### LSC BASEBALL

West Texas A&M and Texas A&M-Kingsville are tied atop the Lone Star Conference standings with three weeks of league play remaining.

This week's schedule includes WT at Angelo State, Eastern New Mexico at TAMUK, and Cameron at Tarleton State.

In 2014, LSC teams are playing a 10-week schedule with a four-game series and three-game series against every other team. Each four-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday, a 7x7 doubleheader Saturday and 9-inning contest Sunday, and each three-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday and a 7x9 doubleheader Saturday.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 8-10, at the No. 1 seed with the top four teams qualifying.

LSC baseball teams are 133-99 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 21-8 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-5 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### HITTERS

##### Noel Nevarez, Tarleton State University, JR, OF, Princeton, Texas, Princeton HS

Nevarez had a monster weekend at the plate, collecting seven hits in his 12 at-bats for a .583 batting average. The junior outfielder racked up a 1.250 slugging percentage as well with a pair of doubles to go along with his two home run blasts and he recorded two walks as well for a .667 on-base percentage. With the Texans trailing 9-8 in the bottom of the ninth inning during the series finale, Nevarez blasted his sixth home run of the season to tie the game and the Texans went on to walk-off with the victory a few batters later.

##### Taylor Taska, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SR, 1B/DH/P, Kingwood, Texas, Kingwood HS

Taska had an impressive week for the Javelinas. The senior hit .556 in four games for the week with 11 runs batted in, two home runs and five runs scored. In the series with Cameron, he finished with a .643 average, 10 RBI and two home runs in three contests. In the opening game on Friday, Taska 4-of-5 with four RBI and three runs scored and a home run. In the second game of the doubleheader, Taska finished 2-of-5 adding three more runs driven in. In Saturday's series finale, Taska again homered upping his season total to five. He went 3-of-4 with three RBI and a run scored. The dual threat also pitched 2-1/3 innings in two outings against Cameron on Friday. He did not allow a run and earned his first save since his freshman season in the second game on Friday. In tossed a scoreless inning against A&M International as well.

#### PITCHERS

##### Colton Burlelson, Tarleton State University, JR, RHP, Jasper, Texas, Jasper HS

Burlelson tossed his first career shutout with the Texans on Saturday, giving up just three hits and helping lead Tarleton to an 8-0 win over Angelo State. Burlelson struck out six Ram batters in his full seven innings of work en route to his third complete game of the season.

##### Cody Williams, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SR, P, Cypress, Texas, Cypress Woods HS

Williams entered the week with a hard-luck 2-5 record, however, things changed for him this week as he went 2-0 earning the win against International and Cameron on Saturday. He tossed 2-2/3 innings of scoreless relief against the Dustdevils. He scattered two hits and struck out four. After a shutout inning of work in the second game on Friday, Williams tossed 5-1/3 innings in the finale in relief of Matt Rhodes. He scattered six hits and allowed three earned runs. He had 3.00 ERA for the week.

### OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Tyler McKnight, West Texas A&M University, SR, OF, Durango, Colo., Durango HS, Senior Tyler McKnight continued to lead the team in hitting as he went 7 of 12 with five runs scored, two triples and one home run over the week. He tallied four RBI and slugged 1.167, while reaching base at a .615 clip. McKnight helped lead WT to a 2-1 weekend series win against Eastern New Mexico and a 5-2 series win for the season versus the Greyhounds. McKnight stole three bases in three attempts and had two put outs in the outfield for the sixth-ranked Buffs. He went 4 for 4 with three runs scored and three RBI, along with two triples in the Buffs' 14-4 win the series opener on Friday. The four hits, three runs scored and three RBI tied his season-highs and the two triples on Friday were a season-high. McKnight extended his reaching base streak to a team-high 29 games and had at least one hit in each of the three games moving his current hitting streak to four games which is tied for fourth-longest currently on the team.

Reggie Rodriguez, Angelo State University, put together the best week of his senior season by going 7-for-16 with three RBI in a five-game week for the Rams. Rodriguez had three hits against McMurry and then four against Tarleton State over the weekend. Adding in two walks, he finished the five games with a .500 on-base percentage and also had a triple and stolen base.

Matthew Burks, Eastern New Mexico University, hit a home run in each game of the three-game series at West Texas A&M. He became the first Greyhounds to hit a homer in three straight games for the first time

since 2008 and the fifth since 1999. Two of his bombs were two-run shots while he led off the second game of the series with a solo home run on the first pitch of the contest. In a non-conference game against Lubbock Christian, Burks was 2-for-5 with two stolen bases and a run scored. For the week, he hit .375 (6-for-16) with five RBIs, a team-high five runs, walked once and was hit by a pitch. He also posted a slugging percentage of .938 and on-base percentage of .444.

Kyle Kesmarki, Eastern New Mexico University, earned the fifth save of his career at West Texas A&M to move into a tie for sixth on ENMU's career list. Three of his saves have come against the Buffaloes. Kesmarki needed just two pitches to earn his first save of the season as he came on with a runner on first with no one out. He induced a ground ball for a double play and then got a pop up to end the game. For the season, Kesmarki has an ERA of 0.00 as he has allowed just one run which was unearned in 8.2 innings with nine strikeouts as well.

Sam Ouellet, West Texas A&M University, saw action in two games this week as he earned the win in relief at Wayland Baptist on Tuesday as he went four innings, allowing three hits, one earned run and one strikeout in the Buffs' 15-6 win. He followed that with 3.2 innings of relief Saturday against Eastern New Mexico as he allowed four hits, two earned runs, one walk and fanned two. Ouellet is 2-0 on the year in eight games with two starts and a 3.38 ERA. He has pitched 37.1 innings, which is fourth on the team.

## LSC NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

### Angelo State

The Rams struggled to continue their momentum from two LSC series wins over ENMU and Cameron by splitting a non-conference doubleheader against McMurry last Tuesday before being swept by Tarleton State in Stephenville over the weekend. ASU went 1-4 during the week and lost its season-series advantage over TSU which is now 4-3 this year against the Rams. ASU hit .309 for the week, but its pitching struggled with a 9.26 ERA. Reggie Rodriguez led the Rams at the plate with seven hits and three RBI, while David Goggin, Cameron Massengill, Christian Summers and Hunter Choate each had five hits in the five game week. The Rams will look to rebound against West Texas A&M this weekend in their final home series of the season. ASU enters the weekend with a 14-7 record at Foster Field this season.

### Cameron

The Cameron baseball team went 0-3 against Texas A&M-Kingsville last weekend. The Aggies recorded 31 hits in the series, but were outscored 30-17. Matt Nilmeier led the team, going 5-12 with a triple and four RBI. Codey McElroy hit a grand slam and scored three runs. CU will take on SWOSU in a single non-conference game April 15 before heading down to Tarleton St. for a three game series.

### Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 1-3 last week against two nationally ranked opponents. On Tuesday at home, the Greyhounds comeback fell short against #12 Lubbock Christian 8-7. Matthew Burks had three hits, Colton Sims had two base knocks and three RBIs and Dylan Nault drove in two runs. ENMU followed by dropping two of three at #6 West Texas A&M. In the series versus the Buffaloes, Burks hit a home run in each game to become the first Greyhounds to do so since 2008 and fifth since 1999. Kyle Kesmarki earned his fifth career save in the first game of the doubleheader on Saturday to move up to a tie for sixth on the school's career list as he needed just two pitches to do so. Blake Cooper also hit a home run in the game, his LSC-high eight of the season, as he went 1-for-1 with three runs, three walks and two RBIs. For the week, Sims led the Hounds with a .444 average, eight hits and six RBIs. Rafael Romo hit .400 with two runs driven in. Burks finished with a .375 average, five RBIs, five runs scored and was 2-for-2 stealing bases. Sam Hedrick and Cooper both stole two bases apiece while Bryan Pinocci led the team with three steals. On the mound, Matthew Artalejo got the team's only win as he improved to 6-3 on the season. Taking the losses were Jackson Gaskins, Ben Monticello and Jorge Quezada. This week Eastern plays four games on the road. First up is a non-conference contest at Wayland Baptist on Tuesday. The Greyhounds then travel to Texas A&M-Kingsville for a key, three-game series to keep ENMU in the hunt for a spot in the conference tournament.

### Tarleton State

The Texans managed to get back into the LSC Championship picture with a three-game sweep over Angelo State this past weekend in Stephenville ... It was Tarleton's first-ever sweep over the Rams in school history ... Alvaro Moreno blasted a grand slam in the series and finished hitting .316 with seven runs batted in ... Noel Nevarez hit his team-high fifth and sixth home runs over the weekend, with his final one tying the game in the ninth inning of the series finale ... A few batters later, Luke Slentz would give the Texans its first walk-off win of the season with his single to left field to score the winning run ... Robert Baker and Colton Burlison picked up wins for the Texans this weekend, and Ethan Lenz recorded the victory in Tarleton's come-from-behind win as well ... Burlison pitched a three-hit shutout on Saturday, striking out six batters and walking just one ... The Texans are now just one game behind the Rams for third place in the conference ... Jared Musgrove leads the league with a .436 batting average heading into this week, as well as leading the LSC with a .531 on-base percentage ... Rustin Thomas ranks second in the LSC with a .585 slugging percentage, but is first with 12 doubles on the year ... Thomas and Nevarez are third in the LSC with their six home runs ... Lenz is currently tied for the league lead with seven saves on the year ... The Texans will take a break from LSC action to play St. Mary's in San Antonio on Tuesday ... Tarleton returns home to face Cameron in a four-game set this weekend.

### Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas went 4-0 this past week downing Texas A&M International at home last Tuesday before sweeping three games at Cameron over the weekend. With the sweep the Hoggies swept the season series with the Aggies. In the seven games, Kingsville outscored Cameron 64-24 with a .346 average at the plate...Last week the team hit .308 at the plate. Taylor Taska lead the way with a .556 average while fellow senior Derrick Walls was second with a .500 mark. Justin Lee and Ryan Guedry averaged .357 and .333, respectively...The Javelinas top two hitters in the order combined to score 14 of Kingsville's 33 runs. Derrick Walls had eight runs scored

and Miles Holcomb has six...Derrick Walls is at or near the top of several categories in the LSC. Walls is second in on-base percentage at .563, steals with and in walks with 26. He is third in runs scored with 33 and plate appearances 176. Walls, who was 4-of-4 in steals last week is 10 shy of Rick Dyer's single-season record of 28 in 2004...Taylor Taska hit .556 in four games for the week with 11 RBI, two homers and five runs. ### West Texas A&M

The No. 6 West Texas A&M baseball team went 3-1 over the week with a 15-6 win at Wayland Baptist on Tuesday and then won two of three games versus Eastern New Mexico over the weekend...WT improved to 30-10 on the year and 18-8 in league play as it is tied with Texas A&M-Kingsville for the league-lead with three series' to play...The Buffs' offense came alive again this week as WT hit .396 for the week with 57 hits, six doubles, three triples and seven home runs which were the most round-trippers in a week this season...WT had four home runs on Saturday's twin bill against ENMU which was half of its total production of home runs for the season...Senior Tyler McKnight continued his offensive tear as he hit .583 in the ENMU series with seven hits in 12 at bats, along with five runs scored, two triples and one home run...He slugged 1.167 and reached base at a .615 clip...WT slugged a season-best .625 for the week and reached base on a .491 clip...Senior reliever Sam Ouellet went 1-0 in 7.2 innings as he won in relief on Tuesday at Wayland Baptist and then pitched 3.2 innings on Saturday against ENMU...Senior Dylan James returned to his normal form, snapping a two-game skid with a six-inning effort Friday versus ENMU to earn the win and clinch the series win versus the Greyhounds...The staff held a 5.73 ERA in four games and 33 innings...It allowed 36 hits, 25 runs (scoring 44) with 21 earned runs, 14 walks and 28 strikeouts...WBU and ENMU hit .281 for the week against WT...The 30 equals last season's win total and marks the first time since baseball was brought back in 1994 WT has won back-to-back 30 games...It also marks the sixth time during that span the Buffs have won 30 games in a season.
