GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S

Ethan Peterson, West Texas A&M University, SO, Clovis, N.M., Clovis HS

Had a career-best finish and tournament at the Mustang Invitational this week at the Palm Valley Golf Club in Goodyear, Ariz...He fired a 5-under 211 on rounds of 72, 69 and 70 and finished tied for sixth, earning all-tournament honors...His 69 in the second round was the low-round for the Buffs in the tournament as the team finished tied for seventh out of 20 teams.

WOMEN'S

Hayley Dambold, Midwestern State University, FR, Highland Village, Texas, Flower Mound Marcus HS

Dambold led the Mustangs at the weather-shortened United States Women's Invitational in Charlotte, N.C. The freshman from Highland Village, Texas/Flower Mound Marcus toured the water-logged par 72, 6,094-yard Pine Island Country Club at 7-over 79 to tie for 17th. The Mustangs finished seventh in the field that featured eight top 40 teams in the 10-team field.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Derek Oland, Midwestern State University, continued his strong play this spring as he finished third individually at the Dallas Baptist Classic. The junior from McKinney, Texas/Boyd shot a 1-over-par 214 at the par 71, 6,859-yard Golf Club of Dallas, that included the best score of the final round with a 1-under 70. It was Oland's fourth consecutive top four finish and fifth of the year. Oland holds a 71.00 stroke average for the season.

Dylan McClure, Cameron University, shot a career best 212 (73+68+71) at the Mustang Intercollegiate this last week and finished in eighth place for his fifth top-10 finish of the season. He would lead the Aggies to fourth overall with a score at 867 (285+295+288) in a field of 20 teams. McClure's second round score (68) also matched a career low mark and CU's fourth lowest score this season. In 13 rounds this season he is carrying a 72.08 stroke average.

Angelo State

Cameron

Cameron finished tied for fourth in Arizona at the Mustang Intercollegiate with a 867 (285+295+288). Dylan McClure was Cameron's best finisher overall after scoring a 212 (73+69+71) to finish eighth overall; his three round score was two shots better than his career mark set in the fall at Western New Mexico's Fall Invite. Cullen Stahl fired off the lowest score of the day in the third round with a career best 67 (5-under) with two eagles and three birdies for place 26th overall with a 219 (77+75+67).

Midwestern State

The Midwestern State women placed seventh at the weather-shortened United States Women's Invitational at the Pine Island Country Club in Charlotte, N.C. The tournament, originally set for 54-holes, was reduced to a single 18-hole round because of storms and flooding late Sunday night and Monday morning...The seventh place finish is the lowest performance of the season for the Mustangs and snapped MSU streak of seven straight top four finishes...MSU is ranked 19th in the latest Golf World/WGCA Division II Coaches Poll issued April 2, up from 20th in the March rankings...MSU has an average score of 313.25, ranking 18th in Division II... Junior Brenna Moore continues to lead the Mustangs with a 75.13 stroke average, seventh in NCAA Division II in raw score...

The Midwestern State men placed 10th at the Dallas Baptist Classic at the Golf Club of Dallas (the former Oak Cliff Country Club)...the result snapped a string of five straight top four finishes by MSU this year...The Mustangs fell to 30th in the latest GolfStat rankings...MSU is not in the Golf World/GCAA Division II Coaches Top 25, but is receiving votes in the poll...The Mustangs are ranked fourth in the first NCAA Division II Regional Rankings released April 4...MSU has an average team scores of 295.29, 20th in NCAA II in raw score...Junior Derek Oland is one of the top Division II golfers in the nation, with a 71.00 stroke average, second in NCAA Division II in raw score and ranking fourth nationally by GolfStat...
