

1998 LONE STAR CONFERENCE CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP

The Abilene Christian men and Angelo State women captured the Lone Star Conference Cross Country team championships on a course at the Kingsville Naval Air Station in Kingsville, Texas. The ACU men repeated as champions with 29 points. The Wildcats had the first, second, fourth, and fifth place finishers. Host Texas A&M-Kingsville was runnerup in the men's division with 76 points, Tarleton was third with 103, followed by Harding (105), and Texas A&M-Commerce (119).

Angelo State had 50 points to edge Harding (52) in the women's division. Abilene Christian was third with 91 points followed by Tarleton (108) and Texas A&M-Commerce (128).

Abilene Christian's Musa Gwanzura repeated as the men's champion with a time of 25:28 over the 8K course. Teammate Gilbert Tuhabonye was second and had the same time. Others in the top 10, and making the All-Lone Star Conference team, were Jerry Moritin (Harding), Ramon Serratos (ACU), Barnabas (ACU), Albert Tabut (Harding), Efrain Velazquez (Texas A&M-Kingsville), Mike Korczynski (Texas A&M-Commerce), Benny Rodriguez (Texas A&M-Kingsville), and Shawn Suitemeier (Tarleton).

Dora Dvila of Angelo State took the women's individual title in a time of 23:33 over the 6K course. Abilene Christian's Freda Valdez was second and ASU's Damaris Vaughan was third. Others making the All-LSC team, and their order of finish, were Sara Powlen (Tarleton), Britney Copeland (Harding), Josie Martinez (ACU), Joyce Martinez (ACU), Tia Tarole (Harding), Cheri Scharff (Harding), and Tosha Randle (Texas A&M-Kingsville).
