LSC SOFTBALL

Angelo State swept Midwestern State to move into first place in the Lone Star Conference at 13-3. The Rambelles have won six straight.

This week's schedule includes Eastern New Mexico at ASU, West Texas A&M at Texas A&M-Kingsville, MSU at Texas Woman's, and Cameron at Tarleton State.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The single-elimination championship will be played May 2-3, at the No. 1 seed with the top six teams qualifying.

LSC softball teams are 161-126 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the group is currently 43-29 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 28-11 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

LUTTED

Morgan Spearman, Angelo State University, SR, OF, Kennadale, Texas, Kennadale

Spearman became the first player in ASU softball history to hit for the cycle on Saturday against Midwestern State. The senior hit a single in the first, a double in the second, a solo home run in the fifth and a triple in the sixth to complete the cycle. She finished the weekend hitting .636 to increase her season conference leading average to .523. Spearman scored 10 runs and became ASU's all-time career leader in runs scored with 197. The Kennedale native recorded two triples, five RBIs and drew five walks. She finished the weekend with a 1.364 slugging percentage and a .750 on-base percentage.

PITCHER

Kelsey Watson, Cameron University, JR, Pitcher, Cache, Okla., Cache HS

Watson went 14 strong innings for the Aggies with a pair of wins and a save in three appearances last weekend at Kingsville. On Friday, she tossed a no-hitter using only 42 pitches while striking out four TAMUK batters. It was the first no-hitter for an Aggie pitcher since the 2009 season. Watson just gave up one run and four hits while holding TAMUK hitters to a .089 batting average. In 21 games played, she is 11-5 with a 3.14 ERA, and has struck out 84 batters.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Katie Hines, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers to 4-2 record including 4-0 in LSC with a teambest .619 average, 11 RBI, 1.095 slugging percentage and .667 on base percentage. In the four wins at Eastern New Mexico she batted .750 with 10 RBI, 1.188 slugging percentage and .778 on base percentage. Hines batted 4-for-4 with five RBI in game-two, 3-for-3 with three RBI in game-three and 3-for-5 with two RBI in game-four against the Zias. She also tossed five innings in the circle in game-two against ENMU and picked up her seventh win of the season.

Marleyna Piñon, Eastern New Mexico University, turned in an outstanding week and led the Zias in hitting (.579), slugging (.895). She hit safely in five of Eastern's six games, with multiple hits in three of them, including a 4-for-4 outing with three runs and four RBIs at Oklahoma Panhandle. Piñon also batted 3-for-4 in the third game of a LSC series against defending champion Texas Woman's, with three RBIs and a two-run homer in the bottom of the seventh inning

Kelley Schaefer, Midwestern State University, hit .545 and slugged 1.455 by going 6-for-11 with a double and three homers while driving in seven runs last weekend against No. 12-ranked Angelo State. The junior third baseman launched two homers in a game for the second time in her career in Game 1 Saturday as she went 3-for-4 with three runs scored and four RBIs. She blasted her seventh homer of the season later in the afternoon going 2-for-2 with two RBIs. Schaefer also delivered an RBI double in Friday night's opening game.

Jessica Sipe, West Texas A&M University, continued to lead the high-powered WT offense this past weekend as the #1 Lady Buffs swept an LSC weekend series against Tarleton State at Schaeffer Park in Canyon with four run-rule victories by a total score of 46-8. WT enters the week in second place in league play, just one game out of first place with a 12-4 record. Sipe hit .500 with two doubles and a home run to drive in seven RBI for a slugging percentage of 1.000 while walking twice on the weekend for an on-base percentage of .538 with three putouts and four assists at the hot corner.

Valerie Ramirez, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led Kingsville with a .450 average for the week and six RBI. Against Cameron she was 4-of-4 in the 6-4 loss on Saturday with two doubles, three RBI and two runs scored. She had a 3-run home run to tie the game in bottom of the seventh against International. On the season, Ramirez leads the Javelinas with a .302 batting average, 21 RBI and three home runs.

Rita Hokianga, West Texas A&M University, continued to dominate in the circle for the #1 Lady Buffs this past weekend as the Hawke's Bay, New Zealand native went 2-0 with a perfect 0.00 ERA with just three walks and 13 strikeouts in her 8.0 innings of work as WT moved to 31-4 overall with a 12-4 mark in LSC play. The junior lefty started off the weekend in impressive fashion as she threw a complete game shutout on Friday night

as the Lady Buffs rolled TSU, 9-0 in five innings while allowing just three hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in the victory.

Mary Kate McKay, Angelo State University, pitched three complete game wins while also starting every game of the four-game series in a sweep of Midwestern State. In the senior's three wins she only allowed five runs (2, 1, 2) on 10 hits (3, 2, 5). MSU did not have more than five hits in a single game against McKay. The Madill, Okla., native limited the Mustangs to a .189 batting average in the four games while striking out six batters. McKay finished the weekend with a 2.21 ERA and a 3-0 record.

Brandie Lander, Texas Woman's University, posted a 3-0 record last week to improve her overall mark to a LSC best 16-3. She struck out 22 batters in 24.2 innings. Lander also tossed her 12th complete game of the season when she went the distance in gametwo against Eastern New Mexico on Friday. On the season she has a 2.93 ERA, 106 strikeouts and five shutouts.

Angelo State

The Rambelles improved to 28-9 overall and moved into first place in the LSC at 13-3 with a sweep of Midwestern State ... Morgan Spearman became the first player in ASU softball history to hit for the cycle on Saturday ... Mary Kate McKay started every game of the four-game sweep and won three of the four games ... Spearman leads the conference in average (.523), on-base percentage (.639), runs scored (55), hits (56), and walks (35) ... Darian Dunn has the third most RBIs in a single season in ASU history with 67 ... Kenedy Urbany hit a career high six RBIs in the 14-13 win over Midwestern State ... The Rambelles will host ENMU this Friday and Saturday for a three-game series.

Cameron

The Aggies went 4-0 last weekend at Texas A&M-Kingsville to bring their record to 21-11, 7-7 LSC. This marks the 11th 20-win season in program history. In the first game of the series, Samantha Betts got her ninth win of the season after going seven innings, allowing three hits and no earned runs. In the next game Kelsey Watson gave CU its first no-hitter since 2009, going seven innings with four strikeouts and two walks. Cameron had to fight back from a 4-1 deficit in game three, but was able to do so by scoring five runs in the last two innings to win, 6-4. The Aggies used a five run third in the final game to cruise to a 7-2 victory and get the sweep. Misty Dooley led CU, going 7-15 with four runs, two RBIs, and a triple. Next up for Cameron is a four game series against Tarleton State in Stephenville on April 4 and 5.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State had its season-best nine-game winning snapped last weekend at Angelo State... The Rambelles dealt the Mustangs their longest losing streak of the season -- 4 games... MSU lost four straight for the first time since losing five in a row from March 16-23, 2013 last season... The Mustangs fell two games back of Angelo State in the LSC race at 11-5 and the dropped from first to third place -- also a game back of West Texas A&M (12-4)... The MSU pitching staff of Katlyn Holmes, Kat Batey and Erin Knox combined for a 2.00 ERA allowing 16 earned

runs on 53 hits with 29 strikeouts and 13 walks during a MSU's nine-game winning streak... The staff allowed 39 earned runs on 45 hits with 17 walks and five strikeouts good for a 14.89 ERA last weekend against Angelo State... Junior third baseman Kelley Schaefer hit .545 going 4-for-11 with three homers and seven RBIs while slugging 1.455 last weekend against Angelo State... Schaefer recorded her second career multiple homer game Saturday against Angelo State. Her other came against Cameron on April 16, 2013... Senior catcher Kim Jerrick led off Friday night's second game with her 52nd career home run. She needs five more to pass current LSC career record hold Kim LeComte. The former West Texas A&M standout hit 56 from 2009-12... Sophomore outfielder Katelyn Vinson has a homer in each of MSU's last three series and now has five this season... Vinson needs one homer to move into a tie for second with Mallory Mooney (2009-12) and Rachael Jackson (2004-06) on MSU's all time list with 28 long balls...

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas went 0-4 in the weekend series with Cameron and split during the week with Texas A&M International...Junior Valerie Ramirez led Kingsville with a .450 average for the week with six RBI. Against Cameron she was 4-of-4 in the 6-4 loss on Saturday with two doubles, three RBI and two runs scored as Kingsville hit .160 as a team. She had a 3-run home run to tie the game in bottom of the seventh against International as the Javelinas overcame a 5-0 deficit in the seventh inning to win in extra innings...Senior Jaeleen Castro was second for the team with a .200 average...Adela Gomez and Bailey Offill each had a .154 average...Carynn Gonzales, Castro, and Gomez each had one run batted in...On the season, Ramirez leads the Javelinas with a .302 batting average while Offill is second at .289. Offill leads the team with 23 runs scored...Ramirez also leads the Javelinas with 21 RBI. Gomez is second for Kingsville with 17 runs knocked in...Junior Carlie Clark moved to 4-13 on the season for the Javelina pitching staff and senior Lauren Denney moved to 0-2 as she made her first two starts of her senior season. Clark fanned one batter and walked two for the weekend. Denney struck out five batters and walked two.

Texas Woman's

The TWU softball team improved to 24-12 on the season and 10-7 in the Lone Star Conference after sweeping Eastern New Mexico in a four-game series over the weekend. The Pioneers dropped a doubleheader to #7 St. Mary's prior to the weekend series at ENM. Senior Katie Hines led the team on offense with a .619 batting average, 11 RBI, three home runs, 1.095 slugging percentage and .667 on base percentage. Freshman Alyssa Galaz also drove in 11 runs on three doubles and one home run. Junior Kendra Sancet hit three home runs and drove in nine runs. She is the conference leader in home runs with 15 on the season. Senior Bailey Vrazel was 11-for-11 in stolen bases in the six games and scored a team-best 11 runs. Senior Brandie Lander posted a 3-0 record with 22 strike outs in the circle. With two hit-by-pitches over the weekend, junior Sarah Wittenburg became the NCAA Division II career leader with 64. She passed Brittany Weaver of Central Oklahoma who had 63 HBP from 2009-12.

West Texas A&M

The #1 Lady Buffs of West Texas A&M continued to roll thru opponents at home this past weekend as they swept a four-game Lone Star Conference series from the visiting TexAnns of Tarleton State at Schaeffer Park with four run-rule victories as they outscored the TexAnns, 46-8 over the weekend to move to 17-0 at home this season. WT carries an overall record of 31-4 into the week with a 12-4 mark in Lone Star Conference play to sit in second place, just one game behind Angelo State who comes to Canyon the final weekend of the regular season for a four-game series. The Lady Buffs hit .453 as a team with 11 doubles, three triples and four homeruns on the weekend for a team slugging percentage of .791 while the pitching staff went 4-0 with a 2.80 ERA and 24 strikeouts on the weekend. Following Tuesday afternoon's doubleheader against Lubbock Christian, the Lady Buffs will hit the road for a three game Lone Star Conference series in Kingsville, Texas against the Javelinas of Texas A&M-Kingsville starting on Friday night with a doubleheader at 5 p.m. followed by a single game to conclude the series on Saturday afternoon with first pitch set for 1 p.m.
