ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

MEN'S TRACK

Baptiste Moreu, West Texas A&M University, JR, La Rochelle, France, Benjamin Franklin HS

Moreu made history on Saturday at the David Hemery Valentine Invitational in Boston, Mass. as he broke the school and LSC record in the men's mile. He finished 38th out of 307 runners in a stacked field at Boston University. His 4:06.77 time broke a 37-year old WT record set by Joseph Kemei, which previously stood at 4:07.4. The previous LSC record was set by teammate Dylan Doss last season. With a narrow carving of the time due to track size conversion, Moreu ranks very high on the provisional qualifying list at 4:09.93.

MEN'S FIELD

Zach Weatherly, West Texas A&M University, SO, Amarillo, Texas, Tascosa HS

Weatherly was a top-10 finisher in both the men's shot put and weight throw last weekend at the New Mexico Classic. He threw 53-0.25 (16.16m) in the shot put on Friday before shattering his personal record in the weight throw on Saturday with a 55-1.5 (16.80m). That weight throw mark currently leads the LSC in the event.

WOMEN'S TRACK

Mireia Guarner, West Texas A&M University, SO, Catalonia, Spain, Col·legi Diocesa' Sagrada Familia

Guarner is coming off an excellent performance at the David Hemery Valentine Invitational last weekend in Boston, Mass. The sophomore broke the school record in the women's mile with a 5:03.16 in a highly competitive field, earning her a provisional qualifying time.

WOMEN'S FIELD

Libby Strickland, West Texas A&M University, SO, Amarillo, Texas, Randall HS

Strickland competed in the UCM Mule Relays and hit provisional in both the pentathlon (3,424) and high jump at 5-7.25 (1.71m). She went on to win the high jump event while placing second-overall in the pentathlon. In the process, she set a new personal record in the shot put with a 31-9.25 (9.68m). She currently leads the LSC in the high jump with her performance last weekend as her mark was just .01m away from tying her school and LSC records set last year.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Isaiah Samoei, Eastern New Mexico University, registered a fourth-place finish in the one-mile run at the University of New Mexico Collegiate Classic, with a provisional time of 4:13.66.

Alesha Jones, Eastern New Mexico University, finished the 800m at the University of New Mexico Collegiate Classic, with a provisional time of 2:17.74 and her fourth-place finish paced four Zias in the event. Her time shattered the previous ENMU record of 2:19.96, set by Amber Saiz.

The Buff and Lady Buff track & field teams competed in three separate competitions last weekend at Central Missouri, New Mexico, and Boston University. In all, the teams posted five provisional qualifying marks, set nearly 20 personal best performances and broke three school records along with one Lone Star Conference record. Libby Strickland competed in the UCM Mule Relays and hit provisional in the pentathlon (3,424) and high jump at 5-7.25 (1.71m). She went on to win the high jump event while placing second-overall in the pentathlon. On Friday, the first day of the David Hemery Valentine Invitational in Boston, Mireia Guarner set the new school women's mile record with a 5:00.18 earning a provisional mark. Then on Saturday, Baptiste Moreu broke a 37-year school record in the men's mile with his 4:06.77 run. In the process, he broke teammate Dylan Doss's LSC record from a year ago. With a few seconds added due to track size conversion, he ranks high on the provisional qualifying list. To cap off the weekend, the men's 4x4 relay team, consisting of Trevor Dennis, Kennedy Prescott, Jerrell Banks & Josh Helom, broke the school record with a time of 3:16.62, also a provisional qualifying time.
