### LSC GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2014 Lone Star Conference Men's and Women's Golf Championships are set for next Monday and Tuesday at Horseshoe Bay Golf Club in Horseshoe Bay, Texas.

The league championships will be determined by a 54-hole tournament for men and a 36-hole tournament for women at Ram Rock Course.

The four men's squads will utilize match play with stroke play in Monday's first round to determine team seeding and conference medalist, semifinal match play in Monday's second round, and championship match play in Tuesday's final round. The seven women's teams will play 18 holes each day.

Midwestern State is the reigning men's champion after claiming its first-ever title last year. On the women's side, Tarleton State will be looking for its seventh straight and eighth overall title, while West Texas A&M's Glory Jangthongsiri returns after winning the individual title in 2013.

### GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

#### MEN'S

**Ethan Peterson, West Texas A&M University, SO, Clovis, N.M., Clovis HS**

Fired a 7-under 135 and finished second at the weather-shortened Wolf Pack Invitational this week. Peterson's 68 and 67 were the low rounds of the season for him as he helped lead the Buffs to a second-place finish, one stroke behind Colorado Mesa in the team standings...It was Peterson's second consecutive week of having rounds in the 60s as he fired a 5-under 211 last week at the Mustang Invitational with a 72, 69 and 70...The 2nd place finish for the Buffs was the best of the season and the one stroke difference also was the best of the season.

#### WOMEN'S

**Beatriz Prados, Tarleton State University, FR, Madrid, Spain**

Prados won her first career individual title, all the while carding a season and career-low 5-under par 67 in the weather-shortened Doc Housewright Invitational this week. Her low-round of the tournament helped guide the TexAnns to a team score of seven-under par and a school record team score of 281.

### OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Glory Jangthongsiri, West Texas A&M University, helped lead the Lady Buffs to an eighth-place finish at the Doc Housewright Invitational this week..Carded a 73 in the weather-shortened tournament to lead the team and tied for eighth.

The TexAnns won its second consecutive tournament with a one-round score of seven-under par at the Doc Housewright Invitational at Harbor Lakes in Granbury this week ... The team score of 281 was a new school record for the TexAnns, bettering the 285 the team shot back in October ... Beatriz Prados shot a season and career-low five-under (67) to win the individual title and Jessica Pickwick, who finished in second place, recorded a career-low three-under (69) ... Tarleton has won three of its last four tournaments and four overall for the season ... The TexAnns will head into next week's Lone Star Conference Championships as the six-time defending champions ... Tarleton has not been defeated in an LSC Championship since finishing in third place back in 2007 ... The TexAnns are currently ranked No. 5 in the nation according to the WGCA rankings and are No. 2 in the West Regional rankings that were released on April 10.

The Lady Buffs struggled a bit this week at the weather-shortened Doc Housewright Invitational, finishing eighth with a 313 score...The Lady Buffs entered the week eighth in the initial NCAA region rankings...Sophomore Glory Jangthongsiri paced the team shooting a 73 as she tied for eighth...Sophomore Whitlee Woods finished 27th with a 78 as the lone two Lady Buffs in the 70s...On the men's side, WT had a stellar week as it finished second at the weather-shortened Wolf Pack Invitational...WT came within one stroke of Colorado Mesa for the team title and the second place finish was the best finish to date this season for the Buffs...WT carded team scores of 289 and 282 for a 3-over 571...The Buffs entered 11th in the initial NCAA region rankings and defeated two team who were ahead of them in the standings in Colorado State-Pueblo and Colorado Christian...Sophomore Ethan Peterson continued his impressive play as he finished with a 7-under 135 on rounds of 68 and 67 to finish runner-up...It was his best finish of the season and the lowest two round total for any Buff this season...Ethan has had three rounds in the 60s in the past two tournaments as he earned LSC Player of the Week honors last week.
