LSC BASEBALL

West Texas A&M leads Texas A&M-Kingsville by one game in the Lone Star Conference standings after the Javelinas won two of three games against the Buffs last week.

This week's schedule includes Eastern New Mexico at WT, TAMUK at Cameron, and Angelo State at Tarleton State for a three-game series.

In 2014, LSC teams are playing a 10-week schedule with a four-game series and three-game series against every other team. Each four-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday, a 7x7 doubleheader Saturday and 9-inning contest Sunday, and each three-game series shall consist of a 9-inning game Friday and a 7x9 doubleheader Saturday.

The overall LSC Champion will be the team(s) with the best winning percentage in regular-season conference games, while the winner of the postseason championship will be recognized as LSC Tournament Champion and receive the league's automatic qualification into NCAA postseason. The championship will be played May 8-10, at the No. 1 seed with the top four teams qualifying.

LSC baseball teams are 120-88 overall this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the teams are currently 19-6 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 18-5 against the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

HITTERS

Miles Holcomb, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SO, OF, Dripping Springs, TX, Dripping Springs HS

Holcomb led all players with at least eight bats with a .500 average as the Javelinas beat St. Mary's and took two of three versus West Texas A&M. He drove in four runs and scored four times with a .750 slugging percentage. Holcomb currently has a 9-game hitting streak and has reached safely in 11 consecutive games.

Brett Ackerman, Eastern New Mexico University, SR, SS, San Diego, Calif., Poway HS/San Diego Mesa College

Ackerman went 5-for-10 at the plate, led Eastern New Mexico with four RBIs and posted a .700 slugging percentage and .500 on-base percentage as the Greyhounds swept a series from Tarleton State for the first time in 17 years. In the series opener, he went 4-for-5 as two of his hits were doubles. Ackerman drove in a career-high three runs in the contest including the game-winner in the bottom of the ninth with a walk-off double. He followed by going 1-for-3 and scored the game-tying run in the first game on Saturday. Although Ackerman did not get a hit in the rubber game, he did plate a run on a sacrifice bunt.

PITCHERS

Jason Zgardowski, Angelo State University, JR, RHP, San Antonio, Texas, Madison HS

Zgardowski threw seven scoreless innings before exiting with a big lead in an 8-0 win over Cameron in the series opener last weekend. Zgardowski cruised the CU lineup, striking out four and limiting the Aggies to five hits. He improved to 4-2 on the season and now has a 1.71 ERA with 59 strikeouts through 58.0 innings this season. Opponents have managed only a .212 batting average against him throughout the season and he has walked only 11 batters.

Brian Schwabe, Cameron University, SR, Pitcher, St. Louis, Mo., Vianney HS

Schwabe tossed 5 2/3 innings of no-hit ball and ended up with a two-hitter in a 3-0 win against Angelo State on Saturday. He would only walk one ASU batter and punched out five in the complete game win. This was the second time this season Schwabe flirted with a no-no, he tossed seven innings straight without a hit given up three weeks ago at home against Eastern New Mexico. In eight starts he is holding batters to a .216 average at the plate with 34 strikeouts and only nine walks.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Harold Cannon, Cameron University, recorded five hits in a three-game series at Angelo State last week and pushed his hitting streak to seven games. He accounted for two-thirds of the Aggies offense in a 3-0 win against ASU and added a pair of RBI in game two on Saturday. During the three game series, Cannon had an on-base percentage at .636 and an 1.000 slugging percentage. In the last three weeks Cannon's batting average has climbed nearly 100 points to .277 for the season.

Tyler McKnight, West Texas A&M University, went 5 of 10 with three runs scored and one RBI as WT held a one-game lead in the league standings over Texas A&M-Kingsville. He had one stolen base and two walks with no strikeouts and one stolen base. McKnight had seven put outs in the outfield.

Christian Summers, Angelo State University, stayed hot at the plate last weekend, going 5-for-11 with two doubles and three RBI for the Rams who took two of three from Cameron at Foster Field. Summers is now 20 for his last 46 (.435) over the past three weeks of LSC play and has four doubles and 11 RBI over that time. He had two doubles last weekend against the Aggies, including leading off the ninth of the series finale with a double to right-center field and scoring the walk-off run for the Rams. Summers also went 2-for-2 on stolen base attempts and is now 6-for-7 this season. He leads the Rams with 24 RBI this season and now has eight doubles.

Scott Cone, West Texas A&M University, pitched seven strong innings in the final game of a three game set at Texas A&M-Kingsville on Saturday. Cone allowed five hits, one earned run with no walks and eight strikeouts as he held the Javelinas to a .227 average in a 9-2 win. The win earned the Buffs the 4-3 series win for the season.

over TAMUK and gave WT a one-game lead in the league standings over the Javelinas.

Matthew Artalejo, Eastern New Mexico University, needed only 85 pitches to throw his third consecutive complete game in a 3-2 win over Tarleton State in the second game of the series. During the contest, he struck out five and walked one while allowing four hits and the Texans to hit .182 off him. It was the third straight game in which Artalejo has allowed the opposing team to get four hits off him. For the season, he is now 5-3 with a 2.78 ERA and 31 strikeouts.

Denver Diefenbach, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, moved to 7-1 on the season with his third complete game. He allowed two earned runs on seven hits with three strikeouts. His seven wins are tops in the Lone Star Conference this season

LSC NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

Angelo State

The Rams improved to 13-6 at home this season by taking two of three from Cameron last weekend. ASU earned an 8-0 win in the series opener before taking a 7-6 walk-off win in Saturday's second game. The Rams are now 11-6 in one-run games this season and have taken their last two LSC series. Christian Summers and Brett David led the Rams last weekend at the plate with five-hit weekends, while Jason Zgardowski threw seven scoreless innings in a win and Jake Feckley earned a win in relief on Saturday. The Rams host a doubleheader on Tuesday against McMurry before traveling to Stephenville for a three-game set this weekend against the Texans.

Cameron

The Cameron Aggies baseball team went 1-2 against Angelo State last weekend. After a tough 8-0 to the Rams in game one, CU used great pitching in game two to win 3-0. Senior Brian Schwabe got the win after going all seven innings and allowing only two hits. Harold Cannon helped the cause with two RBI, including a solo homerun in the fifth. However, the Aggies would fall in the third game, 7-6, after leading in the seventh to lose the series and fall to 12-20 overall this season and 7-14 in conference play. Cameron will host Texas A&M-Kingsville in a three game series on April 11-12.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico swept a three-game series at home from Tarleton State over the weekend. It was the first series sweep of the Texans for the Greyhounds since 1997 when they took four from them. The three victories gave ENMU the season series versus TSU for the first time since 2010 as well. The Greyhounds hit .337 while holding the Texans to a .190 average. Matthew Burks led the squad by going 7-for-11 (.636) and started the series with a lead off triple. Brett Ackerman drove in a team-high four runs while batting .500 with two doubles. His second double of the series opener scored the game-winning run in the bottom of the ninth. Steven Moore also hit .500 while Rawley Gomez (.400) and Rafael Romo (.375) hit over .300 for the series. On the mound, Matthew Artalejo tossed his third straight complete game as he picked up the win in game two. He struck out five while holding the Texans to a .182 batting average. Going eight innings in a start for the third consecutive time was Ben Monticello. Although he did not get the win, he had three strikeouts with no walks and allowed three runs, one earned, on seven hits. Kyle Kesmarki pitched a perfect ninth frame in the series opener to earn his first victory of the season. Rusty Edwards picked up the win in the rubber game, going 5.1 innings with three strikeouts and surrendering two runs on four hits and two walks. Sheldon Mobley earned his first career save as he pitched the final 1.2 innings. The series finale was called in the bottom of the eighth because of lightning and rain while the stats reverted back to the last complete inning, the seventh. This week ENMU hosts Lubbock Christian on Tuesday at 3 p.m. MT for their first midweek game of the season. The Greyhounds return to LSC action on Friday for a three-game series at rival West Texas A&M.

Tarleton State

The Texans dropped all three games of its Lone Star Conference series at Eastern New Mexico this past weekend ... The three losses put the Texans in fifth place and a full game back of the Greyhounds, who are currently in fourth place and in possession of the final spot for the conference tournament that will be held May 8-10 ... Tarleton was swept in a Lone Star Conference series for the first time since April 1, when the Texans dropped four games to Texas A&M-Kingsville ... ENMU won at least three games and took the series away from the Texans for the first time since 2010 ... The series sweep for ENMU was the first over TSU in 17 years ... The Texans hit just .190 over the weekend with Alvaro Moreno leading the way with his four hits in the three-game set ... Moreno led the team with three runs scored, while Garrett Kilgore tallied a team-high two runs batted in over the weekend ... Robert Baker was the only pitcher to not earn a loss over the weekend, as he left the game in a 3-3 tie ... Baker, did however, record a team-high five strikeouts in his seven innings of work ... Tarleton ranks among the top-25 teams in just four NCAA statistical categories, but are among the top six schools in two of those categories ... The Texans rank fourth in the nation in walks allowed (2.07 per 9 inn.) and sixth in fielding percentage (.976) ... Kevin Meredith ranks 39th in the nation with three triples on the season and Rustin Thomas is 51st overall with six home runs ... Noel Nevarez has five sacrifice flies on the year, which ranks 21st in the nation, while Ethan Lenz's six saves ranks 27th ... The Texans will host Angelo State for a three-game set in Stephenville beginning Friday ... The Rams took three of four from the Texans in the first series earlier this season.

Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelina baseball team went 3-1 this past week. The Hoggies climbed to four in the region rankings after downing St. Mary's 10-4 and winning the first two games of its 3-game set with West Texas A&M...The Javelinas host Texas A&M International on Tuesday before heading to Cameron for a 3-game set this Friday and Saturday...The Javelinas were solid at the plate last week as they hit .344 for the week. Miles Holcomb led all players with at least eight bats with a .500 average. He was one of three players to drive in four runs on the week, while finishing second in runs scored with four. Holcomb had a .750 slugging percentage for the week.

Holcomb currently has a 9-game hitting streak and has reached safely in 11 consecutive games...Brian Frazier finished with a .462 on the week driving in four runs and scoring four...James Black led the Hoggies with five runs scored...Ryan Benitez moved to 2-1 on the season with a win over Texas A&M International last Tuesday. He allowed one run on four hits in five innings of work. He added three strikeouts...Denver Diefenbach moved to 7-1 on the season with his third complete game. He allowed two earned runs on seven hits with three strikeouts. His seven wins are tops in the Lone Star Conference this season...Cody Williams earned the win in relief of Dallas Ponder in the opening game with WT. He is now 2-5 on the season despite a stellar 1.89 ERA... When leading after six innings in Javelina games the outcome has been pretty much decided for the Javelinas this season. When leading after six innings, the Javelinas are currently 21-0. When trailing after six they are 1-10.

West Texas A&M

The Buffs went 1-2 this weekend at Texas A&M-Kingsville, but kept a one-game lead in the league standings over TAMUK with a 9-2 win in the series finale...The Buffs won the season series with TAMUK, 4-3...WT hit just .275 for the weekend with 28 hits in 102 at bats and scored 14 runs with five doubles and 12 RBI...The staff struggled a bit allowing 22 runs in the series on 29 hits in 91 at bats as TAMUK hit .319...It was the second series the Buffs have struggled both offensively and defensively as they split a four game series with Cameron last week.
