### LSC BASEBALL

Texas A&M-Kingsville moved to the top of the Lone Star Conference standings and lead West Texas A&M by one game with two weeks of league play left. The Javelinas and Buffaloes have clinched berths in the LSC Championship field with two spots still up for grabs.

This week's schedule includes Angelo State at TAMUK, Tarleton State at WT, and Cameron at Eastern New Mexico.

In 2014, LSC teams are playing a 10-week schedule with a four-game series and three-game series against every other team. Each four-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday, a 7x7 doubleheader Saturday and 9-inning contest Sunday, and each three-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday and a 7x9 doubleheader Saturday.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 8-10, at the No. 1 seed with the top four teams qualifying.

LSC baseball teams are 145-110 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 21-9 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-5 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### HITTERS

##### Matthew Burks, Eastern New Mexico University, JR, OF, Vacaville, Calif., Wood HS/Diablo Valley College

Burks led Eastern New Mexico with a .467 batting average as he went 7-for-15 at the plate while scoring five times and driving in four runs. He also paced the Greyhounds for the week with a .733 slugging percentage and .556 on-base percentage while stealing his ninth base and getting hit by the pitch for the 12th time this season. The junior outfielder extended his home run streak to four consecutive games with a bomb at Wayland Baptist that gave him eight for the season and tied for the conference lead. In the three-game series at Texas A&M-Kingsville, Burks had six hits that included a 4-for-4 performance in the second game of the series. He currently has a 15-game hitting streak and has reached safely in 24 straight games, tied for the 10th longest in program history since 1999.

##### Brian Frazier, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SR, OF, Kingwood, Texas, Kingwood HS

Frazier continues to impress hitting .385 with a team-best six runs batted in. The righty belted two home runs over the weekend. His first was a crucial three-run bomb in the Javelinas five-run sixth inning and had a career-high four RBI in the game. He had a solo home in the second game on Saturday for Kingsville's first run and hit.

#### PITCHERS

##### Brian Schwabe, Cameron University, SR, Pitcher, St. Louis, Mo., St. John Vianney HS

Schwabe went a strong six innings in a razor thin 1-0 win over Tarleton State on Friday. He would only allow five hits, strike out two, and issued no walks in the victory. In 60 innings tossed this season Schwabe is 3-3 with a 3.45 overall ERA.

##### Josh Weyker, West Texas A&M University, SR, RHP, Tucson, AZ, Sahuaro HS

Weyker returned to his early season form with an 8.0 inning, six-hit, one earned run win over Angelo State last weekend in the final game of the series to keep the Buffs within one game of the top of the league standings. He fanned a season-high 11 and had a 1.12 ERA as the Rams hit just .207 against him.

### OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Alvaro Moreno, Tarleton State University, had another great week at the plate, leading the Texans with nine hits that included a double and his third home run of the season. The senior third baseman drove in five runs and scored a pair of runs as well, while registering a team-high .591 slugging percentage on the week.

Nick Chapman, West Texas A&M University, went 5 for 11 from the plate with three runs scored, two doubles and five RBI in three games at Angelo State. He slugged .636 and reached base at a .500 clip. Chapman had one sacrifice fly and five put outs on six chances in the outfield with no errors. His .455 average led the team for the week.

Codey McElroy, Cameron University, pushed his reached base streak to 26 games after helping Cameron to a 4-1 week. He would hit .375 in 16 at-bats, with .474 on-base percentage, and three doubles. The junior accounted for half of CU offense with a pair of hits and three runs to take game three of the series with Tarleton State 6-2. In the last 15 games, he has 12 hits and leads the LSC with 13 doubles and a .303 batting average.

Tyler Coughenour, Angelo State University, provided the heroics during the last weekend of home games by hitting a three-run walk-off home run to lift Angelo State to a 10-8 win in the second game of its series against West Texas A&M. Coughenour's home run was his team-leading fourth homer of the season and gave the Rams the series win. The senior also had a triple, was hit by two pitches, scored three runs and finished the weekend with a .727 slugging percentage.

Jorge Quezada, Eastern New Mexico University, pitched a season-long four innings as he got the victory in the series finale at Texas A&M-Kingsville. The right-hander had a season-high three strikeouts. Javelinas batters hit just .154 off him as he allowed just two hits, both singles.

Heading into the contest with a 5.00-plus earned run average, all Gottardy did was give up three hits and one run through seven full innings and guide the Texans to a crucial win in the series finale against Cameron. The junior-righty struck out a pair of batters on the way to earning his third win of the season.

Dallas Ponder, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, earned his sixth win of the season on Friday night and is now tied for second in program history with 21 career wins. Ponder has recorded the win four of his last five starts.

## LSC NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

### Angelo State

The Rams earned a 2-1 series win over No. 6 West Texas A&M last weekend after taking the first two games of the series. The three-game set was the last home series for the Rams who finished the regular season with a 16-8 record at Foster Field this season. The Rams took the first game of the series 8-7 to improve to 12-8 in one-run games and then took a 10-8 walk-off win in the second game when Tyler Coughenour drilled a one-out, three-run home run to take the series. Graylon Brown earned both wins for the wins on the weekend with both coming in relief appearances. Brett David went 4-for-8 in the series, while Cameron Massengill had a 4-for-9 weekend. David Goggin added three RBI on three hits and Hunter Choate drove in five runs on two hits. Derek Tyner added four hits on eight plate appearances and finished with two RBI. The Rams will now travel to face Texas A&M-Kingsville this weekend before finishing off the regular season with three games at ENMU.

### Eastern New Mexico

Last week Eastern New Mexico went 2-2 with all four games coming on the road. The Greyhounds defeated Wayland Baptist in a midweek contest and took the series finale from Texas A&M-Kingsville, who won the first two games on the weekend. Matthew Burks extended his home run streak to four with a blast against the Pioneers but saw it come to an end in Kingsville. He led Eastern with a .467 batting average, seven hits, a .733 slugging percentage and .556 on-base percentage while tying for the most RBIs with four. Chris Sanders was 6-for-12 in three games with two doubles and drove in his first collegiate RBI versus the Javelinas. Colton Sims has caught fire lately with the bat as he hit .455 with 4 RBIs and saw his season average increase to .290. On the mound, Kiegan Basso and Jorge Quezada picked up victories. Kyle Kesmarki earned his second save of the season and sixth of his career which is tied for the fifth most in school history. Also making two appearances this week and not allowing an earned run was Brett Humphries while Cody Pope went two innings without allowing a run in his lone appearance. This week the Greyhounds play their final non-conference game of the regular season at nationally-ranked Lubbock Christian. ENMU follows up with a three-game series against Cameron as they begin their push to qualify for the Lone Star Conference Tournament for the first time since 2009.

### Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas went 2-1 last week to claim the overall season series with Eastern New Mexico 4-3...The Javelinas now have a 1-game advantage over West Texas A&M for first in the Lone Star Conference...The Javelinas play their final non-conference game of the regular season when travel to St. Edward's for a crucial South Central region meeting. It is the second meeting of the season for the two sides with St. Edward's winning in Kingsville 7-1 at home. The two teams met in last season's regional tournament championship game at Nolan Ryan Field with the Hilltoppers winning...In the three game's this past weekend, the Javelinas out-hit Eastern New Mexico .340 to .266. Three Hoggie hitters hit .545 for the series. Derrick Walls led the way by hitting .600 for the week with three runs scored and two runs batted in. No.-9 hitter Dustin Aguilar hit .556 for with three runs scored and an RBI, while Clint Wallace hit .545 with a team-high four runs scored...Walls raised his season average to .368 which is third in the conference as he was 6-of-10 and now has an 11-game hitting streak. He had a double, walked three times and was hit by a pitch. He finished with a .714 on-base percentage to raise his season mark to .481 and a .700 slugging percentage. Walls was 3-of-3 in stolen bases and now leads the league with 21...The Javelina bullpen played a key role to the Javelinas winning the weekend series. In 13-2/3 innings, the Kingsville bullpen did not allow a run and permitted just five hits and walked two. Matt Rhodes tossed seven innings of scoreless relief, while Cody Williams made two appearances for 3-2/3 innings with a win to move to 5-5 he allowed just one hit and fanned four...Ryan Scott closed out the win in Saturday's first game with his Lone Star Conference leading eight save...Senior Brian Frazier continues to impress hitting .385 with a team-best six runs batted in. The righty belted two home runs over the weekend. His first was a crucial 3-run bomb in the Javelinas 5-run sixth inning. He had a solo home in the second game on Saturday for Kingsville's first run and hit...Catcher Clint Wallace has been tremendous behind the plate. The junior threw out to more runners in the weekend series and leads the Lone star Conference with 18. His nearest competitor has 12.

### West Texas A&M

The Buffs went 1-2 this week at Angelo State and won the season-series with the Rams, 5-2...WT really struggled from the mound, especially the bullpen, as it built big leads in the first two games, only to see the Rams come back with big offensive innings and win...WT held 4-2 lead in the opener in the seventh, but allowed six runs in the bottom of the frame as ASU won 8-7...The Rams then used a three run, walk-off home run in the bottom of the eighth to win the first game of a doubleheader Saturday 10-8 as WT held a 7-3 lead midway through the game...Weyker was dominant in the final game as he pitched eight innings, allowing one earned run on six hits for a 5-1 WT win...The win kept WT within one game of Texas A&M-Kingsville in the league standings...TAMUK and WT entered the series tied at the top, but the Javelinas won 2 of 3 against Eastern New Mexico...The Buffs have the tie-breaker over TAMUK and Angelo State...WT plays its final non-conference game of the regular season Tuesday at Wilder Park against Wayland Baptist and closes the home regular season this weekend with a big series versus Tarleton State...WT won 3 of 4 in Stephenville earlier in the season...TAMUK play Angelo State this weekend at home and then closes the season at Tarleton State, while WT closes the season next weekend at Cameron...It looks as if the conference regular season champion may not be decided, and host for the conference tournament, until the final week of the season.
