six appearances and is tied for the league lead. Scott, who has not allowed a run in 12 of 13 outings on the year, tossed 3-2/3 innings last week allowing two hits with a

walk and two strikeouts. He entered Sunday's game with a runner on second and one out in the top of the eighth. He induced a pop-up in four territory to Noel Nevarez and pop up to second to get out of the inning.

Drew Reidt, Cameron University, tossed seven innings and helped guide Cameron to a 4-3 win in their series opener at #3 West Texas A&M. In his eighth start of the season Reidt held WT batters to a .200 average and allowed only one extra base hit. Reidt would only give up two earned runs and punched out four Buff hitters to move his season ERA to a 2.58 overall.

Josh Weyker, West Texas A&M University, tossed a complete game in a 9-4 win on Saturday to end a two-game skid against Cameron. Weyker allowed nine hits in the game with four earned runs, four walks and he fanned nine over seven innings. He improved to 6-2 on the year and it was his sixth complete game of the season to lead the team in eight starts.

## LSC NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

### Angelo State

The Rams got back to their winning ways last weekend by taking a 3-1 series win over ENMU with three walk-off wins which included an epic 12-inning win on Saturday. In the extra-inning game, ASU was down to its final out twice and also received two three-run home runs - one each from Brett David and Reggie Rodriguez. The Rams earned the win on a Derek Tyner two-run, two-out single to score David Goggin and Christian Summers to take the 9-8 victory. Summers led the Rams with seven hits, including a home run in the series, while Tyner had six hit and Cameron Massengill and Tyler Coughenour had five each. David completed the weekend with a team-high five RBI. ASU's pitching staff had another strong weekend with Jason Zgardowski compiling 11 strikeouts in a win, Dillon Becker striking out six in an 8.0 inning start where he did not receive a decision and Graylon Brown and Erik Monson earning wins in relief appearances. The Rams return to action this weekend with a three-game LSC series against Cameron in San Angelo.

### Cameron

The Aggies split with West Texas A&M last weekend in Canyon. In game one, CU went up 4-0 and was able to hold off the Buffs to win 4-3. Drew Riedt got his fourth win of the season after going seven innings with four strike outs and five hits, and Tobin Mateychick got his third save of the year. In game two, Brian Schwabe got his first win of the season after the Aggie batters scored eight runs in the last three innings to get the win, 11-4. In the final two games of the series, CU couldn't keep up with the WT bats as they lost, 9-4 and 13-6. Codey McElroy led Cameron offensively after going 5-15 with six RBIs and three homeruns. The Aggies will host Southwestern Oklahoma State on April 1st before heading down to Angelo State for a three game series on the 4th and 5th.

### Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 1-3 over the weekend at Angelo State. The Greyhounds dropped the first three games of the series all on walk-offs while coming from behind and scoring four runs over the last two innings to take the series finale. Matthew Burks led the team with a .450 average with three doubles, his fourth home run of the season, seven runs scored and two RBIs. Sam Hedrick had seven hits while Colton Sims had five base knocks and drew a bases loaded walk for the go-ahead run in game four. Blake Cooper was

4-for-4 with two doubles, two home runs and drove in five runs on Friday. He leads the LSC with seven homers. Rawley Gomez had the fourth most at-bats in a game for an Eastern player with seven in game three. He was two away from tying the program mark. Gomez also went 4-for-4 in stealing bases. On the mound, junior right-hander Matthew Artalejo threw his second straight complete game while senior right-hander Ben Monticello tied his career-high with eight strikeouts. Also setting a career-high with strikeouts was junior left-hander Rusty Edwards with six. Getting his first career win was senior right-hander Dylan Montano as he threw two scoreless innings in relief. This week ENMU hosts Tarleton State for a three-game series beginning on Friday at 5 p.m. MT. The first game of Saturday's doubleheader is scheduled for to begin at 1 p.m. MT.

### Tarleton State

The Texans went 1-3 against the Javelinas this weekend, falling to 17-13 overall and 8-10 in league play ... Robert Baker picked up Tarleton's lone win on the weekend, pitching a four-hit, complete-game shutout on Saturday ... The Texans hit just .204 as a team this weekend and was led by junior outfielder Noel Nevarez, who tallied five hits in 14 trips to the plate ... The Texans will travel to Portales, N.M., this weekend to face the Greyhounds in a three-game set beginning on Friday.

### Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas were 4-1 last week as they downed Texas A&M International in a non-conference game before taking 3-of-4 at home from Tarleton State. Kingsville has now won seven of its last 10 games and is two games out of first in the LSC behind West Texas A&M...The Javelinas, who are in the midst of 9-game home stand, host a pair of nationally-ranked teams this week. On Tuesday, No. 13 St. Mary's comes to town, while the Javelinas host No. 23 West Texas A&M over the weekend in a 3-game set...The Hoggies have been getting done on the mound in their nine games since a 7-1 loss to St. Edward's. They have not allowed a team more than three runs in a game since and to two or fewer six times. The team has a 1.60 ERA in the same stretch...The seven hole played a key role in Sunday's series finale win. Brian Frazier set a career-high with three runs batted in before being replaced by Mile Holcomb. Holcomb belted his a solo home run to left field for his first of the season... James Black hit .375 on the week going 6-of-13 with three doubles. He scored a team-best three runs in the process...Ryan Benitez earned his first career win in his second start in midweek action at Texas A&M-International. He tossed 6-2/3 innings scattering four hits and striking out eight. He walked one while allowing just one unearned run in the outing...Ryan Scott continued to emerge as one of the top closers in the Lone Star Conference. The junior picked up three saves over the last week. After having no saves prior to the game at Angelo State on Mar. 21, Scott has six since in six appearances and is tied for the league lead. Scott, who has not allowed a run in 12 of 13 outings on the year, tossed 3-2/3 innings last week allowing two hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Diefenbach is now tied for the LSC lead with six wins overall, while Rhodes is tied for fourth with five overall wins...Ryan Guedry leads

Kingsville with a .347 and is second with 17 RBI. His average is fourth in the LSC...Derrick Walls is second with 19 walks, third with a .444 on-base percentage and fifth with 39 hits. His 12 steals are third...Dallas Ponder is tied for LSC lead with nine starts and is third with 49 strikeouts.

### West Texas A&M

The No. 3 West Texas A&M baseball team salvaged a split with Cameron this past weekend, winning the final two games of the series after dropping the first two...It was the Buffs' first conference split of the season after going 3-1 or 4-0 in the previous four series'...WT owns a two-game lead in the conference standings heading into the back half of the LSC slate...The Buffs open the second half at Texas A&M-Kingsville this weekend in a three-game set...It is the third week where WT will face the second-place team in league play (Angelo State, Tarleton State) WT went 7-1 in those games when facing the second-place team...For the first time this season the pitching staff struggled in a series with 15 walks and just 33 strikeouts, along with 29 runs allowed and 23 earned runs as six errors led to the six unearned runs...WT hit .333 for the series with 43 hits, 10 doubles, three triples and one home run while driving in 28...The staff ERA was the highest of the season at 6.47... The Buffs had seven players hit over .300 for the weekend...The Buffs now are 26-7 on the year and 15-5 in league play heading into the final month of the regular season.
