GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S

Derek Oland, Midwestern State University, JR, McKinney, Texas, Boyd

Oland collected several records in claiming his third individual tournament title of the year with his win at the Argonaut Invitational in Pensacola, Fla. The junior from McKinney, Texas/Boyd tied the Pensacola Country Club record and broke the MSU school record with a 10-under-par 62 in the opening round. He followed that with a 6-under 66 on the par 72, 6815-yard PCC course, equaling the sixth-best round in school history – both on Monday. The 36-hole total of 16-under 128 is also a new school record. He followed it with a 3-over 75 on Tuesday to win the tournament by eight strokes with a 13-under 203 and establish a new 56-hole school record. Oland's play helped MSU to a third place finish as a team.

WOMEN'S

Sharon Lau, Tarleton State University, SR, Malaysia

Lau shot a 5-over 149 this week to win the individual title at the Southwest Classic at Horseshoe Bay. She fired a 4-over 76 in the first round and then paced the TexAnns to a first place finish with her 1-over 73 on Tuesday. It was Lau's first individual win since October 2012.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Kellie Martin, Midwestern State University, placed fourth individually in leading Midwestern State to a second place finish at the Southwest Classic at Horseshoe Bay. Martin fired the best round of her collegiate career with a 2-over 74 in the first round on her way to a 10-over 154 to place fourth. It was her first-ever top five finish as a collegian.

Glory Jangthongsiri, West Texas A&M University, paced the Lady Buffs in a fourth-place finish at the Mustang Invitational this week at the Palm Valley Golf Club in Goodyear, Ariz. Jangthongsiri carded rounds of 77 and 73 for a 150 as the team dropped 16 strokes from the first round to the second and moved up six places in the team standings. Jangthongsiri finished tied for fourth in the tournament as it was her seventh top-five finish in eight tournaments this season.

The Midwestern State women chalked up their third second place finish of the season with their play at the Southwest Classic. MSU posted a 317-320 – 637 in the event at the Horseshoe Bay Resort's Apple Rock Course. The Mustangs have not placed lower than fifth in a tournament this season, with a win, two seconds and a fourth place showing this spring ... MSU is ranked 18th in the latest Golfstat ranking, sixth regionally by Golfstat ... The Mustangs are 20th in the latest Golf World/WGCA Division II Coaches Poll ... MSU's average score of 312.07 is 15th nationally ... Junior Brenna Moore leads Midwestern with a 74.73 stroke average, fifth nationally by raw score and ranking 14th by Golfstat in NCAA Division II ... The Mustangs play in the U.S. Women's Invitational at the Pine Island Country Club in Charlotte, N.C. on April 7-8, their final competition before the Lone Star Conference Championships on April 21-22.

The MSU men placed third at the Argonaut Invitational in Pensacola, Fla., recording a 286-282-300 – 868 for the event. It was the fifth straight top four finish for the Mustangs and the sixth top four finish of the of the year ... Midwestern is ranked 24th in the latest Golfstat ranking, fifth regionally ... The Mustangs average score of 294.52 is 14th nationally ... Junior Derek Oland sports a 70.95 stroke average, second nationally by raw score and ranked fourth in NCAA Division II by Golfstat ... Of Oland's 21 rounds this year, 14 have been par or better with six rounds in the 60s ... Senior Jeremy LeGuen has a 74.37 stroke average, second on the team ... The Mustangs play in the Dallas Baptist Classic at the Hackberry Creek Country Club in Irving on April 7-8, their final competition before the Lone Star Conference Championships on April 21-22.
