LSC BASEBALL

Texas A&M-Kingsville remains atop the Lone Star Conference standings with a three-game lead over West Texas A&M. The Javelinas and Buffaloes have clinched berths in the LSC Championship field with the final two spots and seeding to be determined during the last week of regular season action. TAMUK needs just one victory or one WT loss to clinch the No. 1 seed and right to host the championship. If the teams end up with identical records, the Buffs hold the tiebreaker by virtue of a 4-3 head-to-head advantage over the Javelinas.

This week's schedule includes TAMUK at Tarleton State, WT at Cameron, and Angelo State at Eastern New Mexico.

In 2014, LSC teams are playing a 10-week schedule with a four-game series and three-game series against every other team. Each four-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday, a 7x7 doubleheader Saturday and 9-inning contest Sunday, and each three-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday and a 7x9 doubleheader Saturday.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 8-10, at the No. 1 seed with the top four teams qualifying.

LSC baseball teams are 155-121 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 22-10 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-5 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Garrett Kilgore, Tarleton State University, SR, 1B, Frisco, Texas, Frisco Centennial

Kilgore helped guide the Texans to a pair of wins over the No. 16-ranked West Texas A&M Buffs this weekend, going 9-for-13 at the plate to finish with a .692 batting average over the three-game set. The Frisco native registered a team-high three doubles and scored six runs as well. He recorded a .923 slugging percentage and with one walk on the weekend, he tallied a .714 on-base percentage also.

Matthew Burks, Eastern New Mexico University, JR, OF, Vacaville, Calif., Will C.Wood HS/Diablo Valley College

Burks had a team-high 10 hits in 16 at-bats for a .625 batting average as he had at least two hits in all four games, including four in a rout of Cameron in the series opener. He posted an on-base percentage of .667 and a slugging percentage of 1.000. During the series against the Aggies, Burks hit his Lone Star Conference leading ninth and 10th home runs while scoring seven times, driving in five runs and stealing a base. He extended his hitting streak to 19 games, tied for the fifth longest in program history since 1999, and has reached base in 28 straight games.

PITCHERS

Denver Diefenbach, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SR, P, Victoria, Texas, St. Joseph HS

Diefenbach earned his league-leading ninth win of the season tossing his fourth complete game of the season. He held Angelo scoreless for his second shutout of the season. Diefenbach scattered four hits, walked one and fanned three.

Kyle Gottardy, Tarleton State University, JR, RHP, Spring Branch, Texas, Smithson Valley

Gottardy tossed six full innings and gave up just a pair of runs on the way to earning the victory in Tarleton's 16-4 series finale win over West Texas A&M on Saturday. Gottardy yielded just one earned run, struck out three batters and did not allow an extra base hit to the Buffs in the win.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Beto Rodriguez, West Texas A&M University, led the team in hitting this week, going 8 of 15 with five runs scored, one double, one triple and one home run. He had five RBI with 14 total bases as he slugged a team-best .933 and reached base at a .588 clip. He was 1 for 1 in stolen bases and had no errors in 29 chances with 13 put outs.

Harold Cannon, Cameron University, hit .500 at Eastern New Mexico to lead the Cameron offense. In 10 at-bats he had five hits, with a double, and homer to drive in four RBI. Cannon reached home plate four times and walked twice to give him an on-base % at .583 overall. In the last 18 games Cannon's batting average has jumped from .190 to .296 with three homers, six doubles, 24 hits and 16 RBI.

Taylor Taska, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, belted two home runs on the week in finishing with a .438 average. He led the way with six RBI and six runs scored for the Javelinas with an .875 slugging percentage. Against St. Edward's, he had a part in all three Javelina runs. He scored a run against Angelo by swiping home on a double steal.

Jorge Quezada, Eastern New Mexico University, shutdown Cameron in the 5-4 series finale victory over the final 3.1 innings. He struck out six, the most for him in a Greyhound uniform, and did not walk an Aggie while allowing only one hit and an unearned run. Opposing batters hit a miniscule .083 off him as only two reached base, on an error and base hit, and he retired the final seven batters in order. Quezada is now 2-1 on the season with his ERA dropping to 3.98.

LSC NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

Angelo State

The Rams went 0-3 last week after being swept by the Javelinas in a three-game set in Kingsville. ASU has now lost 10 straight road games entering the final weekend of the regular season where it needs one win over Eastern New Mexico to secure a spot in the LSC tournament. The Rams are 3-1 against the Greyhounds after taking the first series between the two teams earlier this season in San Angelo.

Cameron

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 2-2 last week as they took two of three from Cameron and lost their final non-conference game of the season to #8 Lubbock Christian (9-2). The Greyhounds routed the Aggies 21-3 in the series opener with the 21 runs being the most scored by Eastern since putting up 25 at West Texas A&M exactly six years to the day. CU took the second of the series 6-5 as they scored all of their runs on homers. ENMU held off the Aggies in the finale 5-4. At the plate, Matthew Burks hit his ninth and 10th home runs of the season, the most in the LSC. He is the first Greyhound to reached double-digit home runs since 2000 and just the sixth ever to do so. Burks also batted .625 with a .667 on-base percentage, 1.000 slugging percentage, scored seven runs and drove in five. Rawley Gomez led the team with a .667 average as he posted three extra base hits (2 doubles, 1 triple) which were the first of his career. Rafel Romo hit .556 while Brett Ackerman, Blake Cooper and Colton Sims all batted .417. Of Cooper's five hits, four when for extra bases with two doubles and two triples. Both Chris Sanders and Colton Sims had a team-high six RBI apiece. On the mound, Ben Monticello and Jorge Quezada picked up a win apiece. Monticello went six innings, striking out five and gave up eight hits and three runs in his 12th start of the season. Quezada struck out a season-high six, allowed no walks, only one hit and an unearned run in 3.1 innings while the Aggies hit just .083 off him. Over the past two weeks, his ERA has dropped over two runs to 3.98. Kiegan Basso, Jonathan Joy and Dylan Montano did not give up a run or hit in a combined four innings of relief. ENMU concludes the season with a LSC Tournament berth on the line this weekend at home versus Angelo State in a three-game series.

Tarleton State

The Texans went into Canyon over the weekend and downed the No. 16-ranked Buffs two out of the three games to take control of third place in the LSC standings ... The Texans are a half game ahead of Angelo State for third place and one and a half games ahead of Eastern New Mexico, who is currently in third place ... Tarleton hit .422 as a team and tallied a team ERA of 5.32, compared with WT's batting average of .337 and ERA of 10.17 ... Garrett Kilgore had the hot bat for the Texans over the weekend, hitting .692 with nine hits (three doubles) and scored six of Tarleton's 28 runs for the weekend ... Dalton Weeks had a great weekend as well, hitting .556 and recording a team-high eight RBI ... Kyle Gottardy and Troyal Yosko both picked up wins for the Texans as they combined to toss 9.1 innings of work, four strikeouts and a 0.90 ERA ... Garrett Kelly had four K's in two appearances and managed to record his third save of the season as well ... The Texans will head into the final weekend of the regular season hosting the league-leading Texas A&M-Kingsville Javelinas ... The three-game series is scheduled to begin Friday at 3 p.m. from Stephenville.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Texas A&M-Kingsville baseball team has won 10-of-11 after sweeping its three-game set with Angelo State at Nolan Ryan Field. The Javelinas won the season-series 6-1 over the Rams...Including a non-conference win over St. Edward's, Kingsville went 4-0 last week. They outscored their opponents by a combined 27-5 in the four games...The Javelinas batted .322 as a team last week with four players hitting .438 or better. Brian Frazier led the Javelinas with a .571 average, while Matt Perez and James Black hit .455 with five RBI apiece. Taylor Taska belted two home runs on the week in finishing with a .438 average. He led the way with six runs batted in and six runs scored...With the sweep, the Javelinas finish the regular season with a 21-7 record...The Javelinas enter the final week of the regular season with a 3-game lead over West Texas A&M and have clinched a share of the regular season title. With a win at Tarleton, or a West Texas loss, the Hoggies will host the Lone Star Conference tournament in baseball May 8-10...All four Javelina starters earned wins for Kingsville this past week, and the staff combined for an ERA of 1.12. They lowered their staff ERA to 2.90 on the season. The Hoggies walked six batters in 32 innings last week and limited hitters to a .228 average...Ryan Scott tossed two scoreless innings earning two more saves. He leads the Lone Star Conference with 10 saves and has an ERA of 2.00. He was helped by Cody Williams who tossed three innings of scoreless relief to lower his ERA to a league-leading 1.84...Dallas Ponder climbed to second in career wins and in strikeouts this past weekend. With the win, he has 22 career wins which is two shy of the all-time record. Ponder is tied for third in the LSC with seven wins. He had nine strikeouts raising his total to 228 leaving him 13 shy of a school record...Denver Diefenbach earned his league-leading ninth win of the season tossing his fourth complete game of the season. He held Angelo scoreless for his second shutout of the season. Diefenbach scattered four hits, walked one and fanned three.

West Texas A&M

The Buffs really struggled this past week, especially the pitching staff, going 1-3 with two losses to Tarleton State and a 20-19 setback against Wayland Baptist...WT got down 10-0 through three innings against WBU and battled back, but was unable to get out of jams allowing the Pioneers to continue to score runs...WBU scored in all but one inning in the game, but the Buffs had a chance with 2-4 hitters up in the bottom of the ninth and a man on, but were unable to score the equalizer...Against Tarleton State, the Buffs won the opener, but dropped a doubleheader Saturday for Senior Day...For the week, the Buffs hit .386, but the opposition hit .444 which was a season-high...WT scored 38 runs and allowed 48 with a 12.09 ERA...Senior Beto Rodriguez led the team with a .533 average in four games at second base...He went 8 of 15 with five runs scored, one double, one triple, one home run and five RBI...Rodriguez slugged .933 and reached base at a .588 clip...In all, 10 of 11 batters hit over .300 for the week...WT walked 18 and fanned just 20 for the week which was very uncharacteristic of this team...Senior Dylan James earned the lone win as he improved his strikeout total to a school-record 100 for the season...The 32 wins by WT this season are the most since winning 33 in 1999...The school record for wins in a season is 34...WT has won back-to-back 30 games for the first time in school history and the 2014 season is just the sixth since 1994 of winning 30 or more games... The Buffs sit three games back of TAMUK and will need Tarleton State to sweep TAMUK and WT to win all three at Cameron to earn a share of the LSC title and host the conference tournament as WT owns the tiebreaker against TAMUK...Otherwise, WT will be the No. 2-seed in the LSC tournament...May 8-10 in Kingsville, Texas.
